- **1. MACUMBA DESBOIS -** A three-year-old filly by Falcao de Laurma out of Quiphyle Coglais who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- 2. MAHINA DE WALLIS A three-year-old filly by Love You out of Donostia who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **3. MAJESTY QUICK -** A three-year-old filly by Up And Quick out of Envoûtante Quick who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **4. MERVEILLE BOKO -** A three-year-old filly by Village Mystic out of Una Bella Dolce who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **5. MALIKA DU GUESCLIN -** Disqualified on debut at this course on 26 January. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

MEKNES (12) showed some significant progress in her last start and is worth a good look in. MEA MARIS (11) is on a redemption mission after her last below-par effort.

- **4. MILLESIME STAR -** Not disgraced when 5th on debut but fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out. Capable of making the frame
- **5. MAESTRO D'ESPACE -** Has not shown much so far and was disqualified at this track last time out on 22 January. Others are much preferred
- **6. MANDURO SALICE -** It's probably worth ignoring his last run at Nantes over 2275m on 16 December. Ran well on debut and has a winning chance

- **4. LADY ORANGE -** Disqualified in her first four starts but was runner-up last time out in Class F over this track and trip in 26 January. Can go one better this time
- **5. LUMINA JIEL -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this track on 17 January. Capable of winning if smart this time
