- 1. JUDOKA Finished 6th in class F at Angers over 3125m on 22 January. Unreliable and needs to do more to win
- **2. DONNER AMOUR -** Finished tenth in class E over this course and distance on 16 January. On a long losing streak and is poor in form. Others make more appeal
- **3. JASONDOR DU VINOIS -** Ran well when third in class F over this course and distance on 10 December. On a long losing streak but can earn some minor money
- **4. JET DE CANVILLE -** Unreliable and was 8th in class E at this track over 2850m on 3 January when barefoot. Not unshod this time and others are preferred
- **5. JUST IN LOVE -** Disappointing last run when 12th in class F at Angers over 3125m on 25 January. Victorious back in December and can contest the finish if smart back under the saddle
- **6. JIMANY -** Showed improvement when third in class D over this track and trip on 1 January. Unshod and has a winning chance
- **7. JACK TEJY -** Victorious in Class F at Nantes over 2275m on 21 January. Capable of following up if in the same mood
- **8. JAVRILLON -** Consistent of late and was third in class F at this course over 2175m on 25 December. On a long losing streak but could play a minor role
- **9. JAMY -** Unreliable and was 12th in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 8 December. Returns barefoot and can score back in his preferred discipline

- **2. LEOLIO -** Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 January. Remains barefoot but others are preferred this time
- **3. LE TAJ MAHAL -** Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 January. Unreliable and others are preferred
- **4. LINO DU POMMEREUX -** Finished 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 January. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. LOUIS VITTON MIJO -** Finished 7th in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 27 December. Inconsistent and others make more appeal

- **3. LEONCE DU CLOS -** Unreliable and was 7th in class C over this track and trip on 5 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. LAMONT DU DOUET -** Not disgraced when 5th in class B at this track over 2100m on 19 January. Won well in August but has been unreliable since
- **5. LASKO DES BROUSSES -** Victorious in Class C over this track and trip on 12 January. Remains barefoot and can win again
- **6. LE BEST MADRIK -** Very consistent and was runner-up in class B at this course over 2175m on 25 January. Has a winning chance

Summary: LASKO DES BROUSSES (5) was a sensational winner on his debut in the Mounted code and can follow up despite the rise in grade. A dual winner during the winter meeting, LARA DU LERRE (11) is another one who should be hugely respected stepping up in grade. LEGENDE DU GOUTIER (9) is a smart individual and can leave behind her last below-par run. LE PRIEURE (8) is a progressive horse who cannot be overlooked in a race like that.

- **2. L'AS DE PIQUE -** Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 18 January. Won well in October and can contest the finish if in the mood
- **3. L'EXPRESS DE PLAY -** Finished7th in class F at Argentan over 2150m on 25 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **4. LOUPINO -** Not disgraced when fourth in class F at Argentan over 2875m on 18 January. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- **5. LOOKING BOY -** Has looked good so far and was runner-up in class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 16 July. Returns from a break but would not be a surprise winner
- **6. L'AS DES CARAIBES -** Finished 5th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 22 January. Unreliable and others are preferred
- **7. LE BIEF -** Victorious in Class F at Angers over 2425m in 22 January. Has shown improvement and has a winning chance

Summary: LEADER TUILERIE (9) is well regarded by his connections and it is interesting to see him running barefoot on his first attempt at the Vincennes track. However, it is best to keep a close eye on LE CONQUERANT (1) who was a promising runner-up first time out at Nantes mid-January. LE BIEF (7) can prove a handful but posted a reassuring effort at Angers last time and warrants respect. LOOKING BOY (5) is well spoken on return from a break and is a valuable each-way prospect.

- **2. KILLIE EILISH -** Consistent and was third in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. Not out of it
- **3. KABRELLA -** Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 January. Victorious on three occasions last year and can bounce back to be a threat
- **4. KALYPSO DU CAUX** Not disgraced when 5th in class E at this track over 2700m on 29 December. Victorious in November and is not out of it
- **5. KORINA DE BEYLEV -** Unreliable but was runner-up in class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 19 December. Capable of getting involved with the finish again

- **4. KELLE EAU -** Has improved of late and was 5th in a claimer over this track and trip on 15 January. Can make the frame
- **5. KAJAGOOGOO -** Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in a claimer over this course and distance on 15 January. Can contest the finish again
- **6. KERNEZIA DU CORTA -** Unreliable but was victorious in this division over this track and trip on 15 January. Can follow up

KAJAGOOGOO (5) caught the eye with a pleasing late finish effort behind the selection last time and should go well. KHEOPS SAINT CLAIR (7) takes a step down in grade and can redeem himself. A game fourth in the benchmark race on 15 January, KALINE DES RIOULTS (2) is an each-way prospect.

- **5. MANHATTAN VISAIS -** Has not shown much so far and finished 5th in a Class D Mounted race at this course over 2200m on 16 January. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: METEORE DE SIMM (8) has shown enough ability under harness to be a big player on his first run under the saddle. MESSI PASS (3) was well-backed on debut in this code but blew his chances. He may be worth another go. MAGNOLIADARCHE (11) showed improvement last time over the inner track, finishing in front of several of today's rivals and should go well once again. MEPHISTO DU CLOS (7) looks a player with improvement likely.

- **5. IDOLE DELICE -** Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F over this track and trip on 15 January. Can go one better

GRYFFONDOR DU POLI (7) is usually a reliable horse and is expected to leave behind his last below-par effort. IVAJALE (6) is ideally placed on the front row at the start and can be given a good mention too.
