Both DIANI and WICCAN WARRIOR are better than their recent performances and could upset in a fast run race. QUEUE WING is rising nine years of age but has decent form and is not one to ignore.

I'M A FIREBALL won his penultimate start, setting a new course record over 1450m, and he could be hard to peg back from gate No 1. It's hard to look past these but KANAAL SKATER, who needed his last start, will enjoy a good gallop and could threaten.

GREENLIGHT QUEEN hasn't been convincing but has run well over the track and trip and is drawn well. ETHEREAL VIEW could relish the drop in class and perhaps she could finally get the timing right. LITTLEBLACKGEM is one of many with a say.

The lightly raced daughter of Trippi's rating has dropped she and must be respected even if racing after a break. SARAGOSSA CAT showed good pace on the Highveld and could have a say if ready after a rest. More can earn.
