## R1 ANGERS [R-H]

**C1 - GRAND PRIX ANGERS LOIRE METROPOLE - 3100m (a2m) - Gr3 -  
Harness - EUR € 64,000**

- 1. JOLIE STAR** - Complicated but has ample ability. Flew up in a Vincennes Class D 11 days ago, her first victory since moving to her new yard at the end of the winter meeting, and should prove dangerous at the business end of affairs
- 2. JOYCE DELTO** - Serious mare that returned to winning ways at Caen early last month, securing a 2450m Class D. Imposed here this time last year and, although unlikely to confirm, can nevertheless finish in the mix
- 3. KELLE BEAUTE** - Seldom wins but has been giving a fine account of herself since the turn of the year. Reverts to a previous formula and looks competitive for a place on the podium
- 4. HISA DU MARGAS** - Failed to confirm February performance when eliminated in a Vincennes Class C on 21 March. Is confirmed at Angers, however, and the front-line start will do her chances no disservice
- 5. RIKITA JP** - Already twice a winner this year, latterly dominating a Laval Class A 3 weeks ago. Has never raced right-handed in France but is as tough as they come and, with application, can bring the fight to IDEAL DU ROCHER (9)
- 6. GAUDEPSOU** - Returns to Angers after a pair of lacklustre efforts, but has otherwise been in decent shape. Enjoys a first-row start here, has placed in 1 of 2 Angers appearances, and will have his supporters
- 7. HIWI ROCQ** - Previously a good sort but lost his way last autumn and will first need to reassure
- 8. IDOLE OF LOVE** - Excellent mare when focused and is confirmed at this level, but is shod for comeback and best to keep one's powder dry
- 9. IDEAL DU ROCHER** - Left a very good impression when 3rd in strong Vincennes Gr.3 on 28 February. Ran 5th in Gr.3 Grand Prix Anjou-Maine on his only start at the venue and, despite the 25m handicap, is easy to like for the win
- 10. HIDALGO DES NOES** - Not always the most performant of horses these days but tends to acquit himself decently on a flat surface, and cannot be discounted
- 11. HALFA** - Well-engaged here, and has form at a superior level, but stays shod and is unlikely to create an upset
- 12. IMPALA DE VAL** - Wonderfully-consistent trotter with an enviable strike-rate but is plainly in conditioning-mode and can be ruled out
- 13. FILWELL** - Serious veteran being prepared for a campaign in the other discipline and will have nothing to contribute
- 14. FULTON** - Complicated type with better references in the other code and can be confidently disregarded

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**15. JUST LOVE YOU** - Prix d'Amérique 5th but failed to confirm in Prix de Paris in late-February. Is here for reasons of conditioning and can be passed over

**16. IDEALE DU CHENE** - High-class monte mare starting for first time since running 2nd in G.1 Prix Henri Desmontils on 28 February. Sports shoes this time and will not be troubling the judge

**Summary:** A fine servant that ran 3rd in the Gr.3 Prix du Plateau de Gravelle at Vincennes in late-February, IDEAL DU ROCHER (9) looks the best horse here and will be no easy touch. Clement Duvaldestin will still want to be wary of the talented, and better-placed, RIKITA JP (5) who comfortably won at Laval early last month, and the tricky JOLIE STAR (1) who steps up in category after having dominated in Paris. KELLE BEAUTE (3) has been knocking at the door this term and, reconfigured for the occasion, will be expected to play another active role. JOYCE DELTO (2) has taken little time getting back to her best and, winner of her only Angers start, will be justifiably well-supported.

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## C2 - PRIX BAUGE EN ANJOU - 2350m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. JAMES MADRIK** - Disappointing on the whole for some time and has no realistic chance
- 2. GORDON PAGUERIE** - Undeniably capable but his temperament frequently undermines his efforts. Is still in conditioning-mode and best left alone
- 3. HAMOUR DE SISSI** - Unexceptional trotter that finished last but one on comeback 2.5 weeks ago and cannot be considered a priority
- 4. GAVROCHE ANABA** - Has picked up in 2026 where he left off last season. Has been entrusted to Cyril Baty for the occasion but still represents no more than a minor place prospect
- 5. HURRICANE STEED** - Returns to the provinces after losing his action at Enghien, benefits from a good draw and, barefoot as he was when placing here in November, looks a serious proposition
- 6. HISCO DE PARNIERE** - Has never excelled in the amateur category but has merit. Is competitively-shod for re-entry and is not incapable of getting a look in
- 7. IZELBIO** - Has limited amateur experience but is plainly better than most here and makes his Angers bow with a decent chance of making it a successful one
- 8. HELBERT FOUTEAU** - Still lightly-raced aged 9 and has shown a liking for the track. Faces first real objective of the new year and, despite the wide draw, still has a realistic chance of getting his nose in front
- 9. ISA DU PRESOIR** - Serious campaigner in the amateur division and ran 2nd on sole start at the venue. Has pulled a rough number following her Lisieux comeback but will be barefoot for the occasion and expected to play an active role
- 10. HASARD BLOND** - Occasionally tricky but has form at this level. Has not been seen out since early-November though and will have few friends
- 11. ISPANO BELLO** - Has 2 runs under his belt following a 14 months' absence but stays shod and best to keep one's powder dry
- 12. HEZA DE L'ERDRE** - Fine servant making first appearance since securing an amateurs Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel last October and is going to need the race
- 13. HIDALGO DAIRPET** - Has been an absolute write-off for last couple of years and will have nothing to offer
- 14. JAB KISS** - Never far from faulting but impressed twice last month. Not ideally-placed on the back line but still has the wherewithal to pick up a cheque
- 15. IRMINIO KILY** - Ran 3rd in a Vire amateurs Class G in February but has twice failed to confirm and others easier to back
- 16. GYPSIE MAGIQUE** - Seldom gets her way but regularly gives her best. Is new to the venue, and has been handed a rough draw, but has been reconfigured and is not to be overlooked

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**Summary:** Proven at a superior level, and nicely-engaged, IZELBIO (7) starts wide on the front row but still looks good enough to win this. Starting just to his outside, HELBERT FOUTEAU (8) is competitively-shod this time and has already won at the venue. Better-positioned behind the car, HURRICANE STEED (5) placed here during the autumn and should again figure prominently if he keeps his action together. JAB KISS (14) may not have faired well in the draw stakes but he is clearly in fine shape and will sport front pads this time.

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**C3 - PRIX TENOR DE BAUNE - 2350m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR  
€ 17,500**

- 1. NECTAR DRY** - Qualified in an excellent 1'17'7 but was unable to keep her action together first time out. Is plainly a serious trotter in the making and can get his nose in front if he stays in stride
- 2. NIKE DE JANEIRO** - Pleased on debut on 18 January before disappointing in a Saint-Brieuc Class F a fortnight later. Is not devoid of ability and even in this field can contest a spot in first 5
- 3. NICE ATOUT** - Promising individual that showed a different side when entrusted to Eric Raffin. Has a lot going for him here and looks a serious proposition
- 4. NECTAR DE JANZE** - Has yet to show any particular aptitude for the game and others easier to back
- 5. NEBULON HUB** - Respectable on debut at Cordemais early last month before faulting at Maure-de-Bretagne last week. Is not an obvious choice but with some luck in running can pick up some crumbs
- 6. NO SECRET** - Returns to racing clockwise after giving a respectable account on re-entry at Chartres 2.5 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the race and should have a decent chance of trotting his way onto the podium
- 7. NICO ARCTIC** - Has placed in both clockwise starts to date, latterly 3rd in a Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel mid-February. Is not a standout in this field but still has the wherewithal to finish in the mix
- 8. NEW LOOK SENOVILLE** - Went close on debut at Reims before being eliminated early at Agen. Should take well to the new conditions and Matthieu Abrivard will be keen to relegate his charge's latest run to the history books
- 9. NICOLAS** - Qualified unexceptionally in 1'19'0 at Laval last week and will need to find more in order to make his presence felt
- 10. NAPOLEON BONAPARTE** - Qualified modestly last November before being trounced on debut at Nantes the following month. Has not been seen since and can be ruled out

**Summary:** After qualifying nicely in Grosbois 3 weeks ago, NECTAR DRY (1) was competitive when eliminated on his debut 10 days later, but moves to a hard surface and can get off the mark if Benjamin Rochard keeps him trotting. NEW LOOK SENOVILLE (8) should not be too hastily-condemned for being eliminated at Agen and Matthieu Abrivard will be eager to put things right. Runner-up at Machecoul mid-March when piloted by Eric Raffin for the first time, NICE ATOUT (3) is ideally-placed behind the car, has been fitted with front pads, and looks a major player. Mathieu Mottier takes over on NO SECRET (6) who has looked a decent future prospect.

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**C4 - PRIX DES CUISINES YOU - 2350m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR  
€ 20,000**

- 1. MADONE PIYA** - Blows hot and cold but has twice won racing right-handed. Is competitively-shod for the first time and must not be underestimated
- 2. MALICIA DU ROCHER** - Put away after imposing at Cabourg last October. Has just the one race in her since the break but has been reconfigured for the first time and from the 2 slot will be no pushover
- 3. MIRZA DU BOUILLON** - Moderate element that set off no fireworks on her return to competition 2 weeks ago and is unlikely to influence the result
- 4. MILADY DE LA PIECE** - Well-known to the stewards but has no shortage of ability. Has 2 races under her belt this term and can make a big splash if Matthieu Abrivard gets her off on the right foot
- 5. MARVELOUS PIYA** - Eliminated in first 2 starts this year before running fine 2nd in a 2400m Amiens Class F on 4 March. Mathieu Mottier back in the bike and can win this if he manages to keep her focused
- 6. MERRY DE MALABRY** - Eliminated on comeback in a 2450m Caen Class E on 12 March. Is plainly in good shape though and is well-placed to redeem herself. Chance
- 7. METSUYANE ERA** - Put in a good finish at Caen on 12 March, even though unplaced. Has 2 races under her belt this term and it is just a question of time before she comes good again
- 8. MIRELLA DE LOU** - Is back racing shod after having pleased in a Vire Class E 2 weeks ago. David Thomain in the bike, but his charge races shod this time, and others easier to support
- 9. MARA DU SAPHIR** - Left a fine impression on re-entry despite being eliminated early at Lisieux on 26 March. Goes barefoot again and with application can wrap this up
- 10. MAISY DU DONJON** - Flattering 4th of 7 in a 2850m Vincennes Class E on re-entry in early-February. Has had time to get back in shape but faces a good lot here and Max Beauvais will be conscious of the unfavourable draw
- 11. MAITIKA DE PEBRISY** - No slouch on a good day. and pleased on comeback early last month, but is taking on too much this time
- 12. MIA FELICIA** - Has not been seen out for almost a year. Pleased on lone start at the venue but still has no possible chance
- 13. MISS D'HERMES** - Capable filly starting for the first time since last August and will not be given a hard race
- 14. MAKITA BERRY** - Useful filly that was not overextended on re-entry at Meslay-du-Maine a fortnight ago. Is still being conditioned though and is not a priority
- 15. MELODISYVA** - Pleasantly surprised at Toulouse in January before failing to confirm the following month. Sports a new configuration, will be fresh for the occasion, but is still not a concern

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**Summary:** Although never far from faulting, MARVELOUS PIYA (5) has bags of ability and goes well right-handed. She got back in the game at Amiens early last month, goes first-time barefoot, and can impose. MARA DU SAPHIR (9) showed her form after being eliminated on comeback last week and, despite the draw, still has the ability to impose. MERRY DE MALABRY (6) also lost her action on re-entry but has no shortage of talent, and Eric Raffin will be determined to set the record straight. MILADY DE LA PIECE (4) would have finished closer at Vincennes in late-February had he kept trotting; she returns to racing shod and, with application, can make amends.

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**C5 - PRIX IGUSKI SAUTOMNE - 3125m (a2m) - Class C - Mounted - EUR € 38,000**

**1. COMPETIVO** - Excellent trotter that finished runner-up in both monte starts, including over course and distance. Is plainly at the top of his game and will have this in the bag if form transitions

**2. JOKER DE FROULAY** - Runner-up in his last 2, latterly a Vire Class E a fortnight back. Considering the form of the Mathieu Mottier yard, it is easy to fancy him for a big performance. Chance

**3. JABLO DU CHENE** - Serious campaigner that wins 1 in 3, but has won 2 for 2 under these conditions. Will have had this on his agenda for some time and Paul Ploquin will be keen to get straight back down to business

**4. JINGLE DELO** - Has hardly put a foot wrong since moving stables last summer. Failed to make the grade on sole right-handed monte start, but in current condition is hard to fault

**5. FOREVER D'ARIANE** - Got the year off to a decent start before coming off the boil. Is no longer the most convincing under the saddle and can be passed over

**6. GRAZIELA D'EL** - Back under the saddle after failing to fire lately under harness and is unlikely to make much of an impact

**7. IMELDA** - Honest mare that ran 4th to HASARD (11) in a Laval Class E 3 weeks ago. Has ground to make up but should nevertheless acquit herself honourably

**8. DOWHATYOU DODOWELL** - Previously a decent trotter but has done nothing of note for some time and others easier to back

**9. HURIEL LUDOIS** - No slouch when he can be minded to perform but has not raced since late-December and can expect to be race-rusty

**10. JUS DE FRUIT** - Has failed to deliver in 3 after having imposed at Cagnes before the turn of the year. Did show his form before being eliminated at Enghien last week, and Alexis Collette will be minded to keep him focused. Minor honours

**11. HASARD** - Produced quite the performance to win a Laval Class E 3 weeks ago, beating JINGLE DELO (4). Has turned a corner recently and is unlikely to be far from the action

**12. HOUARNEAU** - 4th in an Enghien Class C last week. Will not be sent out at 175-1 this time but is unlikely to be as competitive either

**13. INSTANT GRAVE** - Showed improvement when 4th behind JINGLE DELO (4) in a Cordemais Class D in late-February. Enjoys a good entry and returns to racing clockwise with a decent hand to play

**Summary:** A fine Swedish raider whose French sojourn has already paid dividends, COMPETIVO (1) is back under the saddle after winning twice under harness recently and will be well-backed to win this. Runner-up in his last 2, it will not be long before JOKER DE FROULAY (2) returns to victorious ways. JABLO DU CHENE (3) may not have been seen out since October but he is undefeated in 2 starts over course and distance and will be barefoot for his return to competition. JINGLE DELO (4) is a model of consistency and will have a lot to contribute if he takes to the new profile.

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## C6 - PRIX 24H AU TROT - 3125m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LUCKY LUC FOSSAVIE** - Respectable type making seasonal re-entry following a 5 months' break, and in this company looks to be out of his depth
- 2. LEVITE** - Showed some ability last spring but subsequently lost his way and, even though barefoot, is not about to garner much support
- 3. LAGOS DE VAL** - Considerably better in the other discipline but always gives his best. Is not about to cause an upset but will be worth monitoring
- 4. LARGO DE LA BESSE** - No slouch on a good day but has just the one race in him this term and would have better prospects at a lower level
- 5. LOVE ET CASH RENKA** - Eliminated at Le Croise-Laroche on comeback just 9 days ago, but is hard to knock when racing right-handed and, competitively-shod on the front row, should not be far off the mark
- 6. LEADER DU RIB** - Capable element in the other code. Makes first appearance since November and will have other ambitions
- 7. LOUP D'ARDENNES** - Moves up in category after having run 4th in a Class F over course and distance in early-February. Comes here fresh from a spell and, while not a priority, should be respected nevertheless
- 8. LUXOR DE MARZY** - Opened his seasonal account in an Enghien Class E 3 weeks ago, but would be preferred barefoot
- 9. LOVE ACTUALLY** - Can prove a handful but otherwise seldom disappoints. Has 3 wins to his name when barefoot, has never disappointed with his driver, and must be regarded a leading protagonist
- 10. LILIAN DU PARADIS** - Fine servant that imposed here last spring. Has not been seen out since August and with shoes fitted will have nothing to contribute
- 11. LUI DU DONJON** - Showed considerable improvement when 4th in a Laval Class E 3 weeks ago. Is barefoot for first objective of the year and is unlikely to disappoint
- 12. LE CAPORAL** - Fine servant that picked up 2 weeks ago where he left off in mid-December. Makes his Angers debut with morale intact and is in with a decent shout of pulling off the hat-trick
- 13. LEO DES MALBERAUX** - Showed he was close to his race when 2nd in a Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne last week. Boasts a 50 percent win-rate going right-handed and can challenge for a place in the mix
- 14. L'AMIRAL TURGOT** - Blue-blooded element being reunited with Gabriele Gelormini after a necessary freshener. Is better than most here and, if applied, can give LE CAPORAL (12) a run for his money

**Summary:** Sent for a break after imposing at Cabourg in December, LE CAPORAL (12) was superb on his comeback at Meslay-du-Maine a fortnight ago and has a realistic chance of confirming. Runner-up that day after having imposed at Saint-Brieuc, LOVE ACTUALLY (9) excels with Eric Raffin, is barefoot for the occasion, and should again figure prominently, however he may first have to see off the wonderfully-entered L'AMIRAL TURGOT (14) who will have come on for his return run. LEO DES MALBERAUX (13) has yet to disappoint when barefoot and should again prove competitive for a spot in the picture.

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## C7 - PRIX ISUZU - ETABLISSEMENT PETIT - 3125m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KADENCE CENSERIE** - Solid in all 4 monte starts to date, but faces a particularly tough task here and chances limited
- 2. JOYEUX DE BOLERO** - 2nd to a good mare at Meslay-du-Maine a fortnight ago, on first appearance in the discipline. Faces some better horses on this occasion but did enough last time to be considered a respectable first-5 prospect
- 3. KANDISSIME** - Put in a solid effort to come 3rd in a Class E at Le Croise-Laroche a month ago. Has had time to freshen up and, on good behaviour, can put in another good showing
- 4. KILOU** - Returns to the monte code after being pulled-up under harness at Enghien on 13 March. Has little experience under the saddle but is clearly in form and looks an interesting outsider
- 5. JANETTE TY** - Put in career-best monte performance at Saint-Brieuc in February but a repeat looks decidedly unlikely
- 6. JINGLE PACA** - Has been off the boil in both codes since last spring and with shoes fitted will have nothing to contribute
- 7. KEOPS LUDOIS** - Made her mark on re-entry when 3rd in a Lisieux Class D last week. Will have come on for the race and is eminently capable of going closer
- 8. JEDI** - Back under the saddle after a comeback run under harness at Laval 3 weeks ago. Has evident ability but would be preferred more-competitively configured
- 9. JOKER DES ISLES** - Returns to code of preference after been given a harness re-entry run at Laval on 18 February. Has nothing to prove under the saddle but in this company will struggle to make his presence felt
- 10. JUST ME NESLE** - Got back in the game on first start since his spell, running 2nd in a Maure-de-Bretagne Class F last week, and with form maintained will not be available at 67-1 this time
- 11. JOLIKOVA D'ARIANE** - Ran 3rd under harness here before losing her action at Challans. Has placed in 1 of 2 monte starts and returns to the code with every expectation that she will hold her own
- 12. JOKER DE LA BRETTE** - Close 2nd in a 2550m Reims Class G 2.5 weeks ago, on first ridden start. Will have progressed for the race and can play a prominent role if she stays in stride
- 13. KORRIGAN OLIVERIE** - Quality individual starting for first time since last September. Comes from a good yard though, will be barefoot for return, and cannot be ruled out
- 14. KORINTO BELLO** - Has taken superbly to the ridden code and has won under these very conditions. Will have been specifically prepared for this and Eric Raffin will be keen to deliver
- 15. INDIGODARCHE** - Nicely-engaged here but has been eliminated in all 3 starts this term and can expect to have few, if any, friends

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**Summary:** Most impressive in this branch of the business, and well-engaged here, KORINTO BELLO (14) may not have been seen out for over 2 months, but he is clearly in race-mode and looks set to take all the beating. KEOPS LUDOIS (7) gave a fine account at Lisieux on his first start this year, and will be more competitively-shod this time. JOKER DE LA BRETTE (12) put on quite the show at Reims mid-March on her monte bow. KANDISSIME (3) put 4 straight eliminations behind her to reassure at Le Croise-Laroche and will have her chances if Arthur Rebeche keeps her trotting.

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**C8 - PRIX INO DU LUPIN - 2350m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
28,000**

- 1. KYNTE FLUSH** - Oddly below-par when eliminated in a Vincennes Class E on 21 March. Has been reconfigured for the occasion and will have a prominent role to play if Alexandre Abrivard manages to keep her focused
- 2. JUMBY BAY** - Has not imposed since last summer but has been acquitting herself particularly well of late. Is new to Angers, but not racing clockwise, and with Mathieu Mottier in the bike, clearly means business
- 3. KASSYA** - Looked in excellent shape when eliminated in a Vincennes Class D mid-February. Benefits from a good entry, is well-positioned on the front line, and can pick up a first victory for 12 months
- 4. KINASSE DE VIVOIN** - Produced 4 excellent performances before failing to deliver in race of reference. Sports front pads this time but should not be entirely ignored
- 5. JAVA DU CHERISAY** - 6th behind KIRA BO FACE (8) in 21 March race of reference. Is at ease over these shorter trips and, sporting a fresh configuration, will have her chances from the 5 slot
- 6. ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Respectable 5th of 17 in a Caen Class F on 16 March, but faces a much stiffer test this time and chances limited
- 7. JINA FOUTEAU** - Has looked rather ordinary for much of the winter. Was not disgraced in race of reference but still has a lot more to find
- 8. KIRA BO FACE** - Blows hot and cold but beat a number of these when 3rd in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 21 March. Should appreciate Angers conditions and will not be available at 34-1. Chance
- 9. JAVOTTE MADRIK** - Won 3 from 4, all going clockwise, before being sent for a rest in December. Has not been seen since, and has pulled an unfavourable number, but is barefoot for the occasion and looks an interesting outsider
- 10. JUDICIEUSE ZAILER** - Lost her way late last summer. Goes barefoot this time but appears to have no possible chance
- 11. KIRCIE DE GUEZ** - Moderate mare with better aptitude for the ridden code and can be passed over
- 12. IDEALE DE LA COMTE** - Has just the one race under her belt since the winter layoff and with shoes fitted will have nothing to bring to the party
- 13. JALNA GIRL** - Returns to the professional ranks after winning 2 straight in the amateur division. Has imposed twice for Arthur Raffin, but not for Eric, although his presence in the bike will assure his mare considerable support

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**Summary:** Given an extra couple of weeks to recalibrate after losing her action in Paris last time, KASSYA (3) boasts solid right-handed references and, with Paul Ploquin back in the bike, can bring home the bacon. Although seldom seen racing right-handed, KIRA BO FACE (8) does not enjoy the best of draws but will be dangerous if she replicates her recent Vincennes performance. JUMBY BAY (2) finished close behind her that day, has produced some good times recently, and even though shod still represents a respectable place chance. She may not be the easiest to use but KYNTE FLUSH (1) reverts to a successful formula for her Angers debut and, if applied, will be no easy touch.
