PAY TO LEARN (1), with Group I entries to his name, fits a similar profile and ought to fight for victory, despite conceding weight to the selection. GIBRALTAR (2) confirmed the promise of his debut (4th) by finishing 3rd last time and will make his presence felt if building on that improvement.
