# C1 - PRIX LES TROTTEURS ET GALOPEURS DE LAURA - 2950m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. JANCYANE D'ISOP -** Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class F at Parayle-Monial over 2625m on 19 May. Yet to win but does have a place chance
- **2. JALENCIA BELLA -** Broke a string of three disqualifications in a row when runner-up last time out in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 19 May. Can go one better if smart
- **3. JESSICA TURGOT -** Broke a string of disqualifications last time out when 6th in Class E at this course over 2800m on 18 May. More is needed to win this race
- **4. JOUANA GEM -** Has struggled this year and was tenth last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 12 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. JELCKAMA RANAISE -** Yet to win a race after 40 attempts and she was disqualified last time out at Vire on 25 May. Capable of playing a minor role
- **6. JESS D'ANARDEL -** Has lost her way of late and she was disqualified last time out at Mamers on 20 May. Best watched for now
- **7. JUNGLE JULRY -** Has needed both her starts this year and was disqualified last time out at L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue on 27 April. Has a good record when barefoot and can bounce back to score
- **8. JEZABELLE DES IRIS -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at this course on 27 May. Capable of better and could surprise if wise
- **9. JOIE DE CORTEM -** Showed some improvement when 7th last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 26 May. Hard to trust and more is needed to win
- **10. JOLIE CLAIRE -** Yet to win a race and was 6th last time out in Class F at Vire over 2825m on 8 May. Capable of playing a minor role
- **11. JUNGLE DU CAUX -** Has lost her way and was disqualified last time out at Lyon-Parilly on 25 May. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **12. JAVA DES LINANS -** Yet to win and was disqualified last time out at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne on 1 May. Unreliable but does pop up in a place every now and then
- **13. JAVA MIP -** Improving and was fourth last time out in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 5 May. Could do better this time
- **14. JULIETTE MIXO -** Disappointing form of late and was 6th last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 20 May. Won three times last year and is capable of an upset
- **15. JUVISY GEMA -** Disappointing of late and was 9th last time out in Class F at Vire over 2825m on 25 May. Did better earlier this year and is not out of it
- **16. JAFLO GEMA -** Unreliable and was 9th last time out in Class F at Durtal over 2825m on 20 May. Capable of better and can contest the finish

**Summary:** JUNGLE JULRY (7) has a good record when unshod so vast improvement can be expected from her and she could bounce back to score. JAFLO GEMA (16) is capable of better than what she has been showing of late and could be a threat. JAVA MIP (13) is improving and should be right there at the finish once again. JUVISY GEMA (15) did better earlier in the year and is not out of it.

#### C2 - PRIX DE LA MONTAGNE BOURBONNAISE - 2950m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. JASON GEDE -** Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at this course on 21 May. Hard to trust and others are much preferred
- **2. JOS DU GOUTAI -** Holding form and was third last time out in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 2019 May. Might play a minor role
- **3. JACK OAKS -** Has struggled all year and was 9th last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 18 May. Unlikely to win
- **4. JULIO MANNETOT -** Returned to form with a barefoot win last time out in Class H at Rânes over 3125m on 20 May. Remains unshod and is not out of it
- **5. JOEYSTAR DE NIRO -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Gournay-en-Bray on 26 May. Capable of earning some minor money
- **6. JERIDAN -** On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Arras on 20 may. Others are much preferred
- **7. JET SIXTY ONE -** Disqualified in five of last six starts including last time out at Gournay-en-Bray on 26 May. Best watched for now
- **8. JASMIN METIS -** Unreliable of late and was 8th last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 18 May. Yet to win but does pop up in a place every now and then
- **9. JOBI SAINT JO -** Yet to win a race after 31 attempts but he did run well when runner-up in Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2800m on 5 May. Could play a minor role
- **10. JUST AN EAGLE -** Could pay to ignore his last run when 8th in Class E at this course over 2800m on 21 May. Usually runs well with this shoe combination and can upset
- **11. JOLVIK DE GUEZ -** Bounced back to his best when victorious last time out in Class F at Saint-Malo over this distance on 20 May. Capable of following up
- **12. JAGUAR GEMA -** Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at Saint-Malo on 20 May. Capable of running well when in the mood
- **13. JUST ME DIESCHOOT -** Mostly disappointing form this year and was 8th last time out in Class f at Caen over 2200m on 18 May. Others are preferred
- **14. JOKER DU RABUTIN -** Nearly a year since last win but he is holding his form and he was fourth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 12 May. Could play a minor role
- **15. JOB DU CEBE -** Did not run badly when 5th last time out in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2600m on 16 May. Has a winning chance
- **16. JIVAGO BLEU -** Very consistent this year and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 26 March. Can fight out the finish again

**Summary:** JOLVIK DE GUEZ (11) was a good winner last time out and looks progressive so could double up. JIVAGO BLEU (16) is very consistent and would not be a surprise winner. JAGUAR GEMA (12) is hard to trust and was disqualified last time out but is capable of contesting the finish. JOB DU CEBE (15) is likely to even better than the recent fifth-place finish.

# C3 - PRIX DU PERCHER - 2800m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- **1. HERMINE DU SABLIER -** Showed vast improvement when runner-up last time out in Class H at Carpentras over 2650m on 12 May. Probably better on the grass now and others are preferred
- **2. IBIZA DE BOURGOGNE -** Disappointing last run when 11th in Class G at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 20 May. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **3. INFLUENCE JULRY -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this course on 18 May. Capable of winning when in the mood
- **4. IDEALE D'ABBEVILLE -** Was a barefoot winner last time out in Class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 19 May. Not fully unshod this time but could make the frame
- **5. INESKA -** On a very long losing run and was 7th last time out in Class D at Carpentras over 2625m on 14 April. Might play a minor role
- **6. HESTIA DU COMTAL** Disqualified in two of her last three starts, with the latest being at Carpentras on 12 May. Others are preferred
- **7. IRONIE DU RABUTIN -** She was in very good form before she fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out at Lyon-Parilly on 3 May. Should fight out the finish
- **8. ISIA DU CHENE -** Returning to her best and she was fourth last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 13 May. Can do even better this time around
- **9. HINATA -** Has been struggling for some time now and she was disqualified last time out at Royan La Palmyre on 19 May. Very unlikely to win
- **10. HEDENE D'ERONVILLE -** On a very long losing streak and was 6th last time out in Class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 19 May. Others are preferred
- **11. ISA DES GENIEVRES** Very unreliable but did run well when runner-up last time out in Class F at this course over 2950m on 12 May. Might place

**Summary:** ISIA DU CHENE (8) showed improvement last time out and could be returning to her best, If that is indeed the case she will be the one to beat. IRONIE DU RABUTIN (7) was in very good form before failing last time out and should be a lively runner. INFLUENCE JULRY (3) is not easy to trust but is also capable of running well. IDEALE D'ABBEVILLE (4) won when barefoot last time out but will not be fully unsod this time around.

# C4 - PRIX DE GIPCY - 2800m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- **1. ITEM DE MONTCIANT -** Disappointing of late and was tenth last time out in Class E at this course over 2950m on 21 May. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **2. ICARE DE PHYT'S -** Unreliable but he did show some improvement when 5th last time out in Class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 19 May. Can do even better this time
- **3. ILTON DE BELLANDE -** Mostly moderate form of late and was 5th last time out in Class H at Carpentras over 2650m on 12 May. Needs to do more to win this race
- **4. HISTORIQUE ELDE -** Has lost his way of late with two disqualifications in a row and the latest was at Hyeres on 11 May. Capable of a surprise if wise
- **5. IGLON DAIRPET -** Usually gives of his best and was fourth last time out in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 20 May. Could make the frame
- **6. INDIGO DE NAPPES -** Pulled off a hat-trick of wins last year but has been disappointing since then and is coming off two disqualifications in a row, with the latest being at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne on 20 May. Others are preferred
- **7. INDEX D'YVEL -** Disappointing form this year and was tenth last time out in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 28 March. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **8. HELLO D'URZY -** Has lost his way this year and was disqualified last time out at Montluçon Néris-les-Bains on 9 May. Others are preferred
- **9. IDEAL D'URZY -** Capable of better than the recent 7th-place finish in Class E over this course and distance on 6 May. Won two in a row before that and can be a real threat to these rivals
- **10. HALTO MESSI -** Fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne on 20 May. In good form before that and is not out of it
- **11. IF BLEU -** Probably needed both his starts this year and was disqualified last time out at this course on 18 May. Can bounce back to score

**Summary:** IF BLEU (11) has won both times for this current driver and could bounce back to score after some modest efforts. ICARE DE PHYT'S (2) showed some improvement last time out and even better is expected this time. IDEAL D'URZY (9) won two in a row before a moderate last run so deserves respect. ITEM DE MONTCIANT (1) is capable of being victorious if at best.

- **1. KID DU POMMEREUX -** Showed improvement when fourth last time out in a claimer at Saint-Malo over this distance on 20 May. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 2. KHALIFE DU CHENE Disqualified on his debut but showed vast improvement in his second start when runner-up in Class G at Le Touquet over 2600m on 19 May. Place chance
- **3. KYLIO DE BERTRANGE -** Yet to win a race after 16 attempts and was disqualified last time out at this course on 18 May. Others are much preferred
- **4. KAMARO DE JOUDES -** Yet to win and was a disappointment when 12th last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 12 May. In good form before that and can earn some money
- **5. KITUS DE BERTRANGE -** Yet to win a race and was tenth last time out in Class E at this course over 2800m on 12 May. Capable of popping up in a place every now and then
- **6. KISS PAULCA -** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Gournay-en-Bray on 20 May. Did better in his penultimate start and is capable of earning some money
- **7. KENZO DE CLOPEAU -** Disappointing of late and was disqualified last time out at Durtal on 20 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset
- **8. KIDAM DE LA VALLEE -** Unreliable this year and was well beaten last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 27 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. KRONOS DE BUSSET Showed some improvement when barefoot and runner-up in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 2 April. Not unshod this time and others are preferred
- **10. KIMCOERE LE FOL -** Seems at very best over shorter distances and was 7th last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 27 May. Others are preferred
- **11. KALOU D'IROISE -** On a long losing run but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 26 May. Place chance
- **12. KANARDO FOR CLARA -** Unreliable but did run well last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 18 May. Not easy to trust but is also not out of it
- **13. KAMERIC -** Probably best to ignore the last run when 7th in Class D over this course and distance on 6 May. Barefoot again and could contest the finish
- **14. KING DE BASSIERE -** Disappointing this year and was 9th last time out in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2250m on 23 May. Capable of playing a minor role

**Summary:** KRACH NONANTAIS (16) won easily for this trainer last time out and it would not be much of a surprise if the follow-on win happened. KASH DES CAILLONS (15) broke a long losing run last time out and deserves consideration. KAMERIC (13) is barefoot this time so can contest the finish. KENZO DE CLOPEAU (7) remains barefoot and is capable of vast improvement.

- **2. KELBELLE MOIRE -** Fair form of late and was 5th last time out in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. KUEEN DE MONGUERET -** Showed what she is capable of when winning last time out in Class F at Ecommoy over 2750m on 18 May. Liked the turf but can contest the finish
- **4. KELLY DU LYONNAIS -** Yet to win a race and she was 7th last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 12 May. Needs to do more to win
- **5. KALIE CHOUM -** Yet to win but she was not disgraced when runner-up last time out in Class F at Loudéac over 2850m on 11 May. Could play a minor role
- **6. KOCARDE -** In good form of late and was fourth last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 26 May. Could earn some money
- **7. KAURA DE LA VALLEE -** Not easy to trust but she has been good of late and she was runner-up last time out in Class E over this course and distance on 12 May. Not out of it
- **8. KATE BRIONNAISE** A mixed bag of tricks this one, with three wins, three disqualifications and a fourth-place finish last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 18 May. Not out of it
- **9. KALIENTE D'ATOUT -** Has yet to win but she was not disgraced when runner-up last time out in Class E at this course over 2800m on 13 May. Place chance if smart
- **10. KEVA LUDOISE -** Much improved this year and she was a winner last time out in Class E at this course over 2800m on 13 May. Can double up
- **11. KROKEUSE -** Yet to win but she has been consistent of late and was third last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 18 May. Might play a minor role
- **12. KELLY DE CERISY -** Well tried this year and did win in March but she was only 5th last time out in a Class E harness race at this course over 2150m on 18 May. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- **13. KENZA KALOUMA -** A winner of three of her five starts so far and she was not disgraced when runner-up last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 18 May. Should be right there at the finish once again
- **14. KALLISTEE -** Won twice last year and was runner-up last time out in Class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 13 October. Has ability but might need this run returning from a break
- **15. KYARA -** She has really struggled this year and she was disqualified last time out at Bernay on 12 May. Best watched for now

**Summary:** KEVA LUDOISE (10) looks much improved this year and can double up on a promising last win. KENZA KALOUMA (13) has been good so far and should fight out the finish once again. KATE BRIONNAISE (8) is not easy to trust but has the ability to win a race like this. KUEEN DE MONGUERET (3) liked the grass last time out but cannot be dismissed from winning on this surface.

- **3. KARINA DE LA MOIRE -** Not disgraced when 5th on debut but she was disqualified last time out at Machecoul on 25 May. Others are preferred
- **4. KAVAL DES AUGERIES -** Has struggled all year and was disqualified last time out at Châlons-en-Champagne on 25 May. Unlikely to win
- **5. KLASSICAL CLASS -** Very hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at Gournay-en-Bray on 20 May. Others are much preferred
- **6. KASANE DU HAUTVENT -** Yet to win a race and was 5th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 25 May. More is needed to win
- **7. KING GEDE -** Disappointing form of late and was 6th last time out in a Class F harness race at Rostrenen over 2850m on 19 May. Capable of better and is not out of it

- **11. KADENCE MAN -** In good form this year and was third last time out in a Class Fa Mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 25 May. Not out of it
- **12. KALINKA GEDE -** Hard to trust and was 6th last time out in a Class E harness race at this course over 2150m on 18 May. Yet to win and others are preferred

- LORENZO D'EVA Disqualified in both starts, with the latest being at Lyon-Parilly on 15 April. Best watched for now
- **3. LADY DU CHENE -** She ran well when third on debut but she has struggled three times since then and was disqualified last time out at Strasbourg on 16 May. Place chance
- **4. LEADER OAKS -** Disqualified twice in just four starts including last time out at this course over 2150m on 18 May. Capable of earning some money if smart
- **5. LISA SOYER -** She is improving and she was runner-up last time out in Class G at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 19 May. Tackles stronger but is not out of it
- **6. LA MAGIE DU PERSIL -** Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at this course on 21 May. Capable of playing a minor role if wise
- **7. LITTLEROK D'EURVAD -** Not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 26 April. Can earn some more money
- **8. LAGON D'ORIENT -** Has shown some promise so far and he was third last time out in Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 26 March. Be right there at the finish
- **9. LEVIATHAN SANTMIXO -** Not at all disgraced when only 5th last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 26 april. Needs to do more to win this race
