# VINCENNES [L-H] - 01 July

## Race 1 - PRIX NEMAUSA - 2100m MOBILE C105 RST E Harness. Purse EUR €51,000.

- 1. **IMOKO AIMEF** Finished 20 metres back in eighth at his latest run over 2875m at Enghien. Certainly worth another chance.
- 2. **KILIMANJARO** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2250m at Enghien. Forgive the recent mishap. Looks ideally placed.
- 3. **FETLOCK JOINT** Finished 16 metres back in fifth at his latest appearance over 2100m at this track. Can improve sharply.
- 4. **IMPACT DE COLMINE** Resumes. He goes well at this circuit and has performed strongly when fresh in the past. Leading contender.
- 5. **BRAND ROC** May need the outing following a spell of four-and-a-half months. Last raced when sixth over 2100m at this track.
- 6. **IMPACT PLAYER** Is ready to win finishing in the money at two of his last three runs the latest when second over 2200m at Vichy. Leading contender again.
- 7. INTEGRE Disqualified for galloping last start over 2200m at Vichy. Forgive the latest run. Can turn things around.
- 8. **INSTRUMENTALISTE** Finished runner-up over 2700m at this track last start after he missed the top-three but wasn't disgraced two back at this track. Will be right in the thick of things.
- 9. **HYPER FAST** Missed out last start when ninth over 2100m at this track after finishing in the placings at this track the start prior. Among the main chances.
- 10. STARO ON THE ROCKS Five-year-old entire by Conway Hall on French debut. Market can guide.
- 11. **BARNABA BABA** Missed the placings again last start beaten 10 metres when sixth over 2700m at this track. Solid top-three prospects.
- 12. **BIAGIO JET** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2100m at this track. Overlook the last run. Looks ideally placed.
- 13. **BENVENUTO PAR** Comes here after finishing a well-beaten seventh on French debut over 2850m at this track five weeks ago. Forward performance expected.
- 14. **PHILOSOPHER** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2475m at Royan La Palmyre. Overlook the most recent outing. Can turn things around.
- 15. **NEW EXPRESS** Finished runner-up over 2100m at this track last start after he missed the top-three but wasn't far away two back at this track. Found a few ahead of him.
- 16. BALDUR Five-year-old gelding from the Vitale Ciotola stable making his first French appearance. Interesting.

**Summary**: INSTRUMENTALISTE (8) is two from four over course and distance and was narrowly denied in a Class B event under those conditions last outing. Top claims for a leading yard. BIAGIO JET (12) was running a race full of promise when DQ at the 400m stage here four weeks ago. Unexposed racing in France and must be respected. IMPACT PLAYER (6) made the running when second in a Class B at Vichy eleven days ago. Hard to dismiss. IMPACT DE COLMINE (4) won a Class A walk up here prior to disappointing latest. Could bounce back in a new shoeing combination. IMOKO AIMEF (1) is another to note.

- 1. **HISTOIRE DU MIDI** Was in the money at Marseille Borely two back then disappointed last time when eighth over 2300m at Marseille Borely. Among the chances on best form.
- 2. **HISTOIRE MODERNE** Had a difficult draw last start and didn't make an impact when 11th at Caen over 2450m beaten 40 metres. Strong contender on her best form.
- 3. **HUNE LOVE** Has been doing it tough recently last time out finishing seventh over 2825m at Le Croise-Laroche. Has ability and can do much better.
- 4. **HOULE DE RIVIERE** Has raced twice since resuming and failed to threaten on either occasion the latest when fifth over 2625m at Chatelaillon La Rochelle three-and-a-half weeks ago. Not keen.
- 5. **ILE AUX MOINES** Again missed the placings last time out but was only 5.5 metres away in fifth over 2700m at this track. Rates highly in this line-up.
- 6. **HIGHNESS KALOUMA** Produced a better effort last start when not far from the winner in second over 2150m at Enghien. Coming off a strong run and bold showing expected.
- 7. **CASH BANK BIGI** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2700m at this track. Put a line through the latest run. Top pick if at her best.
- 8. **ISEULT FLOWER** Returns from a five months layoff. Has won when fresh in the past. Will be hard to beat despite the layoff.
- 9. INTREPIDE LADY Returns from a break and is a first-up winner in the past. Sure to go well.
- 10. **NOUBA MOM** Disqualified for galloping at her latest appearance over 1609m at Argentan. Form not up to scratch.
- 11. **ISABELLA FERM** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2700m at this track. Forgive the recent mishap. Top pick if at her best.
- 12. **KATE BALDWIN** Disqualified for galloping at this track then improved last start to finish third over 2850m at this track beaten 9 metres. A big run would not surprise.
- 13. **CELESTE BREED** Again missed the placings last time out but was only 5.5 metres away in fifth over 2700m at this track. Solid top-three prospects.
- 14. **ISLA JET** Won't find this as tough as last start over 2700m at this track. This looks a nice assignment. Player.
- 15. **BANGLA D'ESI** Scored four runs back but the subsequent starts have been plain the latest when sixth at this track and beaten 23 metres. Has a solid record at this circuit.
- 16. **IBAYA DES FORGES** Did a reasonable job when resuming last start finishing eighth at this track over 2700m and beaten 8 metres. Will be a different proposition this time.

**Summary**: It looks fairly tough to oppose ISLA JET (14) who disappointed when tenth in the G2 Prix Guy Le Gonidec twenty days ago. Four wins from six starts behind the mobile and expected to regain the winning thread down in grade. ILE AUX MOINES (5) finished fifth in that event and is considered back racing behind the mobile. CASH BANK BIGI (7) won the G3 Prix Albert Rayon mobile race last season and is interesting having joined a top yard. INTREPIDE LADY (9) could yet have more to offer for a leading trainer as a dual mobile scorer for five outings.

- 1. **FOLIE DE HOUELLE** Continued a long run without winning when eighth at this track over 2850m last time out. Expecting a better run this time.
- 2. **FA DE MY** Won at Pontchateau two runs back then couldn't follow it up over 2850m at Laval last time albeit only 6 metres off the winner. Winning prospects.
- 3. **EXTASE DU BOUFFEY** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2850m at Laon. Overlook the recent mishap. Well placed to make amends.
- 4. **FAZENDA DE MORTREE** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Finished 15th most recently over 3200m at Landivisiau 145 metres from the winner. Prefer others.
- 5. **ELEGANZA FAC** Has had four runs this prep without filling a placing the latest effort a ninth at Bordeaux over 2650m beaten 70 metres. Ready to find her best form.
- 6. **EXPRESS LADY** Had a tough draw last time and was safely held when sixth at Lisieux over 2725m beaten 25 metres. Place likely best.
- 7. **FILLETTE DEL GREEN** Disqualified for galloping last start over 3150m at La Roche-Posay. Put a line through the latest run. Top pick if at her best.
- 8. **EGINE PRECIEUSE** Clocked-in second at Vichy two starts back then missed the frame but wasn't disgraced last time out over 2350m at Angers. Sure to play a major role.
- 9. **FIONA DE COQUERIE** Has been struggling of late most recently finishing fifth over 2850m at this track. Can improve sharply.
- 10. **FLORA VENESI** Found best form to win two back but last time out disappointed beaten 17 metres when eighth at Angers. Rates well on best form and worth including.
- 11. **FLECHE ETOILE** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Finished fourth last start over 2100m at this track 9 metres from the winner. This will fully test.
- 12. **FUSEE DES VAUX** Started favourite last time but found one better over 3150m at La Roche-Posay. Strong winning chance.
- 13. **DUCHESSE DE SASSY** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Finished sixth most recently over 2100m at this track 16 metres from the winner. Not keen.
- 14. FAVORITE DARLING Returns from a short break. Likely to need the run but may go close.
- 15. **DIOLINE DE LEXLOR** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2750m at Ecommoy. Overlook the most recent outing. Can turn things around.
- 16. **DEESSE DE CORDAY** Finished third over 2350m at Angers last start after she was easily accounted for two back at this track. Winning prospects.

**Summary**: DEESSE DE CORDAY (16) is two from four in this shoeing combination and arrives following a good third in a Class E mobile event at Angers. Major claims with Eric Raffin retaining the drive. EGINE PRECIEUSE (8) has been running well in Class E autostarts of late. Leading chance on his first outing at this venue with eight wins from eighteen starts barefoot. FA DE MY (2) shaped well when 2L fourth in a Class C walk up at Laval a fortnight ago. Interesting back racing without front shoes. Four-time course winner FUSEE DES VAUX (12) has to be included following back-to-back narrow seconds. FAVORITE DARLING (14) is noted.

- 1. **GAGNANT DE BRIKVIL** Missed out two starts ago then finished 15th at his latest outing over 2750m at La Capelle 55 metres adrift. Form not up to scratch.
- 2. **GUNNER** Won two back at Caen then couldn't repeat the dose last time out when fourth over 2850m at Laval beaten 5.5 metres. Capable of playing a major role.
- 3. **GARRY THORIS** Missed out last start when eighth over 2100m at this track after finishing in the placings at Laval the start prior. Should be in the finish.
- 4. **GRANIT DU GERS** Missed the placings again last start beaten 18 metres when seventh over 2450m at Caen. Must do a lot more.
- 5. **GIBUS** Recorded a fine win at this track two starts ago then couldn't follow it up over 2800m at Chartres last time finishing 50 metres away from the winner. Big chance.
- 6. **GAZ D'OCCAGNES** Scored a fine win at Vichy two starts ago then couldn't follow it up over 2450m at Caen last time finishing 12 metres away from the winner. Very hard to beat.
- 7. **GRINDELWALD** Didn't perform two runs ago at Maure De Bretagne but returned to form last time when a winner by 2.5 metres over 3000m at Nantes. Solid top-three prospects.
- 8. **GALA D'URFIST** Didn't perform well last start from an awkward draw when sixth at Montlucon-Neris over 3025m beaten 55 metres. Worth another chance.
- GORESTAN Made significant improvement last start when second at Craon over 2775m beaten 1.2 metres. Expected to go well.
- 10. **GAZELLE DU BOURG** Form only moderate and has been without a win now for 10 runs. Last start finished second over 2450m at Caen. Needs to lift.
- 11. **GEOLE DE LA TOUQUE** Scored over 2100m at this track last time out after a plain effort at Laval the start before. Should be there at the business end.
- 12. **GRAND ROI KALOUMA** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2800m at Mondoubleau. Forgive the latest run. Can turn things around.

**Summary**: GIBUS (5) disappointed when sent off a warm order to collect a Class F mounted prize at Chartres recently but had made all in a Class D course and distance driven event prior. Top chance back in this suitable affair. GAZ D'OCCAGNES (6) won a Class F mobile at Vichy prior to a fair fifth in this grade at Caen. Leading contender with a 50% strike-rate without shoes. GORESTAN (9) finished runner-up on the grass at Craon latest and should appreciate the return to this surface. Thereabouts. GRAND ROI KALOUMA (12) is an interesting candidate despite often competing at a lower level.

- 1. **ICARE DE LA DORETE** Failed to threaten when resuming last start finishing tenth at this track over 2700m and beaten 35 metres. Expect a much better run this time.
- 2. **IRON PARKER** Finished third at Le Croise-Laroche two starts back then improved to score last time out over 2700m at this track by 1.4 metres. Will be about the money again.
- 3. **INVINCIBLE DE BRY** First up since finishing fifth over 2700m at this track eight months ago. Sure to be in the mix while fresh.
- 4. **IDAHO SPRINGS** Finished third two starts back at Enghien then missed the top-three last time out over 2700m at this track. Very hard to beat.
- 5. **INVICTUS MADRIK** Is racing well without winning filling a minor placing at his last four runs most recently when third over 2700m at this track. Should be involved on his recent form.
- 6. **INFINIMENT CITRON** Was below par last time when disqualified for galloping over 2700m at this track after a good second two starts back. Better run anticipated this time.
- 7. **IVRIG VIKING** Finished third at this track two starts back then couldn't repeat the dose over 2875m at Enghien last time finishing 40 metres from the winner. In the mix.
- 8. **INES QUICK** Returned to winning form two back but was safely held last start finishing seventh and beaten 35 metres over 2175m at this track. Better than the last run and can improve sharply.
- 9. **IDEFIX DE CENTULE** Finished runner-up over 2650m at Bordeaux last start after he was easily accounted for two back at this track. Big chance to find the winners' list.
- 10. **ICE TEA** Turned in a much better run second-up finishing a 20 metres fifth over 2150m at Vichy. Races over a little further this time. Needs to have improved sharply.
- 11. **IMAGE D'ATALANTE** Has raced twice this campaign and failed to threaten on either occasion the latest when 11th over 2700m at this track four weeks ago. Not on current form.
- 12. **INSTRUCTOR** Has won two in a row at this circuit most recently three weeks ago at this track over 2700m by 1.3 metres. Looks a strong chance to add to the winning sequence.

**Summary**: The hat-trick seeking INSTRUCTOR (12) impressed when running out a 0.25L winner of a Class C walk up here three weeks ago. Top chance. IRON PARKER (2) made it four wins from seven career starts when making a successful start to life barefoot in a Class D at this venue. Obvious winning claims for key connections. INFINIMENT CITRON (6) would be of firm interest on the form he showed when a close second in a Class C mobile contest at Vichy two back. IVRIG VIKING (7) is interesting with shoes removed and Eric Raffin booked.

- 1. **JALOUSIE DE L'ISLE** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2700m at this track. Forgive the latest run. Can turn things around.
- 2. **JOMOLUNGMA** Placed three back at Nancy but hasn't shown that sort of form since the latest effort a sixth at this track over 2850m beaten 30 metres. Can improve and has to be included.
- 3. **JACINTHE DES PRES** Didn't do a lot when resuming last start disqualified for galloping at Lisieux over 2725m. Prefer others.
- 4. **JETTY** Scored at Maure De Bretagne two runs ago then finished third at this track more recently over 2700m finishing 6 metres from the winner. Sure to be there at the business end.
- 5. **JADE PAROYO** Didn't measure up two runs ago at Caen but atoned last time when a winner by 4 metres over 2850m at Laval. Can play a role in the finish.
- 6. **JONA DE REVE D'OR** Is chasing a hat-trick of wins. Rates highly and expected to go on with the job after scoring at Caen over 2200m by a nose.
- 7. **JAMBAVATI** Last raced at Mauquenchy nine weeks ago when she finished tenth beaten 65 metres over 2850m. Will be hard to beat despite the layoff.
- 8. JAZZY DU LIAMONE Facing a tricky assignment. Fair fourth at this venue ten days ago.
- 9. **JORJA** Disqualified for galloping last start over 2925m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer. Forgive the latest run. Can turn things around.
- 10. **JEXELLE LUGUI** Has been racing consistently at her last few starts most recently when fifth over 2700m at this track. Rates highly and expected to be in the finish.
- 11. **JOIA FEAT** Finished third over 2850m at this track last start after she was easily accounted for two back at this track. Will find this tough.

**Summary**: JETTY (4) followed up a cosy 0.75L success at Maure-de-Bretagne with a good third in a Class D walk up here seventeen days ago. Leading claims with an in-form driver. JAMBAVATI (7) perhaps didn't enjoy the application of pads when down the field in a Class C at Mauquenchy in April. Showed some solid form in this grade prior and expected to bounce back with pads removed. JONA DE REVE D'OR (6) was a narrow winner of a Class E mobile at Caen just over three weeks ago. Not discounted for a top trainer. Dual Cagnessur-Mer scorer JORJA (9) is interesting.

#### Race 7 - PRIX JEAN PAUL FAIRAND - 2200m WALK-UP 650 APP Monte. Purse EUR €90,000.

- 1. **FULTON** Finished third last time out over 2875m at Enghien beaten 25 metres. Has a strong record this course scoring eight times from 18 starts. Likely to be in the finish.
- 2. **ESPERANZA IDOLE** Had a difficult draw last start and didn't make an impact when eighth at this track over 2175m beaten 80 metres. Great chance to bounce back.
- 3. **DOLLAR SOYER** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Failed to measure up when disqualified for galloping last start over 2850m at Laval. Must do a lot more.
- 4. **FLORIDA SPORT** Hasn't been too far off the placegetters at her last few outings the latest when fifth at Enghien over 2150m beaten 13 metres. Genuine threat on her best form.
- 5. **CRACK MONEY** Finished third over 2150m at Enghien last start after he was easily accounted for two back at Marseille Borely. A big run would not surprise.
- 6. **EGAO JENILOU** Has been very consistent lately with a win and one minor placing from his last four starts most recently when fifth over 2850m at this track. Bold showing expected again.
- 7. **CARIOCA DE LOU** Clocked-in third at this track two starts back then couldn't repeat the dose over 3200m at Erbray last time finishing 50 metres from the winner. Might find this a bit tough.
- 8. **CABAN PRIOR** Was not a factor when resuming last start finishing fourth at this track over 2175m and beaten 30 metres. Watch for a spike in form.
- 9. **CHALIMAR DE GUEZ** Finished in the frame but a long way from the winner at this track over 2175m two weeks ago after missing the frame two runs back. Can make amends.

**Summary**: A mounted Group Three for the apprentice jockeys. FLORIDA SPORT (4) shaped nicely in a Class A mobile race at Enghien on reappearance. Winner of the G3 Prix Auguste Francois and G3 Prix Yvonnick Bodin at this venue last year. Top chance back in a mounted event. FULTON (1) disappointed when beaten 9L into third in a Class D at Enghien last outing. Capable of better and would hold strong claims on the pick of his form in the saddle. CRACK MONEY (5) has an excellent record in this shoeing combination and cannot be dismissed despite his best form coming in the harness. CHALIMAR DE GUEZ (9) completes the shortlist following a second in the G3 Prix Paul Delanoe latest.
