- 3. JAYAMA 5L seventh in weaker company at Les Sables eleven days ago. Others preferred.
- 4. JOYFUL FRIEND Sixth debuting at a country track in easier company. May improve.
- 5. **JADE DU VALVIC** 5.5L sixth on first run at Cabourg fifteen days ago. One to note.

- 2. **GRETA DU CHATELET** Infrequent winner who has mixed form in easier mounted affairs this term. Prefer to look elsewhere.
- 3. **FIONA DE COQUERIE** Improved runner-up in an easier mounted event last month. Among the place chances.
- 4. **GRISABELLA VRIE** Excellent mounted form including a pair of easier wins earlier in the campaign. Rates highly.
- 5. **GIRLIKOVA** Placed in a pair of easier mounted starts prior to a DQ four days ago. Not out of a placing without shoes.

- 2. **INDIAN VALLEY** Steadily progressive filly. Worth a chance in this tougher affair with front pads on for the first time. Notable jockey booking.
- 3. **INVINCIBLE TOUCH** Two consecutive DQs at Les Sables. Showed ability previously so not entirely dismissed if able to complete.
- 4. **INFANTE DE TOUES** Inconsistent type thus far but displayed good driven form to finish runner up two back. Consider.

- 2. **INTRIGUE JENILOU** Split re-opposing rivals when a 1.25L second in a class E mounted event at Enghien four weeks ago. One to note.
- 3. **IDALIE VRIE** Capable of going well in a mounted event of this nature but must bounce back from two disappointing efforts.
- 4. INADAME Two wins from three career starts both in class E mounted events. Claims.
- 5. **IDOLE DU CHOQUEL** Unbeaten in two career starts and created a strong impression when winning by 7.25L in a class E mounted race at Les Sables-D'olonne 42 days ago. Top claims.
- 6. ILIS DU VALLON Two placings from four mounted starts. Frame chance once more.
- 7. **I CAN DREAM** 1.25L success in-front of re-opposing rivals in a class E mounted race at Enghien four weeks ago. Open to progress for a top stable.

Similar comments apply to GINGER MADRIK (13) following a 5L eighth in a class B at Grenade. One to note. GRENADE DE VALNY (9) has four wins from nine starts without shoes. In the mix if finding the finish.

- 1. **FAST AND GOOD** 0.75L success in a similar course and distance walk up under this driver. Leading claims.
- 2. **ETOILE DE CHRISTAL** 2L third behind Fast And Good in a track and trip walk up eleven days ago. In the mix without shoes.
- 3. **DESIR D'ARIANE** Good record in this shoeing combination but was a held seventh behind re-opposing rivals over track and journey. More needed.
- 4. **FISH DE HOUELLE** Mixed recent form but certainly capable at this level if on a going day. Dangerous to dismiss.
- 5. **FOREVER'S FELLA** Four DQ from last five outings but sole completion was a 0.25L success from behind the mobile at La Capelle. Dangerous if finding the finish.
- 6. **FANATIC FLASH** Disappointing favourite over course and distance recently but in flying form prior having won four of his last six starts. Top chance to bounce back.

He disappointed drastically finishing tailed off but is taken to regain the winning thread with an excellent career record. FAST AND GOOD (1) won the contest by 0.75L with ETOILE DE CHRISTAL (2) back in third and both should be involved once more. FOSSOYEUR (8) cannot be ruled out eased in grade.
