C1 - PRIX BRUNHILD - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- **1. MAURICIO DU DERBY -** Finished 7th in a Class C over 2200m at this course on 16 August. He is held by others on that last run
- **2. MOJITO DE BANVILLE -** Finished 4th in a Class C over 2200m at this course on 16 August. He does look held by MUST DE CHANLECY (4) on that last race but cannot be ignored
- **3. MONACO -** Ran 3rd in a Class B over 2700m at this course on 17 August. Takes a climb in class and will need to show more
- **4. MUST DE CHANLECY -** Finished 6th in a CIC over 2200m at this course on 16 August. That was his first attempt in a mounted race and has should make further progress
- **5. MAJOR MESLOIS -** Finished 6th in a Class C over 2200m at this course on 16 August. That was his first run in a mounted race and he will be looking for improvement
- **6. MISTER DU BAS BOSQ -** Finished 3rd in a Class B over 2875m at Enghiens on 28 June. Comes back from a short break and will need to up his game
- **7. MONSTER SPEED -** Won a Class D over 2875m at Enghien on 7 August. He is in good form and is proven in this category so a top effort is expected
- **8. MORPHEUS DU LOISIR -** Won a Class E over 2875m at Enghien on 7 August. His harness form is excellent and there is no reason why he can't produce the goods in a mounted event

Summary: MORPHEUS DU LOISIR (8) looks to have loads of talent and and should make a successful transition to mounted racing. The main threat will come from MONSTER SPEED (7), who is proven in this form of racing with a victory last time. There was a lot to like about the manner in which MUST DE CHANLECY (4) ran on last time, his first race under the saddle and he will improve. He does hold MOJITO DE BANVILLE (2) on that last run.

- **1. LEIA HIGHLAND -** Unplaced in a Class E over 2650m at Les Sables D'Ollone on 5 August. Form is uninspiring and gives no confidence
- **2. LOUVE DE BAIS -** Ran 5th in a Class F over 2775m at Les Sables D'Ollonne on 22 August. She has a good turn of speed and ran well enough last time to give her a place chance
- **3. LELIZIA -** Disqualified from a Class E over 2650m at Pornichet on 21 August. She was narrowly beaten by LA LA LAND (14) in her penultimate start and can challenge for top honours
- **4. LITTLE ITALY -** Ran 7th in a Class E over 2875m at Enghien on 27 July. Races unshod this time and hopefully that will bring about some needed improvement
- **5. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE -** Ran 5th in a Class E over 2650m at Pornichet on 21 August. Racing unshod this time, she has strong claims to finish in the places
- **6. LAZULITE GEDE -** Finished 3rd in a Class D over 2475m at Royan-Atlantique on 20 July. Jumps in class and needs to show more. Will race fully shod this time
- **7. LILY BAM** Disqualified in a Class D over 2850m at Carentan on 15 August. Looks outclassed in this field
- **8. LIONELLE DU SOLEIL -** Ran 7th in a Class E over 2875m at Enghien on 3 August. If she can find the form of her previous two races she could run a place
- **9. LUCKY STAR JIEL -** Disqualified in a Class H over 2725m at Vittel on 15 August. That was her first run after a break and will need to show more. Unshod behind
- **10. LALY DE JADE -** Ran 9th in a Class E over 2650m at Pornichet on 21 August. Racing unshod this time but will need to show improvement
- **11. LALE** Won a Class E over 2050m at Cabourg on 12 August. She is in good form and should have the measure of number of her rivals
- **12. LUNE LUMALO -** Won a Class E over 2750m at Cabourge on 26 August. She has been running well and in an open race could stake a claim
- **13. LYLOU DES THUYAS -** Finished 8th in a Class E over 2400m at Amiens on 30 July. That was her first race after a layoff but makes no appeal in this
- **14.** LA LA LAND Won a Class E over 2950m at Le Mans on 26 July. She scored a gutsy win last time, showing a lot of class and should enjoy this track. Will race unshod behind
- **15. LEGENDE DE NILREM -** Finished 3rd in a Class E over 2400m at Amiens on 30 July. Takes a jump in class and will need to do a lot more this time

Summary: This race is highly competitive but there was a lot to like about the manner in which LA LA LAND (14) held off her rivals to win at Le Mans last time out, but she could face a strong challenge from LELIZIA (3) who ran a close second in that race. LALE (11) is in good form and is expected to go close while LOLLIPOP DU CEBE (5), is running well enough to challenge the leading contenders and is expected to place.

- **1. ERGA OMNES PAR -** Disqualified in a Class D over 2250m at Enghien on 288 August. Her form is poor and she is best ignored
- **2. ETOILE DU OZ -** Ran 5th in a Class D over 2250m at Enghien on 2 August. Looks unlikely to trouble the leading contenders
- **3. KENDO JIEL -** Ran 7th in a Class E over 2875m at Enghien on 17 May. This will be his first try in this category but will need to find more
- **4. KALISTA JIEL -** Won a Class D over 2250m at Enghien on 2 August. Showed vast improvement racing in a mounted event and could be a decent outsider.
- **5. FLYING DRUMSTICKS** Has been racing in Sweden and is making his debut in France. He is the unknown factor in the race but has decent form and could run well
- **6. KERIDA DE VIVOIN -** Unplaced in a Class D over 2100m in a harness race at this course. Not consistent but can do well on a good day. Races fully shod
- **7. JACAR DE LA DIVES -** Ran 2nd in a Class F over 2625m at Cherbourg on 18 August. He finished behind JOIE DES VENTES (9) on that occasion and performs well in this discipline.
- **8. JANE HUDSON -** Disqualified in a Class E over 2775m at Les Sables D'Olonne on 22 August. That was in a harness race and she is far better in this discipline. Will race unshod
- **9. JOIE DES VENTES -** Won a Class F over 2625m at Cherbourg on 18 August. She was a runaway winner of that last race and there is a lot more to come from her
- **10. KROME** Ran 4th in a Class D over 2875m at Enghien on 9 August. That was his best run for some time but will need to find more
- **11. KATCHINA FOR CLARA -** Ran 5th in a Gr. 3 over 2175m at this course on 16 August. That was a decent run at a higher class and she has the ability to win a race of this nature
- **12. KOURGA DE LOU -** Disqualifed in a Class D over 2875m in a harness race at Enghien on 13 August. Back in a mounted race she could do better
- **13. KINGDOM KAT -** Disqualified in a Class E over 2875m at Carentan on 15 August. Recent form has been disappointing and improvement is needed
- **14. JONQUILLETE CREPIN -** Finished 2nd in a Class E over 2675m at Divonne-Les-Bains on 25 August. Improved after two disqualifications but will need to up her game even more
- **15. EL VEGO KHALIFA -** Won a Class H over 2425m at Beaupreau on 24 August. Although that was in a harness race he has perfromed well in his only mounted event and looks a potential winner

Summary: This is another open event and a number of runners have winning credentials. KATCHINA FOR CLARA (11) has competed at Gr 3 level and the drop in class will favour her. However, EL VEGO KHALIFA (15), while not performing all that well in harness races, has run well in a mounted event and must be considered. JOIE DES VENTES (9) runs well in this discipline while JANE HUDSON (8) looks well suited to the race conditions.

- **2. KALINE D'ERPION -** Ran 5th in a Class E over 2875m at Enghien on 14 August. Won her penultimate at Cabourg and had excuses in the Enghien race so could be dangerous
- **3. KADOLE JULOUROZO -** Ran 2nd in a Class F over 2500m at Francheville-Les-Bains on 17 August. Her recent results at a lower level have been respectable and this could be an ideal engagement for her
- **4. KOSCA DES CAILLONS -** Ran 6th in a Class F over 2725m at Graignes on 9 August. She has been competitive in her recent races and now unshod, she should run well
- **5. KALAMITY DE CHENU -** Unplaced in a Class F over 2750m at Pornichet on 14 August. Has not run well since coming back from a layoff and looks unlikely to feature
- **6. KITY DE LA MORTRIE** Disqualified in a Class F over 2750m at Pornichet on 14 August. She was in contention before making the mistake and did win her two previous starts. She should fight out the finish
- **7. KATINKA GEMA -** Ran 4th in a Class F over 2750m at Pornichet on 14 August. Ran on well in that last race and is expected to go close in this field
- **8. KELLE EAU -** Ran 6th in a Class E over 2700m at Lemont-Saint-Michel on 17 August. That was her first run for a new yard and hopefully she will do better
- **9. KOKINE BECO -** Ran 3rd in a Class E over 2725m at Enghien on 3 August. She is utraconsistent and always gives of her best so should run well again
- **10. KOMMUNES DE PLAY -** Disqualified in a Class E over 2925m at Dozule on 20 August. Recent form does not indicate there is more to come from her

Summary: Many with chances but there is little doubt KITY DE LA MORTRIE (6) has to the main contender as long as she can keep her mind on the job.KATINKA GEMA (7) is in excellent form and she does have a powerful finish. KOSCA DES CAILLONS (4) will be racing without shoes for the first time and her connections will be looking for a big run. KADOLE JULOUROZO (3) has been running well in lower level races but could be ready for the jump in class.

- **2. MAESTRO KADESH -** He has improved and has won his last two starts, the latest in Class D at Caen over 2200m on 28 May. Returns from a break but can complete the hat-trick
- **3. MIX D'ERONVILLE -** Yet to win a race and was 8th in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 23 August. Can be a threat at this level and must be respected
- **4. MESSAGE PERSONNEL -** A winner of three of his four starts so far, including last time out at Cabourg over 2750m on 25 July. Can win again
- **5. MY LOVE ALWAYS -** Unreliable and finished fourth in a Class C at Enghien over 28750m on 10 August. Capable of making the frame if wise
- **6. MAGNUM -** Unreliable and was 6th in Class C at Cabourg over 2750m on 12 August. Might play a minor role at the very best
- **7. MAESTRO DU CHOQUEL -** Holding form and finished third in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 2 August. Can be competitive once again
- **8. MAXOU DES IFS -** Yet to win a race but was runner-up in Class B at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 15 August. Has a place chance
- **9. MAESTRO JAMINI -** Disqualified last two times, the latest at Caen on 10 May. Returns from a break and could need this run
- **10. MISTER ROYAL -** In good shape and was runner-up in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 23 July. Can go one better this time

Summary: MESSAGE PERSONNEL (4) has delivered some smart performances in his three wins from just four starts. This is his first attempt at Vincennes, but he looks the one to beat. MISTER ROYAL (10) is knocking on the door and could contest the finish again. MAESTRO KADESH (2) is consistent and has only been beaten by some promising types, so he must be respected. MAGNUM (6) is not easy to trust but could get into the mix.

- **3. MUSIQUE CLASSIQUE -** Has won her last two starts, the latest in Class D at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 2 August. Can complete a hat-trick
- **4. MEDEE DU CONROY -** Unreliable but was runner-up in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 13 August. Has disqualification issues. Can contest the finish
- **5. MILANTERA -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Cabourg over 2750m on 12 August. Capable of winning when staying on the trot
- **6. MODE DU VALLON -** Unreliable but was runner-up in Class B at this track over 2175m on 3 June. Liked that shorter distance, but is not out of it
- **7. MAESTRIA GALAA** Battling to regain best form and finished 6th in Class C t Enghien over 2150m on 19 July. More is needed to win this race
- **8. MERIBEL -** Returned to form with a good Class D win at Enghien over 2150m on 14 August. Capable of getting involved with the finish yet again

Summary: MUSIQUE CLASSIQUE (3) is progressing smoothly with some solid wins and has every chance of completing her hat-trick. MILA DES COUPERIES (1) is improving, having won a good race at Enghien, and can follow up. MERIBEL (8) has won three of her five starts and looked better than ever last time, so she must be respected in this line-up. MYRIAM D'AZUR (2) picked up a confidence-boosting win at Mons and can contest the finish.

- **3. NEMROD BUROIS -** Finished 6th on debut in Class C at this track over 2175m on 25 August. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- **4. NINO TOSCA -** Has run well in both his starts and was runner-up in Class E at Saint-Malo over 2150m on 15 August. Can go one better this time
- **5. NEW YORK AVEC TOI -** Disqualified on debut at Arras over 2400m on 24 August. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **6. NEVER FORGET -** Improving and was victorious in Class D at Cabourg over 2050m on 19 August. Can follow up in this line-up

NEW HAVEN WOOD (1) showed significant improvement last time out and could have more to offer. A small field, but several hold winning claims.

- **3. LONELY RIDER -** Only fair of late and was 5th in a Class E harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 20 August. Did run well under the saddle before and is not out of it
- **4. LE VENT DU HOULET -** In good form and finished third in a Class E mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 31 July. Yet to win a race but does have claims
- **5. LANCELOT PLATANES -** Has struggled of late and was 9th in a Class E harness race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 6 August. Needs major improvement to win
- **6. LEOLIO -** Very unreliable and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2100m on 20 August. Tries a mounted race and others are preferred

Summary: LAGON D'ORIENT (8) showed marked improvement when winning under the saddle at Cabourg and can follow up if in the same mood. LONELY RIDER (3) showed promise when trying a mounted race in June and could be a real threat. LYNX DU LUPIN (1) has maintained form since going barefoot and should be involved in the finish. LE VENT DU HOULET (4) remains in good shape and is another capable of winning.
