- LAURE DES FORGES Unreliable and finished 10th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Capable of an upset when in the right mood
- **2. LOVELY DAY CEKE** Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Enghien on 29 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- **3. LESLIE DE VANDEL -** Unreliable and finished 3rd in a Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 27 October. Could need this run returning from a break
- **4. LADY DRY -** Unreliable and finished 9th in Class E over this track and trip on 23 December. Others make more appeal
- **5. LADY DU VALLON** Only moderate of late and finished 7th in C lass E over this track and trip on 23 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
