## R1 CAEN [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-ETIENNE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 35,000**

- 1. INSTAGRAM** - Off form and was disqualified at Vincennes on 24 January. Battling to regain form and others make more appeal
- 2. HELIOS BONBON** - Continues to struggle and finished 8th in Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 1 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 3. KAZY MERITE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Goes well on right-handed track and should be a threat
- 4. HELIOS D'ANCLEMAX** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 6 February. Unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role at very best
- 5. KHARNAS** - Bounced back to best when victorious in Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Can follow up
- 6. KALINE DE FAEL** - Disappointing of late and finished 11th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 15 February. Likes right-handed tracks and is not out of it
- 7. KOALA BLUE** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 16 February. Can go one better
- 8. IN YOUR EYES** - Finished 14th in a Class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 31 May. Returns from a break and others are much preferred
- 9. KAISER** - Holding form and finished 4th in Class B at Enghien over 2875m on 29 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 10. GALAXIE DU HOME** - Off form and was unplaced in Class E at Agon-Coutainville over 3450m on 14 July. Could need this run returning from a break
- 11. JOKER DE CHOISEL** - Disqualified at this track on 11 October. In very good form before that but could need this run returning from a break
- 12. HIWI ROCQ** - Finished 7th at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 December. Has run well at this before and has a place chance
- 13. FALTO DES LANDIERS** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class B over this track and trip on 19 October. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 14. ILLENC DES BOSC** - Consistent and finished 4th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 April. Likely to need this run returning from a long break

**Summary:** A very interesting opening event. KHARNAS (5) does well on right-handed tracks and is a confident selection. KAZY MERITE (3) is not reliable but has run well on right-handed tracks and can be competitive once again. KOALA BLUE (7) remains in very good form and is likely to be involved with the finish. KALINE DE FAEL (6) has only been modest of late but is another that should improve at this track and can shine brightly.

**C2 - PRIX DE TINCHEBRAY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 27,000**

1. **LE TANGO DU RENARD** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F harness race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 22 February. More is needed to score
2. **LAUREL LA RAVELLE** - Did not show his best when 11th in a Class E harness race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February. Has a place chance back in a mounted race
3. **KENAVO RUSH** - Disqualified at Saint-Brieuc on 1 February, Unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role at very best
4. **LORD OF WIND** - Has struggled in some harness races of late and finished 6th in Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 22 February. Can contest the finish back in a mounted race
5. **LEA DE FROULAY** - Off form and finished 10th in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 8 February. Needs major improvement to win
6. **KEZIO PEJI** - Disqualified at Laval on 4 February. Very unreliable and does need to find a few lengths to score
7. **KERGRIST** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class F mounted race at Nantes over 2275m on 19 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
8. **LISA MI FOR CLARA** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including at Vincennes on 9 December. Has won her last two mounted races and is clearly not out of it
9. **L'ARTISTE MIL** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Graignes on 22 February. Hard to trust and others are much preferred
10. **LEON DU CLOS** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 6 October. Returns from a break and others are preferred
11. **LION DES ISLES** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 February. Should be right there at the finish
12. **KENOBI D'HERFRAIE** - Disqualified at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 15 February in a harness race. Better under the saddle and has a place chance
13. **LITTLE DAIDOU** - Finished 9th in a class C harness race at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 December. Better under the saddle and can be a real threat
14. **LOVE AND SUN** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 19 February. Has been off form for a while but is capable of winning a race of this nature

**Summary:** A very open race. LOVE AND SUN (14) might well have won his latest start but for breaking stride. He can make amends but will need to fight off many challengers. LION DES ISLES (11) can go one better this time around after some runner-up performances of merit. LORD OF WIND (4) is capable of improvement under the saddle and is not out of it. LITTLE DAIDOU (13) returns to a mounted race and can win a race of this nature.

## C3 - PRIX DE CUSSY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,500

- 1. NINDALF** - A three-year-old gelding by Galius out of Calineka Gwen. His mother won 7 of her 78 starts. Others make more appeal
  - 2. NITBY** - A three-year-old gelding by Valko Jenilat out of Espérance Jiel who is making his debut. His mother did not win a race after 3 starts. Others make more appeal
  - 3. NAVY SEAL** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes on 31 December. Improvement likely and should make a bold bid at scoring
  - 4. NOLIO DU BARBEY** - Disappointing of late and finished 7th in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Has run well at this track and could earn some more money
  - 5. NIKYSTAR D'AUVRECY** - Returned to form and was a good 3rd in Class F at Angers over 2425m on 28 January. Can be competitive once again
  - 6. NELSON DE BELLANDE** - Much improved second runner-up in a Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 24 January. Can earn some money
  - 7. NICKEL CHROME** - Has run well in both starts, the latest when 3rd in Class E at Cabourg over 2050m on 5 August. Returns from a break but is not out of it if fit enough
  - 8. NEWTON DE MONGOCHY** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class F at Argentan over 2150m on 6 February. Could have more to offer and has a place chance
  - 9. NELATO BELLO** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Nantes over 2275m on 25 January. Did better on debut and has claims in this line-up
  - 10. NEW COUET** - Has run well in both starts and was runner-up in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Should contest the finish
- Summary:** NAVY SEAL (3) qualified in a very good time at this track and did not do badly on debut. He should make a bold bid at beating these rivals, with good improvement expected. NEW COUET (10) has shown some promise in two starts and should be a threat. NICKEL CHROME (7) is doing well and can be competitive once again. NIKYSTAR D'AUVRECY (5) bounced back with a good performance at Angers and can also get into the mix.

## C4 - PRIX DE BOULLEVILLE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,500

- 1. MUST PLEIN CHENE** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 9 September. Returns from a break but could earn some money if fit enough
- 2. MARC AURELE** - Improving and finished 3rd in a class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 16 December. Returns from a break but has claims
- 3. MERCATO MESLOIS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Nantes on 21 February. Not easy to trust but can be a threat when smart
- 4. MAESTRO BLANC** - Consistent and finished 3rd in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 15 September. Returns from a break but does have a place chance
- 5. MISTER LA NUIT** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 13 February. Unreliable but might earn some minor money when smart
- 6. MEKONG** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Vincennes over 2200m on 13 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 7. MEILLEUR KURYS** - In good shape and finished 4th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Has a place chance on best form
- 8. MIDNIGHT DANCER** - Showed improvement and was a barefoot winner in Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Capable of following ip
- 9. MY MILLION ATOUT** - Finished 3rd in Class E at Vichy over 2150m on 2 August. Consistent but is returning from a break. Not out of it
- 10. MAESTRO D'IDEF** - Consistent and finished 3rd in Class D at Pontchâteau over 2200m on 21 December. Returns from a short break but cannot be ruled out from winning
- 11. MADE IN MOUROTAIS** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 22 December. Could need this run after a short break
- 12. MAYFLOWER AR MOR** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in a Class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February, Could earn some more money
- 13. MALANDRINO** - In good shape and finished 4th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 January. Should contest the finish once again ,barefoot this time

**Summary:** MARC AURELE (2) returns from a break but was improving and could score if fit enough. MALANDRINO (13) races without shoes this time and is in good form, clearly a real danger. MIDNIGHT DANCER (8) was a barefoot winner at Argentan and remains without shoes, so can double up with another success. MARC AURELE (2) has a couple of faults of late but is capable of getting into the mix when staying in stride.

- 1. LUTINE DU CEDRE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class F at Vire over 2800m on 8 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. MIAMI** - Faulted at Cabourg on 29 August last time out. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 3. MANUELLA DE PLAY** - Victorious in a Class D at this track over 2200m on 19 October. Has ability but could need this run returning from a break
- 4. MISTRAL JANEIRO** - Victorious in Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 3 November. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 5. MAJOR MESLOIS** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 27 November. Returns from a break and may needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. LOU DES COUPERIES** - Finished 3rd in Class G at Enghien over 2250m on 16 October. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- 7. MACHUCAMBO** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 February. Can get involved with the finish
- 8. LOUSTIC DE FLAM** - Successful in two of his last three starts, including last time out in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Can follow up
- 9. MUSCDARCHE** - Successful in a Class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2825m on 9 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 10. LIKE A PRAYER** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 December. Should fight out the finish
- 11. LA KIFFANCE PIYA** - Consistent and finished 3rd in a Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 8 October. Returns from a break but might play a minor role
- 12. MELOMANE DE LOU** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 December. Can be a threat on best form

- 16. LAISSEZ FAIRE** - Did not show her best when 8th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 10 February. Two good wins before that and is clearly not out of it

**Summary:** MORE LOVE DUCAMPUS (13) is fit and in very good form. He forms a strong hand for trainer Laurent-Claude Abrivard with MELOMANE DE LOU (12). MORE LOVE DUCAMPUS (13) has Alexandre Abrivard aboard and should take some beating. LIKE A PRAYER (10) was not disgraced at Vincennes and looks to do even better this time. MELOMANE DE LOU (12) returns from a short break but can be a threat. MACHUCAMBO (7) has some fair form and is another capable of scoring.

- 1. LE SAP** - Finished 9th in Class D at Nantes over 2275m on 25 January. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 2. LUX DE LA MESLIERE** - Much improved last run when 4th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy at 2850m. Can do even better this time around
- 3. LITCHI DU BISET** - Finished 12th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. In good form before that and could play a minor role
- 4. LE BOSS DANOVER** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 16 February. Could earn some more money
- 5. L'EXPRESS DE PLAY** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. Can get involved with the finish
- 6. LOULOU DE L'AUNAY** - Only moderate of late and finished 8th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 7 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 7. LEO PERRINE** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 8. L'AS DE SMARVES** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 22 February. Ran better than formline shows and could score if smarter this time
- 9. LINGUIST D'HERIPRE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 26 January. Quite capable of making the frame
- 10. LUCKY LUCIANO** - Successful in his last two starts, the latest in a Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 February. Can complete the treble of victories
- 11. LEONARDO** - Disqualified at Enghien on 13 October. In good form before that but should need this run returning from a break
- 12. LUGANO** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 15 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 13. LAFAYETTE DU BOURG** - Consistent and was runner-up in a Class F at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 18 January. Could earn some more money
- 14. L'ECLAIR DE PLAY** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 7 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 15. LEADER DE L'AUMOY** - In good shape and finished 3rd in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 6 February. Can be competitive once again
- 16. L'ASTRE DE NUIT** - Finished 3rd in Class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 4 November 2024. Consistent but is returning from a long break and should need runs

**Summary:** A very competitive looking race. L'AS DE SMARVES (8) ran well after his disqualification and could score if smart this time around. L'EXPRESS DE PLAY (5) has won at this track before and can be a threat if at his best. LUX DE LA MESLIERE (2) also likes this track and can get involved with the finish. LINGUIST D'HERIPRE (9) has been unreliable of late but also cannot be ruled out from winning at this level.

- 1. JASMINE DE LYONS** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class E at Montauban over 2425m on 8 December. Can earn some more money
- 2. JACADY SLY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class G at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 3. INDIGODARCHE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Laval on 26 February. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 4. JAMES MADRIK** - Off form and finished 10th in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 17 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. JOULE DE LA FYE** - Disqualified at Nantes on 25 January. In good form before and can get involved with the finish if staying in stride
- 6. JAHIA DU TRIO** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 22 January. Had some solid wins before that and should be a threat to these rivals if smart
- 7. GERONIMO STARDUST** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 8. JACK DES MALBERAUX** - Disqualified at Laval on 18 February. Unreliable and is probably best watched until improvement is shown
- 9. JOIE DES VENTES** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 26 November. Returns from a break but has claims
- 10. JIRI PACHA** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 February/. Might play a minor role at best
- 11. JAMES OF CARLY** - Finished 5th in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 14 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 12. JADE DU CEDRE** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 8 December. Can go one place better

- 1. KENAVO TUILERIE** - Disqualified at this track on 11 October. Returns from a break and has disqualification issues so others make more appeal
- 2. KANAK DU BOCAGE** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at Laval on 4 February. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 3. JAB KISS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vincennes on 15 February. Capable of a surprise if staying in stride
- 4. KARMA TEJY** - Did not show his best when 10th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 February. Others make more appeal
- 5. KELLOU DES BRUMES** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 15 February. Could play a minor role
- 6. KING DE GINAI** - Not reliable but finished 4th in Class D at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Could earn some minor money
- 7. KITTS ET NEVIS** - Disqualified at Vincennes on 30 October. Returns from a break but can be a threat to these rivals if fit enough
- 8. KOPA D'ARC** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 February. Has a winning chance in an open race
- 9. KAZAR** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 21 January. May need to do more to score

**Summary:** A very tough and competitive lucky last race. KOPA D'ARC (8) put in an improved performance at Vincennes and could pop up and score this time around. KOQUIN D'AMOUR (12) is better judged on a good victory in his penultimate start and he should be a lively danger. KENNEDY FRANCE (10) is unreliable but his recent win at Vincennes was a good one and he must be respected for that. KITTS ET NEVIS (7) returns from a break but can make the frame when in the right frame of mind.
