## R5 LE CROISE-LAROCHE [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE ROUBAIX - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 28,000**

- 1. I FEEL PRETTY** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 31 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. KALMIO DE LOU** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes over 2700m in a Mounted race on 6 February. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 3. IDYLLE DE MAHEY** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 21 January. Others make more appeal
- 4. JAURIAS** - Holding form and was 4th in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 February. Can be a threat once again
- 5. JEALOUS GIRL** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 10 February. Place chance on best form
- 6. JUST D'ACADIE** - Unreliable and finished 12th in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 21 December. Capable of a surprise when in the right mood
- 7. KALAMITY DE CHENU** - Successful last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 8 February. In very good shape and can double up
- 8. JEUNE ORANGE COTON** - Has disqualification issues but did run well when runner-up in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. Can go one place better
- 9. IMOW ROLAU** - Battling to regain best form and was unplaced in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. Others are preferred
- 10. JUMBO DES PRES** - Off form and finished 8th in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 30 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 11. JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL** - In good form and was third in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 February. Better over shorter distance but must be respected in this line-up
- 12. KARTER LEWIS** - Has some fair form and was not disgraced when 5th in Class A at this track over 2825m on 8 November. Returns from a break but could be competitive if fit enough
- 13. IMPRESS ME** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 10 December. Capable of an upset on best form

**Summary:** It does appear more open than what first appeared. JEUNE ORANGE COTON (8) hinted that a winning turn is not far away but does come with disqualification issues. KALAMITY DE CHENU (7) remains in fine form and could follow up on a recent success at Vincennes. KALMIO DE LOU (2) looked likely to win had he not faulted, but that was in a mounted race. JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL (11) is in great shape and quite capable of shining brightly.

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## C2 - PRIX DE CALAIS - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 25,000

- 1. JAVA DES TIGARDS** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. JACKARY D'OCQUE** - Not reliable but was not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Graignes over 2700m on 22 February. Might play a minor role
- 3. JAMBALAYA** - Did not show his best when 9th in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 February. Capable of better and can be competitive in this line-up
- 4. JEYMIXE** - Successful in her last two starts, the latest at Wolvega over 2100m on 14 February. Tougher task in this line-up
- 5. JOHANNA DE BRETT** - Disqualified last time out at Vittel over 2700m on 27 July. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. JOYEUX DE FONTAINE** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 21 January. Can play a minor role
- 7. JULIUS D'ALCI** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class G at Amiens over 2400m on 4 October. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- 8. JIKAO** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 February. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 9. JACKPOT DU DOME** - Faulted last time out at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February. Not reliable but is capable of scoring
- 10. JAMAIQUE DE HOERDT** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. In good form before that and has a place chance
- 11. JUPITER DE MAISY** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February. Better judged on his good penultimate start performance and is not out of it
- 12. JUPITER DU PERCHE** - A winner of 3 of his last 4 starts, including last time out at Wolvega over 2600m on 14 February. Must be respected for that
- 13. JERONIMO DU CAUX** - Only modest of late and was 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 February. Capable of scoring on best form
- 14. JADE** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 18 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**Summary:** Another open-looking race. JACKPOT DU DOME (9) is unreliable and faulted last time out but is capable of bouncing back to win a race of this nature. JIKAO (8) is usually competitive and will fight for top honours in this line-up. JUPITER DE MAISY (11) is clearly better than what he showed last time out and could make the frame. JUPITER DU PERCHE (12) has struck some solid recent wins but this is a tougher ask.

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## C3 - PRIX DE SAINT-OMER - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LOVE KILLS** - Has won his last two starts, the latest in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February. Can complete the hat-trick
- 2. LUDO SANTIGNY** - Did not show his best when 13th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 26 July. Could need this run returning from a break
- 3. LORD DE LA FUTAIE** - Not reliable but was victorious in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 10 December. Can double up
- 4. LARABIEN** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Can be competitive once again
- 5. LE CHEF** - Unreliable but was victorious last time out at Mons over 2840m on 27 January. Tougher task this time but might play a minor role
- 6. LILY POM MIX** - Has major disqualification issues but was runner-up in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 17 February. Can be competitive if smart
- 7. LYX OF CAMARO** - Threatening to win with two runner-up performances in a row, the latest in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 6 February. Should fight out the finish
- 8. LOOPING RENARDIER** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 29 January. Can contest the finish
- 9. LUGER** - Did not show his best when barefoot and 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 16 February. In good form before that and has a place chance
- 10. LITTLE CASH** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. A barefoot winner before that and races without shoes again. Big chance
- 11. LOCKI DU FER** - Did not show her best when 13th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 26 July. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 12. LUCIUS DE PUCH** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in Class A at this track over 2825m on 8 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 13. LUCKY CASTELETS** - Only modest of late and was 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 14. LIBERTY AVENUE** - Has struggled of late and finished tenth in Class B at Reims over 2550m on 14 September. Others make more appeal
- 15. LILI BROAY** - Unreliable and finished 12th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 29 January. Might play a minor role
- 16. LIANE** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 20 January. Not out of it

**Summary:** LITTLE CASH (10) was only modest at Laval but is better judged on a good barefoot win in his penultimate start. He is back without shoes for this and gets a narrow vote to score. LOVE KILLS (1) has struck a purple patch of form and could complete his hat-trick. LYX OF CAMARO (7) is threatening a victory and should be right there at the finish once again. LARABIEN (4) remains in good form and is another to consider.

C4 - PRIX VALENCIENNES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MARQUISE DES ARRIS** - Disqualified in four of her last 5 starts, including last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Hard to trust but could make the frame
- 2. MAM'ZELLE FRO** - Showed some improvement when third in Class F at La Capelle over this distance on 2 November. Returns from a break but could earn some money
- 3. MANHATTAN JENILOU** - Did not show her best when 6th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 4. MELANOURA** - Disqualified last time out at Wolvega over 2100m on 21 February. Needs more to win but might play a minor role at best
- 5. MISS DE REUX** - A good winner on debut but fluffed her lines with a disqualification at this track over 2825m on 23 February. Needed that run and could bounce back to win
- 6. MISSION IMPOSSIBLE** - Very unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 26 January. Capable of being competitive when in the right frame of mind
- 7. MATRIONA** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 6 December. Barefoot for the very first time and has a chance
- 8. MICKAELLA** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 28 November. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of contesting the finish
- 9. MANUREVA TURBO** - Disqualified in four of her last 5 starts, including last time out at Reims over 2500m on 7 December. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 10. MILI DE FLO** - Finished 9th on debut in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 22 February. Capable of improvement but others are much preferred

**Summary:** MISS DE REUX (5) probably needed her comeback run. Fitter this time, she could make a bold bid at scoring. MATRIONA (7) races without shoes for the very first time, so must be respected for that. MARQUISE DES ARRIS (1) is very hard to trust but can win a race like this if staying in stride. MISSION IMPOSSIBLE (6) is capable of being competitive this time around but does have major disqualification issues.

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## C5 - PRIX DE LENS - 2825m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KYOTO GEMA** - Victorious in a Class F mounted race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 15 February. Has some good wins of late and can follow up
- 2. KISS SYMPHONY** - Disqualified last time out in a harness race at Mons over 2300m on 10 February. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money when smart
- 3. KERGOMAR SIBEY** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in a harness claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 February. Needs major improvement trying a mounted race
- 4. KELLE** - Did not show her best when 9th in a Class E harness race at Vincennes over 2850m on 28 December. Faulted the last time she tried a mounted race but cannot be ruled out
- 5. KANDISSIME** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 February. Hard to trust but is not out of it when staying on the trot
- 6. KITO TURGOT** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at Nantes over 3000m on 13 February. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 7. JUST PACHA** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class F mounted race at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 1 February. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 8. KATLEEN REYOR** - Has disqualification issues but was victorious in a Class F harness race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 January. Can follow up if smart this time
- 9. KEOPS DE CASTELLE** - Very consistent under the saddle and was runner-up in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 February. Can go one better this time

**Summary:** A very open mounted race. KYOTO GEMA (1) returned from a break to win his latest start and can follow up if in the same mood. KEOPS DE CASTELLE (9) is very consistent under the saddle and will challenge for top honours yet again. KANDISSIME (5) has a string of disqualifications in a row but can be a threat when staying on the trot. KATLEEN REYOR (8) is also hard to trust but can make the frame when smart.

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## C6 - PRIX PIERRE PARIS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 19,000

- 1. KITALIANO ALGREF** - Successful last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 23 February. Usually competitive and is capable of following up
- 2. KAVAL BOURBON** - Has lost her way of late and was 11th in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Needs major improvement to score
- 3. KRAC BOREAL** - Unreliable and finished 12th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Is capable of bouncing back to score when in the right frame of mind
- 4. KEOPS DU RABUTIN** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 21 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 5. KILLER DRY** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class F mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 21 January. Not reliable but is a danger back in a harness race
- 6. KINDER DE LA NAVE** - May have just needed the run when 6th in Class F over this course and distance on 23 February. Two solid wins before that and could contest the finish
- 7. KAROLUS FAIR** - Faulted last time out at Cherbourg over 2625m on 23 November. Returns from a break but would not be a surprise winner
- 8. KIT ANGOT** - Disqualified last time out at Amiens over 2400m on 21 February. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 9. KYROC D'ERPION** - Showed some improvement when third in Class F over this track and trip on 23 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 10. KRACDARCHE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F over this course and distance on 23 February. Capable of better and has claims for another win

**Summary:** KAVAL BOURBON (2) is clearly hard to trust but does like this track and could bounce back to score. KAROLUS FAIR (7) is barefoot this time but is also returning from a break, so his fitness will need to be taken on trust. KITALIANO ALGREF (1) was a recent winner over this track and trip and could follow up. KINDER DE LA NAVE (6) should strip fitter this time around and can be a threat to these rivals.

## C7 - PRIX DE BAILLEUL - 2825m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. NINA D'AUVERS** - A three-year-old filly by Ni Ho Ped d'Ombree out of Etincelle Rapid who is making her debut. Her mother won 2 of her 34 starts. Others are preferred
- 2. NINA GALAA** - A three-year-old filly by Charly du Noyer out of Celebrata who is making her debut. Her dam won 3 of her 32 starts. Qualified well at Caen and has major claims
- 3. NIZZA PRESTANCE** - A three-year-old filly by Love You out of Quelle Prestance who is making her debut. Her mother won 4 from 13 starts. Has claims to score
- 4. NOLLY WOOD** - A three-year-old filly by Helgafell out of Dolly Des Charmes who is making her debut. Her dam won 11 of her 43 starts. Should be a threat
- 5. NOUCHKA WIND** - A three-year-old filly by Falcao de Laurma out of Uska West who is making her debut. Her dam won 5 of her 53 starts. Looks capable of contesting the finish
- 6. NOUMEA LIGNERIES** - A three-year-old filly by Good Boy Lignerries out of Grande Lignerries who is making her debut. Her mother won 4 of her 28 starts. Did well in qualifying and is not out of it
- 7. NOUNASSIMA** - A three-year-old filly by Fastissime out of A l'Attaque who is making her debut. Her dam was unraced. Capable of playing a minor role
- 8. NUTELLA DU CAMPUS** - A three-year-old filly by Face Time Bourbon out of Haya d'Amour who is making her debut. Her mother never won a race in 3 starts. Others make more appeal
- 9. NUTSY DU COQ** - Not disgraced when 5th on debut in Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 17 January. Likely to improve and is not out of it
- 10. NYMPHE DE DURBUY** - Disqualified last time out at Mons over 1750m on 11 November. Returns from a break and needs improvement to win
- 11. NUNKI QUEEN** - Has only been modest so far and was 5th in Class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 17 January. Might play a minor role at best

**Summary:** A very tricky lucky last race with most of them being unraced runners. They should fill most of the places. NINA GALAA (2) does catch the eye as she did produce a very good qualifying time. NOLLY WOOD (4) is well bred and her mother won 11 times. NIZZA PRESTANCE (3) comes from a family of winners and would not surprise by scoring. NOUCHKA WIND (5) is yet another debutant that could prove to be successful.
