PREVIEW: PARIS RAIN was unlucky to lose his last start. He was beaten a short head but had things go wrong. He could be a bit better over this shorter 1400m and should have every chance this time. FLAMING DRUM was taken to the front last time and finished closer. He is still learning what it is all about and needs to be included. MISTER LINCOLN was too far back in the early stages and finished well behind FLAMING DRUM but is patently better than the performance suggests. He is drawn better and could show true form. LABRAUSCO and RUSSIAN WRITER need to be considered for exotic bets.

He is again experimenting over 1800m but this could be the right race. ETIQUETTE has won on poly and turf at Hollywoodbets Greyville and if the race is run to suit could move them down. SUNDAY ISLAND, NORDIC REBEL and VICTORY TWIST have definite claims on best form.

PREVIEW: ROCK FALL has good staying form and just needs to time his run right. He is not well in at the weights on ratings but a 1.5kg apprentice claim could do the trick in a shallow race. Highveld filly ROSSLYNE gives the impression she could be looking for the marathon distance. The drop in distance in her last start didn't suit. It could get close again between LEOPARD LADY and RISE. The former was just nabbed by the latter but a change in tactics and weights could see a form reversal. Both have stamina in their pedigrees. JOHNNY'S HOPE could make more improvement.

She looks to be in the right race but comes from off the pace and will need the timing to be on point. MAQUETTE, like IN THE ETHER, has been running in stronger races and should relish the drop in class. MAQUETTE has blinkers fitted and could show the pace needed to get away. FLYING THE STAR should be speedy if her last run is anything to go by. She has the leading rider up and could finally win. VICTORY BELLE and RIO'S KISS rate dark horses on form.

The former has won three at this track while the latter is back from the Cape where she didn't disgrace herself.

He now has drawn No 1 and should make it count. VAR PARK popped up with a decent performance in his penultimate start but then disappointed. He has drawn well on local debut and must be included. STANLEY PARK did well from a wide draw in his last start and looks well placed so can score. More with upset claims.
