**C1 - PRIX DU COMITE REGIONAL DU SUD-OUEST - 2625m (a1m1/2) -
Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000**

- 1. MISTER JOHNS** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2575m on 15 March. Not reliable but is also not out of it
- 2. MANU DUEM** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Can make the frame when smart
- 3. MANGO DU POMMEREUX** - Showed some improvement when third in a claimer at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 14 March. Can earn some minor money
- 4. MAVERICK DE VIETTE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at this track over 2575m on 22 March. Unreliable but is capable of an upset when staying in stride
- 5. MILORD MARANDAIS** - Not reliable and finished 10th in Class F at Auch over 2800m on 8 March. Did better at this course in his penultimate start and can contest the finish
- 6. MILOR DE LA CRIERE** - Much improved since going barefoot and was runner-up in Class G at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 March. Remains without shoes and can go one place better
- 7. MON GRAND PRE** - Yet to win a race and was third in Class F at this track over 2575m on 1 March. Can challenge for top honours once again
- 8. MICKEY DE VIVOIN** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2575m on 22 March. Barefoot this time and can be a lively danger

Summary: Faultless in two outings when racing barefoot, MILOR DE LA CRIERE (6) looks set to continue his upward trajectory and commands plenty of respect. MICKEY DE VIVOIN (8) goes without shoes for the first time and could unlock further improvement, while MILORD MARANDAIS (5), judged on his best form, has the ability to be involved. MANU DUEM (2) also enters the reckoning and, if keeping his manners in check, is capable of making his presence felt in a race that offers several possibilities.

C2 - PRIX DE LA FEDERATION DU SUD-OUEST - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LEANA DU CHATELET** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class F at Toulouse over 2850m on 26 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. LUNA SAN LEANDRO** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, the latest at Castillonnès over 2450m on 8 March. Capable of a surprise when smart
- 3. LAMPEDUSA** - In good shape and finished third in Class G at Toulouse over 2325m on 13 March. Can earn some minor money at best
- 4. LISA BLONDE** - Faulted last time out at Laval over 2850m on 26 February. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 5. LATINA GEDE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Saint-Jean-de-Monts on 2625m on 27 July. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. LADY MESLOISE** - Finished 10th in a Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 22 March. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 7. L'HISTOIRE D'EOLE** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 8 March. Needs to do more to score
- 8. LICORNE DU VAAL** - Needed her last run when 12th in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Yet to win a race and others are preferred
- 9. LA KIFFANCE MIL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 10. L'ARIZONA TUILERIE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class F at La Guerche-de-Bretagne over 2800m on 29 March. Not out of it
- 11. LUNA DES MALBERAUX** - Disqualified last time out at Toulouse over 2950m on 20 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 12. LIBREVILLE** - Finished 6th in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- 13. LISA DU VIGNAC** - Successful when barefoot in a Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Remains without shoes and can follow up
- 14. LOUNA STAR** - Successful in a claimer at this track over 2575m on 15 March when racing without shoes. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 15. LICORNE QUICK** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. Capable of making the frame again
- 16. LEGENDE SEVEN** - Disqualified in four of her last five starts, including last time out at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. Probably best watched for now
- 17. LOUISE D'ERPION** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. Can contest the finish once again
- 18. L'ETOILE DE PAME** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Class F over this course and distance on 1 March. Can go one place better

Summary: In a wide-open contest, the two highest earners in the field, LOUISE D'ERPION (17) and L'ETOILE DE PAME (18), could well come to the fore. L'ARIZONA TUILERIE (10), presented barefoot for the occasion, is another capable of playing a leading role. LICORNE QUICK (15), who finished fourth behind our selection last time out, also has solid claims, while LISA DU VIGNAC (13), a winner at Grenade-sur-Garonne in late January, is not without a chance in a race full of possibilities.

C3 - PRIX DU FESTIVAL DES BANDAS-CONDOM - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LLORET GRANDBOIS** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. LINK D'ERONVILLE** - Finished 5th in a claimer at this track over 2575m on 15 March. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 3. L'IRLANDAIS** - Disqualified three times in his last five starts, the latest at Saumur on 8 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. LORD DE JADE** - Finished 10th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Needed that run but is battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 5. LOULOU D'ETANG** - Disqualified at Castillonnès on 8 March. Fitter this time but does need major improvement to win this race
- 6. LORD PAGUERIE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 22 March. Has a place chance on best form
- 7. L'OEIL D'OR CHOISI** - Off form and finished 13th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 March. Needs major improvement to beat these rivals
- 8. LUZ JELOCA** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Toulouse on 26 March. Capable of scoring when staying on the trot
- 9. LUCIFER PACTOLE** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class F at Castéra-Verduzan over 2800m on 6 October. Capable of better but could need this run returning from a break
- 10. L'INDIEN DU VALVIC** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F over this track and trip on 1 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 11. LUIGI WALLIE** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class F at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 March. Can go one place better
- 12. LOS ALAMOS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. Capable of doing better and could make the frame
- 13. L'ARTISTE D'AVENIR** - Disqualified at this track on 9 February. In good form before that and is capable of being a threat to these rivals
- 14. LIVIUS** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 15. LE GRAND BORNAND** - Winner in a claimer at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 December. Could need this run returning from a break

Summary: If keeping his action together, LUZ JELOCA (8) has the ability to take a hand in a race of this nature. LIVIUS (14), who is consistently effective when racing barefoot, and LUIGI WALLIE (11), a recent runner-up at Castillonnès, both look solid podium contenders. LOS ALAMOS (12) has already shown his effectiveness over this track and should be involved at the finish, while L'ARTISTE D'AVENIR (13), competitive at this level, is another to consider in a tightly knit affair.

C4 - PRIX BAHIA QUESNOT - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. KEOPS TILLAYE** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class F at this course over 2625m on 22 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. KORIGANE D'ERABLE** - Clearly needed her only run of the year when 12th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 March. Fitter this time and can make the frame
- 3. KING DE LARRE** - Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 March. Capable of winning a race of this nature
- 4. KELLE BELLE JASMA** - Consistent and finished third in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 17 March. Can be competitive yet again
- 5. KING'S GAME** - In good shape and finished third in Class D at Toulouse over 2750m on 27 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 6. KAPTA JELOCA** - Ultra-consistent and was runner-up in Class F at this track over 2625m on 22 March. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 7. KASGAGNAT** - Successful last time out in Class D at Toulouse over 2750m on 27 February. Unreliable but could earn some more money
- 8. KEYS** - Victorious last time out in Class F at this track over 2625m on 22 March. Remains in good shape and can follow up
- 9. KOOL DU PORHOET** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 7 February. Capable of doing better and can play a minor role
- 10. KING KONG** - Finished 6th last time out in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 22 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. KRISTOBAL** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class F at this track over 2625m on 22 March. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: KING DE LARRE (3) now has three runs under his belt and could be ready to make his presence felt in a race that looks within his reach. It may also pay to revisit the March 22 form on this track, where KEYS (8) got the better of KAPTA JELOCA (6), and both hold solid claims on that evidence. KELLE BELLE JASMA (4) is currently in good form and looks capable of playing a prominent role, while KORIGANE D'ERABLE (1) should strip fitter for her reappearance and is another to consider in a competitive heat.

**C5 - PRIX BELINA JOSSELYN - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR
€ 27,000**

- 1. HEPICETOU** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class E over this track and trip on 22 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. KAVALEUR D'ENFER** - Victorious in Class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 30 January. Remains at the top of his game and can score again
- 3. IDOLE DE BEYLEV** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Caen over 2450m on 25 March. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 4. JEU INTERDIT** - In good shape this year and was 4th in class E over this track and trip on 22 March. Capable of earning some minor money
- 5. JOGGER KILY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride
- 6. HAYRTON MAGIC** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in class F over this track and trip on 1 March. Barefoot thsi time and is not out of it
- 7. JOSEPHA CHOUP** - In good form and was runner-up in class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 February. Barefoot this time and can go one place better
- 8. ISSU DE CORTEM** - Unreliable and finishd 8th in class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 31 August when barefoot. Not this time and is likely to need this run returning from a break
- 9. JADE DE PAME** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 20 March. Consistent before that and has a place chance
- 10. JOHN STEED** - Disqualified in class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 11. KEY TO SUCCESS** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 27 March. Victorious earlier in March and is not out of it
- 12. JOPLIN DES CROUAS** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 March. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role at best

Summary: An interesting race. KAVALEUR D'ENFER (2) returns from a short break but has been at the top of his game and can add another win to his tally. JOSEPHA CHOUP (7) is in good form, will be barefoot, and is a danger once again. KEY TO SUCCESS (11) fluffed his lines with a disqualification at Marseille-Borély but is a threat when staying in stride, so must be respected. JOGGER KILY (5) is not easy to trust but is also capable of scoring when smart.

- 1. MERCI MADAME** - Showd some improvement when 6th in a Class E at Toulouse over 2325m on 13 March. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 2. MONIE EFJI** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 March. Not easy to rust but can earn some money when smart
- 3. MINI FORTUNE** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Castéra-Verduzan on 13 October. Probably best watched for now
- 4. MALIKA DU GUESCLIN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Toulouse on 20 March. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. MILLEPASSI** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E at this track over 2575m on 14 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 6. MADISON GABY** - Finished 8th in a Class E at this track over 2650m on 3 November. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 7. MERCEDES PAN** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at Villeréal on 30 August. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 8. MYRA MARIVALOISE** - Successful in a Class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Has done little wrong so far and must be respected in this line-up
- 9. MYSTIQUE ULTRA** - Did not show her best when 11th in a Class F at this track over 2575m on 1 March. In good form before that and is not out of it
- 10. MEA MARIS** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Has disqualification issues but can contest the finish
- 11. MIMI JELOCA** - Showed improvement when barefoot and runner-up in a Class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Remains without shoes and can go one place better
- 12. MARIE LOU DE LARRE** - Not disgraced when 6th in a Class F at Chartres over 2800m on 15 March. Barefoot for the first time and could score
- 13. MACHINE DE GUERRE** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: MARIE LOU DE LARRE (12) was not disgraced in her comeback run at Chartres. She is barefoot for the very first time and could score in an open-looking race. MIMI JELOCA (11) showed improvement when racing without shoes, remains barefoot, and is capable of striking a victory. MYSTIQUE ULTRA (9) was in good form before a disappointing last run and must be respected. MYRA MARIVALOISE (8) has shown promise and would not be a surprise winner.

- 1. NAPOLEON PAN** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 20 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. NEREIDE PAN** - Only modest so far and finished 6th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 27 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 3. NEW LOVE D'AMOUR** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Needs to do a lot more to beat these these rivals
- 4. NUIT DE ROUAISSE** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 20 March. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. NICKEL D'ARBAZ** - Finished 4th on debut in a Class F at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 March. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- 6. NUBIA TURGOT** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 20 March. Has not shown much so far and others are preferred
- 7. NUVOLA BARAKA** - Not disgraced when 4th on debut, in a Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 20 March. Should be right there at the finish
- 8. NINO DU PLESSIS** - Finished 7th in a Class E at Saint-Malo over 2150m on 15 August. Returns from a lengthy break but has claims for new trainer
- 9. NASTY MAN** - A three-year-old gelding by Brillantissime out of Douce Gergauderie who is making his debut. His mother won 5 of her 90 starts. Should be a threat on debut
- 10. NIRVANA PLAYA** - A three-year-old-year-old colt by Carat Williams out of Bahia Playa who is making his debut. His mother won once in just four starts. Can challenge for top honours
- 11. NUAGEUSE** - Disqualified on debut at Toulouse over 2750m on 13 March. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 12. NEW DE LA COTE** - Disqualified on debut at Toulouse over 2325m on 27 February. Likely to be smarter this time and could earn some money
- 13. NOCTAMBULE SEVEN** - A three-year-old gelding by Hooker Berry out of Happy Family Ar who is makin his debut. His Dam won twice in 45 starts. Others make more appeal
- 14. NECTAR DU PERCHE** - Showed some improvement when 6th in a Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 February. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 15. NATIVE DU GILET** - Disqualified at Auch on 8 March. Did not show much on debut and needs major improvement to win this race
- 16. NIKALY D'EOLE** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Challans over 2375m on 22 March. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

THURSDAY, 02/04/26

Summary: NINO DU PLESSIS (8) was only modest in his first two starts this year. He should improve for this trainer and could be of some value in this tricky lucky last race. NUVOLA BARAKA (7) was not disgraced on her debut and is likely to improve on that. She should be a real threat to these rivals. Two of the first-timers catch the eye. NASTY MAN (9) qualified in a decent time and must be respected for that. NIRVANA PLAYA (10) also impressed in qualifying and is another to consider.
