

R5 VINCENNES [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DIANA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 52,000

- 1. NEEDREAM** - Only modest of late and was 7th in Class C at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 10 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 2. NONOLETA** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 27 April. Might play a minor role
- 3. NUTELLA DE VANDEL** - Showed what she is capable of with a Class E victory at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 7 May. Looks capable of doubling up
- 4. NOBLESSE JISCE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. NIGHT FOR YOU** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Group 2 mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Probably at best under the saddle and others are preferred
- 6. NYX DE LA HAIE** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in Class D at this course over 2200m on 14 April. Fitter this time and could go one place better
- 7. NOLITA MADRIK** - Finished third in only start of this year, in Class D at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. Fitter and could be competitive once again
- 8. NALISMA** - Victorious last time out in Class B at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 15 May. Consistent and can get int the mix of things
- 9. NASHIRA RUSCINO** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 May. Needs to find a few lenghts to score
- 10. NIKITA DES ARRIS** - In good shape and was third in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. Quite capable of earning some more money

Summary: NUTELLA DE VANDEL (3) produced a striking performance to get off the mark at Marseille-Borély and is unlikely to stop there. Third on her reappearance, NOLITA MADRIK (7), fitted with hind plates for the first time, looks highly competitive. Back to the sulky after a good comeback under the saddle, NYX DE LA HAIE (6) is another solid contender, along with NALISMA (8), who is in very good recent form.

C2 - PRIX HESPERIA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 52,000

- 1. NEW HAVEN WOOD** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class C at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 15 May. Might earn some minor money
- 2. NOLIO DU BARBEY** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class B at Caen over 2200m on 9 May. Has disqualification issues but can make the frame
- 3. NANTUS D'AVIGNERE** - Yet to win a race but was fourth in Class D at this track over 2700m on 12 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. NELSON DE CHANLECY** - Has some ability and finished third in Class C at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 3 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. NASH PERRINE** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 3 May. Should fight out the finish
- 6. NEBBIO DU LIAMONE** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2700m on 22 May. Did win a claimer in February but others make more appeal
- 7. NOVO SUPREME** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class C at Vichy over 2150m on 11 May. May need to do more to score
- 8. NEED FOR LOVE** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2700m on 5 May. Clearly capable of better and could earn some money
- 9. NOBEL DU RIB** - Successful in his last two starts, the latest in Class D at Argentan over 2150m on 11 May. Still improving and could complete the hat-trick
- 10. NOTTINGHAM FIRST** - Consistent and was third in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 May. Yet to win but can be competitive once again
- 11. NELATO BELLO** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. Capable of being a threat to these rivals
- 12. NINO DE LARRE** - In good shape and finished runner-up in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Clearly is not out of it
- 13. NELATI DE MORGANE** - Has struggled this year and finished tenth in Class B at Caen over 2200m on 9 May. Others are much preferred

Summary: NOBEL DU RIB (9) arrives on the back of two comfortable victories and takes his chance for the first time in the Paris region with legitimate ambitions. NASH PERRINE (5) has also strung together two wins recently and looks his chief rival. A model of consistency, NOTTINGHAM FIRST (10) should once again be in the mix for a place on the podium. NOLIO DU BARBEY (2) ran much better than his finishing position suggests at Caen and also deserves a mention.

C3 - PRIX PAUL DELANOE - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Gr3 - Mounted - EUR € 90,000

1. **JOSHUA PEJI** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a Class E harness race at Pontchâteau over 2800 on 12 April. Capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride
2. **FALTO DES LANDIERS** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2850m on 26 May. More is needed to score
3. **HEDEN CRUZ** - Disqualified last time out in a Group 3 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 19 May. Capable of doing better and could earn some money
4. **GOLD VOICE** - Has lost her way of late and was 11th in Class A at this track over 2850m on 13 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
5. **KAPULA DE L'EPINE** - Holding form and finished 5th in a Group 3 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 19 May. Should fight out the finish
6. **KYT KAT** - Unreliable but was third in a Group 3 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 19 May. Capable of earning some more money
7. **IMPALA DE VAL** - Disqualified last time out in a Group 3 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 19 May. Quite capable of bouncing back to beat these rivals
8. **FILWELL** - Unreliable and finished fourth in a Group 3 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 19 May. Might play a minor role
9. **FULTON** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Group 3 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 19 May. Capable of making the frame
10. **JEAN BALTHAZAR** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Group 3 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 19 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
11. **IDEALE DU CHENE** - In very good form and was runner-up in a Group 3 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 19 May. Has not won for some time but could go one better

Summary: A trotter of real class, IMPALA DE VAL (7) is expected to bounce back from his recent disqualification, especially as he showed on 15 February that this shorter trip holds no fears for him. Very effective over this course and distance, KAPULA DE L'EPINE (5) is an obvious contender. IDEALE DU CHENE (11), who is rarely far away at the business end is also a threat. FULTON (9) needs to reassure, but he has solid form over this distance on the main track.

C4 - PRIX PROKNE - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. **MULANE DU BOCAGE** - Has shown improvement of late and was third in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 3 May. Might play a minor role at very best
2. **MOONDANCE OKINA** - Often competitive and finished third in Class E at this course over 2100m on 26 May. Is clearly not out of it
3. **MADONE PIYA** - Disqualified in three of her last five starts, including last time out at this track over 2700m on 13 May. Capable of scoring when in the right mood
4. **MANZANA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class D over this course and distance on 5 May. More is needed to score
5. **MISS MELODY PEEL** - Much improved this year and was a barefoot winner last time out in Class E at Argentan over 2150m on 11 May. Remains without shoes and can follow up
6. **MOUSTACHE** - Off form and finished 9th in Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
7. **MELITTE DE RIVIERE** - In good form and finished third in Class D over this track and trip on 5 May. Quite capable of making the frame once again
8. **MADAME D'ERABLE** - Has shown improvement of late and was barefoot and runner-up in Class D at this course over 2700m on 21 April. Not fully barefoot this time but is not out of it
9. **MANDRAGORA FLEURY** - Showed some improvement when fifth in Class D over this track and trip on 5 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
10. **MI FA SOL** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this course over 2700m on 28 April. Capable of bouncing back to score
11. **MOSTRA DE CHANLECY** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class D at this course over 2700m on 21 April. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

Summary: MI FA SOL (10) had the measure of her rivals when she made a mistake turning into the straight last time out. If keeping her action together, she can gain compensation. In fine form, MISS MELODY PEEL (5) should once again be firmly in the shake-up. MADAME D'ERABLE (8), even though she won't be racing completely barefoot this time. Talented but tricky, MADONE PIYA (3) is also capable of playing a leading role if she is smart.

C5 - PRIX MINERVA - 2850m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. FRENCH CONNECTION** - Disqualified last time out at Jägersro over 1640m on 6 November 2024. Should need this run returning from a break
- 2. TRIGUELUS** - Has yet to win a race and was 5th at Mons over 2840m on 12 May. Might play a minor role in this line-up
- 3. PRESLEY BOKO** - Disqualified last time out at Duindigt over 2000m on 16 May. Capable of scoring on French debut for Matthieu Abrivard
- 4. LEADER WOOD** - In good shape and finished third at Avenches over 2400m on 23 May. Tougher task this time but might play a minor role
- 5. GIFT GIO** - Disqualified last time out at Turin over 2060m on 22 April. Capable of better but has a tough task in this line-up
- 6. GRAN PREMIO (ITY)** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Group 1 at Turin over 2060m on 6 April. Can play a minor role at very best
- 7. GIOIELLO ROC** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class B at this course over 2700m on 13 May. On a long losing run but can earn some money
- 8. MAGUEN DAIRPET** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at this course over 2175m on 5 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. GHOSTRIDER FONT** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class B at this course over 2700m on 13 May. Barefoot this time and can contest the finish
- 10. GOLD MAIL** - Has struggled of late and finished 7th at Naples over 2100m on 22 April. Capable of an upset over this course and distance
- 11. MARATHON MAN** - Probably needed his only run of the year when 13th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 11 April. Fitter this time but others make more appeal
- 12. MAGIC JOHN** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class C at this course over 2700m on 19 May. Not reliable but does have claims
- 13. MARS COBBA** - Has needed both starts this year, the latest when 7th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 19 May. Remains without shoes and could make the frame
- 14. MAJOR DU BISTON** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class B at this course over 2175m on 15 February. Could need this run returning from a break

Summary: Blessed with plenty of natural talent, PRESLEY BOKO (3) makes his first appearance in France and arrives with high expectations. MAGIC JOHN (12) is an interesting youngster and, if he behaves himself, should be involved at the finish. Racing barefoot this GHOSTRIDER FONT (9) could well return to form. Partnered by Alexandre Abrivard, MARS COBBA (13) also remains capable of making his presence felt.

C6 - PRIX EDBURGA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class R Claiming Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **KHEOPS SAINT CLAIR** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class E at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 24 May. Has a place chance on best form
2. **LORENZO BERRY** - On a long losing run and finished 9th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Capable of an upset at this level
3. **KADOR JOSSELYN** - Disqualified last time out in this division at this course over 2850m on 26 May. Capable of improvement this shorter distance but others make more appeal
4. **LUNIK DU CHOQUEL** - Disqualified in both starts this year, the latest at Dozule over 2900m on 14 May. Fitter now but others make more appeal
5. **LEVRETTE** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class C at Caen over 2200m on (May. Needs to do a bit more to score
6. **LANNISTER D'AVRIL** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Did win at this level in March and is clearly not out of it
7. **LEADER DE JOUDES** - Successful last time out in this division at Enghien over 2175m on 27 April. Capable of following up
8. **KAISER RIVER** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 22 May. Capable of contesting the finish
9. **KULTA** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 22 May. Can be competitive back in a claimer
10. **LE JIBAY** - Needed the run when 9th in a Class D mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 28 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
11. **L'ARC** - On a long losing run and finished 6th in Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Could be the surprise package of the race
12. **KAID GRIFF** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class G at Vichy over 2800m on 28 May. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
13. **KATANE DU CORTA** - Disqualified last time out at Cherbourg over 2625m on 10 May. Unreliable but can earn some minor money
14. **LOUSTIC D'YVEL** - Not reliable and finished 11th in Class E at this course over 2100m on 15 May. Capable of earning some money
15. **LEONARDO TURGOT** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class E at La Capelle over 1800m on 24 May. Can go one place better

Summary: LEADER DE JOUDES (7) comes here after a clear-cut victory at Enghien. Freshened up since, he looks a formidable contender in a race well within his grasp. Back in his preferred category, LANNISTER D'AVRIL (6) has a good opportunity to bounce back. KULTA (9) has been handed an awkward draw but drops in class for this assignment. Lightened in his shoeing after a recent comeback run, KAISER RIVER (8) is one to keep an eye on.

C7 - PRIX GERALDINA - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. KINGALA** - In good form and was runner-up in Class G over this track and trip on 5 May. On a long losing run but can go one place better
- 2. KOMMUNES DE PLAY** - Did not show her best when 6th in Class H at Rânes over 3125m on 25 May. In good form before that and could make the frame
- 3. JACKPOT DES MONTS** - Has only been modest this year and finished 7th in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 24 May. Needs to do more to score
- 4. JUNINIO FLEURY** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class H at Issigeac over 3175m on 24 May. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 5. JUSTE UN DALY** - Disqualified last time out at Alençon over 2650m on 10 May. Has won twice this year and can score again if smart
- 6. JET SPE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class G at Reims over 2500m on 25 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 7. KANEM** - Successful in Class H at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 25 May. Has disqualification issues but cannot be ruled out from doubling up
- 8. ILOVIROIZ DI LEONE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class F at this course over 2100m on 19 May. Not out of it in this line-up
- 9. KEN FERFAY** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and fourth in Class F at Vitteaux over 2600m on 24 May. Remains without shoes and can be competitive once more
- 10. HAPAX** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class D at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: KINGALA (1) has been knocking on the door for several weeks now and would be fully deserving of a change in fortune for her consistency. Well proven with François Chapdelaine, JUSTE UN DALY (5) also commands respect on his return to Vincennes. Unlucky last time out, KOMMUNES DE PLAY (2) could make amends. KEN FERFAY (9) has already shown his class in stronger company and is capable of scoring as well.

C8 - PRIX CYGNUS - 2850m (a2m) - Class C - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- 1. NOBEL DU CHOQUEL** - Finished 7th last time out in a Class F harness race at Laon over this distance on 1 May. Capable of improvement and can make the frame
- 2. NICO DU COJEUL** - Has only been modest and was 5th in Class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 26 april. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 3. NIRVANA DE VANDEL** - Showed improvement second time out when third in a Class E mounted race at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Can earn some more money
- 4. NOBEL DE LA COTE** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Did better on debut and can be a lively danger
- 5. NAME IS DAIRPET** - Not disgraced when fourth in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2700m on 5 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 6. NEAL DE PERVENCHE** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2175m on 13 May. Capable of scoring
- 7. NEOH DAIRPET** - Disqualified last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Not easy to trust but can earn some money when smart
- 8. NEPAL MISA** - Disqualified last time out at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 9. NELSON DE BANVILLE** - Showed good improvement when runner-up in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2700m on 5 May. Should fight out the finish
- 10. NOBI BAROSSO** - Has disqualification issues but was runner-up in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2700m on 28 April. Can go one better if smart
- 11. NAVAH MERCURY** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class C harness race at this course over 2700m on 5 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 12. NEMO DU VARLET** - Has only been modest of late and was 8th in a Class B harness race at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Might play a minor role back under the saddle

Summary: A tricky lucky last race. A decent runner-up at this course in April, NOBI BAROSSO (10) would only need to keep things straightforward to go one better. NELSON DE BANVILLE (9) showed marked improvement in his second start and is a real threat. Highly regarded for his debut under the saddle, NOBEL DU CHOQUEL (1) returns to the discipline with legitimate claims. Having made a convincing introduction, NOBEL DE LA COTE (4) can also get involved with the finish.
