

## R4 LISIEUX [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX SAINT DESIR LISIEUX - 2675m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000**

1. **JIPANGA DE NILE** - Has yet to display any particular aptitude for the amateur category but showed form at Le Neubourg in late-May and is not incapable of getting a look in
2. **IMPERIAL DU CAPRE** - Moderate trotter that has made no impact since returning from a year-long absence and can be disregarded
3. **KOACH BOND** - Quality element with more ability than his earnings would imply. Tends to show more on turf but has a lot going for him here and with application will be a tough nut to crack
4. **KYMJO DE BELFOND** - Has done nothing of note since imposing at Durtal in July 2025 and even at this level will have little to contribute
5. **KAMARAN MADRIK** - Off the track for almost 2 years and looks a far cry from the good youngster he once was
6. **HICONE DOREE** - Moderate mare that did not displease in 2 before being trounced at Angouleme 2.5 weeks ago. Has placed in one of two for her driver but others still preferred
7. **HOBBY DE L'EVRE** - Unplaced in all 3 starts since returning from his break. Starts on front line but is new to Lisieux and not an obvious choice
8. **KATKO DES CHAMPS** - Makes first appearance at this level after winning a Class H on turf 11 days ago. Starts in front and has a realistic chance of contesting the finish
9. **KING OF RACE** - Has been completely off the boil in 2026 and has no realistic chance
10. **JASEUR** - Is confirmed here but has looked very ordinary so far this term and will have few friends
11. **KOKA RIGHT** - Has placed in 3 of the 5 amateur races he has run, most recently 3rd in a Vire Class G 3.5 weeks ago, and even from the back row can play a prominent part
12. **JADE DU BILLARD** - Got back in the game at Durtal recently when runner-up in a Class F. Had been off the track for some time and, if close to his earlier ability, will have a lot to offer
13. **HERRA D'AVENIR** - Returns to a hard surface following 2 lacklustre turf performances. Has form with her driver, and starts in front, but is not a priority
14. **HAROLD BUROIS** - Surprise 3rd at Dozule in May but has failed 3 times to confirm and can be confidently ruled out
15. **KAIROS DU PERCHE** - Put a number of disappointing runs behind him to come 4th in a Villedieu-les-Poëles Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Has pulled a rough number but will be no easy touch if Romain Foiret keeps him focused
16. **JOLICOEUR DU MIREL** - Has yet to impose at this level but tends to go well for François Marie Roussel and can make first 5 if he successfully negotiates the start

**Summary:** Although eliminated in both amateur starts to date, KOACH BOND (3) has nevertheless won twice recently and from the 3 slot can wrap this up. He will still face resistance from the widely-drawn but recent Ranee winner, KATKO DES CHAMPS (8), who will still be dangerous with shoes fitted, and KAIROS DU PERCHE (15) who reassured at Villedieu-les-Poëles mid-month. KOKA RIGHT (11) made up for his Saint-Malo blip when 3rd at Vire and should not let the side down if he takes to the new conditions.

## C2 - PRIX ARPA 14 - OLIVIER DUHAMEL - 2675m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

1. **NEPTUNE D'AVE** - Left a good impression when imposing on debut at Evreux in early-May. Faces a tougher test this time but can still contest a place on the podium
2. **NUANCE DU GRIPPON** - Showed early promise but very disappointing in last 3 and will have nothing to contribute
3. **NARISSA DE LOU** - Convincing winner of a Class G at Savigny-sur-Braye on debut 3.5 weeks ago. Has been handed a good draw here and enjoys a reasonable chance of confirming
4. **NEPTUNA** - Gave a very good account first time out, easily securing a Class G on turf 2.5 weeks ago. Has significantly more to give and is well-placed to repeat
5. **NORMA CASTELLE** - Is not devoid of ability but is not the most dependable either, and would be preferred a level down
6. **NOUMEA DES YVETS** - Modest filly that has done nothing of note since returning from the layoff and can be ruled out
7. **NYPHE DE BAIS** - Has finished no closer than 4th in 8 career starts and is not about to influence the result
8. **NINA DE NESLE** - Showed tenacity to impose first time out, securing a Class G at Le Neubourg on 13 June. Starts wide, but on the front row, and will be expected to finish in the mix
9. **NASSAU LIGNERIES** - Career debutante making first appearance since qualifying modestly at Caen last December and is unlikely to spice things up
10. **NETFLIX MIJO** - Untried filly that qualified in 1'18'5 at Caen in late-March. Has not been blessed with the best of draws but nonetheless looks capable of making her presence felt
11. **NINA RICCI ERA** - Set off no fireworks when qualifying in 1'19'7 at Caen in late-March. Has little going for her here and others easier to back
12. **NUANCE DE STAR** - Showed improvement at Meslay-du-Maine just over a month ago when 4th in a Class F. Is forced to start on the 2nd line here and is unlikely to make much of an impact
13. **NINA DE SASSY** - Has yet to deliver on the potential she showed in last July's qualification and the draw just compounds the matter
14. **NAGA JOLOKIA** - Ran 2nd on debut before faulting here 12 days ago. Sports hind pads for the first time and will be no pushover if François Le Brun successfully navigates the start
15. **NAPA VALLEY ZEN** - Not the calmest of fillies but showed promise at La Capelle in late-May. Is not a priority but can pick up a cheque if she deigns to keep her action together
16. **NOVELISTA** - Made up for debut elimination when 2nd in a Ranes Class G 11 days ago. Mathieu Mottier back in the bike and looks a player, but will first have to deal with the tough draw

**Summary:** NEPTUNA (4) won on debut, which is great in itself, but she did it in an impressive time on turf and, sporting hind pads for the occasion, looks a marginally better bet than fellow debutante winner NARISSA DE LOU (3) who will be similarly-shod. NEPTUNE D'AVE (1) also won first time out, and should figure prominently, but she may not be cut from the same cloth. NAGA JOLOKIA (14) has been reconfigured following her recent elimination here, is clearly a good future prospect, and although poorly-drawn still represents a decent place prospect.

## C3 - PRIX DES VANS BARBOT - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 20,000

1. **LUEUR MAJYC** - Encouraged at Gournay-en-Bray on 24 May but found the going tough at Caen next time and can be ruled out
2. **LANAE D'ELA** - Eliminated on monte debut at Le Touquet 12 days ago and already looks out of her depth
3. **LEU DES BOIS** - 41 races and yet to get off the mark, but went close at Vichy earlier in the month and on good behaviour can challenge for a place in the picture
4. **LEMILIE SAINT BAR** - Showed form last autumn before coming off the boil and has picked up this term where she left off
5. **LORD** - Ran 3rd at Le Mont-Saint-Michel in late-May prior to being eliminated at Reims on 6 June. Starts in front but in this category will struggle to make his presence felt
6. **LORD DE Jafa** - Makes just 2nd monte appearance in what has been an inauspicious career and considering current form can be confidently ignored
7. **LENOLA DE CORTEM** - Has been a complete write-off since imposing at Cabourg last July and will have nothing to bring to the party
8. **LARIANA CLEVILLE** - 3rd in a Caen Class E 2.5 weeks ago after a 2.5 months' spell. Is well-entered on the front line and Antonin Andre can be justifiably confident of a big run
9. **MISTRAL DE CERISY** - Sent for a short layup after pleasing twice in the capital in April. Will have some work in him though and should not be underestimated
10. **MAZEPPA DU VIVIER** - Returns from a short spell following 3 close calls. Has not won since April 2025 but it is just a question of time. Chance
11. **LA SEGNORA PIYA** - Has ample ability but is not easy to handle. Reassured behind LEU DES BOIS (3) at Vichy 3 weeks ago and with application can get in on the action
12. **MEANDRE DE VANDEL** - Has taken his game to a new level since starting to race barefoot, latterly dominating a Vincennes Class D 2 weeks ago, and is in with a realistic shout of pulling off the hat-trick
13. **MAURICIO DU DERBY** - Sent for a rest after failing to fire at Vincennes on 21 April. Has previously won when shod and, while not a priority, is still worth keeping an eye on

**Summary:** Wonderfully-consistent in both branches of the game, MEANDRE DE VANDEL (12) has, however, found his way under the saddle and even against some hardened 5 year-olds still looks the one to beat. That being said, MAZEPPA DU VIVIER (10) has been knocking at the door and represents the principal threat. LARIANA CLEVILLE (8) made a fine re-entry at Caen, goes first-time barefoot, and will only have come on for the run. LEU DES BOIS (3) has taken well to his new vocation and will be dangerous if Esteban De Jesus keeps him trotting.

## C4 - PRIX DE BLANGY LE CHATEAU - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. MISKAVA** - Lacks discipline but not ability. Reassured on turf 3.5 weeks ago and the 25m head-start will only work to her advantage. Chance
- 2. MANON BLONDE** - 17 races and yet to lose her maiden tag. Has not raced since March and will have nothing to contribute
- 3. MELODY DE MADKER** - Imposed at Graignes prior to running 3rd in a Class F over course and distance on 20 June. Is in better company this time but benefits from a terrific entry and Yoann Lebourgeois will be eager to make hay
- 4. MILADY** - Is back racing right-handed after coming 5th in a Laval Class E 3 weeks ago and has a decent chance of winning this
- 5. MARINE D'ERABLE** - Talented filly but has not been seen out since September 2025 and is going to be race-rusty
- 6. MEGANE DE CERISY** - Made up for Vincennes sanction when 5th in a Caen Class F in late-May. Is new to Lisieux and unlikely to influence the outcome
- 7. MOON LIGHT RIVER** - Makes first start since winning a Vire Class E on 18 March. Is shod this time but cannot be discounted
- 8. MAKARINA DE BOMO** - Undeniably capable but never the easiest to handle. Benefits from a good entry though and, if applied, can pick up a first-5 payout
- 9. MADAME D'ERABLE** - Returns to the provinces following a pair of decent efforts at Vincennes, and in this category looks capable of challenging for the spoils

**Summary:** MILADY (4) won 2 going clockwise before failing to secure the hat-trick at Laval, but returns to racing right-handed and is easy to fancy for the win. Mathieu Mottier will still be mindful of the ideally-entered MADAME D'ERABLE (9) who will be no soft touch on her Lisieux debut. MISKAVA (1) is as complicated as they come but she got back in the winners' circle at Mondoubleau mid-month, will be barefoot this time, starts in front, and on good behaviour can repeat. MELODY DE MADKER (3) gave a fine account here recently, races barefoot for the first time, and is not without a chance of getting her nose in front.

## C5 - PRIX DE CAMBREMER - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. MALRO DU PORTUGAL** - Has yet to demonstrate any aptitude for the discipline and can be confidently disregarded
- 2. MARVEL** - Showed some promise last summer but has failed to come good this term and can be passed over
- 3. MY LUCKY BOY** - Respectable sort but has not been seen out since mid-March and is going to need the run
- 4. MONT BLANC QUARTO** - A veritable disappointment all year. Sports a fresh formula, and starts in front, but others still preferred
- 5. MILLESIME ROC** - Has hardly put a foot wrong this season, latterly runner-up to MIC MAC LOUANGES (10) in a Class F on turf 2.5 weeks ago, and has a decent chance of making the frame once again
- 6. MONACO DU LIVET** - Has yet to get off the mark but always gives what he can. Ran 3rd over course and distance in April and even in this company can pick up another cheque
- 7. MILWAUKEE LEGEND** - Serious colt with a bright future. Lost his action last time out but is clearly in rude health and will have his chances if Yoann Lebourgeois gets him off on the right foot
- 8. MILORD DREAM** - Unexceptional type with better prospects under the saddle and can be ignored
- 9. MIKONOS DE MAHEY** - Is some way off the form he displayed in 2025. Returns to racing shod but is still not an obvious choice
- 10. MIC MAC LOUANGES** - Quality trotter that has yet to be bested when barefoot. Imposed easily 2.5 weeks ago and will be expected to repeat
- 11. MAESTRO D'IDEE** - Has done nothing but improve lately, most recently winning a Bernay Class F on 31 May. Has had ample time to get back to his best and will be expected to put in another good showing
- 12. MARHABATH** - Showed fine form earlier in the season before producing 3 straight eliminations and will first need to reaffirm
- 13. MAGICIEN LUDOIS** - Reliability not his strong suit but has already won this term. Is well-engaged here, races barefoot for the first time, and must be considered a player
- 14. MASCARET DEFF** - Blows hot and cold but can trot. Is due a decent run one of these days and the excellent entry must be taken into account

**Summary:** Sporadically-raced he may be but MIC MAC LOUANGES (10) got straight back in the game at Erbray mid-month, makes his Lisieux bow on a hat-trick, and will be well-backed to pull it off. Justifiably well-regarded, MILWAUKEE LEGEND (7) failed to confirm his May success when quickly eliminated 3 weeks ago but on better behaviour can put things right. Most impressive in 3 of his last 4 starts, and recently runner-up to the Duvaldestin gelding, MILLESIME ROC (5) sports a new configuration and must be taken seriously. MAESTRO D'IDEE (11) imposed a month ago, a year after losing his maiden status, and even though shod this time still looks competitively well in.

## C6 - PRIX DU BREUIL EN AUGÉ - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **LORD DE L'AVRE** - Trotter with bags of ability but eliminated in last 3. Has never got around Lisieux unscathed but sports a fresh configuration which may be just the thing
2. **LUCKY DE LINE** - Gave a respectable account at Alençon before losing his action at Mondoubleau 2.5 weeks ago and in this company has no possible chance
3. **LIPSKA** - Has started to come good again following a slow start to then season. Has form with her driver of the day and from the front row can play a prominent role
4. **LUCKYLUKE DU GIVRE** - Has started to come good again following a slow start to the spring. Made little impact on his sole start at the venue and is not about to create an upset
5. **LUEUR D'HAUFOR** - Has placed just once in 3 starts this term. Is on the front line once more but others still preferred
6. **LUCKY FIX** - Ran 2nd at Elbeuf early last month when still being conditioned. Has been freshly re-shod but is still taking on too much
7. **LOLITA DU STADE** - Has failed to make any impact so far this season and must first get her house in order
8. **LE TANGO DU RENARD** - Nicely-engaged sort in fine form but has considerably better prospects in the other code
9. **L'ABEILLE DU DOME** - Placed in 2 before being conditioned at Laon 3.5 weeks ago. Trainer could not have hoped for a better entry and Sébastien Olivier will be expected to deliver
10. **LADY DU CEDRE** - Got back in the winners' circle at Saint-Malo in late-May but has been fitted with shoes this time and best to hold off
11. **LEONARD DE VINCI** - Quickly eliminated in a Laval Class E 3 weeks ago after having had his way at Saint-Malo. Has conditions to his liking this time and will be expected to finish close
12. **L'ONCLE SAM** - Useful trotter but has not been seen out since March and will be preparing for a campaign under the saddle
13. **LOULOU DE L'AUNAY** - Has not been seen out since running 2nd in a Class E at Le Touquet on 26 April and with shoes on will have nothing to contribute
14. **LOVELY GODIVA** - Has just the one race under her belt since the winter break. Is still in conditioning-mode and can be passed over
15. **LEVIOSA** - Has picked up this season where she left off last year. Ran 3rd under these conditions early last month and even though in better company this time, she sports modified shoeing and must be respected
16. **LUXURY DU DOUAROU** - Twice 2nd before finishing unplaced at Vincennes early last month. Is clearly better than that though and can give this a good go if Franck Nivard gets him off on the right foot
17. **LAMA DE CORDAY** - Superb in the last 3 races he has finished. Ran 2nd here in March and, reunited with his usual partner, can get back down to doing what he does best
18. **LOOK PEJI** - Has turned a corner since being entrusted to Mathieu Mottier, latterly a convincing Laval Class E winner 3 weeks ago, and makes his Lisieux bow with a realistic chance of making it a winning one

**Summary:** Wonderfully-engaged at the limit of earnings, and clearly at the top of his game, LOOK PEJI (18) took well to being fitted with pads at Laval and has every chance of making it 2 on the trot. Also nicely in, LAMA DE CORDAY (17) has been going good-guns for the past 3 months and will be no pushover if Adrien Guarato keeps him focused. LEONARD DE VINCI (11) failed to confirm his Saint-Malo victory when eliminated at Laval, but is back racing right-handed and will be expected to set things straight. At just 125 Euros from incurring the penalty, and plainly in good shape, L'ABEILLE DU DOME (9) will be shod to preference and is unlikely to be far from the action. Behind in earnings due to her spirited nature, LIPSKA (3) also starts in front and has already won for Yoann Lebourgeois.

**C7 - PRIX DE PONT-L'EVEQUE ET DE LA CONFRERIE - 2675m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €  
26,000**

1. **JAMES MADRIK** - Produced 3 fine efforts in May but has since come off the boil. Is new to the venue and even from the front row is not an obvious choice
2. **JIDEO STREET** - Modest element making first appearance since February and has no realistic chance
3. **JOFESCA BUISSONAY** - Tricky mare that was not disgraced at Caen 2 weeks ago despite being eliminated. Tends to go well for Yoann Lebourgeois and from the 3 slot should not be underestimated
4. **JUST FOR FUN** - Gave a very good account at Vichy despite being denied a run. Is patently close to his race and is ideally-positioned to win this
5. **HAPPY HERO** - Faces first target of the summer after a below-par performance at Mondoubleau 2.5 weeks ago. Is nicely-drawn but unlikely to spring any surprises
6. **IL MIO** - Gave a good account in the amateur division recently but faces a tougher test here and will need to find more
7. **HELBERT FOUTEAU** - Barring his Vichy blip has been firing on all cylinders, dominating a Reims Class F on 6 June. Has twice failed to deliver at Lisieux but in current condition is easy to like for a place in the frame
8. **HORS CADRE** - Surprise winner at Le Mont-Saint-Michel in April but has 3 times failed to confirm and can be passed over
9. **HIJO MOKO** - Ran 2nd here on 17 May but has since come off the boil and will have nothing to offer
10. **IESOLO** - Has found his feet again following a tough start to the year. Is forced to break on back line but has excelled for Adrien Lamy and looks competitively well in
11. **JALMAROSA** - Has been an absolute write-off for some time and will have few, if any, friends
12. **JENUFA** - Is considerably better than recent results would suggest. Is confirmed at this level and despite a 2nd row start can finish in the mix
13. **JOYCE DREAM** - No slouch on a good day but returns to racing shod after flopping at Caen 2 weeks ago and will have few takers
14. **INSTAGRAM** - Can trot but has comprehensively failed to confirm his May performance at Bernay and can be ignored
15. **IN LOVE DE CHARDET** - Showed improvement on 2nd start back, coming 4th in a Ranes Class H on 21 June. Has been allocated a bad number but is still worth retaining
16. **JURELLA DE PALM** - Convincing winner of a Vichy Class F a fortnight back. Arnaud Gilles Maillard would have preferred a better draw but, given the mare's condition, must be considered a player

**Summary:** He may not be the easiest of horses to use but JUST FOR FUN (4) showed marked improvement at Vichy, despite some ill-fate, and from the 4 slot can win this - provided Alan Gendrot keeps him focused. HELBERT FOUTEAU (7) laid down the law at Reims recently and with form maintained will be no pushover. JURELLA DE PALM (16) has something of a temperament, and has pulled a rough number, but she has won 2 of her last 4 starts and must be taken seriously. JOFESCA BUISSONAY (3) is better-positioned behind the car, won her only start at the venue, and on good behaviour can get in on the action.

## C8 - PRIX DE SAINT-HYMER - 2725m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. JOLI DE CONNEE** - Went off the boil after imposing at Graignes in February and with shoes fitted will have little to offer
- 2. JOKER GES** - Won a pair earlier in the spring but has been somewhat below-par since. Alexandre Abrivard in the bike this time and could pleasantly surprise if he keeps his charge trotting
- 3. HYGNUM PRIOR** - Rather disappointing in last 3 public appearances. Sports a new configuration but still has nothing to contribute
- 4. JAYF** - Has returned from his winter break in poor form and is not about to spice things up
- 5. JACKSON D'ECAJEUL** - Not the most reliable of horses but has placed in 2 of 4 this term. Has placed just once in 4 at Lisieux but in current condition cannot be discounted
- 6. JALHIA DU HANOY** - Failed to confirm Reims victory when succumbing to poor tactics at Vichy 3 weeks ago. Is clearly in shape though, starts in front, and re-shod for the occasion can play an important role
- 7. ILLICO FLIGNY** - Gave a reassuringly good account when 4th in a Vichy Class E mid-month. Will not be available at 53-1 this time but is unlikely to be as competitive either
- 8. JENKA DE MORMOULIN** - Debuts for new stable, is on the front line, won her only start at the venue, and with her new handler reining will be no easy touch
- 9. INDY DE TYROLE** - Has been giving a good account over recent months, latterly 2nd in a Class H on turf 12 days ago, but can expect to find this a tough task
- 10. JOYCE DE COSSE** - Made up for Lignieres elimination when 3rd in a Durtal Class E on 21 June. Will be barefoot again and is unlikely to disappoint
- 11. JAVADA DU MONT** - Has so far failed to make any impact this season and will first need to re-establish her credentials
- 12. IVY METAL** - Benefits from a terrific entry but has not raced since January and is going to need the run
- 13. JOMA OV** - Has not got her nose in front for over a year but has begun to get back in the game and will not be far off the mark if she stays in stride
- 14. INITIALE LILA** - Nicely-engaged mare who will have improved for comeback run at Vichy 2.5 weeks ago. Incurs the penalty but looks thoroughly capable of imposing this time
- 15. JOCELYNE** - Useful mare starting for first time since early-April. Won her only start at the venue, will be shod to preference, is nicely-engaged, and should not be overlooked
- 16. IDEAL DELADOU** - Left a good impression at Cholet recently despite failing to place but will be reunited with Yoann Lebourgeois and, considering the entry, should be good enough to win a race of this nature

**Summary:** A number in the running here but it may just be on the back line that we find the winner, INITIALE LILA (14) having made an excellent re-entry at Vichy mid-month, and IDEAL DELADOU (16) who is considerably better than his recent Cholet performance would suggest. JENKA DE MORMOULIN (8) is 25m better off and will be barefoot on his debut for Mathieu Mottier. JOYCE DE COSSE (10) reassured at Durtal when barefoot for the first time and has only once failed to fire for her driver.
