ACCAKABA (9) enters calculations on the back of a 3L eighth in the 1300m G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville. Holds claims. Stepping up in grade FANG (2) is a threat for a top yard following a 1L win in the course and distance G3 Prix du Pin.
