## C1 - PRIX DE ROUBAIX - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 28,000

- 1. JACADI BROUETS Continues to struggle and finished tenth in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 19 February. Barefoot this time but others are preferred
- 2. HOLLYWOOD TORINO Disqualified last time out at this track on 16 December. Unreliable but is capable of earning some minor money when wise
- 3. IDEAL DU DIGEON Disappointing last run when 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 February. Capable of an upset on best form
- **4. JASMIN BLANC -** Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 11 February. Was a good winner of his penultimate start and can bounce back to score
- 5. JOB DES MOLLES Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 17 February. Capable of making the frame
- 6. JOMA OV In good form and was third last time out in Class F at Argentan over 2875m on 16 February. Be right there at the finish
- 7. IDYLLE DE MAHEY Unreliable and finished 13th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 8. JULIA QUESNOT Threatening another win and was runner-up in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 22 January. Big chance

**Summary:** The in-form JULIA QUESNOT (8) boasts a solid strike rate when racing unshod and looks a solid winning proposition in this line-up. JASMIN BLANC (4) is always very effective over the longer distances and is a big danger if he can get off to a good start. JOMA OV (6) is a consistent trotter in this class of event and is a must for the shortlist. JOB DES MOLLES (5) is also very useful and could go close if the race is run at a strong pace.

- 2. INVINCIBLE MAUZUN Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 22 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 3. IN THE WIND On a very long losing run and was 6th at Wolvega over 2600m on 20 December. Others are preferred
- **4. IDEAL DU MAXFRAN -** Well beaten last time out in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 19 February. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- **5. IDO MENDY** Has major disqualification issues but was fourth last time out in Class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 16 February. Might earn some minor money
- 6. ICARE DE L'ITON Returns from a break but was runner-up last time out in Class G at Graignes over 2700m on 29 August. Likely to need this run
- 7. ISCHIA Has disqualification issues and faulted again last time out at Pontchâteau on 16 February. Capable of getting involved with the finish when smart

- 2. JIMANY Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out at Vincennes on 1 February. Capable of contesting the finish when wise
- 3. JET DE CANVILLE Only modest of late and finished 7th last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 February. Better over a shorter distance and others are preferred
- 4. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE Disqualified in his last four starts, with the latest being at Vincennes on 1 February. Others are preferred
- 5. JASMIN DANOVER Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Vincennes on 1 February. Others make more appeal
- **6. IRVANA JEPHI -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Saint-Brieuc over 3150m on 2 February. Capable of earning some money
- **7. JEDEO DES VAUX -** On a long losing run but did show improvement when fourth in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 February. Has a place chance
- 8. J'ADORE D'EURVAD Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 12 February. Probably better in harness races and others make more appeal
- 9. JOTT DU BOCAGE Disappointing recent form and was 9th in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 February. Has won at this course before and is not out of it
- **10. IMAGE DE RABET -** Has improved of late and was a barefoot winner last time out in a Class F Mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 5 February. Can follow up

- 3. KIR ROYAL Did not show his best when 12th last time out in Class B at this track over 2800m on 2 October. Could need this run returning from a break
- 4. KIARHA DE NAPPES Disqualified last time out at Vincennes 18 February. Capable of better and has a place chance if smart
- 5. KALIFA MESLOISE Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 18 February, Probably best watched for now
- 6. KIT ANGOT Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 30 January. Not reliable but is capable of an upset

KANTARELLE (9) posted an impressive performance two starts back and has every chance if she can repeat this feature. KEEP OUT (7) should show vast improvement after a much needed comeback run and can get involved too. KARAMBA KARACHO (1) is competitive in this division and is another one to keep on the safe side.

- **4. JUPITER FRANCE -** Has disqualification issues but did run well when fourth last time out in Class E at Vincennes over this distance on 18 February. Can contest the finish if wise
- 5. JACKSON HILL Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 5 February. Might play a minor role

- **3. LADY CYNTHIA -** Bounced back from a disqualification with a good runner-up performance in Class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 5 February. Just as good this distance and can go one better
- 4. LEVE TOI Disappointing of late and was 9th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 19 February. Barefoot this time and can be a threat
- 5. LAURA D'OSTENDE Holding form and was fourth in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 24 November. Can fight out the finish again
- **6. LUNE DE MEMARTIN -** Unreliable but was runner-up last time out at Wolvega over 2600m on 23 January. Might play a minor role at best

- 4. MIRTHE DE REUX A three-year-old filly by Désir Castelets out of Rivières Pourpres. Qualified in a decent time and can score on debut
- 5. MY LADY DE CAHOT A three-year-old filly by Village Mystic out of Unica de Cahot who is making her debut. Qualified in June and deserves respect
- **6. MAMMA PAULO -** Disqualified on her debut at Avenches on 7 October. Has qualified with a good time and can bounce back and be a threat if fit from a break
