**C1 - PRIX DES PIVOINES - 2925m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
27,000**

1. KITKO TEJY - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 26 February. In good form before that and is clearly not out of it

2. INES DE MAJEAN - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out over this track and trip on 26 February. Needs to improve to beat these rivals

3. KHARTOUM DE LA FYE - Unreliable and faulted last time out over this course and distance on 3 February. Very hard to trust but is capable of scoring when in the right mood

4. KABRIEL - Not reliable but was runner-up in a claimer at this track over 2950m on 25 February. Might play a minor role at very best

5. KHEOPS AIREMME - Did not show his best when 12th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Capable of making the frame in this line-up

6. KING DE LARRE - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Does have claims on best form

7. KALIE WOOD - Very consistent of late and was runner-up in Class E at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 13 February. Can go one place better this time around

8. IMPULSIF D'AVENIR - Not reliable but did finish fourth in Class G at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Can get into the mix of things

9. KOH I NOOR - Unreliable of late and finished tenth in Class B over this course and distance on 25 February. Can be a lively danger at this level

10. JERRY DE L'ERDRE - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 15 February. Capable of an upset on best form

11. JACKASS LATIN - Not reliable but did finish fourth in Class G at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 16 February. Could play a minor role at very best

12. JACOVIA MADRIK - Did not show her best when 12th in Class F at this track over 2700m on 17 February. Better over shorter but cannot be ruled out

13. KATELINE DE BRY - In good form and was third in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 8 February. Should fight out the finish

Summary: KHARTOUM DE LA FYE (3) looked capable of scoring before faulting last time out at Vincennes. He is very hard to trust but could make amends if staying in stride. KATELINE DE BRY (13) remains in very good shape and should challenge for top honours yet again. KOH I NOOR (9) is unreliable but does race barefoot and could be a threat. KING DE LARRE (6) has struggled of late but this is a race targeted for him and he can shine.

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C2 - PRIX DES DAHLIAS - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. LOUMIODO** - Not reliable and finished tenth in Class E over this course and distance on 26 February. Can be a threat on best form
- 2. LOEK DE REUX** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 26 February. Off form and needs major improvement to score
- 3. L'AIGLE** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class E over this track and trip on 26 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 4. LIPSTICK QUICK** - Returned to form with a barefoot win in Class E over this course and distance on 26 February. Remains without shoes and could follow up
- 5. LE ROI MARGOT** - Yet to win a race but is threatening to do so and was runner-up in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 2 January. Can go one place better
- 6. LUTIN QUICK** - Victorious in his last two starts, the latest in Class E at this track over 2150m on 5 January. Has disqualification issues but can complete the hat-trick
- 7. LEADER DES APRES** - Showed some improvement when third in Class E over this track and trip on 10 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 8. LOOK DES ECUS** - Off form and was unplaced in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Can make the frame if at best
- 9. LEADER RASTID** - Did not show his best when unplaced in Class E at this course over 2150m on 20 February. Did win over this track and trip before that and can bounce back to score

Summary: LIPSTICK QUICK (4) bounced back to her best with a good course and distance success and can win again. LUTIN QUICK (6) is hat-trick seeking after some solid wins but does come with disqualification issues. LOUMIODO (1) is a lot better than what he showed last time out and can get involved with the finish. LOOK DES ECUS (8) has struggled of late but could show improvement and is not out of it on best form.

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**C3 - PRIX DES GLAIEULS - 2925m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
23,000**

1. KATE DU RIL - Has a good record when barefoot and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2150m on 20 February. Should be right there at the finish once again

2. KATCHINA DUEM - Disqualified last time out at Toulouse over 2750m on 8 February. In good form before that and has a place chance if staying in stride

3. KILIA PETTEVINIERE - Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 22 February. Battling to regain her best form and others are preferred

4. KALIE TEJY - Not reliable but was third in Class E at this course over 2150m on 20 February. Should be involved with the finish once again

5. KIARA DES MONTS - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at this track over 2150m on 20 February. Not easy to trust but can be competitive in this line-up

6. KISMIE DE MONTFORT - Only moderate of late and was 8th in Class G over this track and trip on 17 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

7. KENACHA - Successful in two of her last three starts, including last time out in Class D at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 29 November. Returns from a break but has claims if fit enough

Summary: KATE DU RIL (1) does best when she is racing without shoes and she sets a clear standard for this race. KENACHA (7) has struck form with some nice wins of late and can fight out the finish yet again. KIARA DES MONTS (5) is not reliable but is clearly not out of it in this small field. KALIE TEJY (4) is also unreliable but did run well at this track last time out and can get into the mix of things once again.

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C4 - PRIX DES IRIS - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. HEOL LORIETTES** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class F over this course and distance on 26 February. Needs major improvement to score
- 2. INDESKAYA BIRD** - Fluffed her lines with a disqualification at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. In good form before that and can contest the finish if smart
- 3. HED** - Disqualified last time out at Toulouse over 2950m on 27 February. Unreliable of late and others make much more appeal
- 4. IGGY FAFA** - Has struggled of late and was 6th in Class D over this track and trip on 25 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 5. ICARE DUNGY** - Remains in very good shape and was runner-up in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 February. Big chance in this line-up
- 6. HEROS DHELPA** - In good form and was runner-up in Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 9 February. Should be competitive once more
- 7. HEROIC DES BOSC** - Usually does very well at this course and was third in Class E over 2700m on 31 January. Should fight out the finish
- 8. ICARE FILE** - A runner-up in his last four starts, the latest in Class E at this course over 2700m on 31 January. Can go one place better
- 9. IROISE QUESNOT** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class D over this course and distance on 25 February. Could earn some more money
- 10. HELICE DU TREZON** - Only modest of late and was 7th in Class D at this track over 2150m on 26 February. Needs to do more to score
- 11. HOMMAGE DE LARRE** - Very consistent of late and was successful in a claimer at this track over 2700m on 17 February. Tougher task this time

Summary: A very competitive race. ICARE DUNGY (5) remains in very good form and should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. ICARE FILE (8) has been unlucky not to win one of his last four starts and deserves a winning turn. INDESKAYA BIRD (2) faulted last time out at Marseille-Vivaux but is usually a lively danger. HEROS DHELPA (6) is also in good shape and would not be a surprise winner over this course and distance.

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**C5 - PRIX DES GERBERAS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
26,000**

- 1. LETTY DE BEYLEV** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 21 February. Should be involved with the finish once again
- 2. LIKE A BIRD STAR** - Showed some improvement when 5th in Class E over this track and trip on 20 February. Can earn some minor money
- 3. LADY DU VALLON** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 20 February. Capable of earning some money
- 4. LA REINE MARGOT** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class E over this track and trip on 20 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 5. LAIA D'AVRIL** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 20 February. Can go one better
- 6. LA MOME** - Has lost her way and finished 8th in Class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. Needs major improvement to score
- 7. L'AVENTURE DE YOR** - Has only been beaten twice in eight starts and was successful last time out in Class E at this course over 2925m on 31 January. Big chance
- 8. LEGENDE GAMES** - Faulted last time out at this course over 2925m on 2 January. In good form before that and can make the frame when smart
- 9. LILAS DU MELEUC** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 9 February. Can be a threat once again
- 10. LILIBETH SMART** - Unreliable and was disqualified over this course and distance on 20 February. Others make more appeal

Summary: L'AVENTURE DE YOR (7) has a very good win strike rate so far and will have every chance of adding another win to that tally. LA REINE MARGOT (4) has been consistent of late and will race without shoes for the very first time, so could strike. LEGENDE GAMES (8) was in good form before faulting last time out and could contest the finish. LAIA D'AVRIL (5) has hit the crossbar a couple of times of late and is clearly not out of it.

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C6 - PRIX DE LILLE - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. MAHATMA** - Finished 6th on debut in Class E at this course over 2700m on 26 February. Capable of improvement and could play a minor role
- 2. MAN ON FIRE** - Has done little wrong in two starts and was victorious last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 26 February. Capable of doubling up
- 3. MALIN DE L'ANTE** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class E at this track over 2150m on 20 February. Probably better over this distance and is not out of it
- 4. MON BEAU MEC** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when third in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 18 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. MAUZIN DE CROUAY** - Finished 5th in a Class E mounted race at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 8 February. Has some ability and should contest the finish
- 6. MONDIAL DE FAVEROL** - Has lost his way and was disqualified last time out at Nantes over 2275m on 13 February. Yet to win a race but can earn some money
- 7. MALOU DU BOIS** - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 February. Can be competitive over this track and trip

Summary: MAN ON FIRE (2) has shown promise in two starts and looks the right one for this race. MALIN DE L'ANTE (3) is consistent and distance suited, so can fight out the finish yet again. MALOU DU BOIS (7) has only been modest of late but can be a lively danger over this distance. MONDIAL DE FAVEROL (6) has yet to win a race and does have major disqualification issues but is capable of making the frame once again.

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C7 - PRIX DE CANNES - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. MARION DU CHERISAY** - Yet to win a race but has improved of late and was third in Class E over this track and trip on 31 January. Can earn some more money
- 2. MALICE BLEUE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class E at this course over 2150m on 17 February. Yet to win a race but has a place chance
- 3. MILADY DE NIMES** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Quite capable of making the frame
- 4. MILADY SMART** - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 17 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 5. MIMI RAUDIÈRE** - Very unreliable and faulted last time out at Vincennes in a mounted race over 2175m on 3 February. Capable of winning back in a harness race
- 6. MONNAIE DE VIETTE** - Disqualified in her last three starts, including last time out over this course and distance on 7 February. Very hard to trust but might play a minor role when smart
- 7. MOLLY DE VISAIS** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at this course over 2150m on 17 February. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 8. MONA LISA GEDE** - Disqualified in three of her last five starts, including last time out over this course and distance on 7 February. Will be a lively danger if she stays in stride
- 9. MISS MARGOT** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class E at this track over 2150m on 17 February. Yet to win a race but can make the frame
- 10. MEDUSA DU PONT** - Very unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at Nantes over 2275m on 13 February. Has major disqualification issues but can be a threat if she is in the right frame of mind
- 11. MERVEILLE BOKO** - Likes this course and was third in Class D over this track and trip on 7 February. Can contest the finish once again
- 12. MAYA DES BAUX** - Has some fair form and was not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Could play a minor role

Summary: MERVEILLE BOKO (11) has shown a distinct liking for this course and has been prepared with this race in mind. He gets the vote to score. MEDUSA DU PONT (10) is hard to trust and very unreliable but cannot be ruled out from winning when in the right frame of mind. MONA LISA GEDE (8) has had a few disqualifications of late but is a threat when smart. MIMI RAUDIÈRE (5) can contest the finish back in a harness race.

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**C8 - PRIX DES AGAPANTHES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR
€ 26,000**

- 1. NINA TIME** - Disqualified twice in her last five starts, including last time out at this track over 2925m on 12 February. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 2. NILDA LAND** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class D at this track over 2925m on 7 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 3. NOUMEA COCONUT** - Improving and was victorious in Class E at this course over 2925m on 20 February. Drops in distance but can double up
- 4. NORWEGIAN GIN** - Disqualified last time out at Toulouse over this distance on 7 February. Capable of earning some minor money at very best
- 5. NEURO BELLA** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out at this track over 2925m on 25 February. Hard to trust but cannot be ruled out
- 6. NOLAN QUESNOT** - Has lost his way with three disqualifications in his last four starts, including last time out at the course on 25 February. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring
- 7. NIMEO FLOWER** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 February. Capable of winning a race of this nature
- 8. NEW LOOK VRIE** - A bit of a disappointment when only fourth in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 10 February. Did win a harness race before that on debut and can bounce back to score
- 9. NISSA STAR** - Has improved of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at this track over 2925m on 7 February. Might play a minor role
- 10. NININE DES FLOTS** - Faulted last time out in Class E at this course over 2925m on 20 February. Might earn some minor money at very best
- 11. NEWLIFE DE CAHOT** - Disqualified in three of four starts, including last time out at this course over 2925m on 25 February. Has won over this track and distance and is not out of it if smart

Summary: An interesting lucky last race. NOUMEA COCONUT (3) is improving and was a good winner at this track a few weeks ago. She is clearly the one to beat. NINA TIME (1) is not easy to trust and has had a few disqualifications of late but is capable of getting involved with the finish. NOLAN QUESNOT (6) is talented when staying in stride and could be a threat. NEURO BELLA (5) is yet another with many faults of late but quite capable of scoring.
