C1 - PRIX DES ALPILLES - 2600m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming Handicap - Flat - EUR € 12,500

1. USER KINDLY - Won last time in a similar race at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 18th on the PSF. Three placed runs at this track last year. Player

2. SAINT LANGIS - Unplaced over hurdles last time over 3800m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 race on October 30th. 2nd on the flat last May over 3150m in a Class 4 handicap. Pass over

3. INTERSTELLA - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 2600m at Marseille-Vivau in a Class 4 handicap on February 10th. Course winner over 2600m in March 2025 in a Class 3 handicap. In the mix

4. BONNY WAY - Fair 5th last time over 3150m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 4 handicap on March 15th. Ought to be thereabouts

5. REVENTADOR - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that over 2600m at Marseille-Vivau in a Class 4 handicap on February 10th. Has work to do

6. EXCELSIOR - Two unplaced runs this year, 8th over 2000m at Fontainebleau last time on March 6th in a Class 4 race. Capable of bouncing back to form

7. BAGAZ - Three unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2500m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 4 race on March 5th. Needs to get back on track

8. GOLDEN BLUSH - Three recent unplaced efforts, 7th over 2600m at Marseille-Vivau in a Class 4 on the most recent on March 9th. More can be expected

Summary: EXCELSIOR (6) was a decent third at Deauville in late December three runs back and is more than capable of scoring in a race of this nature. He could have the most to fear from GOLDEN BLUSH (8), who has been low key of late but more can be expected back on turf after a seventh on the PSF last time in early March. USER KINDLY (1) has leading claims each way after a win at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in February on the artificial surface. INTERSTELLA (3) is another to consider.

**C2 - PRIX DE L'HUVEAUNE - 2600m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR
€ 19,200**

- 1. TOREBEK** - Two 3rd placed runs of late, the most recent over 2600m at Marseille-Vivaux in a maiden race on March 9th. Can make the frame
- 2. HUGO CABRET** - Finished 5th on his sole start over 2600m in a maiden race on the PSF on March 9th. Should improve and is one to keep outside
- 3. BASQUIAT** - Ran well to be 2nd on his latest start over 2600m in a maiden race on the PSF on March 9th. Narrowly defeat last time and can feature again today
- 4. ELMY** - Finished 8th over 2000m at this track in a maiden last time on March 18th. Poor form previously. Avoidable
- 5. TOUNSBY** - Finished 10th on the sole start over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 24th in a maiden race. Tailed off in the rear that day and would be a shock winner
- 6. ARMANO** - Finished a pleasing 3rd on his second start over 2000m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a maiden race on the PSF on February 11th. Can improve and is one to pay attention to on turf debut
- 7. THE MAGPIE** - Two 4th placed runs of late, the latter over 2000m at Marseille-Vivaux in a maiden race on March 4th. Can make the top three
- 8. BLACK HENGE** - Unraced gelding by Seahenge, the dam won 1 race. From a respected trainer that knows the time of day. Can improve for this outing and best watched
- 9. MAGIC STORM** - Unraced colt by De Treville, the dam won 2 races and was Listed placed. Some good aspects to his profile and he is worth a market check for any support.
- 10. PUPPET** - Unraced filly by Nathaniel, the dam won 1 race. Looks good on paper and from a respected trainer that knows how to get one ready to strike on debut

Summary: ARMANO (6) ran well when third at Cagnes-Sur-Mer over 2000m in a maiden event on the PSF and can score on his turf debut. His main threat looks like it could be BASQUIAT (3), who has acquitted himself well on both starts, and was a decent second in a maiden on the PSF at Marseille-Vivaux when last seen on March 9th. THE MAGPIE (7) could be a sensible option for the each-way enthusiasts to latch on to. PUPPET (10) completes the shortlist.

C3 - PRIX DE LA SAINTE-VICTOIRE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- 1. MEFIE TOI** - Ran well to be 2nd over 2000m at Marseille-Vivaux in a handicap last time out on March 4th. Outside place chance
- 2. HEPBURN** - Fair 5th last time, a win before that over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a maiden race on January 17th. Can win again
- 3. HERCULE STAR** - Got off the mark last time on the PSF in a maiden race on March 9th over 2600m. The drop back in trip might not be a positive
- 4. CATHERINE LA MER** - Ran well to be 3rd last time over 2000m at Marseille-Vivaux in a handicap on March 4th. Can make the top-four
- 5. PERSIANA** - Two 6th place efforts this year, the most recent over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a handicap on February 18th. Each way contender
- 6. LES PRINCES** - Four unplaced efforts so far, the latter over 2000m at this track in a maiden race on March 18th. More can be expected now trying handicap company
- 7. SCHWANGAU** - Fair 4th on the latest start over 1600m at Cavaillon in a maiden race on March 1st. Has work to do to be involved
- 8. THE BLACK VELVET** - Four placed runs from her last five starts, 2nd on the most recent over 1500m in a handicap on the PSF on March 22nd. Warrants respect
- 9. ADICCION** - 5th last time in a claimer 12 days ago, a win previously over 2000m in a claimer at Marseille-Vivaux on March 9th. Looks vulnerable
- 10. JOJO FANTASIE** - Four unplaced runs, the most recent over 2000m at Marseille-Vivaux in a handicap on March 4th. Hard to fancy
- 11. LA GRANDE JOA** - Four unplaced outings so far, the latter over 2150m in a handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a handicap on February 18th. Hard to recommend

Summary: HEPBURN (2) has been consistent and broke her maiden two runs back at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in mid-January. She acquitted herself well enough when fifth on her most recent start and is the tentative selection ahead of HERCULE STAR (3), who got off the mark on the PSF in a maiden last time out at Marseille-Vivaux on March 9th. LES PRINCES (6) has shown ability in his four runs and can have a say on his handicap debut. THE BLACK VELVET (8) completes the shortlist.

C4 - PRIX DE LA BRILLANE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 15,400

- 1. AMORE MIA** - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 3 handicap on February 15th. Ought to be thereabouts
- 2. MONSIEURVALCHOP** - Three unplaced runs of late, 8th on the latter over 1200m at this track on March 18th in a Class 4 handicap. Can bounce back to form and be involved
- 3. SHELBYLANDOR** - Several unplaced efforts of late, the most recent over 1200m at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 handicap on March 17th. Out of form and best watched
- 4. HY DREAM** - Placed 2nd last time over 1200m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th. One to pay attention to and can feature
- 5. HAARICIA** - Three unplaced runs since a win over 1100m at Chantilly on September 1st in a Class 3 handicap. Needs to bounce back to form
- 6. IDAHO JAMES** - Four unplaced efforts this year, 6th at this track in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th last time out. Place contender if back on song
- 7. NOBLE COTAI** - Five unplaced runs recently, the latter over 1400m in a Class 3 handicap at Saint-Cloud on March 5th. Little to be enthusiastic about
- 8. GO JOHNNY GO GO GO** - Two unplaced runs this year, below par over 1200m in a Class 3 handicap at Fontainebleau on March 17th when last seen. Needs to bounce back to her better form but is capable
- 9. RISKI CHOPE** - Fair 2nd over 1100m in a Class 4 handicap at Fontainebleau on March 6th when last appearing. Can have a say in the finish
- 10. BOSQUET** - Finished 5th last time out over 1500m in a Class 4 race at Marseille-Vivaux on March 22nd. Others seem better equipped
- 11. MERI SHARMA** - Three tame efforts this year, the latter over 1600m at Cavaillon on March 1st in a Class 4 race. Hard to recommend

Summary: HY DREAM (4) ran well over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap in mid-March when second and holds strong claims of going one place better. Her main danger could be RISKI CHOPE (9), who was also second on her latest start in a Class 4 handicap in early March at Fontainebleau. GO JOHNNY GO GO GO (8) is one to consider each-way and IDAHO JAMES (6) who looks best of the remainder.

C5 - PRIX DE SIMIANE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 19,200

1. SASKATOON - Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1300m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 3 handicap on February 22nd. One to keep onside

2. O'DONNELL'S ORCHARD - Not seen since a 4th over 1300m in a handicap at Deauville on August 8th, 2024. Won over track and trip in May 2024. Long absence to overcome and best watched

3. LA MANDALA - Two 2nd place efforts of late on the PSF, the latter over 1500m in a Class 3 handicap on November 12th. Won over 1400m at Compiègne last June and warrants respect

4. GALI LODGE - Finished 7th last time over 1400m at Le Mans on March 20th in a Class 3 handicap. Won over 1350m in October in a Class 4 claimer. Possibly better over a longer trip than today's journey

5. LOVER SONG - Four unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1200m at Fontainebleau in a Class 2 handicap on March 17th. Needs to be more consistent

6. MALINOVKA - Recent success over 1400m at Limoges in a Class 4 race on March 15th. Among the leading each way chances

7. SMILE FOR ME - Two placed runs recently, 4th on the latter over 1500m at Marseille-Vivaux in a Class 4 race on March 22nd. Others rate higher

8. TANIS - Recent success over 1200m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th. Capable of being competitive

9. ETERNEL - Two unplaced runs since a 4th over 1500m on February 9th in a Class 3 handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer. Looks vulnerable

10. RUMPLETEAZER - Fair effort when 3rd over track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th behind TANIS (8). One better terms she can be involved at the finish

11. STUNNING HERO - Creditable 4th on his last start over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th behind TANIS (8). Merits consideration

12. EXPERTISE - Fair 5th last time out over 1200m in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th behind TANIS (8). Can make the top four

Summary: TANIS (8) scored over the course and distance when last seen in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th by over one length and can follow up despite a weight rise. Her main danger could be RUMPLETEAZER (10), who was back in third in the same race and has almost two lengths to make up, but is non more favoured terms today. LA MANDALA (3) has been placed second on her last two starts and is the each-way must. STUNNING HERO (11) was fourth behind the main selection last time and looks best of the rest.

19,200**

- 1. KRISTAL** - Four unplaced runs so far, 5th at Cagnes-Sur-Mer when last seen in a maiden event on February 21st. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- 2. LANDMAN** - Nice debut when 4th over 1600m in a conditions race at Toulouse on March 1st. Open to improvement and can play a leading role
- 3. LEVER DE RIDEAU** - Two good 2nd place runs this year, the most recent over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 21st in a maiden race. One to pay attention to
- 4. FREEZE THE MOMENT** - Two placed runs of late, 4th on the latter over 1500m at Marseille-Vivau in a handicap on December 6th. Ought to play a lead role
- 5. CHANALI DOREE** - Finished 8th on her only run over 2000m at Angers in a maiden event on November 2nd. Needs to show vast progress to have a say
- 6. FAITH IN YOU** - Three placed runs, 2nd at this track over 2000m on the latest on March 18th. Capable of making her presence felt
- 7. RUE MADON** - Well beaten on her debut over 2000m on the PSF in a maiden race on March 4th. Unlikely to make the frame on turf debut
- 8. CHAKILYAH** - Showed ability when 6th on debut at Toulouse over 1600m on March 1st. Open to improvement and can not be ruled out of the frame
- 9. JOYPHORIA** - Two unplaced runs this year, 6th on the latter over 1500m in a maiden race at Marseille-Vivau on March 9th. Others rate higher
- 10. PURPLE DAHLIA** - Finished 6th on her sole start over 2000m at this track in a maiden race on March 18th. Should know more this time and has outside place claims
- 11. LAMIYA** - Unraced filly by Golden Horde, the dam won 1 race and was placed in a Listed race over 2000m. Half-sister to Lazzat (Group 1 winner twice and Group 3 winner) From a leading trainer that will have this filly ready to go on debut
- 12. LASTEXITTOPARADISE** - Unraced filly by Birchwood, the dam ran once. Stable runners tend to improve for a run or two and she is best watched with the future in mind

Summary: LAMIYA (11) is a half-sister to the top-class Lazzat (Double Group 1 winner and Group 3 winner twice and Listed winner). She will be expected to make a winning debut at the first time of asking by her astute trainer. LANDMAN (2) ran well on his debut when fourth and can make the selection work for success. FREEZE THE MOMENT (4) has experience and ran a nice race when fourth in a handicap recently. He is worth considering, as is LEVER DE RIDEAU (3), who heads the rest.

C7 - PRIX DU PONT DE VIVAUX - 1700m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

1. EKTORIA - Previous course and distance winner in 2025, 4th on her last start over 1500m at Marseille-Vivaux in a Class 4 race on March 22nd. Player

2. SANKA CHOP - Two nice runs recently, a win over 2000m on his penultimate at Marseille-Vivaux in a Class 4 handicap on February 16th and a 3rd over the same track/trip on March 4th. Acts on turf and can feature

3. LA HAUTE ISLE - Two unplaced runs this year, the latter over 2150m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 race on February 14th. Unlikely to be involved

4. SPIRIT GREY - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in a Class 4 handicap on March 2nd. Ought to be involved in the finish

5. POLYSPEED - Three unplaced runs this year, well beaten over 2150m in a Class 3 handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 11th last time. Pass over

6. BOOMERANG - Placed 3rd last time over 1800m at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 handicap on March 13th. Capable of making his presence felt

7. LOGIS - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 1500m in a Class 4 handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 24th, Placed form at this track last year and warrants respect

8. OLAF THE BIG ONE - Three unplaced runs recently, the latter over 2000m at Marseille-Vivaux in a Class 4 handicap on March 4th. Might need a few to misfire

9. ELUSIVE NELSON - Decent 2nd last time out over 1600m at Cavaillon in a Class 4 race on March 1st. One to look at each-way

10. SILVER SCHNOK - Two unplaced efforts of late, the most recent over 1800m in a Class 3 handicap at Fontainebleau on March 13th. Looks vulnerable

11. ROSISSIM - Three unplaced efforts this year, the latter over 2000m on the PSF in a Class 4 handicap on March 4th. Hardly inspiring

12. RED COUNTESS - Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 1500m in a Class 4 handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on February 15th. Needs to be more reliable

13. PRINCE LOS - Two unplaced runs this year, the most recent over 1600m at Chantilly in a Class 4 handicap on March 12th. One to steer clear of

Summary: SANKA CHOP (2) has been in good shape on the all-weather surface recently with a win in February and a recent third at Marseille-Vivaux in a Class 4 handicap. He is versatile and acts on turf and is given marginal preference over EKTORIA (1), who was fourth on the PSF last time but is a previous course and distance winner in May 2025. SPIRIT GREY (4) is a likely contender and is one for the each-way backers to latch on to. BOOMERANG (6) makes up the shortlist.

C8 - PRIX DU PARC BORELY - 1700m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- 1. GLAVIA** - Four unplaced runs this year, well beaten over 2000m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th. Needs to get back on track
- 2. BLANC BLEU** - Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 1500m at Marseille-Vivau in a Class 4 race on February 16th. Hard to be enthusiastic about
- 3. KENZAL** - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over 1600m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 3 handicap on February 21st. Can make the top-four
- 4. CHOP VAL** - Four unplaced runs recently, the latter over 1500m on the PSF on March 22nd in a Class 3 handicap. Turf form has been uninspiring
- 5. STUPEFIANTE** - Two 4th placed runs of late, the latter over 1800m in a Class 4 race at Lyon La Soie on March 11th. Leading chance of scoring
- 6. QUEEN SINGER** - Two unplaced runs of late, the latter over 1800m in a Class 4 handicap on March 21st on the PSF. Pass over
- 7. WHAT ELSE CHOP** - Two unplaced runs since a 2nd over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 3 handicap on February 24th. Might find this difficult
- 8. MERCI ELIE** - Two unplaced runs since a 3rd over 1500m at Marseille-Vivau in a Class 4 race on February 16th, Competitive run anticipated
- 9. MAMA IMELDA** - Two unplaced runs this year, 8th on the latter over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 3 handicap on February 24th. Looking for win number 9 and is one to keep safe
- 10. MANDOKI** - Two unplaced runs since a win over 1500m at Marseille-Vivau in a Class 4 handicap on January 5th. Course and distance winner in October 2025. Outside place contender
- 11. FUJI HANA** - Four unplaced runs this year, 5th on her latest over 2000m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on March 18th. Place chance
- 12. COME TI AMO** - Ran well to be 4th last time over 1800m at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 handicap on March 13th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 13. SLEEPY SUZY** - Three unplaced efforts since a 2nd over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 4 handicap on January 17th. Enters each-way calculations

Summary: STUPEFIANTE (5) could be the answer to this open handicap. She has shaped well to be fourth on her last two starts, the latter at Lyon La Soie in early March over 1800m in a Class 4 event. Her main threat could be MERCI ELIE (8). who has a couple of unplaced runs since finishing third at Marseille-Vivau in a Class 4 race on February 16th. COME TI AMO (12) shaped well to be fourth at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 handicap three weeks ago and can have a say in proceedings. MAMA IMELDA (9) heads the rest.
