C1 - PRIX NOBODY DE RETZ - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. JANGO BELLO** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class G at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 March. Remains barefoot but needs to do more to score
- 2. IBIS DE FRECA** - Not reliable but was fourth in a class G at this track over 2950m on 20 March. Reverts to barefoot and could score
- 3. JUDIRA DE HOUELLE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class G at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 March. Has a place chance on best form
- 4. JASMIN D'AVENIR** - Not reliable but did run third in a class G at this track over 2950m on 13 March. Can be competitive once again
- 5. JICOMTE** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in a class E mounted race at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. JASPER DU BELLAY** - Showed improvement when runner-up in a class G at this track over 2950m on 13 March. Remains barefoot and should fight it out
- 7. HIRO DE LA LUNA** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class G at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and has won over this track and trip. Consider
- 8. ICHIRO OKINA** - Unreliable but was fourth in a class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 9. HIDALGO PLANCHETTE** - On a long losing run but was barefoot and fourth in a class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 7 December. Not this time and others make more appeal
- 10. IMPEC DE BERTRANGE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F mounted race at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 22 March. Could earn some money back in a harness race
- 11. HADRIEN MERITE** - Has improved of late and was fourth in a class G at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 March. Might play a minor role

Summary: A competitive opening race. IBIS DE FRECA (2) has not been reliable but did run well at this track last month. He is barefoot this time and is capable of scoring. JASPER DU BELLAY (6) and JASMIN D'AVENIR (4) fought out the finish at this track a few weeks ago and both should be very competitive yet again. HIRO DE LA LUNA (7) is clearly better than his last run would suggest and is a course-and-distance winner who must be respected in this line-up.

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**C2 - PRIX JUSTIN FERRATGE - 2950m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €
21,000**

- 1. LYCOS CARISAIE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class F harness race at Angers over 2350m on 8 December.. Needs to do more to score
- 2. LOOPING DE MA** - Yet to win a race but was third in a class F harness race over this track and trip on 26 March. Hard to trust but might play a minor role if smart
- 3. L'IMPERATRICE** - Finished 6th in a class E mounted race at Vire over 2800m on 18 March. Very hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. LADY GODIVA** - Disqualified in a class E mounted race at Agen-le-Passage over 2750m on 9 February. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 5. MILADY CASTELETS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class E harness race over this course and distance on 26 March. Remains barefoot but needs to do more to score
- 6. MA TALOU JOLY** - Consistent and was fourth in a class E mounted race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2875m on 17 March. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish once again
- 7. LUKOMEDES** - Yet to win a race but was runner-up in a class F mounted race over this course and distance on 20 March. Threatening to score and can go one place better
- 8. LORD DU GILET** - Disqualified in a class E harness rave at this track over 2700m on 26 March. Battling to regain form and others are preferred
- 9. LIZON DES BORDES** - In good form and was runner-up in a class E mounted race at Mont-de-Marsan over 2850m on 24 March. Should be in the thick of things yet again
- 10. LILI** - Did not show her best when unplaced in a class F mounted race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2575m on 29 March. Consistent before that and can make the frame

Summary: An open-looking race. LUKOMEDES (7) is threatening to break through with a victory and has gone close in his last two starts. He can go one better this time around. MA TALOU JOLY (6) remains barefoot and is consistent. She will be in the battle for top honours. LILI (10) is capable of better than her last run and is a threat. LIZON DES BORDES (9) remains in good form and is also capable of shining brightly.

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**C3 - PRIX FRANCIS TREICH - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR €
27,000**

- 1. NOBLE AVENUE** - Disqualified in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 22 March. In good form before that and can earn some money if smart
- 2. NOBLE DE SOURCE** - Successful in a class F at Graignes over 2725m on 15 March. Improving and is quite capable of doubling up in this line-up
- 3. NAGRADO GOLD** - Has shown promise and was runner-up in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2050m on 14 February. Can go one place better
- 4. NIGHT DE BANVILLE** - In good form and was runner-up in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Can earn some more money
- 5. NARNIA PAN** - Consistent and finished third in a class C at this track over 2950m on 19 February. Can be a threat yet again
- 6. NISLANDA** - Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest in a class C at this track over 2950m on 19 February. Can bounce back to score if staying on the trot
- 7. NARRETEPAS GIO** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 8. NEED FOR LOVE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class D at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. Better this distance and is not out of it

Summary: Another competitive-looking race. NISLANDA (6) has had a couple of faults in a row but does have talent and can win a race like this if staying in stride. NOBLE DE SOURCE (2) is improving and was a good winner at Graignes, so he would not be a surprise winner. NAGRADO GOLD (3) is showing promise and should fight out the finish once again. NARNIA PAN (5) is consistent and cannot be ruled out either.

C4 - PRIX GUY DENECHERE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. MIRA D'HAVAROCHE - Unreliable but was victorious in a class E over this track and trip on 7 February. Can follow up if in the same mood

2. MISTER JENILOU - Has disqualification issues but was runner-up in a class E over this track and trip on 27 February. Has claims if smart

3. MEXICO - Disqualified in a class C at this track over 2950m on 22 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

4. MELBA DU PADOUENG - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a class E mounted race at this track over 2325m on 13 March. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance

5. MA LEA DU GUESCLIN - Unreliable and was runner-up in a class E at this track over 2950m on 26 March. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money

6. MAYA DES BAUX - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class D at this track over 2950m on 26 March. More is needed to beat these rivals

7. MONA LISA STARDUST - Holding form and finished fourth in a class E at this track over 2950m on 26 March. Remains barefoot and can make the frame

8. MARLEY QUICK - Yet to win a race but finished third in a class E over this course and distance on 27 February. Can contest the finish

9. MERVEILLE DAB - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2950m on 26 March. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to win

10. MILTON BROWN - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2950m on 26 March. Remains barefoot but is battling to find best form and others are preferred

Summary: MISTER JENILOU (2) is not one to trust entirely. He did, however, run very well over this track and trip in February and can score if staying on the trot. MARLEY QUICK (8) has yet to win a race and is not reliable but is quite capable of beating these rivals if applying his mind. MIRA D'HAVAROCHE (1) arrives for this after a course-and-distance victory and must be respected for that. MONA LISA STARDUST (7) remains barefoot and is capable of making the frame.

C5 - PRIX FAN IDOLE - 2950m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. MALICE D'ATOUT** - Has won all three of her starts this year since going barefoot, the latest in a Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Remains without shoes and can add another win to her tally
- 2. MONTENEGRO** - Disqualified in his last four starts, the latest over this course and distance on 26 March. Hard to trust but can make the frame when smart
- 3. MOON STAR** - Unreliable and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2100m on 3 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 4. MAD DREAM** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class D over this course and distance on 26 March. Can earn some more money
- 5. MISTRAL DE LOISEL** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in Class D over this track and trip on 26 March. Has yet to win a race but is not out of it
- 6. MIKADO PIEMONT** - Victorious in two of his last three starts, including last time out in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2675m on 9 February. Can follow up
- 7. MISTER DU CHOQUEL** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. MAGICAL** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 16 February. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 9. MANGO PAULO** - Has improved of late and was victorious in Class B at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 14 February. Could be a threat once again

Summary: MALICE D'ATOUT (1) is unbeaten in three starts since going barefoot and should make a bold bid for more success. MIKADO PIEMONT (6) is improving, and his last win suggested there are more victories in his tank. An obvious danger. MISTRAL DE LOISEL (5) has hit the crossbar twice in a row and is another to consider. MANGO PAULO (9) is yet another in fine form but does give 25m, so the others may have the edge this time.

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C6 - PRIX ARIBO MIX - 2950m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. LE BEAU FOXGLEN** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class E at Agen-La Garenne over 2625m on 3 March. Should contest the finish once again
- 2. LOVE ME TRUE** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out at Agen-La Garenne over 2650m on 3 March. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. LOUISDOR DECHAMBOU** - Did not show his best when unplaced in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 27 March. Some good wins before that and is not out of it
- 4. LUKE SKYWALKER** - Faulted last time out in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2675m on 8 February. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 5. LORD DE BANVILLE** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out in a claimer at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 February. Might play a minor role when smart
- 6. L'AVENIR** - Not reliable but was also not disgraced when fourth in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 24 March. Could earn some more money
- 7. LUTECIA ELLIS** - In very good form and was runner-up in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2675m on 8 February. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 8. LORKY RED** - At the top of his game with three wins in his last five starts, including last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 26 March. Can score again
- 9. L'AMIRAL DIGEO** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2675m on 7 March. Fitter now and should contest the finish
- 10. LE MAESTRO** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 February. Should be a threat to these rivals

Summary: A competitive race. Benjamin Goetz has a decent hand. LORKY RED (8) finished behind stable companion LUTECIA ELLIS (7) last time out. LORKY RED (8) is the more reliable of the two, though, and he does know how to win races, so gets the vote to score. LUTECIA ELLIS (7) remains in good form and will not go down easily. L'AMIRAL DIGEO (9) needed the last run and should do better this time around. LE BEAU FOXGLEN (1) is hard to trust but can make the frame when smart.

C7 - PRIX JEALON - 2950m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 25,000

1. **JAPAN GIRL** - Off form and finished 12th in class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 19 December when barefoot. Not this time and could need this run returning from a break
2. **JIKA SAUTONNE** - Off form and finished 11th in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 March. Unreliable and others are preferred
3. **JIM JOY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 February. More is needed to score
4. **JASON FAC** - In good shape and finished 3rd in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Victorious in February and is not out of it
5. **JOKER CARISAIE** - Disqualified in four of late five starts, the latest in class F at this track over 2750m on 31 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
6. **JURQUES** - Not disgraced when 5th in class G at Auch over 1700m on 8 March. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
7. **JUST A SONG** - Finished 8th in class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 November when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
8. **JASMIN BLEU** - Victorious in Class G at Toulouse over 2950m on 26 March. At the top of his game and is capable of following up
9. **JAVA DE CAPONET** - Disqualified in class F at this track over 2750m on 26 March. On a long losing streak and needs to improve to win
10. **JOY DU RIF** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class E at Machecoul over 2700m on 1 February. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now
11. **JIRENS DUEM** - A bit unreliable and finished 6th in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Barefoot and capable of striking a victory
12. **JOIE DE BERTRANGE** - Showed some improvement and was 4th in class F at this course over 2750m on 26 March. Victorious back in January and can contest the finish
13. **JUVENTUS** - Did not show her best when 9th in class G mounted race at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 28 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
14. **JAGUAR DU LONDEL** - Disqualified in class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 3 March. Not reliable but can be a threat on best form
15. **JEUNE ORANGE COTON** - Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 21 March. Races without shoes this time and can bounce back to score if smart

Summary: JEUNE ORANGE COTON (15) fluffed his lines with a fault at Vincennes last month. He races without shoes this time around and can bounce back to success. JASMIN BLEU (8) remains in very good form and is an obvious danger to these rivals. JIRENS DUEM (11) is unreliable but is barefoot for the very first time, so must be respected. JAGUAR DU LONDEL (14) is unreliable but is also capable of scoring in this division.

C8 - GRAND PRIX CARAT WILLIAMS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 39,000

- 1. FOX PAPA TANGO** - Not reliable and finished 12th in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. IDEFIX DE CENTULE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 November. Returns from a break but can make the frame if fit enough
- 3. HALL BLACK MESS** - Did not show his best when 8th in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 27 March. Did better with this shoeing before that and has a place chance
- 4. HERMES EXPRESS** - Only moderate of late and finished 7th in class C at Enghien over 2250m on 24 March. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 5. INFINIMENT CITRON** - Finished 10th in class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 21 March. Capable of doing much better and has claims in an open race
- 6. IES WE KAN** - Finished 11th in Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 20 February. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 7. HERMES ANGEL** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 January. Has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 8. HERODE DU CORTA** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up in class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 20 February. Should fight out the finish again
- 9. HAMIGO** - Unreliable and finished 12th in class D at Laval over 2850m on 28 March. Capable of contesting the finish
- 10. INSTINCT SAINT BAR** - Victorious in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 26 February. Has shown improvement and keeps that showing. Must be respected for that
- 11. HYDROMEL** - Disqualified in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 March. On a long losing streak and needs to improve to score
- 12. HEYDAY** - Finished 3rd in class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 13 December. Returns from a break but is capable of earning some more money

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race. INFINIMENT CITRON (5) ran better than his finishing position suggests at Vincennes last month. He has claims over this longer distance. HERODE DU CORTA (8) has been very competitive of late and can challenge for top honours yet again. HAMIGO (9) is unreliable but could be a threat based on his good penultimate start performance. IDEFIX DE CENTULE (2) is returning from a break but can make the frame if fit enough.
