- **1. LOUNA CHIC -** Took some time to come to hand but pleasant 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2025m Paray-le-Monial Class G last month. Is clearly in top shape and can pick up a cheque
- **2. LOLA LOULOU -** Qualified in 1'18"1 at Feurs last month before coming 2nd on debut in a 2100m Class F here 3 weeks ago. Has significantly more to give and looks solid
- **3. LOVE KILLS -** By no means disgraced when 4th of 5 finishers in a 2850m Class F here mid-April, following 3 straight sanctions. Is better than most here and, on good behaviour, can get off the mark
- **4. LORENZO GRIFF -** Faulted in a 2850m Class F here 2 last month after having come 5th to LUCKY CYNASOSO (8) earlier in the month. Serge Peltier has maintained faith though and will legitimately endeavour to erase his recent sanction
- **5. LUCKY ARCTIC -** Drops back in category after finishing last of 8 in a 3000m Marseille-Borély Class D. Front pads fitted but still not an obvious choice
- **6. LOUISIANE DES PINS -** Pleased at Saint-Galmier before faulting over 2850m here midmonth. Not the best horse in the field but can get a look-in if Jean-Christophe Sorel keeps her out of trouble
- **7. LUCKY CYNASOSO -** Progressive colt that finished a valiant 3rd of 8 in a similar event here on 2 April. Handed a wide draw but, with David Békaert reining, will be afforded every chance
- **8. LYNE TENSAU -** Pleased at Feurs before enduring some misfortune when 9th of 11 in a 2525m Cavaillon Class E on 9 April. Has the inside line here and, while not a priority, is still worth retaining
- **9. LEWIS GALAA -** Quickly sanctioned in a 2850m Class F here last month but nevertheless showed his form. Starts on the back row but still looks competitively well-in
- **10. LANAE DE CONROS -** Third in class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 27 April. Needs to show improvement in a race like this
- **11. LADY DRY -** Surprise 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2850m Class F here last month but a repeat looks decidedly unlikely
- **12. LEGENDE DU BUGEY -** Disqualified in class F at LIsle-sur-Sorgue over 2650m on 27 April. Needs to show significant progress to feature
- **13. LE CONQUISTADOR -** 4th of 9, on debut, in a 2025m Avignon Class G on 10 April, after having qualified well last season. On the back line but is fitted with front pads and should not be ignored
- **14. LIBERTY DE NERET -** Solid 3rd on debut before faulting in 15 April race of reference, when well-supported. Forced to start on the 2nd row but will not be far from the action if she can stay in stride

Summary: A good second at this track first time out, LOLA LOULOU (2) has always been well esteemed by her connections and can go off the mark this time around. LE CONQUISTADOR (13) was a game 4th on debut on turf and could show a different figure on his debut on a sand track. LOVE KILLS (3) reassured last time out here and in similar mood can get involved again. LIBERTY DE NERET (14) was well supported on debut and is worth another chance.

- **3. ILE DU SABLIER -** Modest individual that came 7th of 11 in a 2825m Lignières Class F 2 weeks ago and looks thoroughly outclassed
- **4. ISLANDE ELDE -** Switches back to the monté discipline after flopping in a 2825m Lignières harness Class F mid-month. Has previously placed under the saddle here but others still preferred

- 2. JULIE DU NORD Won at La Capelle late-March before faulting in a 2800m Strasbourg Class G a week later and will struggle to make her mark
- **3. JAZZY VET -** Showed early promise but went off the boil some time ago and is hard to recommend after a modest comeback outing (9th) over 2650m at Carpentras on 25 April. Others preferred
- **4. JAZZY MUSIC -** Sanctioned in both starts this year, most recently a 2600m Class G here 3 weeks ago. Front pads fitted but can still expect to have few friends
- 5. JAHIKA Unremarkable mare that came 5th to JIPSY ROYALE (10) in a 2850m Lignières claimer a fortnight ago but still has a lot more to find
- **6. JUNE DE L'ORGUE -** Totally out of the picture in all 4 starts this year, latterly sanctioned in a 2650m Saint-Galmier Class F, and can be written off
- **7. JESSIE DU HAUTVENT -** Showed marked improvement when 3rd of 10 in a 2650m Saint-Galmier Class F last month and, barefoot this time, will be worth monitoring
- **8. JAZZY TOUCH -** One of the more complicated elements here but has some ability. Sanctioned in a 2600m Class G here last month but it is only a question of time before she comes good again
- **9. JONCQUIERE -** Won over 2000m here before losing her action in a 2650m Class F at L'Islesur-la-Sorgue, when full of running, but with application, can set the record straight

- **3. ILTON DE BELLANDE -** Hardy element dropping in category after trotting 5th of 9 in a 2850m Vincennes Class E last month. Forced to start wide on the 2nd line but will still have his chances
- **4. GASTON DE SAUZETTE -** Pulled up in a 2675m amateurs Class G at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne last Month and backs up with limited aspirations
- **5. HESTIA DU COMTAL -** Sanctioned early in a 2700m Class F at Lyon-La Soie on 10 April and is unlikely to generate much interest
- **6. IDEE SHANNON -** Returns to the professional ranks after winning a 2050m Saint-Galmier amateurs Class G last month but chances more limited this time around
- **7. GRAAL DE MY -** 5th of 10 in a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class F on 10 April. Is barefoot this time but has no particular love for Parilly and is unlikely to create any waves
- **8. HOUSTON TEXAS -** Makes his first appearance since being sanctioned in a 2925m Cagnes Class E mid-February. Will be fresh and can play a leading role if Nicolas Ensch keeps him focused
- **9. HISTRIO -** Surprise 5th of 9 behind IDEE SHANNON (1) in a 2050m Saint-Galmier amateurs Class G last month but a repeat seems improbable

- **3. GORDON FLASH -** Pleasant 5th of 12 in a 3000m Marseille-Borély Class D on 17 April. Nicely drawn but nevertheless faces a tough task
- **4. HAUT BRION -** Last of 10 when preparing for this in a 2525m Cavaillon Class D last month, but goes barefoot this time, is ideally placed on the first row, and has never disappointed here. Chance
- **5. GEPETTO DE GODREL -** Won at Cagnes earlier in the year but lacklustre in 5 since, most recently 8th of 9 in a 2650m Carpentras Class A mid-month, and is unlikely to be rocking any boat any time soon
