- **2. CORTEZ BANK -** Nice run when 4th at this track two runs ago over 2000m in a Class2 handicap on February 27th. In the mix
- **3. ROYAL RIGHT -** 4th two runs back over 1900m in a Class 2 handicap at Chantilly on March 14th. One to pay attention too
- **4. BLACK FALCON -** Unplaced last time, won before that over 2000m on the PSF on April 12th. One to keep safe

BLACK FALCON (4) won two starts ago on the PSF but is also effective on grass. MUELHEIMER PERLE (5) is a previous course winner and can not be discounted.

- **4. VICTORY STREET -** Fair 3rd on debut in a claimer over 1000m on April 6th. Should improve and make an impact
