C1 - PRIX DES ABYSSES - 3000m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 31,000

- 1. LIGHTNING RIVER** - Returned from a break and finished 7th in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Fitter this time but others are preferred
- 2. LA LIFE** - Finished fourth in a class E at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 13 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 3. LASKA DU LIVIER** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 4. L'AMBASSADEUR** - Has struggled this year and finished 10th in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Needs major improvement to win
- 5. LIBERTY DU MORTIER** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E over this course and distance on 17 April. Remains barefoot but needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 6. LOMBARDO DE LOU** - Finished 7th in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. LOGAN JIEL** - Finished 6th in a class B over this track and trip on 15 May. Remains barefoot but needs to do a bit more to score
- 8. LUCIFERMORNINGSTAR** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a class C over this course and distance on 29 April. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
- 9. LOVER MAUZUN** - A bit of a disappointment when third in a class C over this course and distance on 29 April. Has claims in this line-up
- 10. LIZZY DE JOUDES** - In good form and was runner-up in a class B at Vichy over 2150m on 11 May. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
- 11. LEVER DU JOAMAX** - Did not show his best when 9th in a class B over this course and distance on 15 May. Can do better and is not out of it
- 12. LORD DE LOIRON** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class B over this track and trip on 15 May. Capable of better and could contest the finish

Summary: An open looking first race. LOVER MAUZUN (9), now with two runs under his belt should be ready for big performance. LORD DE LOIRON (12), judged on his penultimate start, can fight out the finish. LEVER DU JOAMAX (11), can be expected to improve after a needed comeback run so look set to fight out the finish. In top form at present, LIZZY DE JOUDES (10) also has the ability to play a leading role as well.

C2 - PRIX CASTAGNOLLE - 3000m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 25,000

1. **KYOHA** - Finished 8th in a class F at Bihorel-les-Rouen over 2500m on 12 October. Remains barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
2. **KLYDE DU PUY** - Disqualified in a class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. Reverts to barefoot and could make the frame if staying in stride
3. **KEPI DES MONTS** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class H at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of an upset
4. **KING GIORGIO** - Disqualified in a class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 May. Clearly unreliable but has a place chance on best form
5. **JULIANDER** - Finished fourth in a class H at Avignon over 2675m on 24 May. Remains barefoot and showed improvement. Can earn some money
6. **JEZABEL DE LORGERE** - Has needed both starts this year and was 10th in a class G at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 30 May. Others make more appeal
7. **KIYOUNI** - Needed his only run of the year when 9th in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 14 April. Reverts to barefoot and could contest the finish
8. **KLIC JULRY** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class G at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
9. **IGOR D'URZY** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class G at this track over 2300m on 7 May. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
10. **ICARE DES CHAMPS** - Disqualified in a class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
11. **INES DE MAJEAN** - Disqualified in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Very unreliable but has a place chance when staying in stride
12. **KABRIEL** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class D at this track over 2300m on 15 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
13. **KAPITANO DREAM** - Successful twice in his last three starts, including last time out in a class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 May. Remains barefoot and can score again
14. **JALISCO DE NEUVY** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class G at this track over 2300m on 7 May. Remains barefoot but can earn some money when smart
15. **KOUGAR DE SIMM** - In good shape and finished third in a class D at this track over 2300m on 15 May. Can be competitive in this line-up
16. **KING FROMENTRO** - Victorious in a class D at this track over 2300m on 15 May. Not easy to trust but is capable of doubling up

Summary: Successful in his first start for his new yard, which was at this track, KING FROMENTRO (16) looks capable of following up. An easy winner at Hyères last time, KAPITANO DREAM (13) rates the main danger. Fully barefoot, the tricky KLYDE DU PUY (2) and KIYOUNI (7) will give their running from the front line. KLYDE DU PUY (2) arrivers for this after a fault but is barefoot thsi time. KIYOUNI (7) will strip fitter after a fair comeback performance.

C3 - PRIX GRONDIN VOLANT - 3000m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **JOKER JOLI** - Disqualified in a class E at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 13 February. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing run and others are preferred
2. **INUIITS D'EM** - Needed the last run when nplaced in a class H at Oraison over 2650m on 8 May. Needs major improvement to score
3. **JORDANA** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 27 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
4. **JOKER BODENSEE** - Disqualified last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Hard to trust but has a place chance if staying in stride
5. **JUSTIFY MY LOVE** - Disqualified in a class F at this track over 3000m on 15 May. On a long losing run and others are preferred
6. **HOUSTON D'ARIANE** - Finished 6th in a class F over this course and distance on 15 May. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role at very best
7. **IMBRIN BUROIS** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
8. **JAZZISSIME** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class E over this track and trip on 7 May. Can earn some money
9. **JINGALO BABEL** - Disqualified in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Had some fair form before that and could be competitive if smart
10. **HAYRTON MAGIC** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
11. **IZARA DE VIETTE** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class E over this course and distance on 7 May. Has a place chance on best form
12. **JET DES PRES** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Capable of making the frame
13. **ILLICO DU BISET** - Finished 6th in a class E at this track over 2300m on 7 May. Remains barefoot and could be a threat to these rivals
14. **JARDIN DU ROI** - Has won his last five starts, the latest in a class F over this track and trip on 15 May. Remains barefoot and can add another win to the tally
15. **HOUSTON PEJI** - Finished 8th in a class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 27 May. Needed that run and will be fitter this time but others make more appeal

Summary: Victorious in his last five starts, JARDIN DU ROI (14) looks the one they all have to beat in this line-up. JET DES PRES (12), this time racing without his hind shoes, can give him most to think about. ILLICO DU BISET (13), back in a more suitable grade is capable of egtting involved with the finish. JINGALO BABEL (9), judged on his penultimate run is also capable of getting into the mix of things this time around.

C4 - PRIX DES POSIDONIES - 3000m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 53,000

1. **ILLUSTRE FERM** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
2. **HORTINO** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a class E at Montauban over 2400m on 25 May. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing run. Might place
3. **IMPERATRICE VITELA** - in good shape and was runner-up in a class D at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
4. **GOLO KANTE** - A winner of a Mounted class D over this course and distance on 29 April. Better in that discipline and others are preferred
5. **IBROX PARK** - In good shape and was third in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 April. Might play a minor role at very best
6. **HAUTBRION COLMI** - Unreliable but was fourth in a class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 15 May. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of an upset
7. **IRU FUSHI** - Needed the last run when 7th in a class B over this track and trip on 15 May. Reverts to barefoot and could score
8. **INGRID TURGOT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class C at this track over 2300m on 7 May. Remains barefoot but needs major improvement to score
9. **HECTOR DE BASSIERE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class C at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Fitter this time and can get involved with the finish
10. **GABY DES VALS** - Finished 10th in a class D at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 October. Could need this run returning from a break
11. **GYS** - Battling to find best form and finished 10th in a class B over this track and trip on 15 May. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
12. **GREZ** - Not reliable but finished fourth in a class B over this course and distance on 15 May. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
13. **GRAND TRIO LUDOIS** - Finished fifth in a class A at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Not reliable but can get into the mix of things
14. **HARLEM DE BUCY** - Finished 7th in a class A at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Needed that run and could strip fitter this time. Has a place chance
15. **FLOREAL** - Disqualified in a class A at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Not easy to trust but can make the frame when staying in stride
16. **INATO PIERJI** - In good form and finished third in a class A at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Should be right there at the finish once again

Summary: Presented barefoot after two runs to regain fitness, IRU FUSHI (7) will try to hold off INATO PIERJI (16), who this time does not have to concede 50 metres. HECTOR DE BASSIERE (9), did not enjoy the best of runs last time, can play a leading role here. FLOREAL (15), judged on his penultimate effort is one of many more runners in this race that can get involved with the finish and must be respected.

C5 - PRIX ANGE DE MER - 3000m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MONT VENTOUX** - Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in Class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 9 May. Should be a threat to these rivals
2. **MIKE DES CARREAUX** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Might need to do more to score
3. **MERALAIMPER** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
4. **MONEY SIXTY ONE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class F at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Did better with this shoeing before that and is a lively danger
5. **MISTER DES THUYAS** - Has yet to win a race but was barefoot and 5th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 20 February. Not barefoot this time and could need this run
6. **MON BEAU MEC** - Disqualified last time at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Capable of better and might play a minor role if smart
7. **MAFIOSO DRY** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Should contest the finish once again
8. **MASSIMO** - Yet to win a race and finished 7th in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame
9. **MYSTERE TURGOT** - Faulted last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Not reliable but remains barefoot and can bounce back to score
10. **MIRACLE DE CAPONET** - Disqualified last time out at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Has disqualification issues but is also not out of it
11. **MERKEL DE CURBINS** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 8 April. Capable of an upset on best form
12. **MAKEMYDAY** - In good shape and finished third in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Can be competitive in this line-up

Summary: Very unlucky last time, MYSTERE TURGOT (9) looks capable of setting the record straight, with Théo Briand in the sulky. If they keep their manners, MASSIMO (8) and MAKEMYDAY (12) have the ability to fight for top honours over this course and distance. MASSIMO (8) has yet to win but must be respected. MAKEMYDAY (12) has been in good form of late. Consistent since racing in the South-East, MAFIOSO DRY (7) can play a prominent role.

C6 - PRIX PASTENAGUE - 3000m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MAGALI DU CHERISAY** - Disqualified in her last six starts, the latest at Alencon over 2650m on 10 May. Very hard to trust and others are preferred
2. **MIGNONNE DE PLAY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Cabourg over 2650m on 16 December. Could need this run returning from a break
3. **MIRIANA DE BRAYE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Has disqualification issues but is capable of earning some money when smart
4. **MIRACLE GIRL** - Did not show her best when 7th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Capable of better and could play a minor role
5. **MILADY DE NIMES** - Has struggled of late and finished tenth in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 25 April. More is needed to score
6. **MELODIE FAVORITE** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Hard to trust but can be a lively danger on best form
7. **MISSION ROYALE** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class E at this course over 2300m on 29 April. Yet to win a race but can get involved in the finish once again
8. **MESANGE DU PLESSIS** - Remains in good shape and finished fourth in Class F at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Can make the frame
9. **MADISON DE JOUDES** - Showed some improvement when third in Class E at Lyon over 2000m on 26 April. Can be a threat to these rivals
10. **MARBELLA DREAM** - Yet to win a race and faulted last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
11. **MIA DE MALIKEN** - Not reliable and was 6th in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Capable of bouncing back to win

Summary: MIA DE MALIKEN (11) did not enjoy the best of runs last time. With better luck in running she has the turn of foot to finish strongly and settle matters. MADISON DE JOUDES (9), in good form, and the consistent MISSION ROYALE (7) both have solid claims. If she keeps her action together, MELODIE FAVORITE (6) has disqualification issues but can be a threat when staying on the trot and must be respected at this level.

C7 - PRIX MEDITERRANEE - 3000m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. NOLANN DES AGETS** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 27 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. NIXON DE BLARY** - Successful last time out in a Class E at this course over 2400m on 24 April. Consistent and is capable of doubling up
- 3. NEMO DES BROUETS** - Yet to win a race and finished 6th in Class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Might play a minor role
- 4. NEW YORK YANKEES** - Shows promise and has won twice in just three starts, including last time out in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Can score again
- 5. NORIA DE BERTRANGE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 9th in Class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. NARRATRICE** - Improving and was victorious last time out in Class C at Hyeres over 2850m on 27 May. Capable of following up
- 7. NEW BABY DOLLAR** - Returned from a break with a solid victory in Class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Should challenge for top honours if smart again
- 8. NOT ALONE** - Disqualified last time out at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2575m on 23 May. Capable of better but others are preferred

Summary: An interesting race with some promising sorts. Successful in three of her first four starts, NEW BABY DOLLAR (7) has only the switch to a left-handed track to contend with. NIXON DE BLARY (2), an impressive winner at this course last time, and NARRATRICE (6), flawless since her debut, look the most likely to pose a threat. Beaten by the latter on his only defeat, NEW YORK YANKEES (4) will be ready to capitalise on any slip ups from those three runners.

C8 - PRIX DE LA SARDINE QUI ... - 3000m (a2m) - Class G - Mounted - EUR € 25,000

- 1. LUTTE DU LOGIS** - Disqualified last time out at Châtillon-sur-Chalarnonne over 2675m on 25 May. Did much better in her penultimate start but is on a long losing run
- 2. KALYPSO DE CHOC** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class H harness race at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. LISTAO** - Consistent and finished fourth in a Class E harness race at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Better under the saddle and can bounce back to score
- 4. KA DANSE FOLLE** - Returned to form and was third in a Class F mounted race at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 5. LIOUBA JAMES** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Others make more appeal
- 6. LE ROI MARGOT** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class F mounted race at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 21 May. Can complete the hat-trick
- 7. KISS D'EREVAN** - Usually competitive and was runner-up in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 7 May. Capable of making the frame
- 8. KAICHA** - Disqualified five times in a row, the latest at this course on 7 May. Hard to trust and others are much preferred
- 9. KING'S DAY** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at this course over 2300m on 15 May. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 10. JADORE JULRY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track over 2300m on 15 May. Capable of a surprise on best form
- 11. LEOPOLD** - Has lost his way and finished tenth in a Class B harness race over this course and distance on 15 May. Capable of improvement trying a mounted race

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race. A chance can be taken with LEOPOLD (11), who looks well suited to the mounted discipline. Preference is then for the 7 May form over this course, where KISS D'EREVAN (7) and KING'S DAY (9) finished second and third respectively. They can both be lively dangers. Unbeaten in two starts under the saddle, LISTAO (3) will give his running from the front and is clearly not out of it in this line-up.
