C1 - PRIX D'ECQUEMAUVILLE - 2500m (a1 9/16m) - TURF - Divised Handicap - Class 3 - Flat - EUR € 27.000

- **1. LA ROSELIERE -** Returned from a lengthy layoff to win at Erbay on her reappearance and could have more to offer with improved fitness on her side. Follow
- **2. RAINBOW WARRIOR -** Inconsistent though not incapable of staking a claim in a race of this nature. Booking of Théo Bachelot is encouraging
- **3. PUTUMAYO -** Rejuvenated veteran enjoying an incredible run of form, winning his last two starts. Capable of having a say again
- **4. OLYMPIC DREAM -** Showed signs of improvement last time (5th) but that was in a claiming race. Required to do more back in a handicap
- **5. AUENWOLF -** Won consecutive outings prior to his last two starts, which have been less effective. Needs to do more at this value to get involved
- **6. MODERN VALUE -** Belatedly opened her account last time (16th start) after finishing 2nd in 10 previous outings. Raised 2,5kg but remains competitive
- **7. SITUMELEDEMANDAIS -** Finished a reassuring 4th in the reference race last time and ought to make his presence felt if confirming that improvement
- **8. SAKURACHAN -** Made a winning start to the year on her reappearance in May and held her own in both starts since. Upset potential
- **9. LETTYT FIGHT -** Unreliable sort but quite capable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature. Has only a place chance
- 10. CHELSEA DU NINIAN A regular performer at this level with solid form references and another consistent showing can be expected. Respect
- **11. AHA -** Finished runner-up behind MODERN VALUE (6) last time and should again have a role to play here. Keep safe
- **12. KER STORMY -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **13. WEST MARTIN** Changed his fortunes switched from hurdling to the flat recently but has only a minor role to play here. Outsider
- **14. SAAM -** Confirmed the improvement of his previous start by finishing 3rd last time. Gets on well with Léa Bails (1,5kg allowance) so has claims
- **15. PORT AU PRINCE -** Has nothing noteworthy to his name for a considerable period so can be ruled out here. For another day
- **16. BREATH OF FIRE -** Has looked rather ordinary for some time so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore

Summary: LA ROSELIERE (1) made light of a seven-month absence and her opposition when making a winning comeback at Erbray last month and on that evidence seems capable of fighting for victory back in a handicap. Rewarded for her consistency last time after several near misses, MODERN VALUE (6) ought to remain competitive and is likely to pose a threat despite a 2,5kg penalty. AHA (11) and SAAM (14), after finishing 2nd and 3rd respectively in the reference race, are capable of playing leading roles too. RAINBOW WARRIOR (2), SITUMELEDEMANDAIS (7) and rejuvenated veteran PUTUMAYO (3) are not without chances either.

C2 - PRIX DE L'EURE - 1400m (a7f) - ALL WEATHER - Condition Race - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 28.000

- **1. MAJOR OAK -** Debut winner on PSF in October but without a win in seven subsequent outings, though has maintained a good level of form and consistency. Outsider
- **2. SOCIETY MAN -** Finished 2nd and ahead of re-opposing MAKE ME KING (3) last time, so has solid claims here on that form. Keep safe
- **3. MAKE ME KING -** Showed promise last year and, while not disgraced on his comeback (3rd), was expected to do better. Should have more to offer
- **4. SOUS LA NEIGE -** Unexposed colt who revealed serious means last year. Absent since winning on PSF back in December but dangerous to dismiss
- **5. LIWA OASIS -** Improving last-start winner who would've gained confidence from that maiden victory and is open to further progress. Respect
- **6. SUNDAY FUDGE -** Has looked rather limited to this point so her chances here are easily overlooked even at this level. Ignore
- **7. WHISPERING DREAM -** Beat a decent field at Kempton before relocating and made a winning reappearance on turf in her first start on French soil. Follow
- **8. AXDALIVA -** Sparked some improvement to finish 2nd last time and could get a look in if confirming that form. Dark horse
- **9. MONTJICA -** Has improved with each outing this year and confirmed as much by winning recently. Could have a role to play here too

Summary: WHISPERING DREAM (7) made an encouraging start to her career in England and went some way to confirming that promise by making a winning reappearance in her first start on French soil at Saint-Malo last time, and is more than capable of continuing progression with another victory here. MAKE ME KING (3) is likely to improve after a pleasing comeback outing (3rd), so appears the chief threat. SOCIETY MAN (2) caught the eye last time when finishing 2nd at Saint-Cloud and is also capable of staking a claim. LIWA OASIS (5) is another to consider.

C3 - PRIX DE BARNEVILLE - 2500m (a1 9/16m) - TURF - Divised Handicap - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 53.000

- **1. MONSIEUR XOO -** A regular last winter and dual winner of Quinté+ events. Made a quiet return last month after a four-month absence and ought to improve but soft ground is likely to scupper his chances
- 2. SIR GEORGE Has bounced back to form recently over 2800m and is unlikely to be inconvenienced by this shorter distance. Has a role to play
- **3. SALOCIN -** In full possession of means and quickly making up for lost time, winning 5 of his last 6 starts including one at this level. Up another 3kg and soft ground will not be to his liking either
- **4. MYKISS -** Has been unable to shine in handicaps off a mark greater than 36.5 so unlikely to have a say here given his current rating (39.5). That said, the ground will be to his liking
- **5. WOOT CITY -** Last-start winner of a similar contest back in May, having joined Fabrice Chappet ahead of the spring. Has regained freshness and is likely to remain competitive despite a 4kg penalty
- **6. STALLONE** Was declared a non-runner twice in June but has, interestingly, been supplemented to take part in this Quinté+ and very soft ground will serve his interests. Beware
- **7. SRIFANELOGREEN -** Well-related sort with solid form references, including a win and four places in seven outings in Quinté+ races. Will be a factor with soft ground to suit
- **8. WOODSTONE -** Disappointed at Saint-Cloud last time when a well-beaten favourite but shouldn't be written off just yet. Remains capable of better eased 1kg
- **9. NO MORE BOLERO -** Confirmed the improvement of his previous start (victory) by winning a recent claiming race. Starts in the handicaps with some interesting references, so is likely to tempt thrill seekers
- **10. AFTER THE RAIN -** Godolphin filly who was an unlucky 9th in a similar event last time and remains capable of a lot better. Soft ground and this longer trip will serve her interests
- **11. LORNE -** Made a winning comeback after six months out and seems capable of acquitting herself well at this level off her current mark. Keep safe
- **12. SANTURIN -** Has returned to his best recently, judged on the evidence of his last two starts at this level. Confirmed at this value but would probably prefer a firmer track
- **13. DARY CI -** Tried her luck in two similar events for females and is now pitched against male opposition too with her task made complicated by a wide No 15 gate. Outsider
- **14. BADEN ROCKS -** Was returning from a seven-month absence last time and ran a better race than his finishing position (7th) suggests. Ought to do better with improved fitness on his side
- **15. GLACIER PEAK -** Absent since February and has recently joined Marian-Falk Weissmeier's stable. Has some references on soft ground but is probably most effective on the fibresand. Watch for now
- **16. LA TEMPLIERE -** Rewarded for her consistency with a last-start success at Compiègne, but would've probably preferred a longer distance though a soft track will be to her liking. Dark horse

Summary: After an encouraging start to his career over in England, AFTER THE RAIN (10) made a winning introduction on French soil back in March but has been somewhat disappointing since. She was, however, unlucky not to have finished closer last time in a similar event at ParisLongchamp and remains quite capable of finding her way at this level, so is given the nod in a typically competitive Quinte+ contest. SRIFANELOGREEN (7), who will benefit from the very soft ground, heads the challengers ahead of WOOT CITY (5), effective racing fresh after a break, and LORNE (11) who won imperiously on his reappearance. SIR GEORGE (2) is in good form and ought to make his presence felt too. WOODSTONE (8), whose recent failure is best ignored, and SANTURIN (12) are capable of getting into the picture too. LA TEMPLIERE (16) completes the shortlist under a 2,5kg penalty for a recent win.

C4 - PRIX DE PERSEIGNE - 1900m (a1 3/16m) - ALL WEATHER - Divised Handicap - Flat - EUR € 25.000

- **1. GUITRY -** Maintaining a solid level of form and consistency, so should take an active part at the finish. Big runner
- **2. NEVADO -** Unreliable but is not incapable of getting into the picture in a race of nature from gate No 1. Dangerous to dismiss
- **3. ZELZEFYR -** Finished a reassuring 3rd in his last start and is likely to play a leading role here if confirming that improvement
- **4. BLACK HILLS -** Has been struggling for some time now and is unlikely to trouble the judge here, so is best to overlook
- **5. OASIS BAY -** Undeniably capable but not the most reliable. Was a disappointing 8th last time so will need to reaffirm
- **6. ALCOTAN -** At the top of his game at present and on current form is likely to give this another good go. High on the shortlist
- **7. HIGHLAND ARCHER -** Finished a pleasing 5th on handicap debut last time and with any improvement should fight for victory
- **8. ONE TIME BED -** Nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period now and can be ruled out. Others preferred
- **9. APODICTIQUE -** Unreliable but is seldom far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is not easily ruled out either
- **10. SWAG GIRL -** Inconsistent and out of sorts lately, and those struggles look set to continue here. Not likely to trouble the judge
- **11. TROPEIRA -** Lightly raced filly with scope to improve, so could get into the picture from a favourable No 4 gate. Beware
- **12. VULCANIO -** Returned to form last time with a reassuring 2nd and is likely to be prominent in the finish if confirming that improvement here
- **13. TISSEUSE DE REVES -** Reassured by winning last time and will be competitive if confirming that improvement. The booking of Mickaël Barzalona bodes well
- **14. MISTER GOKEN -** Has shown signs of improvement recently and could have more to offer on her debut in this category. Keep safe
- **15. QWENKALY -** Must not be condemned for a recent failure and, with Maxime Guyon aboard, seems capable of making amends. Worth another chance

Summary: QWENKALY (15) is hard to catch right but showed when finishing 2nd in a similar contest two starts back that a race of this nature is well within her capabilities so, with Maxime Guyon back aboard, could well set the record straight. Consistent GUITRY (1) has proven competitive at this level on many occasions and is likely to lead the challenge, ahead of VULCANIO (12) and HIGHLAND ARCHER (7) who are also capable of fighting for victory. On the strength and consistency of his recent form, ALCOTAN (6) ought to remain competitive. ZELZEFYR (3) and TISSEUSE DE REVES (13) complete the shortlist.

- **1. TRES QUEEN -** Improving last-start winner with solid form references. Judged on her best form, she ought to pose a threat
- **2. ERMELIE -** Unbeaten in two starts this year and on an upward trajectory but takes a significant jump up to this category. Place chance
- **3. ONARIA -** Consistent for the most part and has shown enough to warrant consideration here. Has only a place chance
- **4. INES -** Well-beaten 9th in a Listed race on her reappearance but would've tightened up since and is likely to find this a lot easier
- **5. PRINCESS ZIZOU -** Lightly raced filly with scope for plenty improvement. Returns from an absence but will have more to offer
- **6. RUE DE VOLGA -** Has run to fair level of form but will need to raise her game to be competitive here. Has only a place chance
- **7. CAP SAN ROMAN -** Capable filly with fair references. She has two comeback outings under her belt now, so may get into the picture

Summary : INES (4) finished 9th in a Listed race on her reappearance but should redeem herself here given this significant drop in class. She will, however, have to be wary of TRES QUEEN (1) who returned to winning ways recently at Aix-Les-Bains, and ERMELIE (2) who is enjoying a very good run of form. CAP SAN ROMAN (7) ran with meir in a Quinté+ and is also capable of getting into the picture.

C6 - PRIX DE MAMERS - 1900m (a1 3/16m) - ALL WEATHER - Divised Handicap - Flat - EUR € 21.000

- **1. GALLIARA -** Relatively unexposed and is open to improvement with her rider's 1,5kg allowance a bonus. Respected
- **2. HISBANN -** Has been in good form recently and will benefit from his rider's 1,5kg allowance, so ought to be competitive
- **3. LAND OF PARADISE -** Unreliable sort but is not incapable of staking a claim in a race of this nature. Could get into the action
- **4. REASONABLE -** Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore
- **5. SENDMEASTAR -** Judged on her victory at Wissembourg three starts back, she remains capable of getting into the picture
- **6. GLOIRE DE VASSY -** Undeniably capable but appears to have gone off the boil recently, so will need to reaffirm. Outsider
- **7. DE QUEVEDO -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **8. KOULIKOFF -** Arrives in very good order and on the strength of his recent form is one of the contenders for victory
- **9. SIR ALFRED -** Unplaced in both outings this year and is hard to recommend on that form. Improvement is needed to feature here
- **10. UCHRONIE -** At this value (25), she is more than capable of creating a stir in her first start in a handicap. Keep safe
- **11. CALA MOLI -** Debuted well in the category and renews rivalry with KOULIKOFF (8) on 2,5kg better terms. Big player
- **12. ETNA -** Has been struggling for form and consistency for some time now so is unlikely to trouble the judge
- **13. KENDOHA -** Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore
- **14. DREAM CYCLE -** Out of sorts but has dropped significantly in the weights, so could spark some improvement sooner rather than later. Beware

Summary: KOULIKOFF (8) was a pleasing winner of her most recent outings and is capable of defying a 2,5kg penalty for that success by following up here. To do that, though, she will have to thwart the likely challenge of CALA MOLI (11), who made an encouraging handicap debut, and UCHRONIE (10) whose performances in claiming races have not gone unnoticed. GALLIARA (1), with her rider's 1,5kg allowance, has ambitions at this level too, with the shortlist completed by all of HISBANN (2), DREAM CYCLE (14) and SENDMEASTAR (5).

- 2. BEHTAR Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **3. ELIYASS -** On a winning run at the moment and is undefeated this year. Another bold bid can be expected include
- **4. WALDSTAR -** Nothing noteworthy to his name for a considerable period now and can be ruled out. Others preferred
- **5. KATOUCHA -** Has been struggling for form and consistency for some time now so is unlikely to trouble the judge
- **6. PARCHEMIN -** Consistent sort with solid form references and in very good shape at the moment. Will play a leading role
- **7. INTEGRANT -** Returns to the scene of his career-best victory in good form and physical condition. Can fight for victory
- **8. WITHERING -** Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore

Summary: A tricky event in which it could pay to put trust in INTEGRANT (7) who has already imposed himself over track and trip, and can take revenge on ELIYASS (3) with whom he renews rivalry on better weight terms. Between the pair, though, we could find PARCHMENT (6) who is adept on PSF and likely to be competitive. Of the rest, DAWN INTELLO (1) could have a role to play having already distinguished himself at a higher level.

- **1. ZIPPERE -** Returned to form last time and has had excellent success on this fiber sand track. High on the shortlist
- **2. DIWAN SENORA -** Has already shone on this course so could well resurface in this grade/company. Dangerous to dismiss
- **3. KENNY -** Irreproachable in recent weeks and arrives in very good form. His place could be on top step of the podium
- **4. FULL GAIN -** Nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period and can be ruled out. Others are preferred
- **5. MY FLINDERS -** Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore
- **6. BIENNE -** Unrelaible but remains capable and will benefit from her rider's 2kg allowance. SHould have a role to play
- **7. HIS PRIDE -** Undeniably capable but went off the boil last year so will need to reaffirm on his reappearance. Watch for now
- **8. CALY ROSAY -** Has been struggling for some time now and is unlikely to trouble the judge here. Can be ruled out
- **9. MISTER MARIO -** Has nothing noteworthy to his name to warrant consideration here so can be ruled out. Best to ignore

Summary: Despite a 1,5kg penalty for winning three starts back, KENNY (3) has twice proven competitive in handicaps by finishing 3rd in consecutive handicaps so remains the one to beat. BIENNE (6) ran well at Mons lately and will benefit from his rider's 2kg allowance to is likely to pose a threat. ZIPPERE (1), who has never finished further than 3rd at this course, and DIWAN SENORA (2) complete shortlist.
