- **1. LE ROI DAVID -** Unplaced last time, a win before that in a Listed hurdle at Auteuil on October 7th. Capable of making an impact
- **2. JOST -** Unplaced last time over 4800m in a Grade 1 hurdle on November 15th, 4th before that over 4700m at Auteuil on October 23rd in a Grade 3 handicap chase. Hard to rule out
- **3. SURINFIL -** Unplaced last time, 4th previously over 3700m in a handicap chase at Auteuil on October 27th. Unlikely to trouble the principles
- **4. CHES DEMONMIRAIL** Two unplaced efforts since a 4th at Merano (ITA) over 3900m on August 17th. Others look more favourable
- **5. ILLAHO -** Fair 3rd last time over 3700m in a handicap Chase at Clairefontaine on July 16th. Can be fit after an absence. Course winner twice in 2024. Player
- **6. ANGE PITOU** Has been off the track since scoring over 4300m at this venue in a Listed hurdle. He seems to thrive at this racecourse and warrants respect
- **7. GOLDEN PARK -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 4500m in a handicap chase at Clairefontaine on August 27th. Hard to recommend
- **8. BON PRINCE** Three unplaced runs of late, the latter over 3500m in a handicap chase at Auteuil on April 26th. Might be better for this run after a layoff

Summary: LE ROI DAVID (1) won a Listed handicap hurdle at Auteuil two runs back and has solid credentials. He can edge this over ILLAHO (5), who is a previous course winner in 2024 and was a fair third in a handicap chase at Clairefontaine when last seen in July. JOST (2) ran a decent fourth two runs back at Auteuil in late October and can not be overlooked. ANGE PITOU (6) makes up the shortlist.

- **1. BAIE DES ANGES -** Unraced filly by Castle Du Berlais, the dam ran several times on the flat and over jumps without a win. Best watched for her hurdles debut
- **2. NARAKA -** Two unplaced runs on the flat, the latter over 2400m at Toulouse on September 3rd in a maiden race. Hurdle race debut and others make more appeal
- **3. SOCCIA** Five unplaced runs on the flat, the latter over 2200m in a claiming race at Amiens on November 10th. Needs to show more on hurdles debut
- **4. QUONSTANTINE -** Unraced by Beaumec De Houelle, the dam won 9 races on the flat. From the David Cottin stable that can ready a newcomer to strike on debut. Hard to rule out
- **5. OBSTINATION** Unraced filly by Moises Has, the dam was placed over jumps. Likely to improve for this debut run and is best watched for now
- **6. SILVER SEED -** Two unplaced runs on the flat, well beaten in a claiming race over 2200m at Amiens on November 10th. Pass over on her hurdle race bow
- **7. VIE SECRETE -** Four unplaced runs of late on the flat, 2nd over 2100m in a maiden at Saint-Cloud on April 4th. Should be monitored for any market support
- **8. MARQUISE DE L'EST -** Filly on debut by Karaktar, the dam never raced. Stable runners are well prepared and she can be involved at the finish
- **9. SAINTE STYLEE -** Placed 4th on the one run on the flat over 2900m at Amiens on November 10th. Has shown talent and open to improvement on hurdling bow
- **10. STYLE D'AVOINE -** Unraced filly by Vol De Nuit, the dam won 5 races over jumps. Nice profile and can be expected to play a lead role

- **14. AZOTE -** A few unplaced runs since a win at Aix Les Bains on July 1st over 1800m in a handicap on the flat. Capable of making a winning debut over hurdles
- **15. THE MUDS -** Filly on debut by Order Of St George, the dam never raced. Stable runners are respected on debut and the betting market can be the best guide
- **16. MA BELLE D'OR -** Unraced filly by Beaumec De Houelle. the dam won 1 race over jumps. She is one to take seriously if the betting patterns are positive

Summary: AZOTE (14) looks capable of getting success on her hurdling debut. She scored over 1800m in July and should have the stamina for this discipline. STYLE D'AVOINE (10) can be a threat. She has a taking profile, and her trainer knows the time of day. MARQUISE DE L'EST (8) is from a top stable and looks good on paper. She will be well-tuned and can have a say at the business end. MA BELLE D'OR (16) is worth monitoring in the betting for any support.

- **2. MAESTRO D'AUBRELLE -** Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 3400m at La Teste on April 2nd in a maiden hurdle. Others seem better equipped
- **3. CANONBIE LAD -** Two unplaced runs since a 4th over 3550m at Fontainebleau on October 4th in a Class 4 hurdle. Ought to be thereabouts
- **4. THE BIG TICKET -** Showed ability when 5th in a Class 4 hurdle at Fontainebleau on November 19th over 3550m on his last start. Can be on the premises
- **5. BANDJO -** 7th on the last run over 3550m at Fontainebleau on October 28th in a Class 4 hurdle. Flat winner in May. Player
- **6. KENTUCKY IDEAL -** Unplaced on the one start over 3400m at Nimes on November 11th in a Class 4 hurdle. Needs vast progress to be involved

Summary: BANDJO (5) scored on debut on the flay at Vichy in May and has acquitted himself well in two hurdle races since that. - **2. ADVICE -** Not seen since a 6th place effort over 3500m at Auteuil in a Class 2 handicap chase on May 18th 2024. Decent placed form over fences before that at Auteuil and thus track. One to pay attention to
- **3. QUICK DADDY -** Has shown very little of late, failing to complete at Auteuil over 4300m in a handicap hurdle on November 16th. Little to recommend
- **4. ICARE DU SEUIL -** Fair 5th last time, a win before that over 4200m at Fontainebleau on October 13th in a Class 3 hurdle. Key player
- **5. YUTU -** Unplaced on the one run this year over 3900m in a Class 4 hurdle at Machecoul on November 11th. Unlikely to be involved
