### **R1 VINCENNES [L-H]**

# C1 - PRIX DE VILLERS COTTERETS - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 53,000

- **1. OSCAR VAN HALBEEK -** Ran 2nd in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class D 2 weeks ago only to be retroactively eliminated. Has been in flying form lately and on good behaviour can make amends. Chance
- 2. INDICE DU CAIEU Handy sort at a lower level. Is here for reasons of conditioning and can be ruled out
- **3. DAYAK (ITY) -** In the frame in 4 of last 5 starts, most recently 3rd of 16, a place behind KAXIG IN (14) under these conditions on 14 November. Breaks from the 3-spot and will be expected to contest the finish
- **4. DIE HARD (ITY) -** Serious type that has struggled to show his form since returning to competition. Has nothing to prove at this level and it is only a question of time before he gets back in the game. The draw will not hurt
- **5. JOUVENCE DE CAREL -** Put in quite the finish to come 5th of 16 behind KAXIG IN (14) under these conditions on 14 November. Enjoys an excellent draw and in similar shape will be no pushover
- **6. JABLONSKI -** Runner-up in last 3 starts and appears to be close to his 2023 form. Barefoot this time and JMB will be eager to capitalise. Claim
- **7. IDREAMIS -** Remarkably spirited mare but has talent in spades. Hind shoes off for just 2nd start back, but would be preferred barefoot
- **8. DIVA DEL RONCO -** Solid in last 2 barefoot starts, latterly 4th in 14 November race of reference. Starts wide, but is on the front row, and cannot be written off
- **9. JACQUARD -** Fine trotter making first appearance since April and will be preparing for a monte campaign
- **10. CANTAB AS -** Useful sort but has never delivered over 2100m of the main track and, at this level, is unlikely to start now
- **11. LOOK OF LOVE -** Fine Belgian raider that has disappointed just once under these conditions. Is not ideally-placed on 2nd line but in current condition is easy to like for a place in the mix
- **12. VALLATONIAN -** Quality Norwegian element returning to a track he adores after being out of competition for 3.5 months. Goes well for his driver though and will be dangerous if settles early
- **13. RUGER -** Has been excelling in the provinces since coming to France, but has yet to show any liking for the main track. Alexandre Abrivard at the helm this time but still represents no more than a minor place prospect
- **14. KAXIG IN -** Sprang a 43-1 surprise when running 2nd in race of reference. Bjorn Goop in the bike this time but a repeat still seems unlikely

- **15. IRIS INTENSE -** Won over course and distance this time last season, but is still in conditioning mode and is not about to create an upset
- **16. IN RACE LORRAINE -** Pleased over 2850m prior to blowing up over 2700m here 9 days ago, and can expect to have few friends

**Summary:** Back in business following an extended period on the sidelines, JABLONSKI (6) races barefoot for the first time and, considering the draw, looks the one to beat. DAYAK (ITY) (3) has been knocking at the door and the draw fairy has been good to him too. VALLATONIAN (12) is forced to break from the 2nd row, and has not raced since mid-August, but he excels at Vincennes and will be reunited with Matthieu Abrivard. OSCAR VAN HALBEEK (1) can be forgiven his recent elimination and with application will not be far off the mark. JOUVENCE DE CAREL (5) defied her odds here recently and can again figure prominently.

# C2 - PRIX DE PONTCHATEAU - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- **1. MATISSE DU PONT** Capable sort with a pair of comeback runs under his belt but nonetheless needs to reassure
- **2. MON PLAISIR -** Won 2 in a row before coming 3rd of 8 in a 2700m Class E here on 10 November. Is plainly on the way up and will have a lot to contribute if he takes to the inner-course profile
- **3. MELKIOR DE BAILLY -** Has looked decidedly ordinary for some time, latterly 7th in 18 November race of reference, and can be passed over
- **4. MONTENEGRO** Eliminated as often as not but has won the 3 races he has completed. Did not enjoy the best of trips last time but can contest the finish if Theo Duvaldestin keeps him focused
- **5. MAGNUS TOR -** Tough but tricky sort that has been showing his form here recently. Will have no issue with the trip and on good behaviour can play a leading role
- **6. MAJOR DU MARGAS** Improved on Vincennes performance when courageous 2nd to MALABAR MAGO (13) in a 2700m Graignes Class E on 20 November, but still has ground to make up
- **7. MAGELLANO SUN -** Last of 4 on re-entry in a 2175m Class D here early last month and is going to need another run
- **8. MILAN DU BOSQUET -** Has shown form in the provinces but has not been seen out since September and will have nothing to offer
- **9. MAESTRO DES SARTS -** Lost his way at the end of the autumn, finishing unplaced in 2 here, and can be ruled out
- **10. MORETIME DU CAMPUS -** Ran 4th at Enghien before finishing close 2nd in a Bordeaux Class E 3 weeks ago. Is plainly close to his race and will be no pushover if he takes to the new conditions
- **11. MEYOU DU CAMPUS -** Handy element that seldom disappoints when focused, latterly 4th of 10 finishers in a 2100m Class E here on 18 November, however a repeat seems unlikely
- **12. MISTRAL DE LARRE -** Capricious individual but is a tough nut to crack when focused. Takes a dip in distance this time and will not be far off the mark if Franck Ouvrie keeps him trotting
- **13. MALABAR MAGO -** Got off the mark, at 10th time of asking, when tenaciously securing a 2700m Graignes Class E a fortnight ago, and in similar shape will not be going home emptyhanded
- **14. MAGIK DE PIERRAIS -** Significantly better than latest numbers would suggest. Drops down the category-ladder and with the aid of Matthieu Abrivard can win a race of this nature

**Summary:** Although unexceptional in his last 3 starts, MAGIK DE PIERRAIS (14) takes on a less-elevated bunch here, is ideally-engaged at the limit of earnings, and has a decent chance of opening his Vincennes account. Provided he keeps his action together, MONTENEGRO (4) will have his chances, as will the progressive MAGNUS TOR (5) who would have finished 2nd here a fortnight ago had he not been eliminated. MORETIME DU CAMPUS (10) takes to the inner course for the first time, in excellent shape, and the even surface should suit him to a tee.

## C3 - PRIX D'AMBERAC - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- **1. NORMA DU TRIEUX -** 6th of 11 on debut at Auch 3 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the race and with Benjamin Rochard reining will be afforded every chance
- **2. NEEDREAM -** Makes Vincennes, and left-handed, debut after faulting early at Reims 10 days ago. Franck Ouvrie in the bike this time and with application should prove competitive for a place in the frame
- **3. NOSTALGIE DAIRPET -** Ran 3rd on debut at Laval but out of the picture in next 2. Returns to racing left-handed and from the 3-spot can get back in the game
- **4. NEXT DANCE KALOUMA -** Flattering 5th of 8 finishers in a Nantes Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Enjoys a good draw, and will be reined by Francois Lagadeuc, but still represents no more than a minor place chance
- **5. NINA HAGEN D'OR -** Unable to confirm Caen performance when well-beaten in a Class B here a month back. Is better than the result would suggest though and is well-placed to give this a good go
- **6. NINJA DE L'ENVOL -** Was not disgraced on inner track debut in late-October but failed to confirm a fortnight later. Is better than most here though and can expect significant support. Claim
- **7. NIGHT SHADOW -** Made no improvement on Bihorel debut when eliminated in a 2300m Chartres Class F on 3 November. Has had time to get her house in order but still not easy to recommend
- **8. NEBRASKA DE GINIER -** Well-beaten last of 4 in a 2150m Cordemais Class F 10 days ago. Has yet to show any particular flair for the game and will be forced to break wide
- **9. NOTHING BETTER -** Showed signs of encouragement at Lisieux but was trounced at Amiens a week ago and will need to find significantly more
- **10. NALA DE FAY** Qualified respectably but eliminated in both starts to date. Top driver at the helm this time but still not a concern
- **11. NEMO DE BEYLEV -** Qualified smartly in June but made little impact on Cherbourg debut 10 days ago. Mathieu Mottier reining this time and, despite the draw, looks competitively well-in
- **12. NISSA STAR -** Eliminated in all 3 starts to date. Is forced to break from back row, and will have few takers
- **13. NEVER WOOD -** Qualified in 1'19"8 at Grosbois last June. Has pulled a tough number for career debut and can be ruled out
- **14. NOUBA CASTELETS -** Well-related filly that was eliminated first time out. Has been given time to recalibrate and should show improvement provided Nicolas Raimbeaux keeps her focused
- **15. NATIF DU MANOLET -** Looked very ordinary in qualification before being eliminated in La Capelle debut 3 weeks ago and can be passed over
- **16. NIKOS DALY -** Thoroughly outclassed on Graignes debut before faulting when unsupported in a Nantes Class F in late-October. Badly-positioned on 2nd row and has no realistic chance

**Summary:** NINJA DE L'ENVOL (6) takes a considerable drop in category after being well-beaten in a Class D here last month and is well-placed to get off the mark this time. Guillaume Martin can still expect to feel the heat from NINA HAGEN D'OR (5) who returns to a more suitable level, and NEEDREAM (2) provided she gets off on the right foot this time. NOSTALGIE DAIRPET (3) has yet to confirm her debut performance, but has a lot more going for her on this occasion.

- **1. MADE IN ATALANTE** Won a pair on the Riviera during the summer but has since come off the boil and must first re-establish her credentials
- **2. MISS STORY -** Finished well to secure a 2550m Reims Class E on 10 November but has more to find on this occasion
- **3. MAYBE DAIRPET -** Returned to winning ways at Reims last month but latest 7th behind MISS UNIVERS (10) in a 2175m Class D here early last month does nothing to inspire confidence
- **4. MORGANE DE HOERDT -** Lost her maiden status at Strasbourg on 24 October but failed to confirm when eliminated in 18 November race of reference, and can be ignored
- **5. MERRY RIVER -** Ran 4th at Enghien prior to repeating in a 2850m Class E over the inner course last week. Is reunited with Benjamin Rochard who won with her during the spring and on good behaviour is unlikely to disappoint. First 5
- **6. MA AM CHENU -** Quickly eliminated over course and distance early last month before running good 2nd over the main track 3 weeks ago. Is plainly close to her race and with application can get her nose in front this time
- **7. MERVEILLEUSE -** Was going well when faulting in a 2850m Class D over the short course last week. Is plainly in form and Pierre-Yves Verva will be keen to set the record straight
- **8. MISS BELGRAVE -** Got off the mark at Lyon-Parilly in late-October before finishing a place behind MULANE DU BOCAGE (11) in a 2100m Class E over the inner course 2 weeks ago, however in this company a repeat seems unlikely
- **9. MAGIE MESLOISE** 6th behind MISS UNIVERS (10) in a 2175m Class D here early last month. Should be fully-fit by now and can play a more prominent role this time around
- **10. MISS UNIVERS -** Sprang a 36-1 surprise when 3rd of 9 finishers in a 2175m Class D early last month, however she will simply have too much to do this time
- **11. MULANE DU BOCAGE** Made up for main-track disappointment when 4th of 14 in a 2100m Class E over the inner course 2 weeks ago. Will have come on for the race and could well pick up a cheque
- **12. MASTERCLASS D'EARL -** Returns to the inner course after coming 5th behind MISS UNIVERS (10) in a 2175m Class D here early last month. Tends to go well for Franck Nivard and can challenge for a place on the podium
- **13. MALICE SPEED -** 8th behind MISS UNIVERS (10) on re-entry here on 7 November. Top driver at the helm this time and, given the entry, must be considered a player
- **14. MA CATHERINECHERIE** Steps up in category after running 2nd in a Class E over course and distance on 4 November. Is ideally-engaged but chances still seem limited

**Summary:** Although still somewhat green, MA AM CHENU (6) has shown significant potential, was beaten only by a very smart filly here last month, and on good behaviour can impose this time. Louis Baudouin will still be mindful of MAGIE MESLOISE (9) who has three comeback runs under her belt, and the nicely-entered MALICE SPEED (13) who will be partnered by Eric Raffin for the occasion. MASTERCLASS D'EARL (12) is unlikely to lose her maiden tag but is in decent form and should appreciate these conditions.

# C5 - PRIX DE COLOMBES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- **1. KIDNAPPING** Has won 5 of the 9 races he has finished, but is still in conditioning-mode and best to leave alone
- **2. KAVANI** Pleased under these conditions early last month, but failed to confirm when 8th of 10 behind KILLER BOND (7) under similar conditions on 21 November, and others easier to back
- **3. KADOR JOSSELYN** Has not been living up to expectations lately but has bags of ability and with JMB in the bike, can start to redeem himself
- **4. KYSKO DE FAEL -** In the frame in 2 before coming 5th of 10 behind KILLER BOND (7) under similar conditions on 21 November. Takes on a better lot this time though and a repeat seems improbable
- **5. KERRO DE HOUELLE -** Imposed at Laval last time barefoot. Surprise 5th of 16 in a Class C at the same venue when being conditioned next time, and return to Vincennes with every chance of finishing in the mix
- **6. KABOTIN CHENEVIERE -** Pleasant 5th at Lyon-La Soie 3 weeks ago and will be barefoot as he was at Strasbourg. Eric Raffin in the bike and cannot be ruled out
- **7. KILLER BOND -** Produced a fine performance over course and distance on 21 November and will have a realistic chance of getting his nose in front this time provided Benjamin Rochard gets him off on the right foot
- **8. KHARTOUM DE LA FYE -** Never far from faulting but has ample ability. Has just the one race under his belt though and would be preferred competitively-shod
- **9. KHEO VIVANCIERE -** 2nd of 15 on re-entry in a Saint-Malo Class F on 1 November. Has decent references under these conditions and will not be available at 75-1 this time
- **10. KOZMIC BLUES -** Never threatening when eliminated in a Class D over track and trip 11 days ago and is not about to spice things up
- **11. KER DE TOUES -** Won over course and distance during the spring but has not raced since late-June. Sports pads for comeback but still not an obvious choice
- **12. KERNO -** Has looked very ordinary over recent months, latterly 7th of 10 in a 2100m Class D here on 24 November, and poses no threat
- **13. KADO DES MOLLES -** Got back in the winners' circle here, securing a claimer over the inner course 3 weeks ago, but is out of his depth this time
- **14. KRUNCHY -** Serious individual that would have finished closer behind KAVANI (2) in a Class E over course and distance early last month had he not lost his action. Is plainly at the top of his game and must not be underestimated
- **15. KEROSEN DU GERS -** Capable on a good day but reliability not his strong suit. Raced better here 9 days ago than the result would imply, takes a dip in category, and will be reined by Franck Nivard
- **16. KATSUKI -** Complicated type that stormed up at Nantes early last month. Alexandre Abrivard stays faithful and should double up as long as he keeps his charge focused

**Summary:** Winner of 2 of his last 3, most recently with consummate ease, KATSUKI (16) is just 40 Euros from elimination this time and, with application, should have this in the bag. KILLER BOND (7) could well have imposed here recently had he not stumbled early, and Benjamin Rochard will be eager to set the record straight. KHEO VIVANCIERE (9) sports modified shoeing after impressing on re-entry a month back, and will receive a Mathieu Mottier drive this time. KERRO DE HOUELLE (5) returns to racing barefoot after prepping well at Laval and looks competitive for a place on the podium.

# C6 - PRIX DE CHAMALIERES - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- **1. MISTY GIRL -** Showed little when eliminated on debut at Amiens last month and seems to be out of her league
- **2. MORANE D'AVEL -** Got straight down to victorious ways on re-entry in a 2700m Class E here 9 days ago. Benjamin Rochard appears to have found what makes her tick, and a repeat is easy to envisage
- **3. MIRMANDE DEL PHEDO -** Takes to main track for first time after coming 3rd in a Class E over the inner course 3 weeks ago. Takes on better this time and although not a priority, is still worth monitoring
- **4. MADISON MONNERIE -** Never far from faulting but respectable in last 2. Will appreciate a return to the main track but still a minor place prospect at best
- **5. MARION D'HAFLING -** Starts for the first time since getting off the mark in Cabourg last July. Mathieu Mottier in the saddle for re-entry and will be expecting to get in on the action. Chance
- **6. MAJUSCULE -** 9th in race of reference before being eliminated in a 2700m Class C here a week ago, and can be confidently disregarded
- **7. MOON STAR -** Returns to her code of preference after 2 harness comeback runs. Eliminated on lone start over 2175m here, but has come on considerably since and must be regarded a decent first-5 chance
- **8. MELBA DES VAUX -** Produced 3 fine performances before failing to deliver behind MOLLY MADRIK (13 here on 17 November. Plainly has ability but is no priority over the main track
- **9. MARIEVA DE LOU -** 6th behind MOLLY MADRIK (13) in a Class D over track and trip on 17 November, and would be preferred over a more even surface
- **10. MANDARINA DE LOU -** Being switched to the monte code after blowing up in a harness Class D here in late-October. Has done enough in the other code to be considered a serious player under these conditions and with application can go far
- **11. MELODY MUSIC** Has placed just once in 3 ridden starts but returns to the code in excellent shape, and has never disappointed for Eric Raffin. Attention
- **12. MONALYSA DU ROEN -** Showed her talent more than once during the autumn but will need to show marked improvement on recent performance in race of reference
- **13. MOLLY MADRIK** Beat a number of these when 4th of 13 in a Class D over course and distance on 17 November. Has shown significant aptitude for the discipline and can finish closer this time

**Summary:** Unopposed winner over the classic distance here late last month, MORANE D'AVEL (2) looks eminently capable of confirming. MANDARINA DE LOU (10) though debuts under the saddle, and considering the potential she has shown in the other code, making a big impact here is not out of the question. Given time off after imposing at Cabourg last July, MARION D'HAFLING (5) will be reunited with Mathieu Mottier and is plainly in competition-mode. MOLLY MADRIK (13) is just 215 Euros from elimination and is not incapable of making the frame this time.

- **1. NEPITA** Showed improvement when 2nd in a Graignes Class B 3 weeks ago, but faces a much stiffer test on this occasion
- **2. NASHVILLE -** 3rd to NO WORRY (9) over 2200m here before repeating behind NEPITA (1) at Graignes, but still needs to find more
- **3. NOELA JOSSELYN -** Made up for late-October elimination when good 2nd to NO LIMIT DELO (8) in a 2850m over the short course here on 13 November, and again looks dangerous. Chance
- **4. NOVA DE CELLAND -** Has been showing the limits of her capability, most recently eliminated in a 2200m Gr.3 here on 22 November, and is unlikely to influence the outcome
- **5. NEW HOLIDAY -** In the frame in all 4 starts to date, most recently 3rd to NANIKA DU PONT (12) in a 2875m Enghien Class B in mid-October. Faces a test running over the main track for the first time, but can still get in on the action
- **6. NOVA TIM -** In the frame in both starts over the main track but latest effort here was sufficiently poor to warrant little support this time
- **7. NORMA JEANE** Has started to progress but a repeat of her recent 2nd in a Class C over the inner course looks unlikely
- **8. NO LIMIT DELO -** Confirmed debut success with a strong run in a 2850m over the short course here on 13 November. Is new to the main track but has buckets of talent and can maintain her perfect record
- **9. NO WORRY -** Has made short work of both starts to date, latterly a 2200m Class D over the inner track in late-October, and a 3rd straight success is a distinct possibility
- **10. NEBULEUSE FLIGNY -** Got off the mark at Enghien in late-October before running 4th to NEPITA (1) at Graignes, but in this company will have nothing to contribute
- **11. NIKAIA PORT -** Won 2 on the trot before front-running tactics worked against here a month ago. Makes first start for new trainer and with Eric Raffin in the bike will be no easy touch
- **12. NANIKA DU PONT** Moves back in class after finishing last but one in a 2200m Gr.3 here 11 days ago. Enjoys a terrific entry and will be driven by JMB for the first time. First 5

**Summary:** Winner on debut at Reims before imposing over the inner track 3 weeks ago, NO LIMIT DELO (8) will be expected to live up to her name and secure the hat-trick. The main threat should logically come from NOELA JOSSELYN (3) who chased her in that day, and the undefeated NO WORRY (9) who has significant future potential. NIKAIA PORT (11) has similarly shown enormous promise and with a modified strategy can finish closer this time.

#### C8 - PRIX DE DECIZE - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- **1. READY HILL -** Returns to Vincennes after producing a pair of good performances at home in Germany. Matthieu Abrivard in the bike this time and is certainly worth retaining
- **2. ODYSSEY BOKO -** Tricky sort that reassured somewhat in Mons 3 weeks ago but appears to be biting off more than he can chew this time
- **3. KILLER RAIN -** Makes first foray into France after winning over a mile in Victoria Park on 14 November. Has good speed but in this company will have too much to do
- **4. FUOCO DEGLI DEI -** Moderate Italian colt making first appearance here since last January. Looked ordinary in both return runs and will struggle to make his presence felt
- **5. NGANNOU -** Produced a fast-finishing effort to come 7th, a place behind FLAMENCO FER (7), in a 2100m Class C here on 24 October. Has had time to freshen up and it would be no huge surprise to see him open his French account
- **6. LONDON RECALL** Fine servant with just the one comeback run under his belt since the break. Stays shod and is not about to trouble the judge
- **7. FLAMENCO FER -** Blows hot and cold but has no shortage of talent. Debuts for new trainer, has been freshly reconfigured, and can get straight down to business
- **8. LOULOU DES OUBEAUX -** Capable element making first appearance since early-September. Is clearly being conditioned and can be passed over
- **9. LICAR SOMOLLI -** Won a brace across town earlier in the year but eliminated in last 2 Vincennes starts. Is shod to preference this time but others still preferred
- **10. ONANA BOKO -** No slouch on a good day and has solid European form. Takes on a tough lot here but is barefoot on debut for the Bazire yard and, although not a priority, is not to be underestimated either
- **11. MONSIEUR CHOCOLAT -** Won 3 of last 4 at home in Sweden, most recently in good order at Jagersro 11 days ago. Bjorn Goop in the bike this time and although not a leading contender, is still worth keeping an eye on
- **12. LEGOLAS -** Put away after securing the hat-trick in August. Left a positive impression on comeback here on 14 November. Will have progressed for the race and can finish closer this time
- **13. LORENZO BERRY -** Out of the picture in all 3 starts this term, but JMB takes over in the bike and can start to put things right. Place chance
- **14. OLYMPUS DRAGON** Won 4 in a row before being pulled-up at Jagersro in early-September. Is competitively-shod though, with Eric Raffin in the bike and, confirmed under these conditions, must be taken seriously

**Summary:** A well-travelled and -experienced colt that won over shorter here earlier in the year, FLAMENCO FER (7) will be competitively-shod on his first start for the Duvaldestin stable and can wrap this up. Theo Duvaldestin will still be justifiably wary of NGANNOU (5) who caught the eye behind his colt that day, and the terrifically-engaged OLYMPUS DRAGON (14) who has never been beaten in the day's configuration. LORENZO BERRY (13) has a trio of runs under his belt and will be reunited with JMB who won with him on their sole association.
