C1 - PRIX DE LA CHARTRE SUR LE LOIR - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class B Race - Harness - EUR € 60,000

- **1. JALOUZ D'OLIVERIE -** in good shape and was third in Class C at this track over 2850m on 18 January. Capable of contesting the finish
- **2. JET SOCIETY -** In good form and finished fourth in Class C at this track over 2850m on 18 January. Has a place chance
- **3. JOUR DE FETE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class B at this track over 2100m on 23 January. Might play a minor role
- **4. JAPAROV LIRE -** Did not show his best when 9th in Class B at this track over 2100m on 23 January. Better at Mons but could make the frame
- **5. IRMYLA DE SOMMAIRE -** Has some fair form and was fourth in Class E at this track over 2850m on 11 January. Might earn some minor money
- **6. JOURNEE REVEE -** Has disqualification issues but was a winner last time out in Class C at this track over 2850m on 18 January. Can follow up
- **7. JIBI DU FRUITIER -** Unreliable and finished 8th in Class E at this track over 2850m on 14 January. Has a place chance in this line-up

- **10. JOTUNN DU DOME -** Very consistent form at this track and finished runner-up in Class B over 2100m on 23 January. Big chance
- **11. JOLIE STAR -** Unreliable and was 8th in Group 3 at this track over 2100m on 26 January. Capable of making the frame
- **12. INITIALE HERAULT -** Unreliable but was victorious last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 28 December. Tougher task this time
- **13. JULIA QUICK -** Not easy to trust but was victorious last time out in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 January. Might play a minor role

Summary: JOTUNN DU DOME (10) is very consistent and in very good form of late. He has won his last two course and distance appearances and can surely make it three. JALENDRA DE MALAC (8) is unbeaten in four starts for trainer Alexis Grimault and is an obvious danger. JOURNEE REVEE (6) won nicely at this course last time out and looks a big player too. JAPAROV LIRE (4) is at best at Mons in Belgium but could make the frame at this course.

- **1. LADY LAMOTTE -** Disqualified last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 27 January. Ran well in her penultimate start and is not out of it
- **2. LA CANDEUR -** Disqualified twice in just four starts, including last time out at this track on 28 January. Others make more appeal
- **3. L'ODYSSEE MESLOISE -** Yet to win a race and finished 11th in Class F at Angers over 2425m on 29 January. Others are preferred
- **4. LOVE STORY GARDEN -** Disqualified last time out at Cabourg on 7 December. Capable of earning some minor money when in the right mood
- **5. LILIE D'OMAHA -** Has disappointed of late and was disqualified at this track on 10 January. Can improve under Alexandre Abrivard and first time in a Mounted race
- **6. LUCIA PERRINE -** Has disqualification issues but did show improvement when runner-up in a Class E Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 28 January. Can go one better this time around
- **7. LOGE D'ERABLE -** Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class F Mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 11 November. Can go one better
- **8. LUCRECE DE CORDAY -** Very unreliable and finished 8th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 16 October. Capable of an upset on best form
- **9. LYXIE KNIGHT -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Angers on 29 January. Probably best watched for now
- **10. LADY GODIVA -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when third in a Class e Mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 January. Has a winning chance
- **11. LOLA DU LIVET -** Did not show her best when 6th in a Class D Mounted race over this track and trip on 10 September. Has a place chance returning from a break

Summary: LILIE D'OMAHA (5) has disappointed of late in harness races. She could shine trying a Mounted race under top-rider Alexandre Abrivard. LUCIA PERRINE (6) showed improvement last time out under the saddle and would not be a surprise winner. LUCRECE DE CORDAY (8) is very unreliable but does have solid claims if she can keep her action together. LOGE D'ERABLE (7) is close to another success and should be right there at the finish.

- **2. LEON -** Continues to improve and was victorious last time out in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 January. Can win again
- **3. LIGHTNING JIEL -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when third in Class E at this track over 2850m on 7 January. Capable of an upset
- **4. LIKE DESBOIS -** A winner of two of his four starts, including last time out in Class E at Pontchâteau over 2200m on 22 December. Barefoot and can contest the finish
- **5. LUCIFER DU PONT -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at this track over 2700m on 15 January. Better this distance and is not out of it
- **6. LEONARD DE VINCI -** Disappointing form at this track and finished 6th last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 15 January. Might play a minor role
- **7. LUCIFER DU CAIEU -** Needed his last run when 12th in Class D at this track over 2200m on 4 December. Barefoot for the first time and could strike
- **8. LAOS JIEL -** Unreliable of late and finished 7th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 12 January. Others are preferred
- **9. LOVEBIRD -** Very consistent and was not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Should fight out the finish

Summary: A competitive-looking race. LUCIFER DU CAIEU (7) needed his last run in December. He is barefoot and ready for a winning turn. LOVEBIRD (9) is usually very competitive in this division and should fight out the finish yet again. LEON (2) was a good winner at Cordemais so he should go close again if he can reproduce this level of performance. LUCIFER DU PONT (5) is better this distance and can get involved with the finish.

- **2. KING DE COSSIO -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 5 January. In good form before that but others are preferred
- **3. KAIROUAN GLAM -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 21 January. Capable of winning when in the right frame of mind
- **4. KANKAL -** Did not show his best when 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 12 December. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **5. KEOPS DE GODINIERE -** Unreliable and finished 5th at Angers over 2425m on 22 January. Capable of earning some minor money
- **6. KSAR DU CORTA -** Has disqualification issues and faulted at Nantes on 13 January. Capable of bouncing back to score if smart this time
- **7. KOPERNIC DAIRPET -** In good form and was runner-up last time out at Angers over 2425m on 22 January. Not out of it
- **8. KRONOS SMART -** Has struck form with two wins in a row, with the latest being in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. Can complete the hat-trick

Summary: KRONOS SMART (8) has won his last two starts and both of them in Mounted races. He looked good when scoring at Rouen-Mauquenchy and can complete the hat-trick. KAIROUAN GLAM (3) is clearly very hard to trust but can be competitive if wise this time around. KANKAL (4) is better than his last run would suggest and he can make the frame. KOPERNIC DAIRPET (7) is in good form and has a winning chance too.

- **2. KATSUMOTO -** Unreliable and finished 12th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 23 January. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **3. KEVISAN -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 5 January. Unreliable but is distance-suited and capable of winning
- **4. KANT -** In good form and finished third in Class D at this track over 2700m on 23 January. Not out of it in this line-up
- **5. KOZIELLO DE LOU -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 29 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **6. KAMOUR -** Unreliable but was a barefoot winner last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 12 January. Unshod again and is not out of it
- **7. KAN DURAN -** Disappointing last run when 9th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 23 January. More is needed to beat these rivals

KAMOUR (6) was an unshod winner over this course and distance last time out and remains barefoot so he is an obvious danger. KHARNAS (1) has only been modest of late but will do better this distance.

- **2. BOURBONISTA -** Has ability and was victorious at Jägersro over 2140m on 18 January. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **3. FRANCESINA ORS -** Usually competitive and was barefoot and fourth in Class D over this track and trip on 25 January. Can follow up
- **4. FAST EQUOS JET -** Disqualified last time out at Florence Visorno on 21 January. Won her penultimate start and could earn some minor money
- **5. LONG LEGEND** Disqualified last time out at this track on 20 January. Unreliable and others are preferred this time
- **6. LUNA PARK -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class C over this course and distance on 31 December. Should be involved with the finish yet again
- **7. LADY DU CHENE -** Did not show her best when 6th in Class B at this track over 2100m on 20 January. In good form before that and has a winning chance
- **8. LA VIVA DE LOU -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 31 December. Not easily to trust but is capable of scoring when wise
- **9. FASHION GRIF -** Unreliable but was a winner Florence over 1600m on 21 January. Tougher task this time but is not out of it

Summary: FRANCESINA ORS (3) ran well on local debut and gets a narrow vote to score with improvement expected. LADY DU CHENE (7) did not show her best last time out but was doing well before that and has a winning chance if back at her best. FASHION GRIF (9) won in Italy last time out but this does look a tougher race. She remains an intriguing candidate. LUNA PARK (6) was not disgraced over this track and trip in December and deserves some respect.

- **3. HAUTE COTE DE NUIT -** Did not show his best when 8th in Class C at this track over 2850m on 23 January. Better this distance and can bounce to win
- **4. FIRST LADY BLEUE -** On a very long losing run and finished 7th in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 17 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. HIRONDELLE FEE -** Disqualified at this track last time out on 19 January. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- **6. HOLLY D'ECHAL -** Has really struggled of late and finished 13th in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 13 January. Others are much preferred
- **7. IVANJICA DE LOU -** Disqualified last time out at Nantes on 26 January. Unreliable and others make more appeal

- **3. HOTKATISSIME -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 11 January. Might play a minor role
- **4. HELIUM DE L'ITON -** Finished 7th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 26 January. Has disqualification issues but would not be a surprise winner
- **5. FAUCON DE L'ALBA -** Has struggled of late and finished 11th in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 January. Others are preferred
- **6. GET UP DES PLAINES -** On a long losng run but is in good shape and was third last time out in a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 11 January. Be right there at the finish
