- **1. LA CHENEVIERE -** Sanctioned in last 5, latterly a 2875m Enghien Class D 10 days ago, and can expect to have few takers
- **2. LUCKY LADY D'AMOUR -** Returns to the code after finishing 9th of 10 in a 2875m Enghien harness Class E 10 days ago, but already looks out of her depth
- **3. LOU DE LANGE -** 4th of 6 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class E early last month. Has solid monte references but may be taking on too much this time
- **4. LOUISIANE LEMAN -** Runner-up in 3 of last 4, all under harness, most recently a 2150m Argentan Class E on 19 March. Has good speed which will do her chances no disservice. Place chance
- **5. LUTECIA ELLIS -** Sanctioned, on return to competition, in a 2575m Agen harness Class E mid-March. Has yet to disappoint in this branch of the game and is not about to start now. Chance
- **6. LOUISIANE KERYVON -** Given time to recalibrate after running 6th of 7 finishers in a 2700m Class D here on 17 February. In the thick of things for the most part and represents a respectable first-5 prospect

A winner over the main track before faulting across town, a reconfigured LACIENDA FLASH (10) enjoys a good entry here and debuts in the discipline with a decent hand to play.

- **2. LARIFLETTE** Fine servant in this category, most recently 3rd of 7 finishers to LOZEN DE BANVILLE (4) in a 2875m Enghien claimer on 11 March. Has yet to deliver over 2100m of the short course but in current form is easy to like
- **3. L'ARC EN CIEL -** Modest individual making first appearance since running 9th of 16 to LARIFLETTE (2) in a 2150m Enghien claimer last October. Good draw but still no chance
- **4. LOZEN DE BANVILLE -** Tenacious winner of a 2875m Enghien claimer on 11 March. Is in her category and should be good enough to bring the fight to LIKE A BIRD STAR (6)
- **5. LA MOME -** 9th of 11 in a 2700m Cagnes Class C on 26 February. Has done nothing noteworthy for some time and can be confidently ruled out
- **6. LIKE A BIRD STAR -** Flew up in a 2150m Cagnes Class D late-February. Drops down the category-ladder and, considering the draw, should have the measure of the field
- **7. LE CAP -** Disappointing of late, most recently sanctioned in 11 March race of reference, and has no realistic chance
- **8. LAYLA -** 6th of 7 finishers to LOZEN DE BANVILLE (4) in a 2875m Enghien claimer on 11 March and will need to show marked improvement
- **9. LADRA DI MALAVITA -** 7th in race of reference before being disqualified over 2300m at Mons last Saturday. Has little going her way here and others easier to back

She is going to be opposed though by the better-positioned LOZEN DE BANVILLE (4) who scored at this level across town last month, and claiming specialist LARIFLETTE (2) who ran 3rd to her that day. LEGYPTIA DE GUEZ (11) is on the way back up following a lengthy absence and benefits from an Eric Raffin drive.

- **2. KIKI DU ROC -** 5th of 10 to KOPECK DE CHENU (9) in a 2875m Enghien Class D 3 weeks ago. Always gives his best but that is unlikely to be enough this time
- **3. KASSANDRA WIND -** Makes ridden bow after running 9th of 16 on comeback in a 2875m Enghien harness Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Sports modified shoeing but still looks out of her depth
- **4. KRACK CLEA -** Opened his monte account here before running 10th of 16 in a 2700m harness Class D conditioner here a week ago. Shod as he was late-February and although untried over the inner course, can still play an active role
- **5. KADOR DU MONT -** 2nd of 13, on monte debut, in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 16 March. Will have come on for the run and considering his ability under harness, can expect to finish in the mix
- **6. KENYAN BLUES -** Quickly sanctioned in a 2450m Caen Class D a month back, after having twice come 2nd over main track. Reverts to that formula and even though in better company should not be written off
- **7. KINDY PERRINE -** 4th at Enghien before coming 2nd of 4 finishers in a 2850m Class D here a week ago. Won only start under these conditions but faces the boys this time and chances limited

- **2. IBIS D'AUVRECY -** 8th of 18, on first start after a spell, in a 2850m Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne 10 days ago. Can trot but not with success at this level of competition
- **3. HARRY D'OURVILLE -** 4th of 14 in a 2850m Laval Class E mid-February, his first start since April 2023. Will have progressed for the run and debuts for new trainer with a lot to contribute. Chance
- **4. JOKER CASTILUANNE -** Going well before faulting in a 2875m Enghien Class E 3 weeks ago. Is patently in fine form and will not be far off the mark if he stays focused
- **5. IDEAL DU CAPMAY -** Imposed at Argentan before running 5th of 14 in a 3000m Nantes Class E late-February. Is new to Vincennes but has bags of ability and can play a role if he takes to the new profile
- **6. HEART OF GLASS -** Useful but erratic type making first appearance since finishing last of 10 in a 2650m Marseille-Vivaux Class E in November. Stays shod and best to keep one's powder dry
- **7. IERMES DE GUEZ -** Quality element that was sanctioned on re-entry in a Class C over course and distance late-February. Seldom disappoints when focused and although preferred barefoot, he can still get a look-in

Summary: An exceptional horse that has yet to be defeated when barefoot, JE TE CHERCHE (11) just missed out on the hat-trick here at the end of February and after a good month to get back in shape, he should take take all the beating. Damien Bonne looks the most likely to thwart Theo Duvaldestin's plan with JANKO HAUFOR (8) who made short work of an Enghien Class D last month. HARRY D'OURVILLE (3) breaks with a 25m head-start and the presence of Eric Raffin in the bike bodes well for his chances. JOKER CASTILUANNE (4) is a tough nut when focused and David Thomain will be eager to put things right.

- **2. LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE -** Sanctioned in 4 of last 5, most recently when in the running for a cheque in a Class D under these conditions a week ago. Others easier to trust but is not one to be underestimated
- **3. LORD FROMENTRO -** Good class of trotter that was quickly sanctioned in a 2100m Class C here 2 weeks ago. Form is not in question and can play an active role if Théo Duvaldestin keeps him trotting
- **4. LE MAC -** Disappointing last of 7, a place behind LENSOIS DU DOLLAR (5), in a 2100m Class C here on 21 March, and can expect to remain friendless in the markets
- **5. LENSOIS DU DOLLAR -** Last but one in a 2100m Class C here on 21 March and would be preferred under the saddle
- **6. LE GENTLEMAN -** Opened his 2025 account when dominating a 2875m Enghien Class D early last month. Benjamin Rochard gets the nod once more and will be competitive for a repeat
- **7. LION SUR MER -** Complemented Chateaubriant victory when securing success in a Class D over course and distance on 23 February. Has had time to fully recover and the 3-timer is well within his capacity
- **8. LIQUIDATEUR -** Made up for February sanction when 2nd of 13 in a Class D over track and trip a week ago, and can trot his way into the picture if Léo Abrivard keeps him focused

- **3. KRONOS JULINO -** Returns to Vincennes after comfortably winning a 2650m Laval Class E a month ago. Takes on a superior lot this time though and a minor place chance at best
- **4. KOWEIT DE CHENU -** 7th of 13 behind KANCALAIS (11) when preparing for this in a Class D over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Is confirmed over 2700m here and on good behaviour will be competitive at the business end of the race
- **5. KILIMANDJARO PLAYA -** Quality campaigner that ran 9th of 11 on re-entry in a 2650m Bordeaux Class E on 8 March. Still in conditioning-mode though and best to hold off
- **6. KAYNE RICHER -** Won a brace before coming 3rd of 14, a place behind KABOTIN CHENEVIERE (12), in a 2850m Laval Class E on 12 March. Gets to race barefoot for first time and Benjamin Rochard will have his sights set on the silverware
- **7. KING FROMENTRO -** Picked up after the spell where he left off, latterly 2nd of 14 in a 2450m Caen Class E on 10 March. Tends to go well over the main track and although unlikely to impose, can still finish in the mix

- **3. LET ME WIN -** Improving sort returning to Paris after coming 2nd of 12 in a 2750m Toulouse Class D on 19 February. Sports a new configuration, is ideally-positioned onthe front line, and must be taken seriously
- **4. LONDON DELO -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Class D here late-February. Has been off her porridge for some time though and chances appear slim
- **5. LAMTARA BUISSONAY -** Returns to racing barefoot after finishing last of 8 in a 2875m Enghien Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Enjoys a good spot behind the car and is not to be ruled out
- **6. LOVINA PERRINE -** Flew up over the inner course prior to faulting when competitive in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 11 March. Starts in front and with application can make this her own
- **7. LOVE ME AGAIN -** Serious filly making first appearance since being disqualified from winning a 2850m Class D here late-November. Boss in the bike this time and can impose if he manages to keep her mind on the job at hand
- **8. LADY POP -** Pleasant 5th of 11 on comeback in a 2150m Argentan Class E on 19 March. Shoes off for first time, with Eric Raffin in the bike, and will justifiably garner support

- **4. INHERIT -** Classy trotter that returned to victorious ways in a 2875m Enghien Class D on 14 March. Excels with the day's driver and has every chance of confirming
- **5. IN LOVE DE JIEL -** Got back in the game when 3rd of 11 to INHERIT (4) in a 2875m Enghien Class D 3 weeks ago. Unlikely to get his nose in front but can still challenge for a place on the podium

- **13. HEUREUX DE BOUERE -** Beaten 3rd of 15 in a 2100m Class D here on 1 March. Goes over any trip, is plainly in good shape, but may just be taking on too much this time
- **14. HELENCIO -** Produced a good return effort when 5th of 15 behind HEUREUX DE BOUERE (13) in a 2100m Class D here on 1 March. Will have come on for the run and should not be overlooked
- **15. ELEVEN SHAPTER -** Has not been seen out since running 9th of 15 behind GALIA SOTHO (8) in a 2750m Cabourg Class D mid-December and will have nothing to contribute
- **16. GAROU DU CHENE -** 6th of 16 in a 2850m Class D here on 20 February. Has won in both disciplines under these conditions, enjoys a good entry, and it would be foolhardy to write him off

Summary: Simply dynamic with Eric Raffin in the bike, INHERIT (4) ran out a determined winner at Enghien 3 weeks ago and confirming will be the only thing on the champion driver's mind. He will still be legitimately wary of the rehabilitated HIMBERLAND (11) who ran him close that day, and the remarkable ILCAPITANO DU PARC (7) who has won 4 of his last 5. IN LOVE DE JIEL (5) defied his odds in the race of reference and David Thomain will be keen to see how much more he can give. IOUPY TOLLEVILLE (1) steps back up in class but has similarly won 4 of his last 5 and is easy to recommend for a place in the frame.
