#### C1 - PRIX EUROPOLE DE COMPETITIVITE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

- LASCO DE LOU Disqualified in both starts, with the latest being at Saint-Omer on 13 April.
  Capable of better but others are much preferred
- **2. LYNYRD SKYNYRD HOA -** Showed improvement and was 5th last time out in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 13 April. Barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
- **3. LETS DANCE KALOUMA -** Has disqualification issues and was faulted last time out at Nancy on 21 April. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- **4. LILIUM TUILERIE -** Not easy to trust and was unplaced last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 28 April. Might play a minor role
- **5. LEGATO -** Disqualified in his last five starts, with the latest being at Cabourg on 26 October. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- **6. LADY DU PERCHE -** Holding form well and was fourth in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 April. Can earn some more money
- 7. LARIANA CLEVILLE Has improved with a each run this year and was victorious in Class G at Cherbourg over 2625m on 6 April. Has a winning chance
- **8. L'OR BLANC -** Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 28 April. Can make the frame
- **9. LAURYN JIEL -** Disqualified last time out at Reims on 24 April. Did better in some mounted races before that and can be a real threat to these rivals
- **10. LOVER DIVIN -** Yet to win a race and was tenth in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 6 April. Did better earlier this year and is capable of earning some money
- **11. LOOK DU PARCQ** Has disqualification issues but was a winner last time out in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 13 April. Not easy to trust but can follow up
- **12. LA GARBO -** Very unreliable and was 6th in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 26 March. Has a place chance on best form
- **13. LEO JIEL -** Disqualified last time out at Reims on 16 April. A winner of his penultimate start and can bounce back to beat these rivals
- **14. LILOU D'ATOUT -** Has struggled of late and was 12th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. Did better last year and others are preferred

**Summary:** LÉO JIEL (13) fluffed his lines with a disqualification at Reims but is better judged on his penultimate start win and can bounce back to beat these rivals. LOOK DU PARCQ (11) reminded us of his ability with a good win last time out, though disqualification remains a concern. LARIANA CLEVILLE (7) remains in good form and would not be a surprise winner. LAURYN JIEL (9) let her supporters down with a disqualification last time but is another to consider.

- **2. MURPHY DU PONCELET -** A good winner on debut, in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 13 April. Can follow up in this line-up
- **3. MY AMERICA** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Reims over 2500m on 24 April. Could make the frame
- **4. MONEY DI MALAVITA -** Showed what he is capable of with a Class F win at Amiens over 2400m on 7 April. Improving and can contest the finish
- **5. MASSILIO BLOND -** Much improved and was runner-up in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 29 April. Can get into the mix of things again
- **6. MADISON SEVEN -** Showed improvement to score second time out, in Class E at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 20 April. Can double up
- **7. MISS JENILOU -** Has struggled this year and was 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 15 April. Others are much preferred
- **8. MAXOU DES IFS -** Has lost his way with disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Vincennes on 15 April. Needs major improvement to win

**Summary:** MADISON SEVEN (6) is improving and was a good winner at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle last month; another success would not be a surprise. MURPHY DU PONCELET (2) did all that was asked of him on debut and can remain unbeaten over a similar distance. MONEY DI MALAVITA (4) won over a shorter trip last time and deserves consideration in this line-up. MATRIONA (1) was not disgraced on debut and is capable of improvement, though she does face a stronger field here.

- **2. LA CALLAS -** Unreliable but was runner-up in Class F at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre over 3000m on 27 April. Might play a minor role
- **3. LIBERTY ZEN -** In good form and was third last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 7 April. Should fight out the finish
- **4. LA MAGIE DU PERSIL -** Yet to win a race but is holding form and was fourth in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 24 April. Can earn some more minor money
- **5. LILI BROAY -** Disqualified last time out at Reims on 16 April. A mixed bag of form and others are preferred this time
- **6. LOU DE LOSQUE -** Disqualified at Chartres last time out on 13 April. Unreliable but is capable of an upset on best form

**Summary:** LIBERTY ZEN (3) starts from a good position, is in solid form, and gets a narrow vote to score. LUCIA DE BUSSET (16) fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time but had an impressive winning streak at Mons and deserves respect. LATIFA OASIS (9) continues to improve and can follow up on a good win at this course over a similar distance last month. LA PERLA DE LOU (1) has yet to win but is getting closer and remains a threat.

- **1. LEADER TURGOT -** Has major disqualification issues but was runner-up in class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 April. Hard to trust but is capable of winning
- **2. LE ROI DES BRIERES -** Only modest of late and was 5th in class E at Caen over 2200m on 26 April. Probably needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **3. LE DIAMANT DE JAFA -** Victorious in Class F at this track over 2750m on 21 April. In very good form and can score again at this course
- **4. LEAD ME ON -** In good form and was third in class F at Reims over 2500m on 24 April. Should contest the finish again
- **5. LUPIN DE CHIMAY -** Victorious in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 15 March. Very consistent and can be competitive once again
- **6. LUIGI SALICE -** Finished 5th in class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 10 November. Likely to need this run returning from a break

- **3. JOLIE AMARLOUICA -** Disqualified in a class G at Cordemais over 2650m on 20 April. Must be wise to have a chance in this line-up
- **4. J'ADORE BLUE -** Fifth in a class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 13 April. Others are much preferred in this line-up
