

R6 VICHY [R-H]

C1 - SPEED CUP TOUR 2026 - ELIMINATOIR (GR A) - 1609m (a1m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 25,000

- 1. IPPON DE MONTCEAU** - Finished fourth in a class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 May. Not reliable but is capable of contesting the finish
- 2. INESKA** - Very consistent and finished fourth in a class D at this track over 1609m on 28 May. Better over a bit further but is a real threat
- 3. GRANIT DU FRESNE** - Has struggled of late and finished unplaced in a class D at Feurs over 2225m on 12 June. Remains barefoot and needs to do more to score
- 4. GALOPIN DE BIANCA** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class D over this tack and trip on 28 May. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
- 5. ISEO DE LOU** - Did not show his best when 7th in a class D at Feurs over 2225m on 12 June. Remains barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 6. FILOU DE SITA** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class A at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Has a place chance on best form
- 7. JOIE DE LA COTE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a class D at Feurs over 2225m on 12 June. Reverts to barefoot and could make the frame
- 8. IN YOUR EYES** - Battling to find best form and was unplaced in a claimer at this track over 2800m on 1 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: A good start to the meeting. Unbeaten over this distance, ISEO DE LOU (5) looks to have been targeted for this Speed Cup and should, barring any mishap, secure qualification for the Final. INESKA (2), faultless in recent months, will lead the opposition alongside IPPON DE MONTCEAU (1), who is effective with autostart conditions, and JOIE DE LA COTE (7), who should be well suited by the track and trip.

C2 - SPEED CUP TOUR 2026 - ELIMINATOIR (GR B) - 1609m (a1m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 25,000

- 1. HARLEQUIN** - Returned to form and finished third in a class D over this track and trip on 28 May. Big chance in this line-up
- 2. JOOST D'OLERON** - In good shape and was third in a class D at Feurs over 2225m on 12 June. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 3. JERZINHO SPORT** - Usually competitive and finished fourth in a class D at Caen over 2450m on 10 June. Can get into the mix of things yet again
- 4. IDYLLE DU PERSIL** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class D at Feurs over 2225m on 12 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some money when smart
- 5. HELECHO** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class D at Feurs over 2225m on 12 June. Capable of being competitive once again
- 6. GAVROCHE DE L'ITON** - Did not show his best when unplaced in a class B at Hyeres over 2650m on 16 June. Reverts to barefoot and could play a minor role
- 7. IRON D'ESPOIR** - Did not show his best when unplaced in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 13 June. Remains barefoot and was a good winner before that. Not out of it
- 8. INTELLO DE CHENU** - Not reliable but was fourth in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 June. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: Last time over this course and distance, HARLEQUIN (1) produced a superb finishing effort and could return to winning ways if he gets away better. JOOST D'OLERON (2) has shown admirable consistency and, even racing with a lighter shoeing setup, should be capable of making the frame. HELECHO (5), a runner-up over this track and distance in May can contest he finish once again. IRON D'ESPOIR (7) meets more suitable opposition here and deserves some respect.

C3 - PRIX DE SAINT ANGEL - 2800m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. NIKITA DE MAGNY** - Not reliable and finished fourth in Class D at Hyères over 2650m on 16 June. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 2. NORMA DU BOCAGE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at Feurs over 2875m on 12 June. Has a place chance on best form
- 3. NAMOUR DE LA MOIRE** - Improving and was runner-up in Class E at this course over 2150m on 13 June. Can go one place better
- 4. NUNZIATA** - Yet to score and was disqualified last time out in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 9 June. Did better last year and is capable of earning some money
- 5. NOVERRIO** - Successful last time out in Class F at this course over 2150m on 16 May. Showed improvement and could double up
- 6. NUMBER ONE MADRIK** - Disqualified last time out in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2950m on 30 June. Consistent before that and could earn some money if smart
- 7. NAPOLEON AS** - Finished in Class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 17 December. Returns from a break but could score if fit enough
- 8. NYNO DE TROUVILLE** - In good form and was runner-up in Class F at Écommoy over 2750m on 20 June. Should contest the finish

Summary: NAPOLEON AS (7) competed in much stronger company at Vincennes late last year. Although absent since December, his connections have given him a positive signal and he could well open his account. NAMOUR DE LA MOIRE (3) has made a solid start to his career and, well drawn behind the car, can challenge for top honours. NOVERRIO (5), a recent winner on this track is a threat, and NIKITA DE MAGNY (1), who always gives her best is another to consider.

C4 - PRIX DE SAINT PRIX - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. **MADEMOISELLE KEY** - Not reliable and finished 9th in Class E over this track and trip on 13 June. Can bounce back and be a threat to these rivals
2. **MIRAGE QUICK** - A barefoot winner last time out in Class F at Carpentras over 2100m on 31 May. Unreliable but might well double up
3. **MERCURY JIEL** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 20 June. Can get involved with the finish once again
4. **MANON DES CHAMPS** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalarnonne over 2700m on 25 May. Can contest the finish
5. **MAMBA SOMOLLI** - Not reliable and finished unplaced in Class F at Durtal over 2850m on 21 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **MUMBAY CHOISIE** - Remains in very good form and was third in Class E at Agen-la-Garenne over 2625m on 30 May. Big chance in this line-up
7. **MY NAME IS CHENU** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class F at Durtal over 2825m on 21 June. Should be a threat to these rivals
8. **MUSE DU LOISIR** - Disqualified three times in a row, including last time out in Class E at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2650m on 28 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
9. **MOELAND** - Disqualified in three of five starts, including last time out in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 27 June. Can contest the finish when smart
10. **MIDNIGHT OIL** - Finished 6th in Class F at this course over 2800m on 10 June. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of earning some money
11. **MUST WINNER** - Disqualified in four of five starts, including last time out at Orléans over 3400m on 7 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred

Summary: MUMBAY CHOISIE (6) has been faultless since returning to competition this year and looks a serious contender. MANON DES CHAMPS (4) performed well when runner-up at Châtillon-sur-Chalarnonne while shod and, racing barefoot this time, can do even better this time around. MERCURY JIEL (3), who is on the upgrade has to be considered and MY NAME IS CHENU (7), prepared by connections who enjoy success at this track can also shine.

C5 - PRIX DE SAINT VICTOR - 1609m (a1m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **LAO DE NAPPES** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class F at Jullianges over 2425m on 21 June. Remains barefoot and more is needed to score
2. **LINO DU POMMEREUX** - Unreliable and finished third in a claimer at Eauze over 3025m on 22 June. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
3. **LAPON DE BERTRANGE** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class F at this track over 2950m on 10 June. Dropping in distance and could contest the finish
4. **LUCCIANO D'OMAHA** - Unreliable and finished fourth in a class F at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Might play a minor role at very best
5. **LATINO TURGOT** - Finished fourth in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 27 June. Remains barefoot but has yet to win a race. Might place
6. **LORD SAINT MARTIN** - Disqualified three times in last five starts, including last time out in a class F at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Remains barefoot and can bounce back to score
7. **LUXOR D'ECAJEUL** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 25 May. Tries barefoot and could earn some money
8. **LORD PAGUERIE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F at Les Sables- D' Olonne over 2775m on 27 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
9. **LIPTON DE CLERCE** - Holding form and was fourth in a class F at this track over 2950m on 13 June. Remains barefoot and should be a threat to these rivals
10. **LAGOS** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class F at Craon over 2775m on 21 June. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: LORD SAINT MARTIN (6) is talented but never entirely free from the risk of an error. If he keeps his stride from start to finish, he has the ability to see them all off. LAPON DE BERTRANGE (3) finished very close to our selection on 28 May, will lead the opposition and will be very competitive once again. LIPTON DE CLERCE (9), now with two runs under his belt is capable of striking. LINO DU POMMEREUX (2), once again racing barefoot can hit the board.

C6 - PRIX RAOUL ET NOEL BUSSET - 1609m (a1m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **LOLITA DE JEMAX** - Yet to win a race but was fourth in a Class F mounted race at this course over 2950m on 15 June. Might play a minor role at very best
2. **LALA QUICK** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in Class F at Le Dorat over 2725m on 14 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
3. **LADY D'ALEX** - Has only been moderate of late and was 7th in Class F at Jullianges over 2450m on 21 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
4. **LAZIZA JASMA** - Finished 6th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 11 June. Quite capable of making the frame if at best
5. **LOLITA DE VITRAY** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class F at this course over 2950m on 10 June. Not out of it on best form
6. **L'ETINCELLE** - In good form and finished third in Class E at Bernay over 2800m on 28 June. Unreliable but can contest the finish
7. **LOUNA D'AUVILLIER** - Returned to form and finished third in Class F at Hyères over 2650m on 16 June. Should contest the finish
8. **LOLITA DES CHAMPS** - Battling to regain best form and was 9th in a claimer at Jullianges over 2450m on 21 June. Needs major improvement to score
9. **LADY D'ELFE** - Showed some improvement when third in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Can be competitive once again
10. **LADY DES GRAVELS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at this track over 2950m on 24 June. Can earn some minor money
11. **LINDSEY DE NICE** - Not reliable and was disqualified last time out at Jullianges over 2425m on 21 June. Tries a lot shorter and others are preferred

Summary: L'ETINCELLE (6) has never finished worse than third when racing barefoot and could well return to winning ways. However, she will need to be wary of LOUNA D'AUVILLIER (7), who made a striking impression at Hyères, and LADY D'ELFE (9), partnered by Jean-Michel Bazire for the occasion. LAZIZA JASMA (4) has recently changed stables and has been handed a good draw behind the car. If all goes well, she can also get involved with the finish.

C8 - PRIX DE SAINT PRIEST EN MURAT - 1609m (a1m) - Class G - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. KOBALT** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 20 June. Reverts to barefoot and could challenge for top honours
- 2. KEMER SI** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a class F at this track over 2150m on 15 June. Capable of earning some minor money
- 3. KILLER ZOFÉ** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class F at this track over 2150m on 15 June. Remains barefoot and could be a threat in this line-up if smart
- 4. KINGLY DREAMS** - Battling to regain best form and was 10th in a class E at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Needs to do more to score
- 5. KILLER DE MILLAC** - Disqualified in a class G at this track over 2800m on 28 May. Remains barefoot and is often competitive. Has claims in this line-up
- 6. KAID GRIFF** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 June. Capable of making the frame when staying in stride
- 7. KAID DE MORGE** - A winner of a class H mounted race at Montlucon-Neris-les-Bains over 3025m on 7 June. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- 8. KILLER CRUZ** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class F at Jullianges over 2425m on 21 June. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
- 9. KONG** - In good shape and was third at Angouleme over 2750m on 14 June. Reverts to barefoot but tackles tougher this time
- 10. KESARO FIRST** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Niort over 2475m on 7 June. Reverts to barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race. KILLER DE MILLAC (5) showed promise in the spring and now benefits with a good draw behind the car. KILLER ZOFÉ (3) makes his second start for Charley Mottier and is expected to improve with each outing. He can get into the mix of things this time. KOBALT (1) made a strong impression when winning at Bordeaux earlier this year so deserves respect. KAID GRIFF (6), is capable of bouncing back and contesting the finish.
