R3 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'OPALE - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR
€ 26,000**

- 1. MONA LISA GEDE** - Disqualified in a class F over this course and distance on 30 December. Tries barefoot and is capable of playing a minor role
- 2. MOON DES GARENNES** - In good shape and was runner-up in class F over this course and distance on 30 December.. Has a place chance
- 3. MAJORELLE** - Disqualified in class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. Has won twice in four starts and can be a serious threat when smart
- 4. MISS MARGOT** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class B at Toulouse over 2950m on 19 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 5. MOON DU VIVIER** - Unbeaten in three starts, the latest in class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. Tries barefoot and can win again
- 6. MEGANE DE CERISY** -
- 7. MADE IN ATALANTE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 December. Capable of contesting the finish
- 8. MANZANA ERA** - Unreliable and finished 6th at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. Tries barefoot and could make the frame
- 9. MACARENA D'HOULBEC** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class C at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 11 December. Tries barefoot and could earn some more money
- 10. MOOREA** - A runner-up in class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 30 November. Tries barefoot and can be a lively danger but does come with disqualification issues
- 11. MY WAY LEAGABIN** - Not reliable and finished fourth in class D over this track and trip on 13 December. Tries barefoot but needs to do more to win

Summary: MOON DU VIVIER (5) remains undefeated after three starts. She will be barefoot this time and can add a fourth win to her tally. MAJORELLE (3) does come with disqualification issues, but she is talented and can be a real threat to that rival if staying on the trot all the way through. MADE IN ATALANTE (7) may need to find a few lengths to beat those two rivals but can make the frame. MOOREA (10) is not easy to trust but races without shoes and can contest the finish.

C2 - PRIX DE LA COTE VERMEILLE - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. METEORE DU VIVIER** - A runner-up in class E over this track and trip on 23 December. Races without shoes and did win her first two starts. Big chance
- 2. MINOS DE BERLES** - Did not show her best when 6th in class C at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 11 December. Tries barefoot and contest the finish
- 3. MACAO MIP** - A runner-up in class D over this track and distance on 13 December. Be right there at the finish once again
- 4. MISTRAL DE LARRE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 3 December. Hard to trust but is capable of winning when smart
- 5. MYSTERE DE L'AVRE** - Only modest and finished 6th in class C at this track over 2700m on 27 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 6. MICHIGAN HAWK** - Finished 10th in class B at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 10 October. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
- 7. MISTER MAGIC** - In good shape and finished third in a class C at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 11 December. Has a place chance
- 8. MIGUEL DU CHERISAY** - Holding form and finished fourth in class C at this track over 2700m on 27 December. Races without shoes and can be a threat

Summary: A competitive-looking race. METEORE DU VIVIER (1) suffered a first defeat last time out over this course and distance a few weeks ago. He is barefoot this time and was a good winner of his first two starts, so gets the vote to score. MINOS DE BERLES (2) races without shoes, so will do better than his last run would suggest and can be a lively danger. MIGUEL DU CHERISAY (8) is consistent and is also barefoot and ready to strike. MACAO MIP (3) is also capable of getting into the ,ox of things.

C3 - PRIX DE LA COTE SAINT ANDRE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. NOSTRA DE L'ETRE** - Disqualified on debut in class F at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 2. NYAKA** - Much improved last run when runner-up in class F at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Can go one better
- 3. NIMEO FLOWER** - Threatening to win and was third in class F over this track and trip on 23 December. Be right there at the finish
- 4. NORIA DE BERTRANGE** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 8 November. Could make the frame
- 5. NAPOLI DU BOUFFEY** - Not reliable and finished fourth in class D at Amiens over 2400m on 9 December. Has a place chance in this field
- 6. NEO WYNN** - Finished third on debut in class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 8 November. Can be a danger once again
- 7. NOBLE BARRA** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in class E at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 1 October. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- 8. NIKOS VISAIS** - Improving and was runner-up in class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Could earn some more money
- 9. NISSA STAR** - Disqualified in all four start so far, the latest in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 3 December. Best watched for now

Summary: NYAKA (2) showed good improvement last time out at this track. David Békaert sticks with her and she can go one place better this time around. NIMÉO FLOWER (3) is threatening to win and should be involved at the finish yet again. NOBLE BARRA (7) returns from a break but, if fit enough, is quite capable of a winning turn. NEO WYNN (6) ran well on debut and is likely to improve, so is not out of it.

- 1. IDEM JIHEM** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class over this track and trip on 20 December. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- 2. IRIS RIVOISE** - Not disgraced when fifth in class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 13 December. Reverts to barefoot and can be competitive
- 3. IDEM DU PONT** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including at Avenches over 2350m on 17 November. Reverts to barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 4. IMHOTEP FROMENTRO** -
- 5. ILLICO DU JAS** - Very consistent and was third in class C at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 11 December. Be right there at the finish
- 6. HANA D'OCCAGNES** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 1 December. Needs to do more to score
- 7. HUGO DU BOURG** - A winner of a class E at Amiens over 2900m on 9 December. Not reliable but cannot be ruled out either
- 8. ILLICO DE CASTELLE** - Not reliable but was fourth in class D over this course and distance on 20 December. Could earn some minor money
- 9. HELIOT DE GACHERE** - Much improved last tun when runner-up in class E at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Can go one better
- 10. HASHTAG DE TAGOR** - Not reliable and finished fifth in class E at this track over 2925m on 23 December. More is needed to win this race
- 11. HARENA DE MARZY** - Disqualified in class D over this course and distance on 20 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 12. IF YOU CAN** - Only modest of late and was fifth in class C at this track over 2925m on 18 December. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 13. IMPARTIAL** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in class C at this track over 2925m on 27 December. Needs to do more to score
- 14. HAYASTAN DE ROSAN** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class E at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Needs major improvement to win
- 15. GIRLY VICTORY** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in class E at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 16. HAPPY D'AIMTE** - Not disgraced when third in class E at this track over 2925m on 13 December. Might play a minor role

Summary: A very open race. IDEM DU PONT (3) is barefoot and makes a long trip for this race, so has a narrow vote to score. IRIS RIVOISE (2) is racing without shoes, so improvement is likely and some success is a possibility. ILLICO DU JAS (5) has been very competitive of late and should fight out the finish yet again. IDEM JIHEM (1) has only been moderate of late but is capable of getting involved with the finish.

**C5 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'AMOUR - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness -
EUR € 22,000**

- 1. LUTIN QUICK** - Victorious in Class E at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 November. Talented but remains hard to trust. Drops in distance but can follow up
- 2. LE MARGINAL** - Faulted last time at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 4 November. In good form before that and is not out of it if smart
- 3. LEADER RASTID** - Unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class F at this track over 2925m on 30 December. Can be competitive
- 4. LELOUP VALLEE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 20 December. Might play a minor role at best
- 5. LUCKY ARCTIC** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class F at Nimes over 2775m on 11 November. Needs improvement to score
- 6. LIKE THAT** - Not reliable but was a winner last time out in Class F at Marseille-Vivieux over 2675m on 29 November. Can double up
- 7. LA LIFE** - Very consistent and finished third in Class F at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 4 December. Can earn some more money
- 8. LUCKY MIX** - Disqualified at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 27 October. Not reliable and could need this run returning from a break
- 9. LUXY DE CRENNES** - Unreliable but was fourth in Class F at this course over 2925m on 30 December. Hard to trust but might play a minor role
- 10. LIBERTIN MAZA** - A barefoot winner last time out in Class F at Marseille-Vivieux over 2675m on 11 December. Remains without shoes and can score again
- 11. LOOK DES VALLEES** - Did not show his best when unplaced in Class E at this course over 2925m on 19 December. Might earn some money if smart
- 12. LUTIN D'HERMES** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Marseille-Vivieux over 2675m on 4 December. Others make more appeal
- 13. LILLY DE GOUYE** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2925m on 30 December. Battling to regain best form and others are preferred
- 14. LASKA DU LIVIER** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at this track over 2925m on 30 December. Might play a minor role
- 15. LISTAO** - Disqualified last time out at Graignes over 2700m on 30 November. Not reliable and others are preferred
- 16. LUTECE SMART** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in Class F at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 4 December. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: LUTIN QUICK (1) does come with disqualification issues but was a good winner at Mauquenchy in November and could follow up if in the same mood. LIKE THAT (6) was successful at Marseille-Vivieux last time out and can double up, but is not reliable. LIBERTIN MAZA (10) picked up a barefoot win last month and remains without shoes, so is a danger. LEADER RASTID (3) is another that is not easy to trust but is also clearly not out of it.

- 1. IBANA DE MONTI** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest in Class F at this track over 2150m on 30 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. JAZZ BUROIS** - A winner of his last four starts, the latest in Class F at this track over 2150m on 30 December. Can add another success to the tally
- 3. HORACE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at this track over 2150m on 30 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. ICARE DES CHAMPS** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 11 December. Others are preferred
- 5. JOSE DU CHERISAY** - A runner-up in his last five starts, the latest in Class G at this track over 2700m on 30 December. Can go one place better
- 6. JUP AND STAR** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2675m on 11 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. INTERMEDE DU RIL** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 4 December. Capable of being more competitive and is not out of it
- 8. IDEE D'AMOUR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class G at this track over 2700m on 18 December Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 9. JUNIOR DU VIVIER** - Victorious in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 18 November. Consistent and can get into the mix of things
- 10. JALISCO DE NEUVY** - Battling to find best form but was 5th in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 28 December. Might play a minor role
- 11. JONGLEUSE DE BRY** - Needed the last run when 9th in Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 21 December. Barefoot this time and can bounce back to score
- 12. JOSS CAPELLO** - Disqualified last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 23 December. Two good wins before that and can bounce back to score
- 13. HIGH TECH ROC** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class E over this course and distance on 23 December. Others make more appeal
- 14. IBIZA EVENING** - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 11 December. Can make the frame
- 15. ISIS DE LA FERME** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 13 December. Capable of an upset on best form

Summary: JONGLEUSE DE BRY (11) looks to have been prepared for this race, so gets a confident vote to score. She will be barefoot this time around. JOSS CAPELLO (12) faulted in his hat-trick attempt but would not be a surprise winner of this particular race. INTERMEDE DU RIL (7) is unreliable but can get into the mix of things. IBIZA EVENING (14) has not won for some time now but can at least earn some more money.

C7 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'EMERAUDE - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. KYRIELLE DES MONTS** - Battling to regain form and finished 8th in Class F over this course and distance on 27 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. KARA MARIS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class F over this track and trip on 27 December. More is needed to win this race
- 3. KENTUCKY VALLEY** - Showed some improvement and was barefoot and fourth in Class F over this course and distance on 30 December. Remains barefoot and could be a threat
- 4. KISMIE DE MONTFORT** - Off form and was unplaced in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2750m on 21 December. Others are preferred
- 5. KISS THE MOON** - On a long losing run and was 9th in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2675m on 4 December. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. KONSTANCIA D'OYSE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class D over this course and distance on 13 December. Races without shoes and could surprise
- 7. KEIRA SMART** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class E at Luon-La Soie over 2725m on 10 December. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. KATCHINA** - In good shape and was fourth in Class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2675m on 4 December. Can contest the finish
- 9. KALOUGA** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class E over this track and trip on 20 December. Needs to do more to score
- 10. KALIE WOOD** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 23 November. Can go one place better
- 11. KAICHA** - Has needed her last two starts and was unplaced in Class E over this track and trip on 20 December. Races without shoes and could contest the finish
- 12. KYARA** - Battling to find best form and finished unplaced in Class E over this track and trip on 20 December. Others are preferred
- 13. KATELINE DE BRY** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 November. Can win a race of this nature

Summary: KATELINE DE BRY (13) showed improvement at Vincennes last month and does look the one to be with, but she will need to repeat that level of form. KALIE WOOD (10) is best when fully barefoot, and that is not the case this time around, but she can get involved with the finish. KATCHINA (8) remains in good form and is likely to be a real threat yet again. KENTUCKY VALLEY (3) hinted that a winning turn may be close at hand, so deserves some respect for that.

**C8 - PRIX DES COTES D'ARMOR - 2925m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR
€ 33,000**

1. MANHATTAN ROUSSAC - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class A at Laval over 2850m on 15 November. More is needed to beat these rivals

2. LEDZEP - Showed some improvement when third in Class C over this course and distance on 27 December. Can be a threat again

3. LAPS GEDE - Not reliable but did not run badly when 5th in Class C over this course and distance on 27 December. Might play a minor role

4. LE METEQUE - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class C over this track and trip on 27 December. Can contest the finish

5. LEVER DU JOAMAX - A winner of two of his last three starts, the latest in Class C over this track and trip on 27 December. Can follow up

6. LUCIFERMORNINGSTAR - On a long losing run but was fourth in Class B at Lyon Parilly over 2850m on 9 October. Returns from a break but has a place chance

7. LOGAN JIEL - Disqualified last time out in Class C at this track on 27 December. Off form and others are preferred

8. LOVER MAUZUN - Ultra-consistent and finished runner-up in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 November. Big chance

Summary: This lucky last race does look a match between the class runners LOVER MAUZUN (8) and LEVER DU JOAMAX (5). LOVER MAUZUN (8) is ultra-consistent and does win often, so gets the nod to be successful again. LEVER DU JOAMAX (5) had a number of these runners behind him when he won over this course and distance recently, so will not go down easily. LEDZEP (2) and LE MÉTÈQUE (4) were not disgraced in their latest start but will need to step up to beat those two rivals.
