

# MONDAY, 05/01/26

## R1 VINCENNES [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE L'AVEYRON - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR €  
59,000**

- 1. HELLA DE JANA** - A promising 4th in a Class E over 2875m at this track on 21 December. That was her first run back after a change of trainers and she does have good form at this course. Place prospects
- 2. FILLE DE L'OUEST** - A moderate 9th in a Class E over 2575m at this course on 24 December. She faces tougher competition this time and will have a hard time competing against the younger horses.
- 3. JAMAICA BROWN** - Won a Class F over 2875m at this course on 30 December. She has excellent form at this course and returned to winning form in an amateur race last time. She is proven at this level and must have a big winning chance.
- 4. JEUNESSE ETERNELLE** - Finished 8th in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 17 December. She runs well at the course but is better than her last run and looks to be a decent outsider
- 5. JOYCE DES GRANGES** - A decent 3rd in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 17 December. She is in good form and runs on a track that will suit her running style. An unlikely winner but could finish in the top five
- 6. JOY JENILOU** - A promising 4th in a Class D over 2700m at his course on 27 December. She is course and distance suited and is making a return to her best form after dealing with fitness issues. Should run well
- 7. IDOLE JALLERIE** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 22 December. So far she hasn't showed much at this track and even with padded shoes in front, she has her work cut out to feature
- 8. JOLIE INDIENNE** - An excellent 2nd in Class D over 2700m on the main track on 17 December. She has not won on this track and will be taking on younger opposition this time, but is quite capable of coming out on top in this event
- 9. GALINETTE BLEUE** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2200m at Salon De Provence on 25 October. She's getting on a bit and will battle against younger rivals. Will race fully shod but that is unlikely to help her chances
- 10. INES DE LA ROUVRE** - A slightly unlucky 6th in a Class D over 2100m over this course on 10 December. She has reasonable form at this track but is not well positioned at the 25m mark. Could battle in this line up
- 11. JOLIE STAR** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 19 December. She might have some temperament issues but with Eric Raffin in the saddle, well positioned on the grid and racing fully shod, she must have a winning chance
- 12. FERGIE HIGHLAND** - Unplaced in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 19 December. She has had some success at the course but is getting on and may battle, racing with padded shoes on all four feet

**13. IDOLE DE MEAT** - Unplaced in a Class D over 2825m at Pontchateau on 21 December. She is better than that run may suggest as was coming back from a break. She might still be in need of another race

**14. HARMONY LA NUIT** - A moderate 7th in a Class c over 2700m at this track on 30 November. Two runs back she finished 2nd at Bordeaux under the saddle. Could place at best

**15. JASMINE DE VAU** - An excellent 2nd in a Class C over 2700m at this course on 26 December. That came after a fluent victory and she is in top form. Runs well in both disciplines and has to have a lively winning chance

**16. JOCONDE SIBEY** - Proved her ability when 3rd in a Class A over 2700m at this course on 30 October. That was her first run back after suffering from fitness issues and she has been prepared for this race. A clear contender

**Summary:** There is no doubting the ability of JAMAICA BROWN (3) but she's not the most dependable runner. She comes off a win in an amateur race so is in good form and has winning credentials. Eric Raffin is the driver on JOLIE STAR (11), another inconsistent performer, but she does have some class. JASMINE DE VAU (15) has some good results to her name, while Improving JOLIE INDIENNE (8) is suited to the conditions. JOCONDE SIBEY (16) returns from a break but is talented.

**C2 - PRIX DE CHEVERNY - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR €  
40,000**

- 1. MYRIADE D'ORION** - Finished 5th in a Class E over 2200m at this course on 11 December. Has been moderate of late but could place
- 2. MISS DE BAILLE** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 16 September. Finished 2nd in her penultimate start and should run well fresh
- 3. MAJUSCULE** - A poor 8th in a class D over 2175m at this course on 3 December. Does not have the form to be competitive
- 4. MARIEVA DE LOU** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2175m at this course on 3 December. She looked threatening before making her mistake late in the race so could surprise
- 5. MANDARINA DE LOU** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at this track on 24 December. Has been disappointing of late but does have ability and could improve under the saddle this time
- 6. MAGGIOTTA** - Disappointing 5th in a Class D over 2875m at Enghien on 26 October. Returns from a break but will need massive improvement
- 7. MADISON MONNERIE** -
- 8. MALAGA DU DIGEON** - Looked good when 2nd in Class E over 2700m at this track on 25 December. Tries shorter this time but does have the speed to win over this trip
- 9. MINILADY DE CHOC** - Slightly disappointing when 7th in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 17 December. Her earlier form is good so she is better than that last run
- 10. MADONE DU TRIEUX** - A decent 5th in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 13 December. She has proven herself in mounted races with two places from three starts
- 11. MY AMERICA** - Unplaced in a Class D over 2175m at this track on 17 November. Form has not been great and will really need to up her game in order to be a threat

**Summary:** MALAGA DU DIGEON (8) could be the horse to beat after an excellent 2nd last time. She drops in trip but that should not be a concern. It is worth noting that Eric Raffin has ridden her twice for two seconds. MISS DE BAILLE (2) stands out as the main danger as she has ability and should be fresh after a short break. MANDARINA DE LOU (5) could regain her good form racing under the saddle for the first time while MADONE DU TRIEUX (10) could be a threat returning to this discipline.

## C3 - PRIX DE SAINT-BRIEUC - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. HAPPY NONANTAIS** - Ran well enough when 5th in a Class E over 2950m at Le Mans on 15 December. Looked good when winning his penultimate start at Laval
- 2. GRAAL DE MY** - Unplaced in a class E over 2950m at Le Mans on 15 December. Not in the best of form and is best overlooked
- 3. JUSTIN WOOD** - Won a class D over 3025m at Marseille Borely on 21 September. Comes back from a break but will race fully shod this time
- 4. INDULGENTE** - Ran downfield in a Class E over 2950m at Le Mans on 15 December. Recent form has been poor but does have ability on her day
- 5. INUKSHUK** - Looked good when 2nd in a Class E over 2550m at Beaumont De Lomagne on 19 December. That was his first run back following an 82-day break and further improvement is expected
- 6. HISTOIRE DE LIERRE** - A moderate 5th in a Class F over 2050m at Laval on 7 December. Form has been mediocre of late so needs to find more
- 7. HORS CADRE** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2875m at Argentan on 23 December. Finished 4th in his penultimate start in a Class F so has a place chance
- 8. HYROPHARE** - Finished 8th in a Class F over 3025m at Nantes on 26 September. He was placed in his last two races when racing unshod, as he will do this time
- 9. HOKITOLove** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2875m at Argentan on 23 December. Ran 4th in his penultimate when wearing padded shoes on all four feet and will have them on again.
- 10. JERRY DU LOISIR** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2800m at Argentan on 23 December. Cannot be considered on recent form but will race with padded shoes in front this time
- 11. HORACE DU VIVIER** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2800m at Pontchateau on 21 December. He has had some decent performances in this discipline recently and deserves respect
- 12. INDUCTIF** - Was disqualified in a Class E over 2825m at Cordemois on 14 December. Ran second in his penultimate in Belgium so could place
- 13. ISKOYA** - An impressive winner of a Class F over 2800m at Argentan on 23 December. Won that race with ease and could have another win in her tank
- 14. GYPSIE MAGIQUE** - A decent third in a Class G over 2575m at Agen-La Garenne on 18 November. Takes on stronger and will need to up his game
- 15. HIJO MOKO** - Unplaced in a Class E over 2850m at this track on 20 December. Third run back from a layoff so could show more
- 16. JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL** - Won a Class G over 2100m at this course on 11 December. A repeat in of that performance puts him right in the frame

**Summary:** Two runners look likely to dominate this race headed up by ISKOYA (13) who won well last time and looks to have more to come. The other is JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL (16) who also comes of a decent victory but they will both start on the second row. If one puts a line through the last run of HAPPY NONANTAIS (1) and looks at his penultimate performance, he could be the joker in the pack. If HORACE DU VIVIER (11) finds his earlier form he could also be a threat.

## C4 - PRIX DE DOUAI - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MILADY DE MONTCEAU** - Moderate 4th in a class E over 2100m at this course on 20 December. That was a slight improvement but overall form is not great
- 2. MULANE DU BOCAGE** - Ran 6th in a Class E over 2100m at this course on 20 December. Recent form has been mediocre and more is needed
- 3. MAGIE DU CHATAULT** - A reasonable effort when 5th in a Class D over 2550m at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 26 December. That was her first run for her new trainer after a 103-day break so could be more to come
- 4. MY LOVE AFFAIR** - Another good run when 4th in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 13 December. She rarely runs a bad race and should be there again
- 5. MELIA BARBES** - Comes off a good win over 2700m at this course on 13 November. This looks to be a quality filly and should have a lot more to come
- 6. MILKA DES THUYAS** - A solid winner in a Class E over 2100m at this track on 20 December. In good form and should run well again
- 7. MY DARLING DU RIS** - An excellent comeback after a 176-day layoff to run 4th in a Class C over 2700m at this track on 19 December. Further progress can be expected
- 8. MARVINA BELLA** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at this track on 17 December. Coming back from a 204-days break she was entitled to be a bit rusty. Should improve on that effort
- 9. MAMOUNIA SEVEN** - Not a bad effort when 5th in a Class D over 2100m at this course on 26 December. Comes from a strong stable and should be competitive
- 10. MISS BELGRAVE** - Performed well to finish 2nd in a Class D over 2700m on 13 December. Is in good form and did finish ahead of MY LOVE AFFAIR (4)
- 11. MAGIE DE CHAHAINS** - Finished 6th in a Class D over 2700m at this course on 14 November. Did win her third last start so is not out of it

**Summary:** MELIA BARBES (5) looks one of the better bets on the day as she looked dominant in her last victory at this course. She is still below the earnings threshold and can increase that total. MY DARLING DU RIS (7) came back from a lengthy break to put up an excellent performance. There should be more to come from her and she looks the main danger. MAMOUNIA SEVEN (9) should go close while MISS BELGRAVE (10) comes off a respectable second place and looks competitive.

**C5 - PRIX DE RIBEAUVILLE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR €  
46,000**

- 1. FLORIDA BI** - A winner last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 25 December. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 2. LITTLETON LANDING** - Did not show her best when unplaced in Class D at this track over 2850m on 28 November. Others are preferred
- 3. SAHARA FIREBIRD** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class D at this track over 2700m on 25 December. Can get involved with the finish
- 4. FENICIA AS** - Showed promise on French debut when runner-up in Class D at this track over 2850m on 14 December. Has won 7 times in Italy and can win again
- 5. LOLITA TURGOT** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class B at Vichy over 2200m on 16 June. Should need this run returning from a break
- 6. LARA DE CHENU** - Unreliable and finished third in Class C at this course over 2700m on 31 December. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. LUNGA DES BROUSSES** - A faller last time out in Class C at this course over 2700m on 30 December. Unreliable and others are preferred
- 8. FORT WASHAKIE** - Victorious in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 4 December. Quite capable of following up
- 9. LERIKA DU CHENE** - Not reliable and finished third in Class C at this track over 2175m on 20 December. Might play a minor role
- 10. LOUISA D'ATOUT** - Disqualified last time out in Class C over this track and trip on 10 December. In good form before that and has claims
- 11. LITTLE STAR FLEURY** - Showed some improvement when 5th in Class C over this course and distance on 10 December. Hard to trust but does have a place chance when smart

**Summary:** A competitive-looking race. FENICIA AS (4) has a decent record in Italy and was not disgraced on her French debut. She can go one better this time around. FORT WASHAKIE (8) did beat that rival last time out, so should be right there at the finish yet again. FLORIDA BI (1) won over this course and distance just over a week ago and is capable of following up. LOUISA D'ATOUT (10) was in good form before faulting last time out and can make the frame.

## C6 - PRIX CHRISTELLE ZIMMER - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class B Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 70,000

- 1. HEVA BLONDE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2850m on 28 December. Others make more appeal
- 2. JUS DE FRUIT** - Successful last time out in a Class D mounted race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2950m on 23 December. Capable of following up
- 3. HUGO OCCAGNES** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a Class E harness race at this track over 2900m on 24 December. Others are preferred
- 4. JANE AIMEE** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Class A mounted race at Bordeiax- Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 December. Did win her last mounted race and can win again
- 5. IMPERIAL COGLAIS** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2175m on 6 December. Might play a minor role
- 6. FLASH DU BIWETZ** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a Class C mounted race at this track over 2175m on 6 December. More is needed to score
- 7. JUPITER DE PLAY** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a Group 3 mounted race over this course and distance on 27 December. Capable of being a threat when smart
- 8. GREZ** - Disqualified last time out in a Class B mounted race at this course over 2850m on 17 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. JE REVE DU BOIS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class B at this track over 2100m on 13 December. Can bounce back to score under the saddle
- 10. HANNAH** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2850m on 17 December. Could earn some more money
- 11. FICIMER** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2850m on 17 December. Can contest the finish
- 12. JUST FOR BACK** - Disqualified in a Group 3 mounted race over this track and trip on 27 December. Not easy to trust but can contest the finish

**Summary:** JE RÊVE DU BOIS (9) has had some disqualifications of late but was unlucky in one of them and can bounce back and make amends for that. JANE AIMÉE (4) is back in a mounted race, so should challenge for top honours. JUST FOR BACK (12) is very hard to trust but is quite capable of winning at this level. FICIMER (11) is unreliable but is another that can be successful if staying on the trot, so must be considered a possible winner.

**C7 - PRIX DE GONTAUD - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR €  
40,000**

- 1. MAN IN LOVE** - Disqualified last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 28 December. Capable of an upset on best form
- 2. MALIUM** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in Class E over this course and distance on 18 November. Others are preferred
- 3. MANGO PAULO** - Not reliable but did finished third in D at Bordeaux-Le-Bouscat over 2550m on 28 December. Can earn some more money
- 4. MILORD DARLING** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 27 December. Can make the frame
- 5. MYTHE DU GOUTIER** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 6 December. Could earn some minor money
- 6. MESSIRE DU GERS** - Returned to form with a Class E win over this course and distance on 29 December. Not easy to trust but could follow up
- 7. MARQUIS DU CHENE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class D at this course over 2100m on 27 December. Has a place chance on best form
- 8. MAMBO THORIS** - Unreliable and was 6th in a claimer at this track over 2100m on 28 November. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 9. MAGICAL** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in Class D at this course over 2100m on 8 December. Hard to trust but can score when staying in stride
- 10. MALDRIC D'ECHAL** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 10 August. Could need this run returning from a break
- 11. MELI MELO DE CHENU** - Has been a disappointment of late and was 8th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 6 December. Capable of bouncing back to score
- 12. MADMAX JEF** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class D over this track and trip on 26 December. Be right there at the finish

**Summary:** Jean-Michel Baudouin holds a nice hand for this race. MELI MELO DE CHENU (11) has been a disappointment of late but is talented and can win a race of this nature. MADMAX JEF (12) is knocking loudly at the door and can go one place better on the back of a very good course and distance win last week. MESSIRE DU GERS (6) is not reliable but won over this track and trip last time out and might follow up. MILORD DARLING (4) remains in good shape and is not out of it.

**C8 - PRIX DE VIC-FEZENSAC - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR  
€ 41,000**

- 1. PURE ATLAS** - A 9 time winner who was runner-up last time out at Solvalla over 2140m on 26 December. Can go one better
- 2. JOPLIN DES CROUAS** - Showed some improvement and was 6th in Class D at this course over 2700m on 13 December. Might play a minor role
- 3. JACK L'EVENTREUR** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 27 December. Others are preferred
- 4. JADE RENARDIER** - Finished third last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 25 November. Can get involved with the finish again
- 5. JOKER D'OLAINE** - In good form and finished third in E at Argentan over 2150m on 14 December. Be right there at the finish
- 6. JACADI BROUETS** - Off form and finished 9th in Class E at Argentan over 2150m on 14 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. JACK DES MALBERAUX** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in a Class D mounted race at this track over 2700m on 28 November. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 8. JAZZ DE PADD** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. More is needed to win
- 9. GOODWIN ZET** - Disqualified last time out in a Class D mounted race at this track over 2850m on 9 December. Better this distance and can make the frame
- 10. JAZZ D'OURVILLE** - Disqualified last time out at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 28 July. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 11. HIGH FIVE D.K.** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at this track over 2850m on 28 December. Capable of improvement and is not out of it
- 12. MODRIC RENKA** - Consistent and was a winner last time out at Wolvega over 2600m on 20 December. Can contest the finish
- 13. JUDGE DREDD SISU** - Unreliable and finished 7th at Mons over 2300m on 18 December. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 14. PORTOFINO (SWE)** - Not reliable and finished 8th at Jagersro over 2640m on 22 November. Has a place chance on best form
- 15. JARDIN DU ROI** - In good form and finished third in Class F at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 7 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- 16. FIORANO** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at this track over 2850m on 28 December. More is needed to win this race

**Summary:** A very interesting lucky last race. The foreign raiders look to have the upper hand for this. PURE ATLAS (1) has some decent form in Sweden and does look the one to be with. MODRIC RENKA (12) is very consistent and beat a good field at Wolvega last time out, so should be a danger. JADE RENARDIER (4) showed improvement over this course and distance last time out, so is not out of it. JOKER D'OLAINE (5) has solid French form and would not be a surprise winner.
