C1 - PRIX DE LILLE - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. KOREDE Disqualified in his last two starts with the latest being at this course on 23 February. Probably best watched for now
- 2. KEOPS DU RIL Fluffed his lines with a disqualification at Le Croisé-Laroche last time out on 25 May. Returns from a break but is not out of it if smart
- **3. KOALA -** Has disqualification issues and was 7th last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 23 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **4. KLASSIC MENCOURT -** Yet to win a race and was 6th last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 23 February. More needed to win
- **5. KRUNCHY -** Unreliable and was 10th last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 23 February. Yet to win but could play a minor role when in the mood
- **6. KEL PRESTANCE -** Very consistent so far and was third last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 23 February. Be right there at the finish once again
- 7. KABRIEL Only win was as claimer but did show improvement when fourth last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 23 February. Might play a minor role

KEOPS DU RIL (2) returns from a break but could run well if smart.

- **2. IXANA GRIFF -** A winner of her last two starts with the latest being in Class E at Marseille Vivaux on 25 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- **3. ILLARIA MADRIK -** Very consistent of late and was runner-up last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 23 February. Clearly not out of it
- **4. ITALIA DRY -** On a long losing run but ran well when runner-up last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 14 February. Can make the frame
- **5. INSOLITE -** Disqualified twice in last three starts with the latest last time out at Hyeres on 24 February. Won penultimate start which was over this course and distance. Respect
- **6. IVILLA BLUE -** Only modest form of late and was 6th last time out in Class D at Hyeres over 2850m on 24 February. Others are preferred
- **7. IRIS RIVOISE -** Mostly modest form of late and was 6th last time out in Class E at Marseille Vivaux over 2650m on 12 February. Might play a minor role

- **3. FICIMER -** Very unreliable but did show her best when a barefoot winner in Class E over this track and trip on 23 February. Can follow up
- **4. GUS DES CHAMPS -** On a long losing streak and was a disappointment last time out when 10th in Class D over this course and distance on 28 February. Place chance
- **5. FILS DE COSSE -** Unreliable of late and was 7th last time out in Class E at the course over 2700m on 3 February. Others are preferred
- **6. FLAG DE MARIONS -** Has disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this course on 23 February. Can bounce back to score if wise

- **3. HOLD BLUE -** Has really struggled of late and was 8th last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 14 February. Others are much preferred
- **4. IMPERATRICE VITELA -** Last win was in 2022 and was 9th last time out in Class B over this course and distance on 19 January. Capable of better and is not out of it
- **5. HYSOPE DE NGANDA -** Unreliable since last win but was not disgraced when 5th last time out at this course over 2700m on 20 February. Capable of making the frame

Summary: ISSIA DE CHARLY (9) was not disgraced when fifth last time out and makes a long trip to run in this race so deserves the utmost respect. ISABELLE STORY (7) is hard to trust with two recent disqualifications but can bounce back to be a threat. HALAFOLY ROBSEN (2) is in good form and has an obvious winning chance in this line-up. IMPERATRICE VITELA (4) is capable of better and can contest the finish.

- 2. KUEEN MARGOT Holding form and was runner-up in Class F over this track and trip on 4 February. Clearly not out of it
- **3. KLOE REBELLE -** Has disqualification but has been knocking hard at the door and was runner-up last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 19 January. Be right there at the finish
- **4. KRISTAL VICTORY -** Mostly modest form of late and was 8th last time out in Class E at Marseille Vivaux over 2650m on 21 January. Needs to do a lot more to win this race
- **5. KAICHA -** Unreliable but did show what she is capable of when scoring in Class F over this course and distance on 3 February. Should contest the finish
- **6. KROSSBLADE -** Showed some improvement when barefoot and third in Class E at this course over 2150m on 20 February. Can make the frame

- **3. KADINE MADRIK -** A runner-up on two of her five starts so far including last time out in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 24 February. Unreliable but is not out of it
- **4. KLAIRE DE PLAY -** Disappointing last run when 12th in Class F at Marseille Borely over 3000m on 29 November. Has done better at this course and could make the frame
- **5. KAVANA DU BAS BOSQ -** Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 24 February. Place chance
- **6. KAITLYN DE REUX -** Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 20 February. Capable of contesting the finish

- **11. KAEDE DE LA COUR -** Disappointing recent form and was 7th last time out in Class F at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 13 February. Others are much preferred

Summary: KANARY BAY (8) is not easy to trust but did win well in her penultimate start and can score again if in the same mood. KELLY DU RIL (10) and KHALEESI DE KACY (9) are two fillies that are making their debut but could be ready to run big races. KAITLYN DE REUX (6) has disqualification issues and is not easy to trust but should be a threat if smart this time.

- 2. HISTOIRE DE COEUR At very best over shorter but was not disgraced when 7th last time out in Class E over this track and trip last time out. Go close
- 3. HULK GINYU Unreliable of late and was 8th last time out in Class G over this track and trip in 14 February. Better over shorter but is not out of it
- **4. GAVROCHE BOCAIN -** Not at all disgraced when third last time out in Class G at Vincennes over 2850m on 23 February, Be right there at the finish
- **5. GOLDORACK DU BOIS -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 20 February. At very best over shorter but is capable of scoring
- **6. GOPTION MONTAVAL -** On a very long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 12 November. Could need this run returning from a break

GOLDORACK DU BOIS (5) was not disgraced when fourth last time out and is the narrow choice. GAVROCHE BOCAIN (4) is distance suited and is coming off a good run. HULK GINYU (3) is also more lethal over shorter but would not be a surprise winner.

- **2. IRMOSA BELLA -** Disappointing recent runs and was 9th last time out in Class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 24 February. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- **3. GOLDEN TULIPE -** On a long losing run but did run well when third last time out in Class G at Marseille Vivaux over 2650m on 12 February. Place chance
- **4. GAETANE DU VIVIER -** Very consistent of late and is coming off a win in Class G at Marseille Vivaux over 2650m on 12 February. Can follow up
- **5. IPSY DU BOCAGE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at this course over 2150m on 23 February. Versatile distance-wise and can bounce back to score
- **6. HOUSTON D'ARIANE -** Has disqualification issues and was 9th last time out in Class D at Hyeres over 2850m on 24 February. Others are preferred

INVICTUM DU NOYER (7) has major disqualification issues but ran well in his penultimate start and is not out of it if smart. ILLICO DU JAS (8) has yet to win but is capable of earning some money if smart.
