## R5 CHARTRES [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX CINEMA LES ENFANTS DU PARADIS - 2825m (a2m) - Class E -  
Harness - EUR € 23,000**

**1. LICORNE DE L'AVRE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Fitter this time and has a place chance

**2. LOUISON DE FORGAN** - Unreliable and finished 5th in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 2 February. Can be competitive this track and trip

**3. LASCAUX** - Unbeaten in three starts, the latest in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 March. Can add another win to his tally

**4. LOVE ME HAUFOR** - Yet to win a race and finished 9th in a Class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 23 February. Not reliable and others are preferred

**5. LEADER CARISAIE** - Returned to form and was 3rd in a Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. Has disqualification issues but can contest the finish

**6. LOLITA DU RHIN** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class G at Challans over 2900m on 22 March. Keeps that shoeing and can make the frame

**7. LORENZO DU NOYER** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 22 February. Can be a threat once again

**8. LE BIG JANJAN** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, including at Nantes on 21 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred

**9. L'ANGELUS** - In good shape and finished 4th in a claimer at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 December. More is needed to beat these rivals

**10. LOTUS MADRIK** - Finished a good 3rd in a Class F at Angers over 3125m on 7 February. Capable of getting into the thick of things yet again

**11. LOUVIERS** - Successful in a Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. Not reliable but might just follow up if in the same mood

**12. L'HAVANA D'ELMA** - Disqualified twice in a row, included at this track on 16 October. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run

**Summary:** LASCAUX (3) is unbeaten in three starts and has every chance of adding another win to the tally. He should strip fitter this time after winning on his return from a very long break. LEADER CARISAIE (5) has disqualification issues, but his latest run did suggest he is close to scoring. LOUVIERS (11) was a good winner a few weeks ago but is not reliable. LOTUS MADRIK (10) ran well at Angers and can be competitive once again.

## C2 - PRIX GROUPAMA - 2825m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. KALINKA ERA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a mounted race at Vincennes on 21 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. KOBALT APPLE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Challans on 22 March. Capable of making the frame when smart
- 3. JOSIE NONANTAISE** - Unreliable but finished 4th in a Class G at Graignes over 2700m on 11 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 4. KIARHA DE NAPPES** - Disqualified at Nancy on 28 March. Not easy to trust but is capable of playing a minor role when staying in stride
- 5. KOMINA** - Consistent of late and finished 3rd in a Class F at Caen over 2450m on 16 March. Capable of making some more money
- 6. KA DEUX TONIQUE** - Returned from a break with a win in a Class F at this track over 2800m on 1 March. Fitter this time and could double up
- 7. KAPORAL GAME** - On a long losing run but was runner-up in a Class F at Challans over 2900m on 22 March. Can earn some more money
- 8. KIROYAL DU VINOIS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 February. Remains barefoot and can be a threat on best form
- 9. KAISER BEGONIA** - Disappointing form this year and finished 11th in a Class F at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 6 March. Unreliable but is capable of making the frame
- 10. KARMA TEJY** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 March. More is needed to score
- 11. KER POULGWEN** - Has really struggled of late and finished 14th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Needs major improvement to win
- 12. KENTUCKY WOOD** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 15 March. A bit more is needed to beat these rivals
- 13. KRAK D'AZUR** - Disqualified in four of his last six starts, including last time out at Vincennes on 20 March. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 14. KELVASE CASTELETS** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 2 February. Others are much preferred
- 15. KAISER DES GRANGES** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class D at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 16 March. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 16. KAMOUR** - Unbeaten in two starts this year, the latest in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 March. Remains barefoot and can complete the hat-trick

**Summary:** KAMOUR (16) has won both starts this year but can expect a tougher challenge from these rivals. He is capable of completing the hat-trick. KAISER BEGONIA (9) is unreliable and has struggled of late but does have claims in this race. The same could also be said of KIROYAL DU VINOIS (8), and both can be dangers from the first row. KA DEUX TONIQUE (6) returns from a break but is one of many others capable of scoring.

## C3 - PRIX L'ILLIADE - 2825m (a2m) - Class G - Mounted - EUR € 24,000

- 1. JASON GEDE** - Finished 4th in a Class G harness race at Nancy over 2600m on 9 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 2. KERVIGNAC** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class F mounted race at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 25 August. Returns from a break but is not out of it
- 3. KEOPS DE GODINIÈRE** - Disqualified at Maure-de-Bretagne on 24 March. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money when smart
- 4. JABIOLE BELLEMARE** - Not reliable but was victorious in a Class F mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 15 March. Keeps that shoeing and could follow up
- 5. JENNY JO** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Class H mounted race at Elbeuf over 2750m on 29 March. Can go one better
- 6. JOLI ALEZAN** - In good form and finished 4th in a Class G mounted race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 6 March. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 7. JAGUAR D'ESCRIT** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a Class G at Graignes over 2725m on 11 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 8. KLASSIC FROMENTRO** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 30 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. JIL** - Has major disqualification issues but was barefoot and runner -up in a Class F at Caen over 2450m on 25 March. Remains without shoes and can go one better
- 10. JASMIN PHIL** - Battling to find best form and finished 10th in a Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. Fitter this time but others make more appeal

**Summary:** Another open-looking race. JENNY JO (5) has shown improvement of late and gets a narrow vote for a winning turn. JABIOLE BELLEMARE (4) bounced back with a win under the saddle at Graignes and will be competitive once again. JIL (9) is very hard to trust but would not be a surprise winner in a race of this nature. JOLI ALEZAN (6) remains in good shape and looks likely to fight out the finish yet again.

## C4 - PRIX DES ETABLISSEMENTS TRIBOUILLET - 2800m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. MILAN BENOIS** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out at La Guerche-de-Bretagne over 2800m on 29 March. Hard to trust and is unlikely to win
- 2. MYSTIC DE BLARY** - Finished 3rd in a Class E over this track and trip on 12 September. Returns from a break but can be a threat if staying in stride
- 3. MITSUKI DU BOURG** - Showed improvement when barefoot and runner-up in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 14 March. Remains without shoes and is not out of it
- 4. MARIO DU VIEUXCOUR** - Disqualified at at Maure-de-Bretagne on 24 March. Fitter this time and was consistent last year so is clearly not out of it if smart
- 5. MAGIC DE BELLA** - Returned from a break with a victory in a Class F at Challans over 2900m on 22 March. Can follow up if in the same mood
- 6. MARQUIS DE MALAC** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in a Class F at this track over 2800m on 15 March. Has claims in this line-up
- 7. MAN OF WOOD** - Successful in a Class F over this track and trip on 15 March. Improving and keeps that shoeing. Can follow up
- 8. MAGE DE L'ITON** - Victorious in a Class F at Elbeuf over 2750 on 29 March, Has improved of late and is capable of doubling up
- 9. MIROS** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. Might play a minor role at very best

**Summary:** A very competitive race. MAN OF WOOD (7) beat MARQUIS DE MALAC (6) previously, and there is reason to believe they can fight it out again, likely in the same order. MAN OF WOOD (7) is improving and keeps the same shoeing as that day. MARQUIS DE MALAC (6) should strip fitter this time and will be a real threat. MARIO DU VIEUXCOUR (4) faulted last time out but will be fitter and is not out of it. MYSTIC DE BLARY (2) has ability and could challenge for top honours returning from a break.

- 1. MERVEILLE DE JIEL** - Consistent and was runner-up in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 15 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. MAGIA LA TRIGALE** - Much improved last run when 3rd in class F at Reims over 2500m on 19 March when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
- 3. MOON DES ARRIS** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class F at Graignes over 2700m on 15 March. Has a place chance this track and trip
- 4. MISS FRANCE PIYA** - Unbeaten in two starts, the latest in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 22 March. Can complete her hat-trick
- 5. MUSE DE L'AVRE** - Victorious in both starts last year, the latest Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 31 July. Can be a threat if fit enough
- 6. MA BIMBO** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 30 March. Needs to do more to score
- 7. MA PIECE D'OR** - Victorious when racing without shoes in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and can double up
- 8. MALINE DE JED** - Unreliable and was 4th in class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. Has shown improvement and might play a minor role
- 9. MASCOTT DU CHOQUEL** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 22 March. Barefoot that day and remains without shoes. Place chance
- 10. MACOUMBA DAIRPET** - Victorious in Class F at Agon-Coutainville over 2200m on 25 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. MIGRAINE DE CONNEE** - Disqualified in class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 14 March. Victorious in February and is capable of an upset if at best
- 12. MA BRISE TIME** - Consistent and was barefoot and 4th in class F at Graignes over 2700m on 15 March. Not fully barefoot this time but can make the frame

**Summary:** MISS FRANCE PIYA (4) is well bred and has done all that has been asked of her so far, remaining unbeaten after two starts. She is fit and clearly the one to beat. MUSE DE L'AVRE (5) looked solid with her wins last year and will be a danger if fit enough. MA BRISE TIME (12) is consistent and can get involved in the finish again. MA PIECE D'OR (7) was a barefoot winner last time out and is another to consider.

## C6 - PRIX HOMMAGE A BERNARD DUNEAU - 2800m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. NAYA REINA** - A three-year-old filly by Brillantissime out of Calicoba who is making her debut. Should be a threat on debut
- 2. NIRVANA PIYA** - Debut attempt for a three- year-old colt by Gelati Gut out of Gratia Piya. Qualified well at Laval in June and is a threat
- 3. NOE DES MONTS** - A three-year-old gelding by Gospel Pat ou of Quirane du Louvain. Will probably need this experience so others make more appeal
- 4. NEW YORK FRANCE** - Only modest so far and was 6th in class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 14 January. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 5. NOBEL DE PAIL** - Disqualified in class F at Chartres over 2300m on 15 March. Did better on debut and could be a threat if smart
- 6. NIGHTMARE** - Did improve when 3rd in class F at Graignes over 2725m on 15 March. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. NINA FOX** - Disqualified in class F at Rambouillet over 2000m on 29 March. Has disqualification issues and is unreliable. Others are preferred
- 8. NEHO CINQ** - Improving and finished 3rd in class F at this track over 2300m on 15 March. Can get involved with the finish
- 9. NIGHT ERCA** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in class F at Caen over 2450m on 19 March. On a long losing streak and needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 10. NAVIDA PURA VIDA** - Not disgraced when 3rd in class F at this track over 2300m on 15 March. In decent form but and could make the frame
- 11. NISSA LA BELLA** - Showed promise when a runner-up on debut, in class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 22 March. Can go one place better
- 12. NATCHO UP STAR** - Has run well in both starts, the latest when 3rd in class F at Pontchâteau over 2200m on 29 March. Has claims in this line-up

**Summary:** An interesting race.It is easy to see why the newcomers can be expected to fight out the finish.Naya Reina(1) showed promise in her qualifying run and could score first time of asking.Nirvana Piya(2) qualified well at Laval and is a lively danger.Neho Cinq(8) is progressing and could be the best of those that have raced before.Natcho Up Star(12) is fit and experienced in this game,so is clearly not out of it.

## C7 - PRIX HOMMAGE A SYLVAINE VANDROMME - 2825m (a2m) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. IRONIE DES BROUETS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class G at Nancy over 2600m on 28 March. Unreliable but might play a minor role
- 2. JUSTINE DU MESNIL** - Consistent and was runner-up in class G at Laval over 2850m on 28 March. Can go one place better
- 3. KAMILLE DU MESNIL** - Not reliable and was 7th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 27 December. Returns from a break but has a place chance
- 4. KATNISS MORMOULIN** - Finished 10th in class E at Nantes over 3000m on 21 February. Returns barefoot and can be a threat in this division
- 5. KYRIELLE PRINCESSE** - Unreliable and was 9th in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 9 November when barefoot. Not this time and could need this run returning from a break
- 6. IRIS DE MEMARTIN** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in class H at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 2 November. Has disqualification issues and could need this run returning from a break
- 7. IKKO JOSSELYN** - Needed his last run when 6th in class H at Villedieu-Les-Poeles over 2825m on 29 March. Returns barefoot and can contest the finish
- 8. HARMONIE CLEFOISE** - Finished 15th in class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 24 March. Needed that run but will probably need this run as well
- 9. GREAT STUDBAKER** - Not disgraced when 6th in class G at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 15 March. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 10. JUST A WINNER** - Not disgraced when 6th in class G at Laval over 2850m on 30 March. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- 11. ILOULOU JASMA** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class G at Vincennes over 2100m on 11 December. Victorious earlier in September and is capable of scoring

**Summary:** A very tricky lucky last race to close the card. Justine du Mesnil(2) is a model of consistency and ran a solid race at Laval just last week; she looks ready to go one better this time. Katniss Mormoulin(4) competes barefoot, and that could spark noticeable improvement—she shapes as a real danger. Ikko Josselyn(7) likely needed the comeback run and, now racing barefoot, should be much sharper and ready to feature. Just a Winner(10) remains unshod and has the ability to get into the frame.
