## **R5 MAUQUENCHY [L-H]**

### C1 - PRIX LE CAFE DE LA GARE DE LUNERAY - 2850m (a2m) - Class G Race - Mounted - EUR € 25,000

- **1. IMAM FLASH -** Pulled-up in a 2800m Bernay Class G on 1 May. No longer the horse he once was and can be ignored
- **2. INITIALE MACHA -** 10th of 12 in a 2400m Amiens harness amateurs Class G on 17 May. Has never shown much aptitude for the ridden game and is not about to break the mould
- **3. JACADY SLY -** 8th of 11 finishers in a 2700m Graignes Class G a fortnight back. Is confirmed here but in this company will need to find more
- **4. JEKILL ROCQ -** Below-par at Alencon but redeemed himself when 2nd of 15 in a 2750m Elbeuf Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Tends to go well here and in current form is easy to like for a place in the frame
- **5. JOYAU DE MORTREE -** Back under the saddle after being sanctioned in a 2825m Sablé-sur-Sarthe harness Class E on 25 May. Has produced some good efforts this season and, shod to preference, should not be overlooked
- **6. JET BESP -** Authoritative winner of a 2550m Gournay-en-Bray Class H on 25 May. In better company this time and while unlikely to repeat can still challenge for a place on the podium
- **7. JUBLA VIKING -** Drops in category after running 7th of 8 in a 2450m Caen Class F on 17 May. Is better than recent numbers would suggest and will not be far from the action if she can keep her action together
- **8. JASMINE DE NEUVY -** Complicated but talented mare that made it 2 on the trot when dominating a 2700m Graignes Class D early last month and if applied will take all the beating
- **9. ISIDORE BONHEUR -** 6th of 11 in a 3150m Abbeville Class H a week ago. Has little room for manoeuvre against the 5yo's but has shown a liking for Mauquenchy and, shod to preference, is worth retaining
- **10. IN LOVE DE L'ITON -** Made up for Alencon clinker when unopposed winner of a 2825m Class F at Le Croise-Laroche on 21 May. Seldom puts a foot out of line and is not about to buck the trend. Chance

**Summary:** Back at the top of her game following a tough start to the season, JASMINE DE NEUVY (8) makes her Mauquenchy bow on a hat-trick and with application can pull it off. That said, IN LOVE DE L'ITON (10) has never been bested win the day's configuration, benefits from a fine entry, and will be no easy touch. Barefoot and in-form for his return to the discipline, JEKILL ROCQ (4) has shown a liking for the venue and is not to be underestimated. JET BESP (6) got back in the game 11 days ago and sports modified shoeing for the occasion.

# C2 - PRIX LA MAISON DE LA PRESSE DES ANDELYS - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- **1. KISS SYMPHONY -** Sanctioned in a 2550m Reims Class E on 17 May. Has been off her porridge over recent months and has no realistic chance
- **2. KOMSI KOMSA -** Continued her modest ways when sanctioned in a 2600m Class F at Châlons-en-Champagne on 25 May and can expect to remain friendless
- **3. KHALEESI HEAVEN -** 5th of 8 in a 2550m Gournay-en-Bray Class F 11 days ago. Races barefoot with Franck Ouvrie in the bike but still has too much to do
- **4. KISS ME FIRST -** Well-beaten in both starts this season, most recently last of 12 in a 2800m Bernay Class E on 1 May, and will struggle to make her presence felt
- **5. KABRIOLE D'ENFER -** Imposed at Moulins 2.5 weeks ago, at 30/1, before running 2nd of 15 in a 2150m Vichy Class F 8 days later, at 50/1, and must be taken more seriously this time around
- **6. KARINA JOSSELYN -** Defied expectations to fly up in a 2875m Laon claimer on 18 May. Makes first appearance for new stable and even with shoes fitted is worth keeping an eye on
- **7. KLEM DU HANOY -** Sanctioned when preparing for this in a 2775m Elbeuf Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Trainer back in the bike and although in better company this time still looks competitively well in
- **8. KOPAZE DE HOUELLE -** Has yet to make her mark this year, latterly 6th of 11 finishers in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E on 11 May, and is unlikely to create an upset
- **9. KAMELIYA -** Secured the double in a 2625m Cherbourg Class F last November. Unraced since but is hard to knock when applied and can bring the fight to KAROLE DU JOUAN (12)
- **10. KARA DES DUNES -** Has not been seen out since winning a 2700m Graignes Class F late-December. Should appreciate Mauquenchy profile though and even with pads fitted can still finish close
- **11. KELLE NANA -** Sanctioned in last 2, latterly a 2625m Cherbourg claimer on 11 May. Is well-entered though, with Yoann Lebourgeois reining, and must not be underestimated
- **12. KAROLE DU JOUAN -** Imposed at Pontivy before running 2nd of 12 in a 2800m Tours Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Pleased on lone start at the venue and, barefoot this time, is easy to like for the win
- **13. KRONA VIKING -** Starts for first time since being sanctioned in a 2175m Vincennes Class E on 11 April. Forced to start on back line here and can be passed over
- **14. KIRA DE CAHOT -** Disappointing so far this year, most recently 10th of 13 finishers in a 2875m Argentan Class E last week, and prospects look decidedly slim, barefoot or not
- **15. KUNZITE D'EM -** Encouraged in March and April but sanctioned in last 3, latterly a 2400m Amiens Class D 10 days ago, and the extra 25m to travel will do her no favours

**Summary:** Something of an open affair this, but it is nonetheless difficult to ignore the well-engaged KAROLE DU JOUAN (12) who has turned a corner since returning to racing barefoot. KAMELIYA (9) though is seldom far off the mark when focused and even though unseen since November, she still looks the main threat. Mare of a similar profile, KARA DES DUNES (10) sports pads for her the-entry and makes her Mauquenchy debut with a realistic chance of coming close. KLEM DU HANOY (7) is barefoot as she was when successful in Lyon and must be considered a player.

### C3 - PRIX LE CAFE DES SPORTS D'ENVERMEU - 2850m (a2m) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- **1. KIROYAL DU VINOIS -** 7th of 15, a place behind KAPITAN TER BLEKTE (7) in a Class E over course and distance mid-March. Has not been seen since and, shod for the occasion, is unlikely to shake things up
- **2. KROONER DE L'ITON -** Last but one in a 2825m Sablé-sur-Sarthe Class F on 25 May. Is not devoid of talent but appears to need another race
- **3. KANSAS DU RIB -** Met little opposition en route to victory in a 2800m Vire Class F, on comeback, early last month. Is as tricky as they come but on good behaviour could well confirm
- **4. KADO DE VANDEL -** Last of 11, on comeback, in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E a month ago and is clearly out of his depth
- **5. KASH WIT -** 10th of 12 in a 2725m Graignes Class F on 1 May. Re-shod this time, won his only start here, but is taking on too much
- **6. KRUNCHY -** Sanctioned in last 2, latterly a 2825m Sablé-sur-Sarthe Class F late last month, and can be confidently ruled out
- **7. KAPITAN TER BLEKTE -** Always gives his best but will need to improve on his 6th of 11 in a 2550m Reims Class E on 17 May
- **8. KENAVO BELRI -** Comfortable winner of a 2600m Châlons-en-Champagne Class F 11 days ago, on first start for 2.5 months. Shoes off again and steps up in category with a good hand to play
- **9. KIKEN GASHI -** Back under harness after finishing 6th of 7 in a 2550m Gournay-en-Bray monte Class F late last month and with hind shoes back on is not about to spring any surprises
- **10. KUZCO -** Sanctioned in 2 before running 9th of 12 in a 2600m Class F at Châlons-en-Champagne on 25 May. Ran 2nd here when barefoot last autumn though and will have his supporters
- **11. KARTING DU VIVIER -** Sanctioned early in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E on 21 April. Has won 4 of the 5 races he has finished and with application can make this his own
- **12. KESSERO -** Ran 3rd of 15 in a 2800m Bernay Class E on 1 May. Goes barefoot for the first time on a hard surface and despite the handicap could exceed expectations
- **13. KILLER ANGOT -** Won nicely at Villedieu-les-Poëles before coming 2nd of 13 in a 2700m Graignes Class E a fortnight ago. Is a tough nut when barefoot and even from the 2nd line will not be far off the mark
- **14. KARAMBA KARACHO -** 5th of 12 in a 2700m Class D at Le Croise-Laroche on 21 May. Is confirmed when barefoot and, well-engaged, will be no easy touch if focused

**Summary:** Nicely-entered at the limit of earnings, KARTING DU VIVIER (11) reverts to a previous configuration after having lost his action early at Cherbourg and Sébastien Ernault will be determined to set the record straight. Leading the opposition, KENAVO BELRI (8) has done nothing but improve this term and is not incapable of confirming his Châlons success, while Yoann Lebourgeois will have been encouraged by the performance KANSAS DU RIB (3) put in on re-entry early last month. KESSERO (12) is 25m worse off but showed marked improvement last time out and runs barefoot again.

# C4 - PRIX LE VINCENNES DE NEUVILLE LES DIEPPE - 2850m (a2m) - Class F Race - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- **1. HUTA JAZZ -** Unexceptional mare that was sanctioned in a 2750m Elbeuf Class F on 27 April and would be preferred at a lower level
- **2. JOURNAL INTIME -** Ran 2nd at Cholet before coming 5th of 11 in a 2825m Durtal Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and from the front line is unlikely to disappoint
- **3. IPSON WIND -** Pleasantly surprised on re-entry when 3rd of 13 in a 2400m Amiens amateurs Class G on 17 May, but a repeat seems most improbable
- **4. JAVA DES BERTHES -** Sanctioned in a 2875m Argentan Class D on 25 May. Sanctioned in last 2 here and with hind shoes back on is unlikely to trouble the judge
- **5. JAZZY MAKER -** Particularly productive since starting to race barefoot, most recently 2nd of 12 in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle a month back, and the 25m head-start will only work to her advantage. First 3
- **6. HOLLY GREEN -** 6th of 11 in a 2725m Graignes Class E a fortnight back. Incurs the penalty but with shoes off this time should be able to give this a good go
- **7. HANUGAN -** Has not been seen out since being sanctioned in a 2750m Cabourg amateurs monte Class F last August and will have nothing to offer
- **8. JAGUAR DU FAN -** Solid as a rock so far this season, latterly 2nd of 16 to JOLIE COKTAIL (10) in a 3150m Abbeville Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Bridesmaid in 4 of last 5 but it is just a matter of time before he gets his nose in front
- **9. INFIEL -** Sanctioned in a 2400m Amiens Class E on 17 May. Races barefoot for first time this year and with application will not be far off the mark
- **10. JOLIE COKTAIL -** Came 3rd at Elbeuf before winning a 3150m Abbeville Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Has freshness on her side and looks every part the pick of the field

**Summary:** A fine servant when barefoot and focused, JOLIE COKTAIL (10) benefits from a golden entry here and in current condition will take all the beating. Runner-up to him at Abbeville, JAGUAR DU FAN (8) is plainly close to his race but may have to play 2nd fiddle once more. A model of consistency, and presently enjoying a rich vein of form, JAZZY MAKER (5) is 25m better off and represents a solid place prospect. Similarly breaking in front, JOURNAL INTIME (2) is in fine shape and must be afforded respect.

- 1. LOOK DAIRPET Back to racing barefoot after running 7th of 11 behind LOTUS JIEL (8) in a 2600m Nancy Class F last Friday and can expect to have few friends
- **2. LAUREL -** Opened his 2025 account at Loudeac before running a good 4th of 10 in a 2700m Vire Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and is in with a realistic chance of imposing
- **3. LYX OF CAMARO -** Won on April comeback at Vire before running courageous 4th of 12 in a 2800m Chartres Class E early last month. Comes here fresh and will be expected to contest the finish
- **4. LABORANTIN -** Out of the picture in 3 starts this year, latterly last of 9 in a 2450m Caen Class E last week, and will struggle to make his presence felt
- **5. LISSANDRO D'ARC -** Runner-up in 2 of last 3, latterly a 2150m Vichy Class F on 20 May. Top driver in the bike this time and from the 5-spot will be no pushover
- **6. LIKE YOU MADRIK -** Won 3 in a row before coming 2nd of 18 in a 2650m Cherbourg claimer on 11 May. Steps up in category on first outing for new yard and in current form is hard to ignore
- **7. LOOK DES CAILLONS -** Made up for Loudeac sanction when imposing over 3150m in an Abbeville Class F 3.5 weeks ago. Benefits from a good entry and will be competitive for the spoils
- **8. LOTUS JIEL -** 4th of 11 in a 2600m Nancy Class F last Friday. Unlikely to win this but is still good enough to make first 5
- **9. LOGO MAJYC -** Quickly sanctioned on re-entry in a 2300m Chartres Class E last Sunday. Has evident ability, is entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois, and could well get his nose in front
- **10. LE LIBERTY -** Last of 8, on return to competition, in a 2200m Caen Class F last Saturday and has no possible chance

**Summary:** Enjoying something of a renaissance since starting to race barefoot, LAUREL (2) returns to running left-handed and with form maintained should have the measure of LYX OF CAMARO (3) who took no time getting back in the winners' enclosure, and the more widely-drawn LOOK DES CAILLONS (7) who has won 2 of his last 3. LISSANDRO D'ARC (5) has been handed a good spot behind the car and, entrusted to Gabriele Gelormini for the first time, will be afforded every chance.

# C6 - PRIX ICI NORMANDIE ET PICARDIE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- **1. LILOU D'ATOUT -** Back under harness after running 7th of 13 in a 2750m monte Class E at La Capelle a month ago. Starts on the inside but is first-time barefoot and merits respect
- **2. LADY MAJOR** Made short work of a 2725m Graignes Class F on 23 May. Similarly configured this time and has a realistic chance of doubling her money
- **3. LA VALLEY FLIGNY -** In the frame in last 4, latterly 3rd of 8 finishers in a 2300m Chateaubriant Class E on 25 May. Barefoot this time but the challenge looks significantly stiffer this time around
- **4. LOUNA DU LOCHEUR -** Serious filly making first appearance since faulting in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on Christmas Eve. Has nothing to prove at this level and, if applied, can make a big splash
- **5. LEWISIA DE LATOM -** Got straight down to business on re-entry, winning a 2400m Amiens Class F mid-May. Boasts a 50 percent win-rate which she could well extend here
- **6. LA BELLE MIKA -** 4th of 11, at 22/1, in a 2400m Amiens Class E 10 days ago but will struggle to repeat
- **7. LADY MASTER -** Failed to confirm Graignes victory when 5th of 14 in a 2650m Alencon Class F last weekend. Is undeniably capable though and has a decent chance of trotting her way into the picture
- **8. LA CALLAS -** 5th of 6 finishers in a 3150m Class F at La Roche-Posay on Sunday. Just front shoes off this time but others still preferred
- **9. LUNA DE BELFONDS -** Disappointing for past 2.5 months, most recently sanctioned in a 2300m Chateaubriant Class E 11 days ago, and will have nothing to contribute

**Summary:** LADY MAJOR (2) stormed home at Graignes recently when competitively shod for the first time and is ideally-positioned to repeat. Robin Lamy will nevertheless be justifiably wary of LEWISIA DE LATOM (5) who he himself drove to victory mid-May, and LOUNA DU LOCHEUR (4) who, although unraced since December, will be no soft touch if focused. LADY MASTER (7) proved superior to the Jajolet filly at Graignes and warrants consideration.

### C7 - PRIX LE MARYLAND DE GISORS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class G Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- **1. JEREZ -** Makes first start since running 5th of 12 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D last August. Shod for re-entry and starts on the rail but takes a notable dip in category and will be hard to oppose
- **2. GRANADOS -** Last of 13 on comeback in a 2800m Vire amateurs Class G on 20 April. Raced better that day than the result would suggest and looks main danger to JEREZ (1)
- **3. GET READY -** Back in the harness game after coming 7th of 11 in a 2700m Graignes monte Class D a fortnight ago. Has never excelled at Mauquenchy but has the wherewithal to pick up a first-5 cheque this time
- **4. HIMEROS DU GOUTIER -** Honest campaigner that ran 4th of 12, a place behind GOPTION MONTAVAL (8), in a 2750m amateurs Class G at La Capelle last Saturday. Handed a good draw but seems to be biting off more than he can chew
- **5. FRINGANT PACHA -** Ran 2nd over course and distance before comfortably winning a 2850m Laon amateurs Class G on 1 May. Has nothing to prove under these conditions and is well-placed to give this a good go
- **6. FLASH BACK DU NORD -** Has raced respectably this year, most recently coming 4th of 10 in a 2825m amateurs Class G at Le Croise-Laroche on Monday, and backs up with moderate ambition
- **7. HOUBLON BLEU -** Made little impact when 7th of 18 in a 2825m Bernay claimer 2.5 weeks ago and the draw will do him no favours
- **8. GOPTION MONTAVAL -** Produced another good effort to come 3rd of 12 in a 2750m amateurs Class G at La Capelle last Saturday. Is plainly close to her race, has form under these conditions, and despite the draw can finish close
- **9. GYPSIE MAGIQUE -** Ran 3rd at Enghien but failed to confirm when 11th of 12 in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class F in late-April. Comes here fresh, is proven at the venue, and should not be overlooked
- **10. GAVROCHE BOCAIN -** Unexceptional 7th of 15 on comeback in a 2700m amateurs Class G at Le Croise-Laroche on 12 May and will have nothing to offer
- **11. HARLEY DE JANEIRO -** Last of 11 in a 2750m Elbeuf amateurs Class H a month ago. Barefoot this time but latest numbers do nothing to inspire confidence

**Summary:** A quality element that has never failed to fire at Mauquenchy, JEREZ (1) may not have been seen out since last August, and races with shoes fitted, but at this level will be hard to beat. GRANADOS (2) has yet to deliver in the amateur division but is a very capable sort with a decent spot on the front line. Less favourably drawn, GOPTION MONTAVAL (8) has been progressing well and ran 3rd on her only start under these conditions. FRINGANT PACHA (5) takes on a decent lot here but is in the form of his career and has solid credentials in the day's configuration.

# C8 - PRIX ZAZA DE BRETEUIL - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- **1. MASSILIO BLOND -** Unremarkable type that ran 10th of 12, a place behind MY LADY DE CAHOT (9), in a 2700m Class D at Le Croise-Laroche a fortnight ago, and will have nothing to contribute
- 2. **MULTIPASS** Has come into himself this year, most recently securing a 2750m Elbeuf Class G 2.5 weeks ago. Enjoys a decent draw and is unlikely to be far from the action at the business end of the race
- **3. MASSALIA DU BOURG -** Made amends for 2 straight sanctions when 3rd of 7 in a 2600m Nancy Class D last Friday. Placed nicely on front row but has no left-handed references and others easier to back
- **4. MADE IN CASTELETS -** Honourable 4th of 7 in a 2400m Amiens Class E 10 days ago. Races first-time left-handed and in this company seems to be taking on too much
- **5. MYRIADE D'ORION -** Made up for April sanction when 2nd of 9, at 34/1, in a 2550m Reims Class E on 17 May. Unlikely to repeat but is still worth keeping an eye on
- **6. MUZE MAKER -** Won on debut before coming 2nd of 10 in a 2700m Graignes Class E on 9 May. Starts in front and winning this is well within his capacity
- **7. MICHELANGELO ZEN -** Lost his maiden tag at Lyon-Parilly before finishing 6th of 7 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle on 8 May. Ran better that day than the result would imply and it would be foolhardy to ignore his chances
- **8. MARIEVA DE LOU -** Well-regarded filly that ran 2nd of 12 in a 2400m Amiens Class F in early-April. Not ideally-drawn, and takes on the colts, but nevertheless has a realistic chance of opening her account
- **9. MY LADY DE CAHOT -** Out of the picture in all 3 starts last month, latterly 9th of 12 in a 2700m Class D at Le Croise-Laroche a fortnight ago, and can be ruled out
- **10. MAYO DES FLOTS -** Failed to make any impression when 9th of 12 on debut in a 2300m Le Mans Class F on 8 May. May not be an obvious choice on paper but has the wherewithal to turn a few heads
- **11. MOGADOR -** Sanctioned in a 2800m Rambouillet Class F a week ago. Has evident ability and even though starting on back row will be dangerous if focused

**Summary:** Sent for a spell after making a solid debut at Amiens 2 months ago, MARIEVA DE LOU (8) runs left-handed for the first time but is a promising future prospect with a decent chance of getting off the mark. Robin Lamy will be justifiably wary though of the better-placed MUZE MAKER (6) who has been thoroughly professional to date. MAYO DES FLOTS (10) is better than her Le Mans bow would suggest and should be treated more favourably on this occasion. MOGADOR (11) has yet to make good on his promise but it is just a question of time.
