

## R3 NANCY [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX CHAMPAGNE COMTE DE LA FORTELLE - 5000m (a3m1/8) - TURF - Class 3 - Cross - EUR €  
24,000**

**1. JIBE DES DUNES** - Finished 5th in a Conditions race over 5500m at Moulins on 17 September. His connections have called on Félix de Giles for his first run back and that speaks volumes

**2. HERMINE ALLEN** - A 15-length 3rd in a Conditions race over 5200m at Lyon Parilly on 4 May. She may have been well beaten last time but she could run into the places

**3. BRUNCH ROYAL** - Ran 4th in a Cross Country event over 4100m at Merano in Italy on 10 May. He drops in class this time and must be considered

**4. GAZEE DE BEDON** - A moderate 7th in a Conditions race over 5200m at Strasbourg on 18 April. Likely to battle in this event

**5. SPES FULLKAM** - Beaten just 0.5lengths in a Steeplechase over 3500m at Toulouse on 21 May. That was his first run of the year and it should prepare him for a decent run in this

**6. DISCO DE VAUT** - Finished at the back of a 5-horse field in a Conditions race over 5200m at Strasbourg on 27 September. Comes back from a break and will need to up his game

**7. GABSTONE** - A 6-length 2nd in a Conditions race over 4500m at Nancy on 26 April. A consistent performer who has not finished outside the top two in cross country racing

**8. KARMIX** - Finished 4th in a Conditions race over 4500m at Nancy on 26 April. Does look held by GABSTONE (7) on that run but is another than could place

**9. FREYDIS** - A well-beaten 6th in a conditions race over 5000m at Nancy on 12 October. Unlikely to be competitive in this company

**Summary:** GABSTONE (7) is a reliable performer who is always a contender, and after a decent run last time at this course over shorter in which he was running on strongly, he will be better over this trip and can claim his first win. SPES FULLKAM (5) was narrowly beaten last time after a rest and should improve returning to cross country racing. JIBE DES DUNES (1) makes his comeback with Félix de Giles up while BRUNCH ROYAL (3) drops in class.

**C2 - PRIX ALPINE NANCY (PLACE D'ALLIANCE) - 3800m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Claiming - Hurdles - EUR € 19,000**

- 1. SYSKO** - A 3.50-length winner of a Claimer over 4100m at Royan on 14 May. That was his first run at this level and he could easily double up
- 2. TY ZUMS** - A poor 9th in a Maiden over 3400m at Moulins on 9 May. Hopefully that race on the Flat will have sharpened him up but he will need to regain his old form
- 3. JUST A KISS SIVOLA** - Was 8th in a in a Steeplechase Handicap over 4200m at Strasbourg on 8 May. Has a win in this discipline and needs to be taken seriously returning to hurdles
- 4. KABRIOLE DE SIVOLA** - Finished 9th in a Hurdles Conditions race over 3800m at Moulins on 9 May. Has been alternating between Flat and Hurdles and will be looking for her first win in this discipline
- 5. JILAIJONE** - A 0.75-length winner over a Claimer over 3600m at Auteuil on 26 May. Did well to win on sweltering day and will be looking to confirm that form
- 6. QUEMAL** - Finished 5th in a Flat race over 2400m at Mulheim in Germany on 17 May. Will be having his first attempt "over the sticks" and will need to prove himself
- 7. LE PETIT NICE** - Finished 6th in a Steeplechase Handicap over 4700m at this course on 20 May. Has good form at this level and returns to hurdles with high hopes
- 8. IN MY MIND** - A 5-length 2nd in a Steeplechase Handicap over 3900m at Wissembourg on 25 May. She is running well and should perform better back over hurdles
- 9. BEAUTYFULL EYES** - A well-beaten 11th in a Claimer over 3600m at Auteuil on 26 May. She is better than her recent performances and she could showed it in this event
- 10. MISTER DU BRIZAIS** - A moderate 6th in a Steeplechase over 4000m at Orleans on 17 May. Still chasing a first win, he will need to up his game

**Summary:** SYSKO (1) could hardly have been more impressive when running out a facile winner of a Claimer, and there is no reason why he can't notch up a quick double. The main challenge is likely to come from JILAIJONE (5), who also comes off a courageous victory and has a good record at this level. BEAUTYFULL EYES (9) has the ability to be a threat and needs to be taken seriously while LE PETIT NICE (7) has a decent record at this level.

### C3 - PRIX NEUVES-MAISONS - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 11,500

1. **CAPITOL HILL** - A hard-fought winner of a Claimer over 1800m at Evreux on 26 May. Is in good form and must have a winning chance
2. **SPARKS OF LOVE** - Finished 6th in a Claimer over 1600m at ParisLongchamp on 28 May. She drops in class this time and will be a threat in this field
3. **CHACUN SA VIE** - Finished last in a field of 14 in Claimer over 1100m at Croise-Laroche on 17 May. Never showed in that race and is best ignored
4. **ZITTO** - A mediocre 8th in a Conditions race over 2400m at Compiegne on 25 May. Struggling at the moment and will need to show more
5. **EXTRAVAGANZA** - A poor 10th in a Claimer over 1600m at Lyon Parilly on 8 May. Has a lot more to do to make a mark in this race
6. **MARANELLO** - Finished 4th in a race over 1850m at Cologne in Germany on 25 May. Form in France has not been encouraging
7. **CHIPITO** - A well-beaten 5th in a Maiden over 2400m at Wissembourg on 25 May. So far form has been moderate but might prefer the drop in trip and class
8. **SEEWAY** - Finished 9th in a Conditions race over 1200m at Saint-Cloud on 22 May. He takes a serious drop in class and can come back to his best form
9. **NATIVE RULER** - Ran 5th in a race over 1750m at Halle in Germany on 9 May. Ran 3rd the last time he raced at this course and should be competitive
10. **KHENOUCHOPE** - A well-beaten 10th in Handicap over 2000m at this track on 20 May. Needs to up her game to have any chance
11. **SEDE VACANTE** - A moderate 9th in a Handicap over 2000m at this course on 20 May. Will be more competitive dropping to this level and can place
12. **MON COEUR ALLEMAND** - A poor 8th in a Maiden over 1400m at Strasbourg on 14 September. Comes back from a lengthy layoff and will need to do more
13. **CHARISMATIC GOLD** - Unraced 3yo filly by Galileo Gold out of Dandy Man mare Fast Dandy trained by Mickael Seror. Comes from an in-form stable and must have a chance in a weak field

**Summary:** SEEWAY (8) won on debut when arriving from the UK but that was on the sand. He will now be out to prove he can be as effective on turf. CAPITOL HILL (1) fought all the way to the line to win his last race and probably has the best recent form in the race. SPARKS OF LOVE (2) faced a far stronger field when 6th last time and can improve on that position in this company. NATIVE RULER (9) has a decent record at this course.

**C4 - PRIX PONT-A-MOUSSON - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR €  
15,400**

- 1. WOODSTONE** - Finished 6th in a race over 2000m at Munich-Riem in Germany on 23 May. He is expected to be competitive in a race of this strength
- 2. CASCADEO** - A decent 4th in a Handicap over 2000m at this course on 20 May. Finished ahead of LADY MADEIRA (5) in that race but could struggle to confirm that form
- 3. READY KING** - Winner of a Claimer over 1800m at Croise-Laroche on 17 May. Takes on stronger this time so will have more to do
- 4. VALLANDO** - A 1.5-length 2nd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 20 May. If he can repeat that performance he could prove hard to beat.
- 5. LADY MADEIRA** - A reasonable 6th in a Handicap over this track and trip on 20 May. She is probably better than that run may indicate
- 6. VITUS BERING** - Winner of a Handicap over this course and distance on 20 May. Fought well to win that race and jumps from a better draw this time
- 7. MIAIMAOU** - Finished 4th in a Handicap over 2000m at this track on 20 May. Looks well held by other on that last run
- 8. BREMONTIER** - A narrow winner of a Conditions race over 2125m at Wissembourg on 25 May. Will find it a lot tougher in this race
- 9. LOVELY TESS** - Winner of a race over 2200m at Hassloch in Germany on 16 May. Her earlier runs at this course have not been inspiring
- 10. LADY ACE** - A close-up 2nd in a Handicap over this course and distance on 20 May. She was touched off by VITUS BERING (6) in that race and is capable of turning the tables
- 11. SECRET GLORY** - A solid 3rd a Handicap over this course and distance on 20 May. She ran well in the race won by VITUS BERING (6) and should be up there again

**Summary:** There is quite a lot of close form in this race but there was a lot to like about the way VALLANDO (4) competed last time when second behind a decent performer and he can get it right this time. WOODSTONE (1) ran well in a race in Germany and should find these conditions ideal for him. There is not much to choose between LADY ACE (10) and VITUS BERING (6) on their last run but the former looks capable of reversing that earlier defeat.

**C5 - PRIX DE LA PLACE STANISLAS - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR  
€ 17,300**

1. **LEPARD** - Unplaced last time, 2nd previously over 2000m at this track in a Class 4 race on April 26th. Can be on the premises
2. **USER AMISTOSO** - Recent success over 2500m in a Class 4 race at Le Croise-Laroche on March 28th. Can give another decent account of himself
3. **MURRAY** - Placed 3rd on the latest start over 2300m at Mulheim (DEU) in a conditions race on May 17th. One to pay attention to
4. **SAINT AQUILIN** - Recent win over 1800m in a Class 4 race at Evreux on May 26th. In form and has to enter each-way calculations
5. **STAR CREEK** - Placed 4th on his most recent run over 2000m at Lyon Parilly on April 29th in a Class 4 handicap. Unlikely to trouble some of these
6. **FITZCARRALDO** - Recent 5th over 2000m at this track in a Class 4 race on April 26th. Not the most reliable and can be opposed
7. **TAKEO** - Two unplaced efforts this year, the latter when 7th at Deauville over 1900m in a conditions race on January 30th. Outside place contender
8. **SILVER BEAUTY** - Placed 4th on the latest start over 2000m at Strasbourg on May 8th in a Class 3 handicap. Live chance
9. **ZARAKIVA** - Two 5th place runs since a win over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on April 4th. Likes this track and has leading claims
10. **RUE HELENE** - Two unplaced runs this year, 7th at Le Croise-Laroche in a Class 4 race on May 17th when last seen. Makes limited appeal
11. **MR RIEM** - Unplaced last time over the track and trip on April 4th in a Class 4 handicap behind ZARKAVIA (9). Hard to recommend

**Summary:** ZARAKIVA (9) is attractively weighted and has performed with credit in both outings since her victory over this course and distance on April 4. She gets the vote to come out on top. SILVER BEAUTY (8) looks the principal danger after a solid fourth-place finish at Strasbourg on May 8. LEPARD (1) produced a respectable runner-up effort at this track two starts ago and is another with strong claims. SAINT AQUILIN (4) arrives in winning form following a recent success at Évreux and also merits respect.

**C6 - PRIX HENRI DORY (PORTE HERE) - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 19,200**

1. **VENT DU LARGE** - Decent 2nd on sole start over 2400m at La-Roche-Posay in a maiden race on May 17th. Can improve and play a lead role
2. **HELLO SPRING** - Three unplaced runs, well beaten over 2200m in a maiden at Fontainebelau on February 28th when last seen. One to avoid
3. **WHITE MIRACLE** - Two unplaced runs since a 4th on debut at Hamburg-Horn (DEU) over 1400m in a conditions race on June 29th, 2025. Hard to rule out of the frame at nice odds
4. **LUSON** - Has not featured in two runs, well beaten over 2000m at Nancy on May 20th in a maiden last time out. Hard to fancy
5. **LEDESMA** - Non-Runner
6. **IWAJUR** - Showed talent on the sole run over 2400m at Saint-Cloud in a conditions race on May 15th. Can improve and know more this time
7. **SCHWYZER** - 7th on his debut over 2000m at Compiegne on May 25th in a conditions race. Has to make vast progress to trouble the principles
8. **YUNA** - Below par last time over 2400m at Compiegne when 7th in a maiden race on May 9th. She must do more to make the frame
9. **WILDSTAR** - In the rear over 2000m at Nancy in a maiden on her only start on May 20th. Has to improve considerably to make the top three
10. **TULLIS** - No show in two starts, the latter over 2600m at Marseille Borely in a maiden race on May 18th. Place chance at best
11. **CEVENNES** - Finished 5th last time over 1800m in a Class 3 race at Le Croise-Laroche on April 4th. Likely to find a few too smart
12. **PRINCESS OF HABO** - Fair 3rd two runs back at Munich-Riem (DEU) in a conditions race over 2000m on May 1st. Can make the frame
13. **SORELINO** - Unraced gelding by Intello, the dam won 2 races. From a good stable that can produce first time out winners. Can be expected to have a say in the finish
14. **BIJOUX STAR** - Filly by Weltstar, the dam won 3 races over jumps. Likely to need this run for experience and is best watched for the time being

**Summary:** LEDESMA (5), from the Francis-Henri Graffard stable, looks the most logical choice in this open contest. He has finished third on both career starts at Lyon Parilly, most recently on May 8, and appears ready to go close. The main threat could be SORELINO (13), a newcomer from a yard capable of producing debut winners and one who warrants close market attention. IWAJUR (6) showed promise on debut at Saint-Cloud last month and is entitled to improve. VENT DU LARGE (1) also merits consideration.

**C7 - PRIX CLAIRE ET JACQUES LECLERC - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 4 Claiming Handicap - Flat  
- EUR € 11,500**

- 1. SHACKLETON** - Four unplaced runs this year, 7th at Strasbourg over 3000m in a Class 3 handicap on May 27th last time out. Has the ability to put in a better performance
- 2. COLE CHOP** - Placed 3rd last time over 2500m at this track in a Class 4 race on May 20th. One to look at each-way
- 3. SAMBA** - Two unplaced runs of late, 2nd before that over 2400m at Lyon La Soie on March 21st in a Class 4 handicap. Can be opposed
- 4. LOS SUENOS** - Well beaten at this track over 2000m on May 20th in a Class 4 handicap last time out. He needs to bounce back to form but is capable of doing so
- 5. ROCHEUX** - Did not inspire last time at this track on May 20th, 3rd before that in a Class 4 race over 2125m on May 1st at Wissembourg. Looks vulnerable
- 6. WINDJANA** - Placed 3rd on her most recent start at this track over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap on May 20th. Can get another success
- 7. GLORY DAYS** - Unplaced on the one run this year over 2000m at Strasbourg in a Class 4 handicap on May 8th. Unlikely to be a threat
- 8. M'GLAMOUR** - Finished 4th last time out over 2500m in a Class 4 race on May 20th. Has work to do to make the top four

**Summary:** WINDJANA (6) shaped well when finishing third in a Class 4 handicap at this venue late last month and earns a narrow vote to go one better. SHACKLETON (1) has been below his best on his last four outings, but he remains capable of making an impact in a contest that lacks strength in depth. COLE CHOP (2) produced a solid effort at this track on his most recent start and holds strong each-way claims.  
LOS SUENOS (4) disappointed here last time, but his success on the PSF in February suggests he cannot be overlooked

## C8 - PRIX LEONARD ERMANN - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - Class 3 - Flat - EUR € 14,600

**1. KHALINSKHA** - She won her last two races, both at Cagnes-Sur-Mer, the latter over 1500m in a handicap on February 22nd. Improving and will be ready to go

**2. MARDAD FAL** - Unplaced in a Listed race on May 14th last time out, a win over this track and trip before that in a maiden race on April 4th. Hard to ignore

**3. SARDINIAN RULER** - Nice success over 1500m in a maiden at Cagnes -Sur-Mer on January 14th with a game effort. One to pay attention to

**4. MADAME FAYETTE** - Won on her latest start over 1600m at Lyon Parilly in a maiden race on May 8th. More to do in a better race

**5. REPEL** - Finished 5th last time over 1400m in a Group 3 race at Deauville on April 7th, and a win before that over 1100m on August 5th, 2025. Can score back in calmer waters

**6. MADAME MAGIC** - Unplaced last time over 1600m in a maiden race at Lyon Parilly on May 8th, Listed placed in Germany last September. Looks safely held

**Summary:** REPEL (5) faced a stiff assignment in a Group 3 contest at Deauville last time and should find this company much more manageable. She is preferred over KHALINSKHA (1), who rates the main danger. A dual winner seeking a hat-trick, she arrives on the back of a handicap success over 1500m at Cagnes-sur-Mer in late February and still appears open to progress. SARDINIAN RULER (3) made a successful second start in a maiden in January and remains a horse with considerable scope for improvement.
