## C1 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE LANGON - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LIBERTA FLEURANCE** - Unplaced in a class F mounted race at Monpazier over 3125m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 2. LEGENDE DE MAI** - Off form and finished 9th in a class E over this track and trip on 15 May. Needs major improvement to score
- 3. LOVELY GAZELLE** - Disqualified in a class F at Montauban over 2400m on 24 May. Remains barefoot but is not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 4. LAMPEDUSA** - Disqualified in a class F at Issigeac over 2275m on 24 May. Not easy to trust but has a place chance on best form
- 5. LADY GODIVA** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, the latest in a class F at Vichy over 2150m on 28 May. Capable of a surprise when smart
- 6. LILONA DU PADOUENG** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a class F at Montauban over 2400m on 24 May. Reverts to barefoot and can go one place better
- 7. LADY BEAUTIFUL** - Disqualified in a class F at Chatelaillon-La-Rochelle over 2500m on 1 May. Very hard to trust and others are preferred
- 8. LOLA DE LA DOUCE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted in a class E at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Can be a threat for Theo Briand
- 9. LAIKA CARISAIE** - Did not show her best when 7th in a class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 10. LUNA DE NARMONT** - Finished 7th in a class E at Monpazier over 3125m on 31 May. Reverts to barefoot and could score in a race of this nature
- 11. LICORNE QUICK** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F at Issigeac over 2275m on 24 May. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 12. LILAS DU MELEUC** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class D at Montauban over 2400m on 25 May. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- 13. LUCRECE** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset in best form
- 14. LA MOME BEAUFOR** - Did not show her best when 9th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 22 March. Reverts to barefoot and is clearly not out of it

**Summary:** In this wide-open contest, the answer could lie on the front line, with Luna de Narmont (10), who is being aimed at this first real target, Lola de la Douce (8), whose chance hinges on her temperament but deserves respect, and Lilona du Padoueng (6), who goes fully barefoot this time. From the 25-metre handicap, La Môme Beaufour (14), improved when racing without shoes and can get involved with the finish yet again.

## C2 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE VILLEREAL - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. NIGHT DE JANEIRO** - Victorious in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2050m on 14 February. Improving but could need this run returning from a small break
- 2. NAOMIE DUEM** - Has been promising so far and was runner-up in a class E at Montauban over 2400m on 14 May. Can go one place better
- 3. NITALIANO MIJO** - Has done little wrong so far and was a runner-up in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 17 May. Has claims in this line-up
- 4. NEVIDENCE ROC** - Did not show her best when 6th in a class D at Castillonnes over 2450m on 26 April. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 5. NORTON DU GOSIER** - Has some fair form and fifth in a class D at Castillonnes over 2450m on 26 April. Might play a minor role at very best
- 6. NATAELCO DU PELUT** - Consistent so far and finished fourth in a class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Capable of making the frame
- 7. NACRE D'ALBRET** - Disqualified in a class E at Montauban over 2400m on 14 May. Capable of playing a minor role when staying in stride
- 8. NASHVILLE BLUE** - Unreliable but did run well when fourth in a class D at Argentan over 2150m on 11 May. Can be a threat if staying in stride
- 9. NINO DU PLESSIS** - Disqualified in a class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Capable of doing better but is unreliable and others are preferred
- 10. NICOTINE D'ELLE** - Successful on debut in a class G at Monpazier over 2275m on 3 May. Tougher task this time but cannot be ruled out

**Summary:** A field of largely unexposed three-year-olds, some of whom look destined for a bright future. Nitaliano Mijo (3) is fitted with shoes for the first time, which could make all the difference. However, the fillies Naomie Duem (2), who bumped into a smart rival at Montauban, Nashville Blue (8), a winner at Laval as a two-year-old, and Night de Janeiro (1), worth noting on her reappearance, all have solid claims.

### C3 - PRIX JEAN-LOUIS CHARLEMAGNE - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **LE FILS PRODIGUE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F at Montauban over 2400m on 25 May. Did better last year and others make more appeal
2. **LYCOS D'OSMOZ** - Holding form and finished fourth in a class F at this track over 2325m on 3 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
3. **LEXO JELOCA** - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2950m on 15 May. Remains barefoot but is capable of earning some money when smart
4. **LEWIS DU PADOUENG** - Successful in a class F at Montauban over 2400m on 25 May. Not reliable but is capable of doubling up
5. **LYCAON DES VENTS** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 255m on 29 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **LAISSEZ PASSER** - Unreliable and finished third in a class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 17 May. Might play a minor role at very best
7. **L'AMI DE LANCOUR** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Has a place chance on best form
8. **LESS TIME** - Victorious in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of following up
9. **LEWIS DE BLARY** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and can be a threat to these rivals
10. **LEXINGTON DU BOURG** - Disqualified in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
11. **LOULOU'S TEAM** - In good form and finished third in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
12. **LOYAL FRIEND** - Unplaced in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 April. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of an upset on best form

**Summary:** A competitive looking event and the talented but tricky, Less Time (8) got back to winning ways on the grass at Avignon. He can follow up on the sand. If he falters, Loulou's Team (11), now back in top form, looks the one most likely to capitalise. Lewis du Padoueng (4), who has a great understanding with Frédéric Clozier, and the ultra-consistent Lewis de Blary (9), also bring strong claims to the table.

## C4 - PRIX FONTAINE BAYONNE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KOETANE D'AVRIL** - May have needed the last run when fifth in a class F at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 6 April. Remains barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 2. KATHY DU PERCHE** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class G at Montauban over 2400m on 25 May. Might play a minor role
- 3. KAPRIJKE CALENDES** - In good form and was third in a class G at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 May. Remains barefoot and can challenge for top honours
- 4. KIRKENESSE** - In good shape and was fourth in a class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 24 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 5. KIERA MAGIC** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class E at Miramont-de-Guyenne over 2700m on 25 May. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
- 6. KALIPETTE JELOCA** - Unreliable and finished fourth in a class D at Argentan over 2875m on 19 May. Has a place chance on best form
- 7. KISS ME JIHEM** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 24 May. Needs to do more to score
- 8. KWINIE JIHAIME** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a class H at Miramont-de-Guyenne over 2700m on 14 May. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 9. KALINA STAR** - Victorious in a class F at Carcassonne over 2625m on 10 May. Remains barefoot but does tackle stronger this time around. Might place
- 10. KANDIE DU BASSIN** - Off form and was unplaced in a class H at Miramont-de-Guyenne over 2700m on 14 May. Needs major improvement to score

**Summary:** Koetane d'Avril (1) thrives in partnership with Théo Briand and likely needed her latest outing, so she is worth another chance. Kirkenesse (4), is much improved since racing without shoes and looks the main danger. Kaprijke Calendes (3), in excellent form and ill not go don easily this course and distance. Kiera Magic (5), should come on for her recent comeback run and is capable of troubling the judge.

**C5 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE CASTILLONNES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR €  
24,000**

- 1. KALINEO PENEME** - Disqualified in class F at Castillonnes over 2450m on 8 May. Not easy to trust but is quite capable of bouncing back to score when smart
- 2. KRISTOBAL** - Finished 13th in class E at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2550m on 29 April. Off form and others are much preferred
- 3. KASH DE TILLARD** - Returned to form and finished 3rd in class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 24 May. Likely to be competitive once again
- 4. KADOR D'ESPACE** - Disqualified in class G at Vichy over 2950m on 10 May. Very hard to trust but can make the frame when staying in stride
- 5. KAPEO** - Very consistent and was runner-up in class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 24 May. Should fight out the finish once again
- 6. KRISTAL DU PALAIS** - Finished 6th in class D at This course over 2950m on 15 May. Capable of better and is not out of it in this line-up
- 7. KNOX JENILOU** - Victorious in class G at Le Touquet over 2600m on 24 May. Not reliable does look capable of following up
- 8. KROONER D'ORION** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at Issigeac over 2300m on 24 May. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. KASIMIR JELOCA** - Has struggled this year and was 9th in class F at Gourney-en-Bray over 2550m on 24 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. KALIMERO** - Only modest of late and was 9th in class F at Castelsarrassin over 2375m on 3 May. On a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 11. KIRIKOU DU DROPT** - Consistent and was 4th in class E at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2550m on 17 May. Victorious in April and can earn some money
- 12. KOALA DU DROPT** - In good shape and was 3rd in class E at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2550m on 29 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 13. KAMARO DUEM** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in class G at Marseille-Borely over 2400m on 17 August. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 14. KRIS ROC** - Not reliable and was 5th in class E at Issigeac over 3175m on 24 May. Needs to do a bit more to score

**Summary:** KNOX JENILOU (7) returned to winning ways on his mounted race debut and now switches back to the sulky full of confidence. He looks a leading contender. KAPEO (5), who is thriving at present, and the unpredictable KALINEO PENEME (1), for whom it will likely be all or nothing are dangers. At his best, KASH DE TILLARD (3) should make the most of this golden opportunity and can also be a threat to these rivals.

## C6 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME DE MONTAUBAN - 2950m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 25,000

- 1. JIKA SAUTONNE** - Disqualified in a claimer at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2550m on 1 June. Very hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 2. JIM JOY** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 30 May. On a long losing streak and needs to do better to win
- 3. JUST A SONG** - Disqualified in class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 30 May. Unreliable and needs to improve to beat these rivals
- 4. JADE GERBEHAYE** - Finished 5th in class E at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2550m on 17 May. Victorious back in April and can contest the finish
- 5. JOHN STEED** - Did not show his best when 8th in class D mounted race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 30 May. Victorious back in April and can score back in a harness race
- 6. JEEN LOVER** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 27 May. VMight play a minor role at very best
- 7. JAGUAR DU LONDEL** - Has struggled this year and was 9th in class H at Monpazier over 3125m on 3 May. Unreliable and needs to do more to score
- 8. JIVA** - Not reliable and finished 7th at Durtal over 2850m on 25 May. Better judged on a good penultimate run and is not out of it
- 9. JAURIAS** - Only modest of late and was 11th in class G at Langon over 2800m on 1 May. Barefoot this time and can get into the mix of things
- 10. JUPPY UP** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Can be competitive in this line-up

**Summary:** The victory should be fought out between JOHN STEED (5), who is transformed when racing unshod, and JIVA (8), who looks close to his peak level of form. A newcomer to the South-West, JAURIAS (9) is one to keep an eye on and should soon be making his presence felt. JUPPY UP (10), consistent in his efforts may need to find a few lengths to beat those three rivals but is capable of making the frame this time.

## C7 - PRIX BAPTISTE MASSEGUIN - 2950m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 30,000

1. **MAC VENESI** - Did not show his best when 11th in a Class D over this course and distance on 15 May. Had been in good form prior to that and is not out of it
2. **MOOREA DE SAUSSEAU** - Unreliable this year and finished 8th in a Class D over this track and trip on 15 May. Others preferred
3. **MISS DE LA COTE** - On a long losing run and finished 5th in a Class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 7 May. Might play a minor role at very best
4. **MISTRAL DE LOISEL** - Yet to win but has gone close on several occasions, including when runner-up last time in a Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 23 May. Can go one place better
5. **MALICE D'ATOUT** - In good form and runner-up in a Class C at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 7 May. Should be involved in the finish
6. **MIKADO PIEMONT** - Below par when 10th in a Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 17 May. Had some solid wins before that and could bounce back
7. **MAGNUM DAIRPET** - Consistent of late and finished fourth, barefoot, in a Class D over this course and distance on 15 May. Can make the frame again
8. **MARAVILLA DU METZ** - Has shown fair form and finished 5th in a Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 17 May. Others preferred for winning purposes
9. **MUSCDARCHE** - Usually competitive and finished third in a Class C at Vichy over 2150m on 18 May. Can be in the mix of things
10. **MAURICIEN** - Winner of three of his last four starts, including a Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 23 May. Leading contender once more
11. **MARZIPAN** - Needed both runs this year and was 9th in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 2 May. Can challenge for top honours
12. **MANHATTAN EMGE** - In good form and was runner-up in Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 March. Can go one place better

**Summary:** A chance is taken on Manhattan Emge (12), who must concede 50 metres but still commands plenty of confidence from his astute trainer. Marzipan (11), racing lighter for the very first time drops in class for this and is a threat. The progressive Mauricien (10) also looks a threat to these rivals. From the front line, Magnum Dairpet (7) is unlikely to hang about and could prove hard to peg back this time.

## C8 - GRAND PRIX DU CAPITOLE - 2950m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 53,000

- 1. NEW EXPRESS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 10th in class E at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2400m on 17 May. Needs to do more to score
- 2. CAVIAR FROM MINE** - Did not show his best when 12th in Vincennes over 2700m on 22 February. Capable of better and could make the frame
- 3. FILOU DE SITA** - Much improved last run when 3rd in class D at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Might play a minor role
- 4. KINGSLAYER PELLINI** - Successful in four of last five starts, including last time out in class C at this course over 2100m on 15 May. Should score again
- 5. FREEDOM (NOR)** - Victorious in class C at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Has already won three times this year and is clearly not out of it
- 6. ICARE DU BERYL** - Has shown improvement of late and was 3rd in class C at this track over 2150m on 15 May. capable of earning more money
- 7. JUST A MIDI** - Unreliable and was unplaced last time out in Class A at Granville over 3100m o 24 May. Down in class and caould be a threat to these rivals
- 8. GERICAULT** - In good form and was runner-up in class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 15 May. Can contest then finish once again
- 9. GUERRIER CASTELETS** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in class C at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Has a place chance in thsi line-up
- 10. GALANT DE CAREL** - Only moderate of late and finished 6th in class C at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 30 May. On a long losing streak and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 11. FAKIR MERITE** - Off form and finished 10th in class A at Beaumont-de Lomagne over 2550m on 29 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**Summary:** Still in advance of the handicapper, KINGSLAYER PELLINI (4) is chasing a fifth win in six starts this year and continues to look a cut above his rivals. Stablemate GERICAULT (8) and ICARE DU BERYL (6) filled the places behind him recently over a shorter trip and once again look set to be in the thick of things. We also interpose FREEDOM (5), who has been rarely disappointing since arriving on these shores and should remain competitive.
