- **9. EDGAR SABA -** Came 4th over shorter here before running 10th of 12 finishers in 2850m Gr.2 Prix Jean-Yves Lecuyer at Vincennes on 22 June. Has never disappointed at Enghien though and Francois Lagadeuc will be eyeing a place on the podium
- **10. KOBAYASHI** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently 22 June race of reference. Was not the most fortunate that day but has nothing to prove at this level and with stride in check can get in on the action
- **11. JAZZMAN (GER) -** Was clearly in good shape when sanctioned in 22 June race of reference. Already a Gr.3 winner this term and although unlikely to repeat, he sports pads this time and can make first 5
- **12. LOVISSIME -** 6th of 17 in a 2850m Vincennes monte Gr.1 on 22 June. Here for a change of scenery and can be passed over
- **13. KEEN WINNER -** 6th of 12 finishers behind KARAMBAR (7), despite some poor luck, in 2850m Gr.2 Prix Jean-Yves Lecuyer at Vincennes on 22 June. Is patently in excellent condition though and and can impose if she stays clear of trouble
- **14. KAMEHAMEHA -** 6th of 10 finishers behind KEEN WINNER (13) in 2175m Gr.2 Prix Jean le Gonidec across town a month ago. Will have come on for the run and the engagement of Eric Raffin speaks volumes

Summary: Runner-up in the Gr.2 Prix Jean le Gonidec a month ago before being denied a run in the G.3 Prix Jean-Yves Lecuyer a fortnight ago, KEEN WINNER (13) has already won under these conditions and can do so again if Yoann Lebourgeois keeps her out of harm's way. KAMEHAMEHA (14) makes just his 2nd start back but is reunited with Eric Raffin and looks the main threat. KARAMBAR (7) left a good impression here 2 weeks ago and should again figure prominently, as should the Enghien-loving EDGAR SABA (9) who will be expected to bounce back.

- **1. FUNNY HORSE -** Good 2nd of 10 in a 2575m Agen Class E 2 weeks ago. Sports modified shoeing but starts on the rail and others easier to back
- **2. GUESS FOUTEAU -** Takes a dip in category after coming 7th of 14, a place behind GIPSY BOND (6), in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 30 May. Franck Nivard stays faithful and from the 2-spot is not about to disappoint
- **3. GALINETTE BLEUE** 4th of 10 finishers in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class D on 8 June. Gabi Gelormini in the bike this time but still needs to find more
- **4. GAMINE DE RIBEAU -** Sanctioned in a 2800m Rambouillet Class E a fortnight back. A write-off so far this year and has no possible chance
- **5. HEYDAY -** Quality element that ran 11th of 16 in a 2800m Class E conditioner at Castéra-Verduzan last weekend and even though new to the venue still looks the one to beat
- **6. GIPSY BOND -** Back under harness after coming last but one in a 2700m Vincennes monte Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Starts in front and can play a role if he repeats his penultimate performance
- **7. GROUPIE DU QUENNE -** Sanctioned in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class D a month back. Reunited with Yoann Lebourgeois with whom she goes well and is eminently capable of finishing in the mix
- **8. HEUREUX DE FLEUR -** 3rd of 14 on re-entry in a 3450m Agon-Coutainville Class E a fortnight ago. Has a particular liking for Enghien and will have a lot to offer if he stays in stride
- **9. HURLEVENT -** Sanctioned on comeback in a 2350m Angers Class E on 10 June and would be preferred under the saddle
- **10. HAROLD SAUTONNE -** Unable to confirm Les Sables-d'Olonne victory when 6th of 14 in a 2650m Segre Class E last Sunday. Tends to go well in the day's configuration and even from the 2nd row looks a leading contender
- **11. HEAVEN D'ECAJEUL -** Returns to the professional ranks after dominating a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class F 11 days ago. On 2nd row but is plainly enjoying a rich vein of form and must be respected
- **12. HILDA DU THYRAL -** 2nd of 10 in a 2875m amateurs Class F here late last month. Forced to start on 2nd line though and is unlikely to cause an upset
- **13. HUGO DU BOURG -** 9th of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 20 June. Has been disappointing all year and can be passed over
- **14. GISARO -** Back at a more reasonable level after being sanctioned in a 2100m Vincennes Class C a fortnight back. Not ideally drawn but goes barefoot, will be reined by Eric Raffin this time, and must not be ruled out
- **15. HANDZARO DU BOCAGE -** Facile Amiens winner before being sanctioned in a 2800m Moulins Class F last weekend. Just front pads fitted this time and will have little to offer
- **16. GREFFIERS FLINOIS -** In the frame in 3 of last 4, most recently 2nd of 11 in a 1800m Class E at La Capelle mid-June, but with pads on is not about to set Enghien alight

Summary: A fine campaigner when barefoot and focused, HEYDAY (5) has a pair of runs under his belt, has been handed a good draw, and despite being preferred racing clockwise, he still looks good enough to win this. Reassuring at Agon, HEUREUX DE FLEUR (8) is forced to break wide but has never disappointed at Enghien and with application will be competitive for the win. Winner at Les Sables-d'Olonne before failing to confirm on turf, HAROLD SAUTONNE (10) returns to a hard surface and, reconfigured for the occasion, is unlikely to let the side down. GUESS FOUTEAU (2) raced better at Vincennes than the result would imply and Franck Nivard will be keen to put things right.
