- **1. HISA DU MARGAS -** Has struggled all yeat and finished 12th in Class C at Enghien over 2150m on 28 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **2. HYDROMEL -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Feurs over 2225m on 13 June. Capable of making the frame this line-up
- **3. GAVROCHE DE L'ITON -** Much improved of late and was a winner in Class D at Montauban over 2400m on 9 June. Can complete the hat-trick
- **4. FILOU DE SITA -** On a long losing run and finished 10th in Class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 18 June. Needs to do a bit more to win
- **5. HARMONY LA NUIT -** Very consistent and finished 3rd in Class D at this track over 2950m on 25 June. Kept to further so far but does have a winning chance

HARMONY LA NUIT (5) caught the eye with a strong late surge on her most recent outing at this venue and, if reproducing that effort, is a serious contender. INDOCILE (9) returns from a short break following his last victory and could go well fresh. GAVROCHE DE L'ITON (3) appears to be back to his best and deserves respect in this company.

- **2. FLASH MONEY** Disappointing form of late and finished 7th in Class D at this track over 2950m on 25 June. Needs to do a bit more to win this race
- **3. IBIS QUICK -** Versatile distance-wise and was a winner in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 13 June. Can score again
- **4. FALKO DE NOUVILLE -** Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class D at this track over 2950m on 25 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- **5. GAMIN D'ALJY -** Disappointing last run when 12th in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 20 June, Capable of better and could surprise
- **6. IMPULSE JULRY -** Has disqualification issues but did run well when 4th in Class D at this track over 2950m on 2 July. Can be competitive in this line-up if wise

He is given the vote in this competitive line-up. LABEL MESS (5) has shown marked improvement since racing unshod and rates as a major danger. LEVIATHAN SANTMIXO (6) is well placed at the conditions and benefits from the booking of a top driver—he should not be overlooked. LUIGI PAN (2) travels a long distance for this engagement and, running barefoot, presents himself as an intriguing outsider.

- **3. JEU DECISIF -** Showed some improvement when 5th in Class H at Saint-Pierre-La-Cour over 2600m on 21 June. Could play a minor role
- **4. JEAN MAJYC -** Returned from a break in good form and was 3rd in Class E at Cholet over 2800m on 21 April. Fitter this time and has a winning chance

METEOR PIERJI (6) continues on an upward trajectory and appears capable of playing a leading role in this company. MY LADY ISLAND (4) ran a courageous second in a similar contest last time and is expected to be competitive once again.
