**C1 - PRIX DE LA VIEILLE FORGE - 1350m (a7f) - TURF - Condition Race -
Maiden - Flat - EUR € 12.500**

- 1. BAILEYS VITESSE** - Fair 5th on debut in early July at Clairefontaine over 1600m. Needs to improve a good amount to feature
- 2. LIKING** - Good 2nd last time over 1400m at Clairefontaine in mid-July. Sets the standard
- 3. KEDUREV** - 4th at Saint-Malo on the last run over 1600m in mid-July. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 4. MEMORIAL DE PREAUX** - Unplaced at Tarbes on only run so far over 1100m in April. Others look better equipped
- 5. SAUVIAC** - Newcomer by George Vancouver, Yard juveniles usually improve for a run. Any market interest should be noted
- 6. SERENITE DES ROSES** - Newcomer by Planteur, the dam was a winner. From a good stable, will be well-tuned for a good run on debut
- 7. COUNT PARIS** - Debut for the son of Reoletos, the dam was placed. Stable runners need respect on debut. Market support should be noted

Summary : Experience could be key in this race and LIKING (2) has shown enough in two runs to suggest he can be too smart for these. He was a decent second on his latest run over 1400m last month. He has two nicely bred newcomers as his likely main dangers. SERENITE DES ROSES (6) will be expected to make a bold show on his debut. His trainer will have him nicely tuned as will connections of COUNT PARIS (7) who has a nice profile. Both need to be monitored in the betting. KEDUREV (3) has the most experience and drops back in trip today as he possibly found the 1600m a bit too far on his last outing.

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C2 - PRIX DU CHATEAU - 2900m (a1 13/16m) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 14.000

- 1. IGOR KERGADOR** - Won last time over 3200m at Erbray in early July. Has plenty of experience and can play a role
- 2. JALWAY** - Fair 3rd on the latest outing over 2400m in late July. Has work to do to trouble some of these
- 3. JUSSEY** - 2nd over 2600m at Morlaix in mid-June last time. Looks like the one to beat
- 4. JESPER** - Unplaced on the last two runs, won before that over 2400m at Le Lion D'Angers in April. Opposable
- 5. IVRE DE TOI** - 2nd last time over 3200m at Erbray in early July. Capable of making an impact
- 6. JOVLAK DU LION** - Won at Corlay on the last run over 3100m in early June. Others seem more likely
- 7. JET DES OBEAUX** - Unplaced on the last run over 3000m in February. Has to improve a good deal to be involved
- 8. JOKER DU LYS** - Fair debut 3rd in March at this track over 2900m. Can improve a good deal from that and feature

Summary : JUSSEY (3) has been progressing with each run so far and this could be an ideal race to get off the mark. JOKER DU LYS (8) caught the eye when third on debut over 2900m at this track in March. He will be a lot sharper for that run and can be expected to be involved at the business end. IVRE DE TOI (5) has been second on both runs on the flat, with two unplaced hurdle runs between them, the latter flat effort was over 3200m at Erbray in early July. He can not be ruled out. IGOR KERGADOR (1) makes up the shortlist.

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C3 - PRIX DE LA BLIZIERE - 2900m (a1 13/16m) - TURF - Condition Race - Flat - EUR € 14.000

- 1. IMPERIALE TRESOR** - Unplaced last time, 2nd before that at Granville over 3100m in July. More needed in a better race
- 2. JOLIE MOIRETTE** - Won on last run over 2400m at Vittel on July 14th. Will be fit and has each-way claims
- 3. IMAGINE D'ALENE** - 3rd two runs back over 2700m at Les Sables in early June. Ought to be on the premises
- 4. ISY STONE** - 5th last time over 3200m at Erbray in early July. Has a lot of experience in these type of races and ought to be thereabouts
- 5. JANLY** - Nice 3rd at Saint-Malo over 2500m when last seen in August. Will be fit for return and is a live player
- 6. JAGUAR DES OBEAUX** - Fair 5th in a Class 3 chase at Auteuil last time over 3700m in late May. Capable of bold run
- 7. JULIETTE BANBOU** - 5th on only run so far over 2600m at Morlaix in mid-June. Others rate higher
- 8. JOLIE DOUCE** - Newcomer by Gris De Gris, can improve for this debut run. Any market support should be noted
- 9. JIJI GIRL** - Unplaced on only run over 2850m at Rostrenen in late May. Has work to do to figure

Summary : JAGUAR DES OBEAUX (6) has been running over fences of late and is a previous winner on the level last year over 2300m. She gets the marginal verdict over JANLY (5) who has not been seen for a year but showed enough on her last run at Saint-Malo when third to give her a live chance in this. IMAGINE D'ALENE (3) is the each-way angle, she ran in a Group 3 AQPS race last time when unplaced and was a good third before that at Les Sables. JOLIE MOIRETTE (2) warrants respect after a recent success at Vittel in mid-July.

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C4 - PRIX DU SUD MAYENNE - 2900m (a1 13/16m) - TURF - Condition Race - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 11.000

- 1. LE GAST** - Fair 4th on the last run at Compiegne over 2800m in mid-July. Ought to be on the premises
- 2. ULTRA D'AUNOU** - Nice 2nd at this track over 2900m on the last run in early July. Among the top chances
- 3. VIRTUOSE** - Unplaced on only run over 2200m in mid-July. Can improve and ought to be involved
- 4. ROCKABILLY** - Fair 4th on only run over 2400m at Nantes on July 6th. Can make presence felt
- 5. LE BETULLA** - Has been unplaced in all three runs so far the latter over 2900m at this track in early July. Vulnerable
- 6. RODAINAH** - 5th in a maiden at Compiegne last time over 2800m in mid-July. Capable of getting off the mark
- 7. KHAGNE** - Ran 4th over 2900m on the only run in late July. Might find a few of these too smart
- 8. CYANE** - Unplaced on both runs so far, but has shown some ability, the latter run was over 2800m at Compiegne in July. Consider
- 9. L'ETOILEE** - Unplaced on only run so far over 2350m at Machecoul in February. Others seem more likely
- 10. KADOFA** - Newcomer by Top Trip, from a good stable and warrants respect. Any market support should be monitored
- 11. LE SCEAUX DE MIX** - Newcomer by Gemix, stable not known for debut winners. Will be better for this outing
- 12. LOVE IT** - Unraced by Doctor Dino, should be better for this outing. Market will be informative

Summary : RODAINAH (6) has shown enough to land a race of this nature. She was fifth on her last outing at Compiegne and ought to get the better of her likely main rival LE GAST (1) who has experience and ran a solid fourth when last seen over 2800m at Compiegne when only beaten just over 2L. CYANE (8) enters calculations and is capable of making the top three. She can improve a good deal from her last outing. ROCKABILLY (4) is also worth mentioning, he showed enough on debut when fourth and will be a lot wiser for that run.

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C5 - PRIX HENRI MAILLARD - 2300m (a1 7/16m) - TURF - Condition Race - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 22.000

- 1. BEL ET BIEN** - Won over 2500m at Saint-Malo in late July on the last run. Needs to progress again in a better race
- 2. SIR ALEXANDER** - Won on the last run over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in March. Has been given a break and will be fit for a good run
- 3. VRAIMENT BIEN** - Newcomer by Al Wukair, will need to be useful to win on debut. Any market support should noted
- 4. QUALIAND** - Won on the last run over 2400m in March at Pornichet. Might find a few of these too smart
- 5. TOLGANAI** - Nice 4th over 2400m in a Listed race last time in late June at Toulouse. Live chance
- 6. MA LIBERTE** - Won two runs ago over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in June. Each-way option
- 7. LOFSONGUR ISLANDE** - 6th on the last run over 2000m at Parislongchamp in early July. Won on debut and looks a player

Summary : LOFSONGUR ISLANDE (7) won nicely on her debut and has been performing well in decent races since that success. She might just edge this from TOLGANAI (5) who ran a good fourth in a Listed race on her latest outing at Toulouse. MA LIBERTE (6) won two starts ago over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in June and is the best each-way option. SIR ALEXANDER (2) is a promising horse, he has been given a break since winning in March over 1800m at Lyon La Soie. He should be fit for his return and warrants respect.

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C6 - PRIX MURPHY HERBAL (PRIX DE LA FORET D'ARAIZE) - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - TURF - Condition Race - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 11.000

1. **SWEEP AWAY** - Fair 3rd over 2200m on the last run in mid-July. Looks like the one to beat
2. **KHAMEPHIS GAME** - Nice 3rd over 1950m at Chateaubriant last time. Expected to be competitive
3. **TALK SHOW** - Unplaced last time over 2200m at Clairefontaine in July. Ought to be thereabouts
4. **APALAIN** - Fair 2nd two runs ago over 2100m at Haras Du Pin in late April. Consider from an each way perspective
5. **AMERA** - Nice debut 4th over 2400m on only run so far in mid-June at Saint-Cloud. Among the top chances
6. **FLAVILAND STARS** - Unplaced on only run over 1600m at Nantes last month. Unlikely to trouble some of these
7. **JALAPAO** - Unplaced last time, 4th before that over 2650m in early June. Can make the top three
8. **PANACOTTA** - Unplaced on only run so far over 1950m at Le Mans in May. Has work to do to figure
9. **PASIPHAE** - Unplaced on only run so far over 1500m at Saint-Cloud last October. Others rate higher
10. **SAMBA** - Fair 2nd last time over 2000m in a claimer at Vichy 16 days ago. Looks unlikely
11. **DRAGON GIRL** - 6th on only start so far over 1950m at Chateaubriant in early June. Best watched for now
12. **SEAHERA** - Newcomer by Seahenge, will likely be better for this outing. Market can be the best guide
13. **SULTANE OF SWING** - Newcomer by Seahenge, the dam never raced. Can have a say on debut. Market can guide
14. **PRINCESS KARA** - Newcomer by Agent Secret, the stable runners are usually better for a run. Any market support should be noted
15. **KORA DE TRUDUJOU** - Daughter of Le Houssais, will improve for this debut experience. The market guide should be informative
16. **KALASH DLAHERVIAIS** - Newcomer by George Vancouver, the stable runners are not known for a win on debut. Watch the betting market for clues

Summary : SWEEP AWAY (1) could be the best option in this open looking maiden. He has run well on both starts so far and was a good third over 2200m when last seen 3 weeks ago. AMERA (5) is the likely main rival. She shaped with plenty of promise on her debut when fourth at Saint-Cloud in June and will be more streetwise for that run. KHAMEPHIS GAME (2) can play a hand in proceedings and should not be overlooked for a place. JALAPAO (7) is another to consider, although below par last time. She looks the best of the remainder.

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C7 - PRIX CLAUDE ROUGET - 3800m (a2 3/8m) - TURF - Condition Race - Class 2 - Hurdles - EUR € 30.000

- 1. PLACENET** - Won a Listed chase last time over 4400m at Dieppe in mid-July. Can be dangerous
- 2. ZADALL** - Fair 4th over hurdles last time at La Teste in early July over 3900m. Others seem more likely
- 3. RESPLENDOR** - Nice win over 4200m at Chateaubriant last time in mid-July. Looks the one to beat
- 4. FATALISME** - Won last time over 3800m in a Class 5 race at Plesse 13 days ago. Will need to raise the bar in a better race
- 5. GENERAL DESJY** - Won over fences last time, that was over 3900m at Dieppe in early July. Has place claims
- 6. HALF DOZEN** - Won two runs ago over 3250m at Hereford (UK). Makes his debut on French soil and is not discounted
- 7. SAVINES LE LAC** - Has not been seen since a 3rd over 4300m at Granville in a chase in June. Might find this difficult

Summary : RESPLENDOR (3) won nicely last time over 4200m at Chateaubriant recently and has a solid chance of following up. He is well in under race conditions as he is top-rated and receives a lot of weight from the biggest rival PLACENET (1) who won over fences last time. He is versatile and the switch to hurdles should not be a concern. HALF DOZEN (6) could make life difficult for his rivals and has the added bonus of James Reveley doing the steering. GENERAL DESJY (5) scored on his latest outing over fences at Dieppe and will be on the premises.

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C8 - PRIX DES SENONNETTES - 3600m (a2 1/4m) - TURF - Condition Race - Class 3 - Hurdles - EUR € 26.000

1. **KAZADOR DE KERSER** - Newcomer by Karaktar, nice run anticipated from a good trainer. Merits consideration
2. **DIYASHAL** - 3rd on the last run over 3400m on hurdle debut in mid-July. Can improve and looks like the likely winner
3. **KING PEDRO** - Fair 4th on hurdle debut at this track over 3600m in July after two runs on the level. Place chance
4. **KASTELL SAPI** - 5th on the last run over 3400m at Dieppe in mid-July. Others make more sense
5. **PELOPS** - Unraced son of Born At Sea, trained by a top trainer and can be expected to play a prominent role
6. **ETZIGAR** - An unraced gelding by Free Port Lux, is likely to need this opening run. Any market support should be noted
7. **TUTTI QUANTI** - Newcomer by Chanducoq, stable runners need respect on debut. Any support in the betting will be informative
8. **LILLOU** - Unraced son of Kamsin, can come forward for this debut run, Market best guide for expected performance
9. **YUTU** - 6th on only run so far over 2700m at Orleans in mid-May. More needed to make the frame
10. **KIT RAFFLES** - Newcomer by Saints Des Saints, has a choice profile and a bold run can be expected on debut. Market best guide for clues
11. **KABICHAULIRIC** - Unraced gelding by Al Namix, from a top yard. Among the leading contenders. Watch the betting market
12. **WINONA** - Newcomer by Masterstroke, can be expected to improve for this outing. Market best watched

Summary : DIYASHAL (2) can improve off a good debut over hurdles when fourth at Clairefontaine last time. He can score under James Reveley. He has probably the most to fear from the nicely bred KIT RAFFLES (10) who has a taking profile and will be expected to give a good account on his first day at school. The same can be expected from KABICHAULIRIC (11) who needs to be monitored in the betting exchanges and could be useful. KAZADOR DE KERSER (1) is also making his debut and will get every assistance from Johnny Charron on his back.
