- **1. MELIE LUMALO -** Set off no fireworks in qualification a month back, posting 1'20"0 at Laval, and can expect to have her work cut out
- 2. MISS IBIZA Qualified in 1'20"1 at Laval in July 2024. Market will guide
- **3. MUSCATE -** Qualified in 1'16"9 here on 11 February and if as good in competition, could pleasantly surprise
- **4. MYRCIA** Sanctioned in both to date, most recently a 2850m Laval Class E a week ago. Alexis Collette at the helm this time but others still easier to back
- 5. MISS TAVEL 4th of 7 finishers, a place behind MANILLE D'ERABLE (7), in a 2225m Vire Class F 3.5 weeks ago. Has more to find though and is unlikely to shake things up
- **6. MISS DE LA FERME -** 7th of 11, on first start for 2.5 months, in a 2275m Nantes Class F 12 days ago. Will have come on for the run but still not the easiest to recommend
- **7. MANILLE D'ERABLE -** 3rd of 7 finishers in a 2225m Vire Class F 3.5 weeks ago. Steps up in category but with the champion driver reining is unlikely to be far off the mark
- **8. MY QUALITA PIYA -** Produced career-best performance when 4th of 15 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 11 February. Not the easiest to handle but has shown ample promise and can play a leading role if she takes to the new profile
- **9. MIBORA BUISSONAY -** Confirmed solid qualification when 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2275m Nantes Class F on 18 February. Goes the other direction on this occasion but was sufficiently convincing last time to be considered a player once more
- **10. MEDEE DU VIVIER -** Unsure of stride when 7th of 10 behind MONNAIE DE VIETTE (11) in a 2575m Class F at Saint-Brieuc on 24 January. Has been afforded ample time to recalibrate and with Gabriele Gelormini in the bike will be afforded every chance
- **11. MONNAIE DE VIETTE -** Pleased on re-entry at Saint-Brieuc before being sanctioned in a 2725m Graignes Class E 3 weeks ago. Reliability may be in doubt, but ability isn't, and can win this if she stays in stride
- **12. MONIA VERDERIE -** Did not enjoy the best of trips when 4th of 9 in a 2275m Nantes Class E 3 weeks ago. Is untried racing clockwise but in current form is hard to ignore
- **13. MANUREVA DE HOERDT -** 2nd of 8 on debut in a 2850m Laval Class F a month ago. In a similarly good lot this time and can again make the frame
- **14. MY DESTINY QUEEN -** 2nd at Angers on 12 January prior to running 7th of 11 in a 2850m Mauguenchy Class E a fortnight later. Benefits from a good entry and, if focused, can make first 5

Summary: Although sanctioned at Graignes after having put on a good show at Saint-Brieuc, MONNAIE DE VIETTE (11) returns to racing right-handed and Yoann Lebourgeois will be keen to put things right. They will still come under pressure from MY QUALITA PIYA (8) who has shown a lot of potential, and MANUREVA DE HOERDT (13) who did everything right on her recent racecourse debut. MANILLE D'ERABLE (7) is plainly an improving filly and the engagement of Eric Raffin's services will do her prospects no disservice.

- **2. LODIVA D'AUVILLIER -** Switches code for first time after being sanctioned in a 2575m Saint-Brieuc harness Class G 2.5 weeks ago and seems to have nothing to contribute
- **3. LOUVE DU RELAIS -** Starts for first time since finishing 8th of 10 in a 2875m Argentan harness Class G on 11 January and will need to show another side to herself
- **4. LULU DES LOUANGES -** Complicated individual that was sanctioned on monté debut in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 23 February. Shoes off this time but can nevertheless be confidently disregarded
- **5. LARIANA CLEVILLE -** Unseen since coming 5th of 7 finishers, a place behind LIVIA DES LANDES (7) in a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 7 December. Will have progressed for the run but still no more than a minor place prospect
- **6. LEA MADJI -** Made it 2 straight sanctions when faulting in a 2575m Saint-Brieuc harness Class G on 2 February. Yet to dazzle under the saddle and even though reconfigured, is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **7. LIVIA DES LANDES -** 10th of 12 finishers behind LIZETTE DE VAU (11) in a 2425m Angers Class F late-January. Cannot be considered a priority but has decent monte credentials and could well pick up a cheque
- **8. LITTLE ECLIPSE -** Makes just 2nd appearance in the discipline, latterly finishing last of 9 in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 23 February. Barefoot as she was when imposing under harness at Argentan and should not be entirely ruled out
- **9. LALIGA DEL PHEDO -** Placed in last 2 starts under the saddle, most recently 3rd of 13 in a 2700m Graignes Class F on 23 February. Takes on a marginally better lot this time but should still play an active role
- **10. LYRIC -** Lost her action early in a 2850m Laval Class E a week ago. Is proven in the discipline and Anthony Barrier will be intent on putting things right. Place chance

Fourth over course and distance on her lone monte appearance, LITTLE GIRL (12) has a race under her belt, runs unshod-behind for the first time, and the Eric Raffin-factor cannot be ignored. LYRIC (10) is considerably better than recent numbers would suggest and the new configuration may be just the ticket. Tricky she may be but LIZETTE DE VAU (11) has shown ample potential and sports front pads for the first time.

- **2. KEY WEST DE CHENU -** Imposed at Angers prior to running 3rd of 14 in a 2625m Agen-Le Passage Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Can prove a handful but is hard to knock when focused and looks a serious player on Caen bow
- **3. KASSIOPEE DREAM -** 4th at Graignes on 3 February before coming an unlucky 3rd of 11 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E a fortnight later. With a clear path, and form maintained, can make a big impact from the 3-spot
- **4. KAMA D'EM -** Sent for a break after imposing over course and distance last October, latterly 10th of 12 finishers on re-entry in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E a fortnight ago. Hard to ignore when barefoot from the 4-spot. First 5
- **5. KRISSA DE MORGANE -** Sanctioned in 5 of last 6, most recently a 2700m Vincennes Class E last week. Is by no means without merit though and it is only a matter of time before she comes good again. Minor place chance
- **6. KATINKA COTON -** Ran 2nd at Vincennes before repeating in a 2850m Laval Class E mid-February. Starts in front, is hard to knock when barefoot, and can finish in the mix if she runs to her value
- **7. KATOUCHKA -** Handy sort making first appearance since finishing 9th of 16 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D last September. Hind shoes off for the occasion but others still easier to back
- **8. KALINE DJOB -** Failed to confirm good Argentan effort when 6th of 13 behind KATINKA COTON (6) in a 2850m Laval Class E mid-February. Has yet to make her mark at the venue and is unlikely to start now

Summary: Sent for a 4 months' break after running second here last October, KORIGANE D'ERABLE (1) did everything right on her re-entry run, has been reconfigured for her return to racing right-handed, and looks to have a realistic chance of opening her 2025 account. That said, KEY WEST DE CHENU (2) has returned to her best and will not be easily disposed of, and neither will the well-placed, and barefoot, KAMA D'EM (4) who was an impressive winner here last autumn. Tom Debost would have preferred a better draw but KASANE DU BISET (11) won well at Graignes last month and should again be competitive for a place in the frame.

- 2. LELLAMIKA Unraced since faulting in a 2850m Vincennes Class E late-November. Is not without merit but will need the race
- **3. LADY VICTORY -** Last but one finisher behind LILYROSE WIND (6) in a 2200m Vincennes Class E on 18 February. Nicely-placed behind the car, is shod as she was at Angers, but no more than minor place prospect
- **4. LA BELLE JAMINI -** Ran 7th of 15 behind LILYROSE WIND (6) in a 2200m Vincennes Class E on 18 February. Seems more at home racing right-handed and looks considerably more competitive here
- **5. LILOU -** 8th of 10 in a 2875m Argentan Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Shoes off for the occasion and has been handed a decent draw but has no particular love for Caen and others preferred
- **6. LILYROSE WIND -** 5th of 15 in a 2200m Vincennes Class E on 18 February. Went close under these conditions during the autumn and must be taken seriously

- **4. JARYCA -** Fine servant making first appearance since comfortably winning a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 11 January. Afforded ample time to recover and has a reasonable chance of making it 2 on the trot

It will not be all plain sailing though considering how well the poorly-positioned, but on-form, JEROM BUTTERFLY (15) has been acquitting himself over recent months. Shod as he was when 2nd at Bordeaux, JUST DE LA MORTRIE (8) can put his Vincennes blip behind him and even though shod, should be taken seriously. JACKPOT DE JUMILLY (6) consistently gives his best and placed on his lone association with Eric Raffin.

- **9. KEEN WINNER -** Sanctioned in last 2, most recently a 2700m Vincennes Gr.3 on 19 January. Pleased on lone clockwise start and even racing shod, still looks good enough to finish in the mix
- **10. HISA DU MARGAS -** 10th of 14 on re-entry in a 2100m Vincennes Class C 11 days ago. Is barefoot for the occasion, will have progressed for the run, and should not be ruled out
- **11. EQUEJUELO -** Disappointing of late, latterly sanctioned when unsupported in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on 25 January. Has won twice at the venue but with pads fitted is not about to extend that tally
- **12. HAWAI PONT VAUTIER -** Ran 2nd at Bordeaux before faulting, when running in for a cheque, in a 2150m Toulouse Class D on 18 January. Benefits from an excellent engagement and must be afforded respect
- **13. GOLD MENCOURT -** Last of 11, on return from a lengthy layoff, in a 2700m Vincennes Class B 3 weeks ago. Appears to be race-rusty and arguably best to hold off
- **14. IBIKI DE HOUELLE -** Given a rest after running 4th of 16 in a 2100m Vincennes Class A early-December. Is new to the venue but has decent right-handed references and is not incapable of defying the handicap and making a big splash
- **15. IZOARD VEDAQUAIS -** Unseen since running 6th of 12 in a 2100m Vincennes Gr.1 last June. Usual driver in the hot-seat and despite the distance penalty, can still bring home the bacon

Summary: A high-class trotter with nothing to prove at this level, IZOARD VEDAQUAIS (15) has not been seen out since last June. He sports just hind shoes for the occasion but still has a reasonable chance of kicking the year off victoriously. Benjamin Rochard will still be justifiably wary of co-back-row starter IBIKI DE HOUELLE (14) who excels with Eric Raffin. A Gr.2 winner last summer, KATAKI DE WALLIS (7) makes his first start since October, but is shod to preference and the 25m head-start will only work to his advantage. IRIS DES ROSEAUX (5) is barefoot for his return to the track, adores Caen, and is not about to let the side down.
