C1 - PRIX NIOBE - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 40.000

- **1. LE ROI SOLEIL -** Disqualified last time out at Elbeuf on 27 April. Has won a Mounted race before but others make more appeal
- 2. L'ARTISTE MIL Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 8 April. Can contest the finish
- **3. LUSSABEAU -** Only modest for shown this year and was 8th in a Class C Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 22 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. LOVE ME DO -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track on 22 November. Has won twice but should need this run returning from a break
- **5. LOVI CADENCE -** Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out at Enghien on 19 April. Yet to win a race but is capable of making the frame
- **6. LOVE D'AUTHISE -** Unreliable but did run well when third in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 April. Has a winning chance
- **7. L'APOGEE IMPERIAL -** Yet to win a race and was 8th in a Class E Mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 3 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **8. LANNISTER D'AVRIL -** Unreliable this year and was 8th in a Class D harness race at Enghien over this distance on 19 April. Did better in a mounted race before that and can contest the finish
- **9. L'ARTISTE ZEN -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 19 April. Did better under the saddle before that and has a winning chance
- **10. LEONARDO DE LOU -** Has improved of late and was victorious in a Class D Mounted race at this track over a similar distance on 8 April. Stays with that shoe combination and can follow up

Summary: LEONARDO DE LOU (10) has been improving recently and was a very easy winner over a similar distance at this track last time out. He can double up and beat these rivals. L'ARTISTE ZEN (9) ran respectably when finishing runner-up to that rival but will need to find a few lengths to reverse the form, and has since been disqualified in a harness race. L'ARTISTE MIL (2) has yet to win a race but is capable of making the frame. LANNISTER D'AVRIL (8) is inconsistent but cannot be ruled out.

- **1. LADY DE JANEIRO -** Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 9 April. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- **2. LOVE ME AGAIN -** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at this course on 22 April. Has ability and can win if wise
- **3. LORELEI -** Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest being at Maure-de-Bretagne on 17 April. Did win over this course and distance in January and has a winning chance if smart
- **4. LAMTARA BUISSONAY -** Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class D at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 23 April. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **5. LONDON DELO -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien on 17 April. Yet to win a race and is probably best watched for now
- **6. LOVELY DAY CEKE -** Unreliable and finished tenth last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 17 April. Others make more appeal
- **7. LAIKA D'ESPACE -** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Cagnes-sur-Me on 26 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **8. LOULIANA DE VANDEL -** Unreliable and finished 7th last time out in Class D at this course over 2700m on 22 April. Has a place chance
- **9. LADRA DI MALAVITA -** Has struggled in her three starts of this year and was 9th in a claimer at this track over 200m on 4 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **10. LOVELY JIM -** Does not always show her best side and was 6th in Class D at Enghien over this distance on 17 April. Has already won twice this year and is not out of it
- **11. LOTTA ROSIE -** Very consistent this year and was fourth in Class D at this track over 2700m on 22 April. Just as good this distance and should fight out the finish again
- **12. LIO DE PIENCOURT -** Finished 6th last time out in Cass D at this track over 2700m on 22 April. Capable of earning some money this shorter distance

Summary: LOVE ME AGAIN (2) has a few recent disqualifications to her name but has shown talent in the past and is quite capable of bouncing back to score in a race like this. LOTTA ROSIE (11) has been very consistent since going barefoot and looks likely to get her head in front before long. LOVELY JIM (10) has already won twice this year but is better suited to longer distances. LORELEI (3) is not easy to trust but holds winning claims.

- **2. IGNACE GUENESERIE -** Disappointing last run when 11th in a Class D Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 24 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. IAGO ROSE -** In good shape and was third in a Class F harness race at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 18 April. Barefoot and better in Mounted races. Go close
- **4. IDEAL DU NOYER -** Always gives of his best and was third in a Class D Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 24 April. Should make a bold bid at victory
- **5. HILTON MAZA -** Has struggled this year and was 11th in a Class E harness race over this course and distance on 18 April. Others make more appeal
- **6. ILEO PIERJI -** A runner-up twice in his last three starts including last time out in a Class D Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 24 April. Be right there at the finish again
- **7. HANDSOME BOY -** In good form of late and was victorious in a Class D Mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 24 April. Can follow up

Summary: There was not much between the three main contenders when they met at Laval last month. IDEAL DU NOYER (4) was third that day but could turn the tables on his rivals. HANDSOME BOY (7) won that race and has every chance of following up over a suitable distance. ILEO PIERJI (6) finished second between the other two and should be right there at the finish once again. IAGO ROSE (3) races barefoot this time and would not be a surprise winner.

- **2. LOTUS GRIFF -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track on 12 April. Capable of playing a minor role when wise
- **3. LE JIBAY -** Disqualified last time out at Pontchâteau on 16 April. Has struggled of late and needs major improvement to win
- **4. LANCIER DU GOUTIER -** Victorious last time out in Class D at Caen over 2450m on 3 March. Has ability and is capable of following up
- **5. LOIC BARON -** Disqualified last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer on 9 March. In good form before that and could earn some money if wise this time
- **6. LOVE GLYCINES -** Showed some improvement when fourth in Class A at this track over 2100m on 20 February. Might just need this run returning from a short break
- **7. L'AMIRAL GAGNANT -** Much improved of late and has won his last two starts, the latest being in Class C at at this track over 2100m on 21 March. Can complete a hat-trick
- **8. LUTIN JABA -** Did not show his best when 6th in a Class B Mounted race over this course and distance on 5 April. Better in harness races and can contest the finish
- **9. LAGNU MAG -** Has struggled this year and was 11th last time out in Class A over this track and trip on 22 March. Others make much more appeal
- **10. LOUISON -** Holding form and was third last time out in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 March. Might play a minor role
- **11. LOTUS ZEN -** Consistent of late and finished third in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 1 February. Remains barefoot but is better undr the saddle

Summary: LANCIER DU GOUTIER (4) reminded us what he is capable of with a good win at Caen in March. He can follow that up with another success. LORD DU GERS (12) drops in class and should be very competitive in this line-up. LIVE TO TELL (14) won at this track last time out and has been ultra-consistent of late, so is clearly not out of it. L'AMIRAL GAGNANT (7) is not reliable but is quite capable of getting into the mix again.

- **2. MOUSTIK LA GOVELLE -** Disqualified in his last three starts, with the latest being at Maure-de-Bretagne on 23 April. Looked the winner before faulting and can bounce back to score
- **3. MBAPE DES CHARRONS -** Has won two of his four starts so far, including last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 25 April. Not easy to trust but can win again
- **4. MY LOVE GIO -** Much improved of late and was victorious in Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 21 April. Can complete a hat-trick
- **5. MEMPHIS ELLIS -** Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when fourth in Class D at this track over 2850m on 8 April. Might play a minor role
- **6. MYSTIC MAN -** Holding form and finished third in Class D at this track over 2200m on 15 April. Capable of making the frame
- **7. MURO -** Unreliable and finished 7th in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 19 April. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred

MY LOVE GIO (4) has won his last two starts and can complete the hat-trick.

- **3. MYRIAM D'AZUR -** Returned from a break and was victorious in Class E at Reims over 2550m on 16 April. Tackles tougher but is not out of it
- **4. MESSINA -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 22 April. Won her first two starts and can win again if wise this time
- **5. MALIDA -** In good form and was third in Class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 18 April . Can be competitive in this line-up
- **6. MODE DU VALLON -** Has some fair form and was not disgraced when 5th in Class C over this track and trip on 22 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **7. MAIA JIEL -** Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Clas D at this track over 2200m on 15 April. Has a winning chance in this line-up

MEGANE DE CERISY (9) looks much improved this year, though she did have major disqualification issues last season. MIDNIGHT EXPRESS (8) has not been disgraced in her recent runs and has a winning chance against these rivals. MAIA JIEL (7) found only one too good at this track last time out and can go one better over a distance that suits.

- **3. MOUGINS D'OCCAGNES -** Finished fourth on his debut, in a Class D Mounted race over this track and trip on 29 April. Capable of improvement and is not out of it
- **4. MISTER DUAL -** Has disqualification issues but was not disgraced when fourth in a Class F harness race at Laval over 2850m on 24 April. Tries a Mounted race but has a winning chance
- **5. MIDNIGHT DE CUY -** Has shown improvement of late and was victorious in a harness claimer at Neuillé-Pont over 3025m on 27 April. Tougher task trying a Mounted race
- **6. MAGNUM DE BLARY -** Disqualified last time out at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 21 April. Has fair form in harness races and can earn some money trying a Mounted race

Summary: MISTER DUAL (4) clearly has his issues, but he shows promise and could thrive now switched to a mounted race. MITCH DE GRANOU (7) disappointed with a disqualification last time out but had run well in this discipline before that and has an obvious winning chance if he keeps his act together. MAGNOLIA D'ARCHE (8) has yet to win a race but has been competing in stronger company than this and deserves respect. MOUGINS D'OCCAGNES (3) was not disgraced on debut and could have more to offer with improvement likely.

- **3. JISKA DE DREAM -** In good shape and was runner-up in Class G at Rambouillet over 2800m on April. Can contest the finish once again
- **4. IRIS RENARDIER -** Very consistent this year and was third in Class F at Vitre over 3225m on 27 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **5. JOY D'OURVILLE -** On a long losing run and was 6th in Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 28 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. HORYVIL DES MOYEUX -** Disqualified twice in his last two starts, including last time out at Cordemais on 30 March. Quite capable of contesting the finish when wise

HORACE DU VIVIER (10) won over this course and distance on his penultimate start and should be very competitive in this line-up. IRIS DE CHOTA (9) has a mixed bag of form but is not out of it.
