


## 1. MILLIONDOLLARRHYME



Speedy sort that will try to come from behind and pick up a piece of the pie. Could spring a surprise.



Milliondollarrhyme is a Ready Cash gelding that has his place just below the elite horses. He can finish very fast the last 200 meters but often comes up short at the highest level. Although he won his elimination from the front, this race is much harder, and he is not the likely leader. He showed that the form is there when arriving a close second to Hail Mary, one of the possible contenders in Elitloppet. With a nice trip, which is almost guaranteed from the 1 post, (knowing that Åby has got an open stretch), Milliondollar-rhyme should be able to go close.

Great draw for this six-year-old in his prime. Should get into a good stalking position and will go close.

Trixton horse out of a Yankee Glide mare. Won 800 000 SEK when winning the Breeders' Crown for 3-year-olds. Some French blood on the female side brings the perfect mix of strength and speed. Mister Hercules has shown a lot of speed and trotted today's distance in 1'10"4 when fourth in the Jubileumspokalen (Gr.1) in August. Mister Hercules was far away from San Moteur that day but should be closer today. The draw was very helpful for Mister Hercules who should be in a very good position entering the stretch. Örjan Kihlström will let Mister Hercules do his best in the last part of the race.



He has trotted the distance in 1'11"9 and will have to improve on that today. Chapuy has won 20 starts from 82.

Runner-up in the Norwegian Derby. Clearly held by most of today's rivals. Good draw.

Cicero T.G. has always been held in high regard and was outstanding as a three-year-old and a four-year-old in Norway. He has not been winning regularly as an older horse and will have to find plenty of improvement to finish in the top three today. Folded easily to Hades de Vandel in the elimination race despite posting slow fractions in the lead. Today's draw is perfect for Cicero T.G. who could be in a very good position come the final stretch. With a little bit of racing luck Cicero T.G. might be able to outrun his odds and finish in the frame.

This Love You horse is known, among other things, for his ability to defy bad draws. To-day it will be interesting to see how forward he can be from a good draw. Rackham has continued to progress over the years and is more than ready to prove himself against the very best. Rackham spent last winter in France where he came second behind Aura SL in the Grand Prix de la Ville de Laval over 2850 m. He was sent to the lead in his elimination race, slowed the pace to a crawl, and then increased the speed for the final lap. Rackham has a high cruising speed and can sustain it for a long time.

Has not won anything useful the last two years, but put up a good performance in his elimination race when easily going away from the leader Cicero T.G. despite having to trot on the outside for a substantial part of the race. The wide draw behind the car won't help at all and to believe in this horse you have to believe in his driver, the very good Robin Bakker. Hades de Vandel will probably not be far away come the finish line, but winning is unlikely. A little bit of improvement will see him go close.

Swedish superstar with a question mark regarding form. Outside draw is not an issue. The one to beat.

San Moteur has 16 wins from 21 starts and showed that he is world-class when destroying a good field in Jubileumspokalen (Gr.1) in 1'09"7 despite a draw in the second row behind the car. Last year he won a race at this card over 2640 m in 1'11"9. San Moteur won his comeback race 2023 but was scratched after that which always is a concern. The draw is not as bad as it looks, San Moteur can just be as aggressive as he wants and is a horse capable of winning this from first over should he have to. 16 wins from 21 starts has led to an incredible 7,4 million SEK in earnings. He will add to that today.

## **8. EMOJI**




The elimination race didn't say much about the form and Emoji is taking a substantial class hike here.

The trainer/driver is a genius though and in a race like this, anything could happen. 25 wins from 53 starts is telling you that Emoji is a horse that loves to win

After failing to qualify for the German Derby the Love You colt came to Alessandro Gocciadoro's yard where he immediately won the German Breeders' Crown for 4-year-olds. After that he won a lesser race at Vincennes. This year Jimmy Ferro B.R. won Gran Premio Padovanelle before scoring from first over in Prince Carl-Philip's Jubileumspokal at Färjestad. It is very hard to assess how good he really is since he is still unexposed. The only weakness so far is a lack of early pace which won't matter from this draw. Major player.


