C1 - PRIX DU MANS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 53,000

1. **LIPA STAR** - Disqualified in a class D at this track over 2850m on 19 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of earning some money if smart
2. **LADY OF DURBUY** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th at Mons over 2840m on 12 May. Reverts to barefoot but more is needed to score
3. **LADY DU CHATELET** - Off form and was unplaced in a class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 23 May. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
4. **LUPIN DES TOURS** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up in a class D at Alencon over 2650m on 19 April. Can earn some minor money
5. **LEVEL ONE SYGA** - In good form and finished third in a class D at this course over 2100m on 30 April. Can earn some more money
6. **LETIKALIN** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a class D at this track over 2100m on 10 April. Can go one place better
7. **LUGANO DE LOU** - Disqualified in a class C at Caen over 2200m on 9 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of scoring when in the right mood
8. **LUNGA DES BROUSSES** - Disqualified in a class C at this track over 2700m on 5 January. Remains barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
9. **LIMO DE MER** - Holding form and finished fourth in a class C at Enghien over 2150m on 13 March. Returns from a short break and could need this run
10. **LARIANO** - Showed some improvement when 6th in a class C at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Barefoot and could be a threat
11. **LA DIVA SUPREME** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class C at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
12. **LOOK D'HERMES** - Not reliable but was a runner-up in a class B at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Might play a minor role at very best
13. **LORIGRE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a class C at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
14. **LUSANIO DE WARNOC** - In very good form and was a runner-up in a class D at this track over 2100m on 30 April. Remains barefoot and has a chance
15. **LITTLE ITALY** - Did not show her best when unplaced in a class C at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Reverts to barefoot and could bounce back to score
16. **L'AS DE SMARVES** - Successful in three of last four starts, the latest in class D mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 27 April. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
17. **LOUNA DU LOCHEUR** - Successful in a class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of following up

C2 - PRIX DU SNPT - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 56,000

- 1. BEENTHERESEENTHAT** - Finished 8th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 15 May. Remains barefoot but does need to find a few lengths to score
- 2. REDBULL PELLINI** - Disqualified in a class D mounted race at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 3. ODANA VRIJTHOUT** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class E over this track and trip on 15 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset
- 4. DISTILLATO** - Much improved of late and was runner-up in a class E over this track and trip on 6 May. Big chance in this line-up
- 5. TOSCANA SOUTHWIND** - Successful in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 9 May. Unreliable but keeps the same shoeing and could double up
- 6. CANTAB AS** - Did not show his best when 7th in a class D over this course and distance on 22 May. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 7. VINCI NICE** - In good shape and finished fourth in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 9 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. CONDOR PASA GAR** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 9th at Naples over 1600m on 18 April. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
- 9. MULBERRY (SWE)** - Unplaced in a class D over this course and distance on 22 May. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 10. HASHTAG SIMONI** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a class E over this course and distance on 15 May. Should fight out the finish once again
- 11. JADE RENARDIER** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class D at this track over 2175m on 30 April. Capable of earning some money
- 12. JOYEUX DU LANDRET** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class A at Granville over 3100m on 24 May. Might earn some minor money
- 13. DILVA JET** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class C at this track over 2100m on 15 May. Capable of contesting the finish when in the right frame of mind
- 14. DAYAK (ITY)** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: A very open looking race. DISTILLATO (4) looks to be edging close to a winning performance and gets a narrow vote to score. HASHTAG SIMONI (10) arrives in peak form and should go well again. DILVA JET (13) is well worth another chance and is not to be discounted is atying in stride. TOSCANA SOUTHWIND (5) comes here off the back of a recent success at Caen and commands respect over this course and distance.

C3 - PRIX DU DAUPHINE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 46,000

1. **KENTUCKY WOOD** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F at Arras over 2900m on 25 May. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
2. **KOPA D'ARC** - Unplaced in a class D at this track over 2700m on 22 May. Capable of better and is not out of it in this line-up
3. **KAKO GASCOGNE** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 24 May. Might play a minor role at very best
4. **KINDY DU VIVIER** - Victorious in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class E at Graignes over 2725m on 22 May. Can win again
5. **KOSY D'ERONVILLE** - Disqualified in a class D at Enghien over 2875m on 16 April. In good form before that and can bounce back to score
6. **KINGSTON DE BLARY** - Did not show his best when 10th in a class D at this track over 2700m on 22 May. Clearly capable of better and should be a threat to these rivals
7. **KETBERNY** - A runner-up twice in a row, the latest in a class D at Ecommoy over 2750m on 31 May. Remains barefoot but this is a tougher race
8. **KAZAR** - Did not show his best when 6th in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 24 May. Capable of making the frame
9. **KRAK D'AZUR** - Off form and finished 9th in a class D at this track over 2700m on 22 May. Needs major improvement to win
10. **KELLE HAUFOR** - Unreliable but was fourth in a class D at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
11. **KID PARKER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a class D at this track over 2700m on 22 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
12. **KALISCO PLANCHETTE** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class F at Arras over 2900m on 25 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred

Summary: KOSY D'ERONVILLE (5) boasts strong course form and is expected to be right in the thick of things again. KINDY DU VIVIER (4) is in excellent shape and arrives firmly at the top of her game. KOPA D'ARC (2) is best forgiven a recent blip and remains capable of bouncing back. KAZAR (8) has been handed a tricky draw behind the autostart but still has the ability to get involved if things fall his way.

C4 - PRIX JULES THIBAUT - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr2 - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. MON PLAISIR** - In good shape and was a runner-up in a class B over this course and distance on 29 May. Tougher task this time
- 2. MOONWALK D'HERIPRE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Tries barefoot and could be a lively danger
- 3. MILORD JAVRONNAIS** - In good shape and was third in a Group 2 mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
- 4. MANASLU** - Finished fifth in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. MARDOUK DE GODREL** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 22 May. Unreliable but is capable of earning minor money when smart
- 6. MAKE YOUR DAY** - Much improved last run when a runner-up in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 22 May. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
- 7. MONZON NORMAND** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 8. MENTOR DE PLAY** - Finished third in a Group 3 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Oystanding at this course and should make a bold bid at victory
- 9. MOUSTIK LA GOVELLE** - Consistent this year and was third in a Group 2 at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. Capable of earning some more money
- 10. MAGNUM DU CHOQUEL** - showed some improvement and finished fourth in a Group 3 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Remains barefoot but might need to do a bit more
- 11. MAGIC MAN** - Successful in a Group 3 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Back to best and is quite capable of doubling up
- 12. MAESTRO VRIE** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Clearly capable of better and can get involved with the finish when smart
- 13. MAITRE JACQUES** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Group 1 at this track over 2200m on 28 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 14. MACK DE BLARY** - Finished 6th in a Group 1 at this track over 2700m on 24 January. Returns from break but can make the frame if fit enough

Summary: MENTOR DE PLAY (8) can be forgiven his defeat at Caen, where he appeared uncomfortable around the right-handed turns. Back on Vincennes' main track, the winner of five consecutive races here looks well placed to secure a deserved first Group 2 success. MAESTRO VRIE (12), a top-level winner last winter, has two runs under his belt following a break and should be sharper now, especially reunited with Mathieu Mottier. MAGNUM DU CHOQUEL (10) enhanced his claims when landing a key trial at Caen in May and remains firmly on the upgrade. MACK DE BLARY (14), a high-class performer returning from an absence. Fitness is the obvious question, but his raw ability makes him impossible to ignore.

C5 - PRIX DU QUERCY - 2850m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 75,000

1. **JET EXPRESS** - Often competitive and finished fifth in a Group 3 at Le Croise Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. Should fight out the finish
2. **JOLIVERT DU GERS** - Usually competitive and was 3rd in class C at this course over 2700m on 22 May. Has to be respected in this line-up
3. **IL VIENT DU LUDE** - Not reliable but was 4th in class C at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
4. **INDIEN DE FONTAINE** - Did not show his best when 9th in a Goup 3 at at Le Croise Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. Capable of earning some money
5. **JOUR DE FETE** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race over this track and trip on 26 May. Might play a minor role at very best
6. **HARDI CROWN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class C at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
7. **INDIGO DE FONTAINE** - Victorious in class A over this track and trip on 13 May. Unreliable but cannot be ruled out from doubling up
8. **FOSTER WOOD** - Disqualified in class B at Hyeres over 2850m on 1 May. On a long losing streak and is probably best watched for now
9. **HURRICANE CARTER** - Unreliable but was runner up in class B at this track over 2100m on 2 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
10. **JANGO VICI** - Showed some improvement and finished 6th in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Can earn some money
11. **IBISCUS MAN** - Did not show his best when 13th in a Group 3 at Le Croise Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. capable of doing better and has a chance
12. **JINGLE DU PONT** - Disqualified in class A at this course over 2850m on 13 May. In good form before that and is not out of it if smart
13. **JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL** - Not disgraced when 5th in class A over this track and trip on 13 May. Victorious in April and should be a threat to these rivals

Summary: JET EXPRESS (1) caught the eye with a strong late run in the Green trophy leg at Le Croisé-Laroche and looks capable of making his presence felt again. IBISCUS MAN (11) returns to the harness code with an unbeaten record alongside Eric Raffin and will be a major player if maintaining that level. JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (13) goes unshod for the first time, which could unlock further improvement. JINGLE DU PONT (12) is best forgiven a recent run and remains one to consider.

C6 - PRIX JEAN LE GONIDEC - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Gr2 - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. LOUIS VITTON MIJO** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Toulouse over 2950m on 15 May. Not easy to trust but is also cannot be ruled out
- 2. LEWIS RIVER** - Did not show his best when 6th in a Class A at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Can bounce back and contest the finish
- 3. LAROZE DU GERS** - Successful in a Class B at Enghien over 2850m on 27 April. Lethal over this shorter distance and is capable of following up
- 4. LOBBING DE BLARY** - Not reliable and was disqualified last time out in a Group 3 at this course over 2700m on 13 May. Might play a minor role at best
- 5. LIZZANO D'ALOUETTE** - Has some fair form of late and finished 5th in a Group 2 at this track over 2850m on 2 May. Can get into the mix of things
- 6. LARGO DE CASTELLE** - Often competitive and finished third at Wolvega over 2100m on 22 May. On a long losing run and has a tough task in this line-up
- 7. LOULOU DE MYE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Group 2 at this course over 2850m on 22 May. On a long losing run and others are preferred
- 8. LEARN TO FLY** - Much improved of late and was third in a Group 2 at this track over 2850m on 2 May. Capable of making the frame
- 9. LANCIER DU GOUTIER** - Faulted last time out in a Group 2 at this course over 2850m on 2 May. Very consistent before that and can bounce back to score
- 10. LIBERTE DE CHOISEL** - Has already won twice this year, including last time out in a Group 2 at this course over 2850m on 2 May. Better over further but would not be a surprise winner
- 11. LOVINO BELLO** - Finished 6th last time out in a Group 1 at this course over 2200m on 28 February. Returns from a break but could be a threat if fit enough

Summary: LANCIER DU GOUTIER (9) is worth another chance after a below-par effort and has the talent to bounce back in this company. If returning to his best form, he should play a leading role. LIBERTE DE CHOISEL (10) arrives in excellent heart after an authoritative Group 2 success in the Prix Albert Demarcq, confirming her place among the leading performers of her generation. Progressive filly LAROZE DU GERS (3) continues to improve with racing and looks capable of taking another step forward. LOVINO BELLO (11) returns from a break and his fitness must be taken on trust, but his class is beyond doubt.

C7 - PRIX GUY LE GONIDEC - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr2 - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. MISSING** - Victorious in her last three starts, the latest in a Class C over this track and trip on 15 May. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 2. MARGAUX DES ARRIS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. MARILOU** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class B over this track and trip on 2 May. Clearly in with a chance again
- 4. MYSTERY QUEEN** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class B over this course and distance on 2 May. Can complete a hat-trick
- 5. MY LADY CASTELLE** - Unreliable and was 6th in a group 3 over this track and trip on 11 January. Should need this run returning from a break
- 6. MISSANDEI** - Needed her last run when 11th in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Unreliable and could need this run
- 7. MOLLY MADRIK** - Consistent again this year and finished 3rd in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 2 May. Should fight out the finish once again
- 8. MY PRINCESS** - Disqualified in a mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Not reliable and needs to do more to score
- 9. MELODY DE VIVOIN** - Finished 8th in a Group 2 mounted race over this course and distance on 29 May. Others make more appeal
- 10. MIDWAY LADY** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 2 May. Has a place chance on best form
- 11. MADEMOISELLE JANE** - Battling to find best form and finished 7th in a mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. MADRID HAUFOR** - Victorious in a Group 2 at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. In very good shape and is capable of doubling up
- 13. MAGIC NIGHT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Group 3 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. quite capable of bouncing back to score

Summary: MAGIC NIGHT (13) has been disqualified on her last two starts at Enghien and Caen, but she is better judged on her previous form and can make amends on her return to Vincennes. MADRID HAUFOR (12) arrives on the back of a deserved victory and looks set to remain competitive at this level. MOLLY MADRIK (7) is particularly effective when partnered by Alexandre Abrivard and should once again be involved in the finish if reproducing her best form. MYSTERY QUEEN (4) continues to progress, especially racing without shoes, and another forward step would come as no surprise.

C8 - PRIX CHAMBON P - 2850m (a2m) - Gr2 - Harness - EUR € 120,000

- 1. JALENDRA DE MALAC** - Did not show her best when 7th in a Class B at this course over 2700m on 6 February. Returns from a break and is not out of it if fit enough
- 2. FIFTYFOUR** - Disqualified last time out in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 22 May. Can be a threat if smart this time around
- 3. COBRA KILLER GAR** - Returned to form and was third in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Can contest the finish once again
- 4. HULYSSE DIGEO** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 22 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. GENDREEN** - Disqualified in four of his last five starts, including last time out in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 21 March. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. HORCHESTRO** - Faulted last time out in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Capable of bouncing back to beat these rivals
- 7. IBIKI DE HOUELLE** - At the top of his game and was a Group 3 winner last time out over this track and trip on 22 May. Can double up
- 8. IDEAL LIGNERIES** - Has not won since 2024 but is knocking at the door and was runner-up in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Can get involved in the finish yet again
- 9. INA DU RIB** - Has lost her way of late and was 13th in a Group 2 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Capable of an upset on best form
- 10. KOCTEL DU DAIN** - Returned to form and finished third in a Group 2 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Quite capable of making the frame
- 11. HOOKER BERRY** - On a long losing run and was 6th in a Group 2 at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Might play a minor role at best

Summary: HORCHESTRO (6) was disqualified after an inquiry in the Prix Jean Riaud on 22 May and will be keen to gain compensation for that misfortune. Back under the spotlight, he has the ability to make a bold bid if everything falls into place. IBIKI DE HOUELLE (7) inherited the victory that day and arrives with solid credentials once again. KOCTEL DU DAIN (10) impressed with a standout performance at Caen and rates a major danger, while IDEAL LIGNERIES (8) continues to progress and looks capable of reaching another level.

- 1. MOWGLY FRECA** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Class B at Vichy over 2950m on 11 May. Capable of an upset on best form
- 2. MIKA DE LA VALLEE** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a Class D at Le Croise Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Can be competitive yet again
- 3. MELOPE DU GOUTIER** - Victorious in her last three starts, the latest in a Class D at this course over 2175m on 5 May. Can add another win to her tally
- 4. MY NAME IS BOND** - Battling to find best form and finished 9th in a Class D over this track and trip on 12 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. MISTHOS CHRISTAL** - Victorious in a Class E at Bernay over 2800m on 3 May. Liked it on the grass and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 6. MONNAIE COURANTE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class D at this course over 2700m on 28 April. Can get into the frame
- 7. MY DREAM** - In good shape and finished 3rd in Class D over this course and distance on 12 May. Should be in the mix of things
- 8. MILLIUM QUESNOT** - Not reliable and was 7th in a Class D at this course over 2700m on 30 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. MODE DU VALLON** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D at this track over 2700m on 28 April. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 10. MARA DU SAPHIR** - Successful in Class D at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 4 May. In very good form and can fight out the finish again
- 11. MAJOR DE TIMM** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vincennes over 2175m on 29 May. Victorious in October and has a place chance if smart

Summary: A competitive lucky last race. MELOPE DU GOUTIER (3) arrives in flying form having completed a hat-trick with David Thomain and looks the one to beat. MARA DU SAPHIR (10) impressed when scoring at Meslay-du-Maine and rates the main danger, while MIKA DE LA VALLEE (2) is knocking firmly at the door and MY DREAM (7) is holding her form well and shouldn't be underestimated in this line-up and can make the frame.
