## TURFFONTEIN STANDSIDE (SA) - 6 JULY 2025

**RACECOURSE:** Turf. 2700m oval track. Races up to 1160m straight course; beyond 1160m clockwise round turn with 800m run-in. Track rises 12m from 1600m to 800m marks, making it most testing circuit in SA. **TOP JOCKEYS AT TRACK:** G Lerena 280-83 (29.64%)-125, C Zackey 165-29 (17.58%)-67, P Strydom 80-23 (28.75%)-28, C Habib 172-16 (9.30%)-59 **TOP TRAINERS AT TRACK:** S G Tarry 310-42 (13.55%)-117, A P Peter 236-33 (13.98%)-77, J J van Vuuren 161-25 (15.53%)-63, P F Matchett 244-17 (6.97%)-90 **DRAW:** Low-number draws favoured over 1400m and to a lesser extent 1600m. **APPRENTICES (ALLOWANCES):** K J Lihaba, T Mayhew (1.5), G Samo-Burthia (4.0).

**DOWN IN CLASS:** EIGHT HATS.

**TIPS:** 3 EIGHT HATS 9 OPEN SESAME 1 ALTA CAPITANA 7 PRINCESS KEIRA

**PREVIEW:** ALTA CAPITANA was outrun late by PRINCESS KEIRA over track and trip last time but should turn the tables on 2kg better terms. The latter is a Reserve Runner in a 2yo Grade 2 on HWB Durban July day. EIGHT HATS didn't go unnoticed in a 1200m Grade 1 last time, staying on well after early interference to be beaten a little over 5 lengths. On the evidence of that performance, she could have more to offer stretching out to this distance. It is interesting to note regular rider Phila Mxoli partners stablemate LET'S GO LOLA instead. OPEN SESAME would've come on from her debut and should have a say.

**TIPS:** 4 SHADOWFAX 2 JAN VAN GOYEN 1 BLIZZARD QUEST 7 RADIO STAR

**PREVIEW:** BLIZZARD QUEST justified market support when stepped up in trip on his reappearance as a gelding and should have more to offer. JAN VAN GOYEN was outrun late over 1160m by SHADOWFAX last time and is weighted to avenge that defeat on 3kg better terms. However, this extended distance will likely favour the latter who is good value to confirm his superiority. NYAKA NYAKA wasn't beaten far by that pair last time and should again acquit himself competitively. Maiden RADIO STAR, 2nd in both starts over this track and trip, isn't taken lightly in receipt of 3kg.

**TIPS:** 4 RADICCHIO 2 FIRE 'N FLAMES 6 SILENT WAR 3 GIMMEANOTHERCHANCE

**PREVIEW:** SON OF RAJ is weighted to be competitive but he's also a Reserve Runner in the HWB Durban July, so his participation could be in doubt. FIRE 'N FLAMES was outclassed in a KZN Grade 1 last month but will be more competitive at this level under these conditions. GIMMEANOTHERCHANCE has found form recently and another 3-point drop in the ratings should stand him in good stead. RADICCHIO had excuses for finishing behind that rival last time and deserves a reward for his consistency. SILENT WAR has a bit to find at the weights but is dangerous to discount under 50kg.

**FORECAST BETTING:** 5-2 CONSTELLATION; 3-1 HEMISPHERE; 33-10 IT'S PERSONAL; 6-1 SEA WOLF; 8-1 LONELY AS A CLOUD; 10-1 WILLIAM WEST; 12-1 AND UPWARDS OTHERS.

**HEADGEAR CHANGE:** BLINKERS ON: SAIGON SUZIE. CHEEK PIECES ON: IT'S PERSONAL.

**TIPS:** 4 CONSTELLATION 2 IT'S PERSONAL 3 HEMISPHERE 1 SEA WOLF

**PREVIEW:** Promising 2yo CONSTELLATION wasn't winning out of turn last time when fitted with a tongue-tie. With further improvement likely, he could be leniently treated so it could pay to follow his progress. Older rivals IT'S PERSONAL and HEMISPHERE are closely matched - both have the form and experience to challenge the youngster. Returning SEA WOLF and course-and-distance winner LONELY AS A CLOUD complete the shortlist.
