

R5 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE CAP ESTEREL - 2925m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 58,000

- 1. HOOPER DES CHASSES** - A runner-up at Berlin-Mariedorf over 1900m on 22 March. Unreliable and could need this run returning from a break
- 2. FICIMER** - Disqualified in a class B at Hyeres over 2650m on 16 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of better. Others make more appeal
- 3. JONGLEUSE DE LUNE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class A at Sable-sur-Sarthe over 2800m on 28 June. Reverts to barefoot and could make the frame
- 4. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Group 3 at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 17 June. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 5. INVICTUS MADIBA** - Finished third in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 13 June. Not reliable but is capable of contesting the finish
- 6. INDUS VAL** - Vitorious in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 13 June. Quite capable of doubling up this longer distance
- 7. HARLEM DE BUCY** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in a class A at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Needs to do more to score
- 8. JINGLE DU PONT** - Returned to form and finished third in a class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and should be a threat once again
- 9. FLOREAL** - Disqualified in a class A at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Remains barefoot and is is capable of playing and minor role when smart
- 10. HUDO DU RUEL** - Consistent and was third in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 20 February. Remains barefoot and could be a threat returning from a break
- 11. INATO PIERJI** - In good form and was runner-up in a class A at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Does well with this shoeing and can go one place better

Summary: A competitive looking opening event. INATO PIERJI (11) will not be conceding ground for once and finds a golden opportunity to score. The game INDUS VAL (6) is expected to give everything again and represents a solid base. JINGLE DU PONT (8) should appreciate leaving Vincennes and can be considered a possible winner. JONGLEUSE DE LUNE (3), this time fitted out for competition is also capable of getting into the frame.

C2 - PRIX MARCEL VERCRUYSSSE - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 38,000

1. **GIRLY VICTORY** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
2. **KALENCIO FLAC** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th at Waregem over 3500m on 9 June. Capable of better and is not out of it
3. **KAPORAL DES FORGES** - Off form and finished 10th in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 29 April. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
4. **JAGUAR WIT** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 7 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
5. **KINGSLAND DE SIMM** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 2 May. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
6. **ILCAPITANO DU PARC** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class D mounted race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 2 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
7. **KENO PETTEVINIERE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Might play a minor role at very best
8. **KOTKIE** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a Group 3 at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 17 June. Reverts to barefoot and could upset
9. **KEMIA DU CHENE** - In good shape and was third in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Has claims in an open looking race
10. **ICAMORA DE HOUELLE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class D at Alencon over 2650m on 31 May. Needs to do more to score
11. **JINGLE LOVER** - Successful in five of last seven starts, including in a class D at Feurs over 2225m on 12 June. Can score again
12. **GAILLARDE QUERAY** - Finished 9th in a Group 3 at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 17 June. Reverts to barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
13. **JOJOBA DE QUERAY** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and should be competitive once again
14. **HEYDAY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class A at Eauze over 3000m on 7 June. Remains barefoot and has won twice this year. Might place

Summary: KEMIA DU CHENE (9) posted a solid performance at Enghien last time out and is narrowly preferred. KALENCIO FLAC (2) possesses a sharp finishing kick but has only been moderate of late. JINGLE LOVER (11), currently in irresistible form will not go down without a fight for top honours. KINGSLAND DE SIMM (5) has been given a short break since his runner-up finish on 2 May at Vincennes and remains competitive as well.

C3 - PRIX BOSS DU MELEUC - 2925m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 38,000

- 1. LASCAR D'ENFER** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 16 June. Can complete the hat-trick
- 2. LIKALETO DE WALLIS** - In good form and was runner-up in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish once again
- 3. LORKY RED** - Victorious in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Remains in good shape and is not out of it
- 4. LEDZEP** - Finished 7th in a class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 1900m on 22 June. Remains barefoot and has disqualification issues. Others make more appeal
- 5. LIVANTO KALOUMA** - Unreliable and finished unplaced in a class B at Enghien over 2875m on 13 June. Reverts to barefoot and could contest the finish
- 6. LEVER DU JOAMAX** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
- 7. LORD DE LOIRON** - Disqualified in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Quite capable of bouncing back to score if staying in stride

Summary: A small field but a very interesting race. We'll tentatively side with LORD DE LOIRON (7), who left some regrets after his last-start mistake. LIVANTO KALOUMA (5) is now fully tuned up after a needed comeback run and could be ready to strike. LASCAR D'ENFER (1), currently improving steadily is not without a chance. LIKALETO DE WALLIS (2) is very consistent and likely to get involved with the finish.

C4 - PRIX BABY LOU MAX - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. KEOPS JUTH** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a class H at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Capable of better and is not out of it
- 2. JUPITER DELO** - A winner of a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 19 June. Remains barefoot and could double up
- 3. LEE ROCK BOND** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 19 June. More is needed to score
- 4. LUGANO** - Not reliable and was fifth in a class E at Argentan over 2800m on 11 May. Might pop up in a minor place
- 5. LASKO DES FORGES** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Remains barefoot and has run well for this driver. Can make the frame
- 6. JUP AND STAR** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 13 March. Not easy to trust but can earn some money
- 7. LOGAN JIEL** - Disqualified in a class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 June. Remains barefoot but has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 8. JALICO DU FRUITIER** - Returned to form and was fourth in a class F at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish yet again
- 9. LUCIFERMORNINGSTAR** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 10. LAUTREC TURGOT** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in a class D at Toulouse over 2950m on 15 May. Remains barefoot and could complete the treble

Summary: The victory should be fought out between LAUTREC TURGOT (10), irresistible this year, and JALICO DU FRUITIER (8), who finds a field well within his reach. LAUTREC TURGOT (10) can complete a solid hat-trick. LASKO DES FORGES (5) is poorly drawn but gets on very well with Pierre Vercruysse and will be race-fit. From the front line, KEOPS JUTH (1) also merits a mention over this track and trip.

C5 - PRIX BAHIA QUESNOT - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **LILLY DE GOUYE** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 10 June. Might play a minor role
2. **LADY DU CHENE** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class E at Chartres over 2825m on 17 June. Can be a threat if smart
3. **KERIA FLEURY** - Off form and was unplaced in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over over 2700m on 22 June. Reverts to barefoot but needs major improvement to score
4. **KALYPSIA BOND** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a class H at Bollene over 2800m on 28 June. Reverts to barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
5. **LENA D'HERIPRE** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a class D at this track over 2925m on 2 January. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
6. **LILIBETH SMART** - Victorious in a class E at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 27 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money
7. **LA REINE MARGOT** - In good form and was runner-up in a class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 13 March. Returns from a break and could need this run
8. **LIUBA JAMES** - Successful twice in two of last three starts, including last time out in a class G mounted race at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June.. Better under the saddle
9. **LA SPEZIA DE LOU** - Unreliable of late and finished 7th in a class D at Lisieux over 2725m on 20 June. Capable of better and could make the frame
10. **LUTECIA ELLIS** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
11. **LIBERTY PAT** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class C at Vincennes over 2300m on 20 February. Could need this run returning from a break
12. **KAICHA** - Finished 10th in a class G mounted race at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
13. **LATINA DU FER** - In good shape and finished fourth in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Remains barefoot and has claims in this line-up
14. **KIWA BLEUE** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a class C at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 1 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
15. **JOCONDE DE RHEVE** - Successful in a class G at Nantes over 3000m on 22 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of following up
16. **KANELLE STAR** - A winner of a class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 14 June. Not reliable but is capable of doubling up

Summary: LATINA DU FER (13) was only beaten by three quality contemporaries last time out and now looks to have a fine opportunity to get off the mark, taking on only fillies. From the front line, LENA D'HERIPRE (5) and LADY DU CHENE (2) look like the most solid options. KANELLE STAR (16) comes off a pleasing win at La Capelle and also looks capable of getting involved with the finish once again.

C6 - PRIX ANZI DES LIARDS - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. MISTER NICE** - Disqualified in a class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 27 June. Reverts to barefoot and did better on debut. Might surprise
- 2. MAHATMA** - Successful in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Has improved of late but this looks a tougher task
- 3. MONT VENTOUX** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 19 June. Reverts to barefoot but has disqualification issues. Can upset
- 4. MY MILLION D'ANSY** - In good form and was third in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 11 June. Remains barefoot and can score
- 5. MILORD DES CHARMES** - A winner of a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Unreliable but cannot be ruled out of a follow up win
- 6. MILLESIME STAR** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 10 June. Needs major improvement to score
- 7. MY WAY DE QUELETTE** - In good shape and was runner-up in a class E La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
- 8. MISTER DUAL** - Off form and finished 9th in a class D at Laval over 2850m on 25 June. Needs to more to beat these rivals
- 9. MAESTRO CASTELETS** - Successful in three of last five starts, including in a class E at Chartres over 2800m on 7 May. Can add another win to the tally
- 10. MICHIGAN HAWK** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a class D at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 11. MYSTIC BOND** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 16 June. Reverts to barefoot and should be a threat to these rivals
- 12. MILLER DU VIVIER** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class D at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: MY MILLION D'ANSY (4) comes into this in top form, but he will need to be quick to resist the finishers. MY WAY DE QUELETTE (7) ran in a very strong race last time at La Capelle and can be a real threat. MYSTIC BOND (11), whose form lines are strong and must be given much respect. MAESTRO CASTELETS (9) is not easy to trust but is quite capable of scoring again if staying on the trot..

C7 - PRIX ELSA DE BELFONDS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. NAURIEL ATALANTE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 27 June. Capable of better and could contest the finish
- 2. NASTRO D'ORO** - Has run well in both starts and was third in a class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 June. Can contest the finish once again
- 3. NAGOYA QUICK** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 26 June. Needs to do more to score
- 4. NORA D'HOULBEC** - Showed some improvement when third in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Can challenge for top honours if smart again
- 5. NOUBA CASTELETS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 26 June. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 6. NAIKA MAXENTAISE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class G at Avignon over 2025m on 24 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. NUANCE SECRETE** - Finished third on debut in a class F at Amiens over 2400m on 26 November. Returns from a breal but can be a threat if fit enough
- 8. NOLAN D'OR** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 19 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 9. NIKITA D'ORGUEIL** - Finished 9th on debut in a class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 1 May. Needs o find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 10. NIKITA D'ALOUETTE** - Disqualified on debut in a class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 31 May. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 11. NIAGARA RIVER** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 12. NELSON DE GUELLE** - A three-year-old colt by Atlas de Joudes out of Iroise De Guelle who is making his debut. His Dam never raced in France. Could need this experience
- 13. NARSEO** - A three-year-old colt by Village Mystic out of Donatella de Lou who is making his debut. His mother won once in 22 starts. Others make more appeal
- 14. NAOS DU POMMEREUX** - Disqualified on debut in a class G at Le Neubourg over 2200m on 13 June. Capable of improvement and could be a threat
- 15. NOTCH UP** - A three-year-old gelding by Impressionist out of Enamorada Jet who is making his debut. His mother won 3 of 16 starts. Qualified in a smart time and could score
- 16. NINA ERA** - Finished 8th in a class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 16 June. has shown little so far and others make much more appeal

Summary: A very interesting lucky last race. his race could spring a few surprises. Well-qualified newcomer NOTCH UP (15) gets a narrow vote to score ahead of the "Derieux" runner NUANCE SECRETE (7), who made promising debut appearances late last year. NASTRO D'ORO (2) and NAURIEL ATALANTE (1) could make use of their experience advantage and can both get involved with the finish this time around.
