She will still be justifiably wary of GITAN DE TOUCHYVON (9) who won here almost exactly a year ago, and the wonderfully capable JAMES OF CARLY (8) who is shod to preference for his first objective of the season. JOJO DE L'AUNAY (10) has nothing to prove at this level and associated with Pierre-Yves Verva must be taken seriously.
