COIN SPINNER faces a competitive bunch just out the maidens but has scope and could make the required improvement. IRONTAIL needed his last few and should come on. He prefers this track and trip. If allowed to 'bowl' along in front QUANT MASTER could bag another win at this venue. CABINET SHUFFLE didn't disgrace himself at Greyville last time and is even better at this course. MOUNT GREYLOCK has drawn No1 one - watch out.
