Race 1 - PRIX MARIUS DE ANDREIS - 2000m HCP. Purse EUR €18,000.

- 1. **LEPTI PRINSADI** Solid 2.75L third at Nimes over 1900m four weeks ago in a Class Three conditions event. Interesting.
- 2. **LOUVE SAPHIR** Ran well at this venue three weeks ago when 2L second in a 1500m claimer. Shortlisted with the trainer in good form.
- 3. **KING MOTIF** Consistent type who ran 3.25L fourth at Lyon-la-Soie in a 2150m AW Class Three conditions race 23 days ago. Holds claims.
- 4. **MARS** Good 3.5L third here three weeks back behind Louve Saphir tackling a 1500m claimer. Consider.
- 5. **LA BRUXELLOISE** Consistent filly who produced a solid 1L second at Salon-de-Provence two weeks ago in a 2400m handicap. Down 1.5kg. Leading contender.
- 6. **BENI KHIAR** Not disgraced at Marseille-Borely in October when 2L seventh in a 1600m handicap. Place likely best for a notable new trainer.
- 7. **A LA FOLIE** Lightly raced but promising filly. Makes AW debut and trainer worth noting. Take a second look.
- 8. **NAMASTE** Ran with credit at Lyon-la-Soie 23 days ago when 5.25L fifth tackling a 2400m handicap. Deauville 2500m AW handicap winner prior. In the mix down 0.5kg.
- 9. **PRETTY SUZIE** 7.25L fifth at Marseille-Borely three weeks back in an 1800m handicap. Each-way hope down 0.5kg.
- 10. **AMSTERDAM** Mixed form in Germany in recent months. New trainer now and open to improvement.

Ran 3.25L fourth at Lyon-la-Soie in a 2150m AW Class Three conditions race and holds claims. NAMASTE (8) was not disgraced at Lyon-la-Soie when 5.25L fifth tackling a 2400m handicap and proved a Deauville 2500m AW handicap winner prior. In the mix down 0.5kg.

- 4. **BECH RIVER** Longchamp 1600m handicap winner prior to a fair fifth at Marseille-Borely over 1800m. Upped 1kg. Interesting.
- 5. **WALACHOPE** 9.5L fifth at Nimes four weeks ago in a 1900m Class Three conditions event. Needs to be at best.

May build on that effort upped in distance.

- 2. **MYSTICAL PRINCE** Course and distance specialist who finished a 1L third in this handicap class a month ago. Claims.
- 3. ROXY MUSIC Below par on his last two starts and needs to bounce back to best if he is to feature.
- 4. **MANAROLA** Consistent type who scored narrowly over course and distance two back. Unexposed on the AW. Key chance.
- 5. **CHANTE BLU** Conditions to suit as a dual track and trip winner and although below par latest he cannot be discounted.
- 6. **CASIVE** Finished behind Mystical Prince when a 2.5L sixth over track and trip last month. Not dismissed dropped 1kg.
- 7. **EXPRESS POWER** 3.5L third in a course and distance claimer last month. Needs to replicate back in a handicap.
- 8. CHANT D'AUTOMNE Fourteen race maiden who is yet to show much on the AW. Best watched.
- 9. **KHIVALA** Running consistently in and around this grade of handicap recently. Strong each-way player.

KHIVALA (9) continues to race favourably in similar handicaps and must be respected once more. Top-weight ANFRATI (1) holds each-way claims.

- 2. **AMBRE** 22 race maiden who is capable of going close as she did at Marseille Borely two back. Needs to bounce back from a heavy defeat at Toulouse recently.
- 3. **MEJAEN** Bounced back to form with a surprise 0.75L course and distance victory. Often goes well here and respected.
- 4. **LE PIN** 2.5L fifth in a Class Three handicap over track and trip a month ago. Frame chance.
- 5. **DUBAI EMPIRE** Held sixth in a lower grade claiming handicap at Hyeres last start. Others preferred given a poor AW record.
- 6. **BONFIRE HEART** 2.75L third in a Class Three conditions event over course and distance three weeks ago. Claims.
- 7. **LADY MAG** Moderate sixth in a Class Three handicap over 2500m on soft ground at Le Croise-Laroche. Needs to do more back on the AW.

Summary: BONFIRE HEART (6) shaped nicely to finish a 2.75L third in a Class Three conditions event over course and distance three weeks ago. Leading chance in this suitable contest. Three-time track and trip winner MEJAEN (3) bounced back to form with a surprise 0.75L success under those conditions. Key contender if replicating. AMBRE (2) needs to bounce back from a heavy defeat at Toulouse but could do so returned to the AW. LE PIN (4) holds each-way claims.

- 4. LA VENELLOISE Held over course and distance recently but dangerous to dismiss on best form.
- 5. **NIGHT OF THE OPERA** 4.5L seventh over 2000m here last month. Could find the frame on best figures.
- 6. **MEHANYDREAM** 0.75L runner-up over 1100m at Le-Croise-Laroche last month. Key chance if replicating upped in trip.
